SECRETIVE TRILATERAL SUBCOMMITTEE RUNS SALT TAIMS

WASHINGTON, D.C., Nov. 27 (IPS)--David Rockefeller's Trilateral Commission is directly controlling "policy planning" for the U.S. delegation to the Strategic Arms Limitation Talks (SALT) in Geneva.

The General Advisory Committee on Arms Control and Disarmament, the body that drafts most of U.S. policy, contains no less than six Trilateral Commission members and is represented at the talks by Trilateral Executive Committee member Dr. Harold Brown, president of the California Institute of Technology.

The full Committee, appointed by the President, serves as the advising agency to the negotiating team, the President, the Secretaries of State and Defense, and the National Security Council. Representatives of the General Advisory Committee, which is composed of "non-governmental, private citizens," also meet regularly with the "back-up" negotiating committee in Washington, which includes the top officials of the Central Intelligence Agency.

The present chairman of the General Advisory Committee is Dr. Harold Agnew, director of the Los Alamos Laboratory. A spokesman for his office at the Advisory Committee in Washington today refused to answer any questions from IPS reporters. The spokesman, Howard Myers, in response to a question regarding the function of the Committee, would only comment: "I'm not going to tell you anything. And if I knew, I still wouldn't tell you...because the work of the Committee totally depends on continued strict conditions of confidentiality." Dr. Agnew thus far has refused to answer questions from IPS concerning the activities of his Committee.

Meanwhile, a spokesman for the Arms Control and Disarmament Agency informed IPS that the present members, in addition to Dr. Agnew, are:

Gordon Allott, former U.S. Senator from Colorado; Edward Clark, former U.S. Ambassador to Australia; Lane Kirkland, Secretary-Treasurer of the AFL-CIO and member of the Trilateral Commission; Dr. Karl Marcy, former staff director of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee; Joseph Martin, Jr., former U.S. Ambassador to the Geneva talks; John A. McCone, former Director of the CIA; Gerard C. Smith, North American director of the Trilateral Commission; I.W. Abel, president of the United Steelworkers and executive committee member of the Trilateral Commission; former Secretary of State Dean Rusk; Dr. John Wheeler; William C. Foster, former director of ACDA; Dr. Harold Brown, executive committee member, Trilateral Commission; and William Scranton, former Governor of Pennsylvania, overseer of the First Great Oil Hoax, and executive committee member of the Trilateral Commission.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE CONSIDERING PLANS TO RELOCATE URBAN INDUSTRY

Nov. 27 (IPS)--James Sundquist of the Brookings Institute testified before the House Public Works Committee yesterday on a program to deindustrialize urban areas in the United States and to relocate industry into selected rural areas and small cities.

Sundquist's plans, which involve giving Federal grants to encourage dispersed plants, would accelerate the already ongoing Rockefeller efforts to relocate the urban workforce into scattered development projects.

The House Public Works Committee is now working closely with the West Regional Commission of the Economic Development Administration to develop a comprehensive plan for the Rocky Mountain slave-labor projects.

Describing these plans to IPS, an aide for the Public Works Committee said that they were based on the concept of "carrying capacity" developed at the Academy on Contemporary Problems. The "carrying capacity" concept, he said, was initially developed to work out how many cattle, sheep, hyenas, wolves, etc., could live on Western range land.

Mass Transit "Wasted Expenditure"

When IPS remarked that cities were already being depopulated, the aide agreed and pointed to the recently passed \$11.6 billion mass transit bill as an example of "wasted expenditures on a decaying urban civilization."

The Committee aide also acknowledged that most of these ideas were originally brought together by the Rockefeller family, specifically by John D. Rockefeller III and his Commission on Population and the American Future. Many of the key members of the Science Advisory Panel which is developing the fascist public works program for the Committee, such as Sundquist and S. David Freeman, have long associations with Rockefeller institutions like Brookings and the Ford Foundation.

In the aide's estimation, if Nelson Rockefeller is confirmed as Vice President, the population dispersal policies formulated by Sundquist for the Public Works Committee will be elevated into a national issue by Rocky.

CIA STEPS UP PRESSUPE ON IRAQ

Nov. 27 (IPS)--The Iraqi government today accused the United States, Great Britain, and Iran of planning to occupy oil-producing countries in the Middle East. The accusation, released through official government organs, is clearly in response to recent intense provocations by the CIA against anti-Rockefeller Iraq.

Yesterday, the United States aircraft carrier Constellation, with 100 aircraft aboard and accompanied by the destroyers Berkeley and Cochrane, carried out maneuvers in the Persian Gulf, in what the Pentagon called a brief "familiarization deployment." According to an Associated Press news dispatch, this is the first time in 25 years that a U.S. aircraft carrier has entered the Gulf.

When questioned about these maneuvers and the continuing step-up of provocations against Iraq, a Washington-based Strategic Studies veteran who recently returned from CIA Middle East headquarters in Iran frankly detailed increasing Iranian-CIA bellicosity. Asked, for example, about the Iran-supported Kurdish war against the pro-Soviet Iraqis, this think-tanker pro-claimed that the Kurdish situation was small stuff compared to the Iraqi-Iranian tension around the waters of the Tigris-Euphrates headgulf. Iran has consistently ignored a long-existing treaty between the two states over the waters, and in fact recently evacuated the border town of Abadan to avoid possible Iraqi shelling and to set the stage for new escalations against Iraq.

WORKERS MOBILIZE TO SPREAD HCLC CONGRESSIONAL TESTIMONY

WASHINGTON, D.C., Nov. 26 (IPS)--Testifying on the Vice Presidential nomination of Melson Rockefeller, Mational Caucus of Labor Committees Mational Chairman Lyn Marcus told the House Judiciary Committee today, "Rockefeller and his programmatic commitments represent a menace to the human race. Rockefeller and his accomplices must be stopped at all costs."

In the past few days the Labor Party political machine has mobilized its briefing and sales networks around Marcus' appearance before Congress to see that every worker in North America gets that message. Angrily recalling the CIA media blackout of Marcus' late-September testimony before the Senate Rules Committee, Labor Party worker-organizers have organized other workers to barrage newspapers, radio, and television stations with phone calls demanding that they cover Marcus--forcing at least 25 media outlets to make commitments to report the testimony.

Even more significant, workers are strengthening the Labor Party machine by organizing their families, friends, and coworkers to hear the testimony, even if Rockefeller succeeds in enforcing another bourgeois media blackout. At numerous meetings, both prearranged and spontaneous, over the next ten days or so, groups of workers will gather around tape recorders in factories and in each other's homes to listen to Marcus. One worker in New York City has already called a meeting of the 39 people who came to his house last week; this time they will hear the Marcus tape. Worker fundraising meetings have been organized to view Marcus' testimony on videotapes supplied by the Labor Party. And as a result of working-class pressure, a growing number of cable TV and public broadcasting outlets across the country will play tapes of Marcus' indictment of Rockefeller.

This week's mobilization has shown Labor Party organizers a qualitative change in the political consciousness of the working class. Comparing workers' responses to Rockefeller now with their responses at the time of Marcus' Senate testimony two months ago, organizers have found that today workers express not merely their gut hatred of Rocky, based on class instinct, but their active understanding of his fascist policies.

In the past month Labor Party exposure of the Rockefellerengineered United Mine Workers "strike" and Middle East war scenario has initiated successive waves of working-class self-organization which has significantly crippled the intended effects of these operations against workers.

In the case of the UMV charade, for example, the Labor Party has been unable, despite a diligent search this past week, to locate any workers who believe Rocky's psywar message that the current wave of layoffs in basic industry is attributable to the miners strike. Workers are saying: "It's Rocky."

Mounting rage in reaction to the layoffs and threats of layoffs is their characteristic response. At a Bethlehem, Pennsylvania steel plant where layoff rumors have been incessant, a worker driving out of the plant yelled to a Labor Party organizer selling New Solidarity: "We ought to shoot Rockefeller, we have to shoot him." When the organizer yelled back, "That's not enough," the worker stopped his car on a green light. While 30 cars piled up behind his, this worker then ran back to the organizer to get a 30-second educational.

That hundreds of thousands of workers have already had that educational and have decided to build a revolutionary party was reflected in the massive vote for Labor Party candidates this fall. These workers are now intensively discussing the International Caucus of Labor Committees Strategic Studies series, selling New Solidarity subscriptions, organizing groups of other workers to meetings, deploying with the Labor Party, etc. Probably three times this number are active organizers for the Labor Party, in direct touch with the Party over the course of a month. Among this group of a thousand or so Labor Party worker-organizers are most of those whose organizing activities were by and large limited to buying the newspaper and making phone calls in late September.

ISRAEL ECONOMY HAS FOUR MONTHS TO GO, CHASE SAYS

Nov. 26 (IPS)--Burning up its foreign exchange reserves at the monthly rate of \$200-250 million, Israel will face bankruptcy within four months. No positive effects are to be expected from the recent 40 per cent devaluation of the Israeli pound.

This is Chase Manhattan Bank's estimation of the current economic crisis in Israel. According to a Chase economist: "The situation is pretty critical, as evidenced by their willingness to devalue the pound, something they fought against for a very long time." The economist added that the devaluation would not help Israeli imports, since their market position depended on special arrangements, and were not price-elastic. Instead, the devaluation was forced by "panic buying by consumers."

Mormally, Israeli currency reserves have been maintained at about \$1.5 billion. But now, at less than \$900 million, the reserves face rapid exhaustion at a rate of \$200 to \$250 million per month.

In addition, the Chase economist said, "Israel is under additional pressure because the invisibles they normally get are not coming in, in particular the contributions from world Jewry." A financial scandal around the Israel Corporation last September has affected the willingness of Israel's supporters to shell out.

Mo funds, public or private, are coming in on the scale that Israel requires, the Chase source added, with no solution in sight.

Recently, the president of the oil multinational Atlantic Richfield said that one of the factors militating for a new Mideast war was the "disintegration" of the Israeli economy.

FIRST PENN PREVENTS ISRAEL FINANCE PANIC

PHILADELPHIA, Nov. 26 (IPS) -- The First Pennsylvania Corporation is negotiating the purchase of 13 per cent of the equity of the First International Bank of Israel, averting a possible new Israeli bank scandal, bank spokesmen confirmed today. But the bank refused to say who the purchaser of the equity will be.

The Israeli bank in question, in which First Pennsylvania has a 42 per cent equity share, was threatened by the bankruptcy Friday of Britain's Triumph Investment Trust, which held 13 per cent of the equity stake. The bank, Israel's fifth largest, was founded two years ago with participation by the Israeli government.

Trouble at First International Israel would have deepened the current financial crisis in Israel. Problems at the Israel Corporation, an investment bank whose stockholders included the French Rothschild family, rocked the Israeli financial scene in September and discouraged further contributions by Jewish supporters of Israel.

The Israel Corporation lost several tens of millions of dollars when a Swiss bank with whom it had heavy dealings, the Geneva-based Banque du Credit Internationale, applied for a debt moratorium under Swiss banking law. Previously, the Israel Corporation lost heavily when its deposits with the Swiss bank were placed with several failing real estate companies in Lichtenstein.

IPS reported in September that the bank problem in Switzer-land showed evidence of sabotage by the Rockefeller financial group. Its director, Dr. Tibor Rosenbaum, was alleged by U.S. Treasury officials to have Mafia connections and was linked circumstantially to wartime Office of Strategic Services and postwar CIA activities.

In the case of the First International Bank of Israel, however, the same faction is taking steps to prevent further scandal, as the First Penn decision indicates.

An officer of a large New York bank which corresponds with the Israeli bank said that his dealings with the First International Bank of Israel, which include normal letter of credit and trade financing activities, are proceeding normally.

SEARCHES FOR TERRORISTS HIT GERMANY IN AFTERMATH OF BRITISH EMERGENCY LAWS

WIESBADEN, BRD, Nov. 26 (IPS)--The West German Federal Criminal Office with the cooperation of the Hessen, West Berlin, Hamburg, and Bavarian state police yesterday began a widespread search mission allegedly in pursuit of "student terrorist groups." The move is part of the Rockefeller-controlled Trilateral Commission's efforts to replicate in West Germany the same conditions of terror and economic chaos which just resulted in the passage of martial law in Great Britain.

The excuse for the national police mobilization, which led to over 40 arrests in a 12-hour period, was the murder two weeks ago of the High Judge of West Berlin by a band of sympathizers of the imprisoned Baader-Meinhof terrorist gang. The gang is a West German version of the CIA-created brainwashed zombie group in the United States, the Symbionese Liberation Army.

There is substantial evidence that today's arrests, which included at least one case of a police break-in without the existence of an official search warrant, are aimed at frightening and demoralizing the German working class in preparation for this winter's soaring unemployment and the collapse of the economy.

The official West German press agency DPA told IPS that there is no evidence that the 40 arrested suspects are linked to the Baader-Meinhof. A highly placed official at the U.S. State Department also informed IPS that the West German police agencies were keeping special watch on Arab expatriates, the Japanese Red Army, and the office of the Palestine Liberation Organization in East Berlin. When it was pointed out that none of these groups were student organizations, the official admitted that only the Japanese Red Army would fit into that category.

Collapse of Justice

An evening television special on the situation, featuring the Ministers of the Interior and Justice and the head of the Committee of the state-level Interior Ministries, was devoted to the collapse of justice in West Germany. The head of the state Interior Minister's Committee Schwarz delivered a biting attack on the governing Social Democratic Party, claiming that the party leadership was sabotaging police efforts to catch terrorists. To heighten the red scare-terror climate, Schwarz also claimed that terrorists were receiving aid from North Korea and Morth Vietnam and had pilots trained in Sweden! Federal Interior Minister Maihofer then speculated on links between the imprisoned Baader-Meinhof groups and the possibility of wildcats breaking out in industry in the coming months.

A secondary but significant psychological warfare tactic signalled by the arrests is the focus of the police raids on offices of radical lawyers. The effort to discredit left-wing

lawyers by attaching them to feared terrorist bands and the TV discussion on the collapse of justice are aimed to provide a cover for the reintroduction of a right-wing judicial system in West Germany like that of the Veimar Republic in the 1920s. Every political West German worker remembers that throughout the Weimar Republic, Mazi terrorists were handled with kid gloves by "respectable" judges, while working-class leaders were thrown in prison.

MIDEAST ON RAZOR'S EDGE: ICLC MOVES TO BREAK STALEMATE

NEW YORK, N.Y., Nov. 26 (IPS)--Following weeks of war preparations climaxing in the psychotic anti-Arab frenzy manifested by enraged Israeli workers after the massacre at the border village of Beit Shean, Rockefeller's Middle East war stands poised on a razor's edge.

With Israelis and Arabs mobilized and on alert, the political decision to ignite the Middle East powder keg--a decision made not in Tel Aviv, Cairo, or Damascus but in offices of Richard Helms in Teheran and in Pentagon and Chase Manhattan war rooms--depends now on two interrelated factors. One is Rockefeller's ability to recreate an international controlled environment, despite the Labor Committees' massive exposure of the original CIA gameplan for an Arab-Israeli nuclear war and the resulting "Arab oil embargo;" the second factor is the remote possibility that the terrified and confused Soviet bureaucracy will find the courage to challenge the NATO/CIA offensive in Europe and the Middle East.

ICLC Counteroffensive

Since early October when it became apparent to International Caucus of Labor Committees Intelligence that initial war preparations were being made by the CIA and its Arab and Israeli allies, the Labor Committees mobilized internationally to expose and counter Rockefeller's Oil Hoax War scenario. As New Solidarity reports of the coming war penetrated into the consciousness of workers in North America and Western Europe--in nine languages -- IPS reporters and ICLC Intelligence personnel initiated a systematic briefing network among Middle East governments, UN diplomats, foreign and domestic reporters, and the press, even including numerous conversations with State and Defense Department and CIA officials--letting them know we knew. The extent of Labor Committee cross penetration of these layers was revealed in a conversation with an Arab diplomat in Washington yesterday, who--not realizing whom he was addressing--asked an ICLC Middle East intelligence officer in the course of a discussion: "Have you read an article in this newspaper New Solidarity?" In addition, positive contacts were made with existing pro-working class

forces in the Middle East around joint exposure of the CIA's Arab-Israeli war of puppets.

In the face of this organizing, the Rockefeller-CIA decision to unleash the Israeli missiles and tanks must take into account the spreading cracks in the controlled environment on which the war depends and workers' increasingly sensuous understanding of the meaning of CIA-manipulated tension in the Middle East. In addition, another factor is that a simple playing out of the already exposed war options would give widespread credibility to Labor Committee analysis, not least among the timorous but well-briefed Soviet and East bloc diplomatic and party circles--thus severely weakening the hegemony of the detente-loving peoples of the Soviet Politburo.

Stalemate...So Far

Despite the above-outlined political risks and despite the major gains already achieved in reorganizing Western governments and forcing continued Soviet capitulation in Europe and the Middle East, a major Middle East explosion and attached Oil Hoax are still necessary for Rockefeller to implement his plans for a "new world order." Thus, moving to keep war options open, the Israeli government Nov. 24 announced its intention to set up a new industrial settlement on the West Bank, in a belligerent provocation underlining the often-repeated Israeli refusal to relinquish its grasp on the territory. This warlike move was accompanied by renewed talk in Israel of a "Government of National Unity" that would include the right-wing hardliners in the Likud bloc, including infamous General Ariel Sharon.

Sharon, bloodthirsty "hero" of the October War, in an interview with the West German magazine Quick threatened ominously that in a new war "Israel will not allow itself to be stopped," implying that it was U.S. pressure alone that prevented Israeli tanks from rumbling into Damascus and Cairo. Sharon further threatened that "our eyes look to the oil fields to the east and south," referring to the oil-rich Gulf states of Iraq, Kuwait, and Saudi Arabia. The major threat is, of course, against the isolated pro-socialist government of Iraq, which could come under a coordinated attack from Israel and Iran, two countries who maintain close intelligence via the CIA.

As the Rockefeller-CIA forces continue their escalation of the quiet Middle East war, the ICLC and the U.S. Labor Party have moved to take advantage of the current stalemated situation. The ICLC Emergency Food Program is being submitted to all Middle East governments and organizations with a recommendation for immediate action. By advancing such a proposal as the CIA plots the devastation of large sections of the Middle East, the possibility emerges for a programmatic united front that can permanently shatter the regional controlled environment and cause Rockefeller's cynical manipulation to backfire.

FRENCH FINANCE MINISTER SAYS DEINDUSTRIALIZATION IS GOVERNMENT POLICY

Nov. 26 (IPS)--At a French Senate meeting Nov. 22 Finance Minister Jean-Pierre Fourcade openly said that the destruction of sectors of French industry is official government policy.

After stating that "a more selective action of industrial restructuring" must be the government's policy in 1975, Fourcade added:

"There is naturally no question of instituting a mechanism of automatically rescuing companies in difficulty: such a system would be irrational from an economic point of view because it would slow down the indispensable evolution of our industrial structures and would do away with sanctions against bad management...In reality, the actions of public authorities in this area can only be selective. Its objective is to facilitate the structural evolution made necessary by economic progress."

Fourcade was reminded by another Senator that such policies might cause increased unemployment. To this the Finance linister replied: "But one cannot at the same time want to redeploy industry and fight for maintaining present [levels of] company employment."

HUDSON INSTITUTE WRITES OFF BRITAIN ...THEN REST OF ADVANCED SECTOR

Nov. 25 (IPS) -- The Hudson Institute Europe, Paris-based counterpart of the Rockefeller think tank in New York, delivered a psychological time bomb to the British last week--a report suggesting that the United Kingdom may not exist by the year 1980. Hudson Europe produced its report, entitled "The United Kingdom in 1980?", after studying Britain for some 18 months.

By the end of the decade, Hudson says, Britain's standard of living will sink so far that it will be less prosperous than France or Italy, and by 1985, Britain will slump behind Greece and Spain, then back to the level of Dickensian England. Trapped by its feudal past and hedonistic present, says Hudson, Britain may not survive the century--unless it adopts the explicitly fascist program outlined in the report.

The Fascist Panacea

Hudson's remedy is for Britain to accept a variety of fascist measures: rule by a "technocratic elite," the break-up of the country into spheres of local control, full slave-labor exploitation of North Sea oil, and, above all, a "deep" change in psychological attitudes. Lest anyone protest these fascist measures, Hudson's menacing alternative is the "process of economic decline which may well end in the break-up of the United Kingdom."

According to Hudson, six years of technocratic rule is needed to bring Britain into the ranks of "modern...growth oriented societies." This six-year national plan should be run "under the aegis of the State" by a French-style bureacracy of three interlocking directorates—national planning, regional planning, and science and technology. The fascist plan would be operated by a new "elite" of the "best brains in Britain," including its best "economists and administrators, all serving the nation in a self-conscious spirit of ambition and enterprise." A newly created National Administrative College would provide the specially trained civil servants to staff the plan and spearhead national "regeneration."

To set up the slave labor apparatus, the report urges a major reorientation of the British economy away from declining, low technology industries "as rapidly as decently can be done." Among those industries slated for the scrap heap are cars, cheap textiles, and basic consumer goods. To make sure that Arab oil money is funnelled directly into productive ventures such as these, Hudson calls for the creation of a National Investment and Development Corporation which would salvage only those industries which fit into Rockefeller's plans.

"The Scottish Exception"

The only part of the country which escapes the Institute's knife is Scotland, since it already has well developed slave labor camps. In a chapter entitled "The Scottish Exception," the report speaks glowingly of Scotland's "regional dynamism which will allow for a steady increase in living standards and social amenities."

Hudson Saves the Oueen

Hudson specifies that the hereditary peerage in the House of Lords must be abolished. Instead, Peers would have to earn their role in the technocratic elite. This step, according to the report, would be "of considerable symbolic and psychological importance and would have the effect of strengthening the monarchy, rather than the reverse." (emphasis added) A Third World style Britain suffering material deprivation, Hudson implies, will be more dependent on their Queen for spiritual succor.

Hudson makes it crystal clear that even these proposed remedies will not save Britain unless "there is a shift, a deep shift, in psychology, in will--in short, in style. For style, in this case, is everything."

Goading the British on in calculated psychological warfare style by degrading the national character, the report ascribes Britain's stagnation and decline to "a kind of archaism of the society and national psychology, a habit of conciliation in social and personal relations...a lack of aggression, a deference to what exists, a repeated and characteristic flight into pre-industrial, indeed pre-capitalist fantasies, a suspicion of efficiency as somehow 'common,' a dislike for labor itself." Workers, according to Hudson, will now have to prove that they are man enough for slave labor in order to refute these assertions.

"More Right Than Wrong"

The think-tank team is headed up by Hudson Europe director Edmund Stillman, a former U.S. State Department Intelligence Officer in Eastern Europe and the Balkans who studied strategic warfare under a Rockefeller grant. Stillman justifies the free-wheeling style of the report saying, "We don't think economics is a science. We know that numbers are dangerous...almost any economist will admit that he doesn't really know what's going on." He told the London Times, "Look, it may not be right, but it's more right than wrong....Even if the methods are bad, the situation of Britain is so glaring that please, for the country's sake, don't quibble about the methodology."

Timed perfectly to coincide with the Atlantic Bridge meeting of Rockefeller operatives in Bonn, which discussed the restructuring of national sectors and Second International puppet

Willy Brandt's proposal to give Eritain second-class status in the Common Market for its own good, the Mudson Institute has laid out the clear choice--Britain first and the rest of the advanced sector next--of whether to sink or submit to fascism. In fact, one of Stillman's major forecasts is that, "Germany is going to be the Britain of the 1980's...and the United States will be the Britain of the 1990's."

PLANNERS TELL GHETTO TO GROW OWN FOOD

Nov. 25 (IPS)--The Rockefeller conduit New York Times and the San Francisco Chronicle newspapers carried simultaneous feature articles Nov. 21 calling for the most devastated slum sections of each city to be transformed into "agricultural cooperatives," a step in the direction of deliberate starvation of ghetto and welfare and unemployed populations.

A vice chairman of the New York City Planning Commission, Martin Gellent, in an op ed column in the <u>Times</u> proposed collective farming in the fertile tenement areas of the South Bronx. Gellent's "concrete" proposal involves the employment of welfare recipients, ghetto unemployed, and youth in the cultivation of the numerous vacant lots and abandoned buildings which mar the pastoral setting.

An equally perverse appeal was delivered by the Chronicle editorial, "Dignity in the Dirt." The editors call for expansion of a San Francisco program in which 50 acres of land derived from stalled urban renewal projects have already been given for "community gardening" purposes.

This emphasis on feudal traditions appeared in print immediately following the Rome World Food Conference, during which the Rockefeller policy of mass genocide through starvation of "useless eaters" in the Fourth World was officially confirmed. In effect, the Rockefeller press is announcing that "useless eaters" in the U.S. too may continue eating only if they grow their own food.

The machinery moving into place in San Francisco is openly advertised in the <u>Chronicle</u> editorial. A "Community Gardening Movement" is being organized under the auspices of the "Institute for Applied Ecology," run by Richard Nilsen and Rosemary Menninger, the daughter of the notorious mind-murderer Dr. Carl Menninger. It is estimated that key cadre in this "movement" are being brainwashed and activated as part of their participation in "youth guidance" centers and the Laguna Monda "alcoholism treatment" unit, where techniques of behavior modification and related therapy are used.

MEDIA "REVEAL" CIA-MY LAI LINK

Nov. 25 (IPS)—Nine months ago New Solidarity International Press Service blew the story on the CIA's responsibility for the My Lai massacre as part of the CIA's takeover of the U.S. Armed Forces. Now the news finally has made its way into the bourgeois press.

Today's Newsday, a Long Island daily, as well as several radio stations and other media outlets, provide belated corrobotation of New Solidarity's story. Their source is a copyrighted article from the Sunday Oklahoman.

The brief Newsday story reported that Capt. Dennis Johnson, an intelligence officer with the company that raided the Vietnam village of My Lai, claims that the operation was CIA-directed. Johnson, who was punished in 1971 for his involvement in the cover-up of the slaughter, reports that the company's commander Lt. Col. Frank Barker met with two CIA agents just before the raid was carried out. The massacre was part of Operation Phoenix, a mass-murder operation headed by William Colby, now Director of the CIA.

Retired Lt. Gen. William Peers, a top Army "covert operations" agent who headed up the "investigation" of the My Lai massacre, denied Johnson's story.

IRA BOMBINGS SPARK MARTIAL LAW MEASURES IN BRITAIN

Nov. 25 (IPS)--British Home Secretary Roy Jenkins today announced comprehensive police powers amounting to virtual martial law.

Nominally aimed against the Irish Republican Army (IRA), these powers will be used first to replicate the terror of Northern Ireland in Britain, and second, as the pretext for indiscriminate harassment of the British Left.

Jenkins, a member of both the British Labour Party and the Trilateral Commission, has waited for anti-Irish hysteria to peak following last week's bombing in Birmingham before announcing these measures. British Intelligence, which formed the Provisional IRA in the late 1960s to create terror in Northern Ireland, has now deployed the IRA to pull the same operation in Britain.

Gasoline bombings and other retaliatory acts have been reported in Irish working class areas as British workers vent their frustration against these manufactured scapegoats. Auto workers in Britain's industrial heartland have walked off the job, refusing to return until action is taken against the IRA. Irish workers who have lived in Britain for as long as 30 years

were afraid to show up for work on Friday. Housewives are staying home, too scared even to venture out to local stores for the day's shopping.

The press is gleefully fueling an already explosive situation. The Observer headlined the Birmingham explosion: "The night a city felt trapped." Describing bomb casualties, the Observer quoted a local doctor: "You would go into the casualty ward and could be forgiven for thinking roast beef was cookingthe smell of burns was still there long after these people were removed."

With reports of more fabricated "terrorist" attacks to follow, Jenkins warned: "We could be moving to a situation that could be as dangerous in the long-term as in Northern Ireland itself."

Jenkins' measures made it an offense to be a member of, or support in any way, the IRA. Since the British Left openly supports the IRA as a liberation force in Northern Ireland, they will be prime targets in Jenkins' new reign of terror. Homes of British leftists are already regularly raided and searched on the pretext of IRA sympathy. Now they will be subject to intensive interrogation in Irish-style detention camps while awaiting deportation, imprisonment, or unlimited fines if tried and found guilty.

The Conservative Opposition has promised special cooperation with the Government's proposals so they can become law by Nov. 28.

BIRMINGHAM PLAN FOR SELF-POLICING, WARRING NEIGHBORHOODS IS MODEL FOR U.S.

NEW YORK, N.Y., Nov. 25 (IPS) -- A pilot citywide system is being set up in the city of Birmingham, Alabama to divide the working class into squabbling, self-policing "strategic hamlets" competing for jobs, services, and housing. It is a triple-tiered structure with 86 elected neighborhood citizens committees at its base, an intermediate level of 19 community committees, and a Citywide Advisory Board. Elections to the neighborhood committees were held Nov. 20.

The system is strikingly similar to the Judenrat (Jewish Council) structure set up by the Mazis to control the doomed Jewish ghetto of Warsaw.

Under the Community Planning and Development Act of 1974, the Department of Housing and Urban Development is helping to set up similar structures in cities throughout the United States.

While set up under MUD requirements to provide "community participation" on matters of housing, schools, etc., the Birmingham apparatus will interface with other citywide slave labor institutions to create an integrated Judenrat system. Most importantly, according to an official at the Birmingham Department of Community Development, it is intended that the local Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) group known as the Manpower Planning Consortium will use the HUD apparatus to get neighborhood participation in the planning of slave labor programs.

It is also likely that the HUD neighborhood apparatus will be used to develop Law Enforcement Assistance Administration programs. According to Jesse Stewart, a Birmingham long-standing poverty pimp, once the neighborhood committees are set up, "the people of each neighborhood will be forced to be responsible for the crime rate."

Prior to the elections for the neighborhood committees, counterinsurgents from Operation New Birmingham went throughout the city asking people what neighborhood they live in and where their neighborhood ends and another begins. In this way, the parochial tendencies of the population were reinforced, and the neighborhood committee boundaries were drawn on the basis of a map of the neurotic fears of the population.

Existing neighborhood organizations, such as black civic groups, white ethnic groups, local community associations, are expected to provide the backbone of the neighborhood committees.

UAW'S BLUESTONE ASKS WORKERS TO SACRIFICE FOR SUB PAY

TORONTO, Nov. 25 (IPS)—At a closed meeting here of the United Auto Workers General Motors Council Nov. 21, Council head UAW Vice President Irving Bluestone put forward an Executive Board proposal to divert up to 10 cents per hour in negotiated wage and cost of living increases into the GM Supplementel Unemployment Benefit (SUB) fund. GM SUB pay, according to Bluestone, is "in a crisis" due to mounting extended layoffs.

Eluestone asked the 500 Canadian and U.S. Council members to "sound out" their rank and file on the idea. "It is morally and economically right," he claimed. "We have to ask workers to sacrifice, not only for workers already laid off, but for those still employed who may be idled in the future."

Bluestone is doing nothing less than calling for the Brazilianization of the American working class. The first step in the devastating recycling of the Brazilian working class was based on the notorious PIN program whereby workers set aside part of their wages for expected layoffs and other misfortunes.

However, in order to collect, workers had to maintain a good behavior record and remain on the job for a specified amount of time. Workers were laid off and recycled more quickly than the law stipulated they could receive their SUB pay. Thousands of such recycled workers have already died in the Triage Centers in the Amazon.

This process has already begun in the United States. Steel workers who are now being laid off cannot collect SUB pay since they are allegedly being laid off because of a union strike—the Jay Rockefeller-directed UNI coal strike.

It is expected that when UAW bureaucrats sound them out on the Bluestone proposal for self-sacrifice, the auto workers' reaction will not be positive.

U.S. STEEL HOLDS RITUAL LAYOFF BRIEFING

FAIRLESS HILLS, Penna., Nov. 25 (IPS)—Management at the 9,000-man U.S. Steel plant here called a meeting last week to inform workers of the waves of layoffs expected "due to the effects of the coal strike." Workers were told that increasing layoffs were scheduled for the plant.

Several days after being told they might lose their jobs, workers at the Fairless Hills plant were infuriated to learn from a local newspaper that not one piece of coking coal for the plant comes from U.S. mines; the total supply is imported--primarily from Venezuela, with smaller amounts from West Germany.

ROCKY'S DOUBLE DEAL

Nov. 25 (IPS)--The Senate Rules Committee voted unanimously (9 to 0) in favor of Melson Rockefeller's confirmation as Vice Pre President last Friday, Nov. 22.

High Congressional Democratic sources informed IPS that this confirmation was the result of a deal made between Ford and the Democrats. In exchange for speedy confirmation of Rocky, Ford agreed to support the Democrats' social fascist legislative package, now in Congress. Rocky wins on both counts.

PHONY TRADE WARS TO LEAD TO IMF CONTROL OF WORLD TRADE

Nov. 25 (IPS)--Exactly as the Atlantic Council, a bilateral version of Rockefeller's Trilateral Commission, suggested six months ago, the annual session of GATT (General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade) in Geneva last week proposed to tie up the world in an International Monetary Fund (IMF) controlled World Trade Order. GATT's chairman, Kitahara of Japan, warned member nations that "trade wars" would erupt unless new policy measures are taken immediately to "engage in closer and more intimate collaboration with the International Monetary Fund."

Rockefeller has deliberately sabotaged international trade through the reactivation of Chase Manhattan's commodity cartels and the blocking of the Trade Reform Bill in the U.S. Congress. This bill, which is essential for Presidential authority to negotiate mutual tariff cuts, has been held up in Congress for years due to the phony "Soviet jewry" question raised by Rockefeller agent Henry "Scoop" Jackson. Now, the future of GATT itself, the only international forum for negotiating multilateral tariff cuts, is uncertain due to the "loss of credibility surrounding the multilateral trade negotiations."

The recent "trade war" climate created by Canadian Finance Minister Turner, who is also a member of the IMF's Interim Committee, through denial of Canadian wheat to world markets and oil to the U.S. is aimed at ripening the conditions for the breakdown of international "free" trade. International free trade is to be replaced by Rockefeller's Schachtian "new world order" where the IMF will decide on the ideal price for a particular commodity. An IMF spokesman told IPS that it was waiting for the right conditions and had funds earmarked to finance stockpiles "based on the balance-of-payments needs of the countries involved." Using the cover of insuring strategic supplies in the wake of Turner's actions, Fred Bergsten of Brookings Institute, the CIA think-tank, is now adding fuel to the fire by recommending that U.S. government finance stockpiles of critical commodities. Bergsten has had a lion's share in the organizing of the commodity cartels.

Meanwhile, the various commodity cartels continue to deliver short-term dividends to Rockefeller. Chile has been pressured by CIPEC, the copper cartel, to shut down its fourth largest mine while the other CIPEC members have not reciprocated. The halfway measure agreed upon by CIPEC to cut copper exports by 10 per cent has resulted in a further drop in the price of the metal. This economic arm-twisting will result in Chilean dictator Pinochet's downfall.

A combination of the coal strike, the Chinese change of heart to buy Japanese steel on a deferred payment basis, and the diversion of Indian and Australian iron ore to Iran at the

expense of Japan, will leave the Japanese with no choice but to relocate their industry in Rockefeller's "development" project zones.

Authoritative IMF sources told IPS they were particularly pleased that "Eastern Europe was being drawn into this arrangement." Poland, Hungary, and Romania sat in on the Geneva GATT meeting, and Poland is considering membership in CIPEC. The ultimate objective, of course, is to loot the Soviet Union itself.

A Brief to Congress

U.S. Labor Party Elections 1974

In the 1974 U.S. elections a new mass-based working class political party emerged — the United States Labor Party.

A massive socialist political organizing drive penetrating factories, unemployment centers and working-class neighborhoods to an extent not seen in American history since the 1930's reached a milestone this November 5 when more than 300,000 individuals from coast to coast voted Labor Party.

While the election marked a major historic victory for the self-organization and political maturity of the American working class, the real story of the elections has been blacked out of the capitalist press. In most cities the Labor Party's vote totals have not been published at all. In most of the cities where complete returns have been divulged, a picture of unprecented, systematic fraud emerges — most of it absurdly heavy-handed and unsubtle.

The vote estimates given in this brief come from a precinct-by-precinct analysis of the voting patterns in those few areas where the votes were counted relatively honestly, and a very conservative projection into other races based on organizing penetration analysis, straw polls and population/social-class analysis of the areas where the votes were cast.

In many cases cited in this brief, the Democratic Party — which crusaded against "Watergate" — has been implicated in devastating crimes against human rights, far more weighty than any of the Watergate tricks

They have committed the crimes of coercion, physical intimidation of voters, and wholesale vote-stealing, in the cities of Philadelphia, Detroit, Flint, New York, Buffalo, Charlotte and elsewhere. It has also been demonstrated that much of the political arrangement for these crimes was set-up under the New York State Administration of Nelson Aldrich Rockefeller.

I The Vote

Three cities where official figures reflected the real voting pattern were Richmond, Virginia; Boston, Massachusetts; and San Francisco, California.

Alan Ogden, U.S. Labor Party (USLP) candidate for Congress in Virginia's 3rd district, was officially credited with 7,539 votes, or 11 per cent of the total, in his race against the incumbent David Satterfield. Despite having one of the smallest organizing forces of any USLP local, the Ogden machine ran over 20 per cent in all of the racially integrated or predominantly black working-class areas, running as high as 40 per cent in some predominantly black precincts. The USLP vote was consistently lower in middle-class districts.

In Boston the USLP candidates in the 8th and 9th Congressional Districts, James Kiggen and Lawrence Sherman, were credited with 7,951 votes and 11,514 votes, respectively; 6.5 per cent and 10.8 per cent of the totals in their districts.

The official USLP vote was 11.1 per cent in the predominantly white working-class South Boston areas, and 11.7 per cent in the black ghetto area of Roxbury. In the racially mixed South End area, the official USLP tally was 14.2 per cent. In some districts — such as the home precinct of Sherman's Democratic opponent, incumbent John Moakley, the USLP was credited with up to 30 per cent of the vote.

Again, the Labor Party scored consistently high in working class areas, and lower in middle-class areas — in the 5-7 per cent range.

In the San Francisco, California race for city Board of Education, the USLP candidate Richard Clancy was officially credited with 14,338 votes, representing the choice of approximately 6 per cent of the voters.

In San Francisco's "Inner Mission" precincts, comprised mainly of unemployed or low-paid workers, the USLP recieved between 10 and 20 per cent overall, going as high as 46 per cent in one precinct. In the working-class North Beach precincts — heavily Teamster and Longshore workers, many of Italian decent — the official USLP tally ran from 10-15 per cent, up to 33 per cent in one precinct.

But the results for the city as a whole indicate blatant, easily provable fraud, greatly understating the actual Labor Party vote total by wiping out up to two-thirds of the count in the areas of greatest USLP organization and campaign presence, such as the "Outer Mission" district.

It was in the regions of maximum Labor Party organizing penetration of the industrial working class — in Michigan, in New York State, in the Philadelphia-Wilmington-Camden region, in North Carolina, and in Washington State — that worker support for the Labor Party was strongest, and where the most massive, systematic vote stealing in American history took place; over a quarter of a million votes, by the most conservative estimate, were stolen in these regions alone.

Taking the vote officially received on average in working-class districts of the cities cited, a conservative projection into comparable districts in the cities where USLP organizing has been strongest yields a nationwide pattern of from 10-30 per cent of the total vote in working-class neighborhoods. This estimate has to be made on the basis of very partial returns, due to withholding of official returns for

unprecedented periods of time. The estimated Labor Party vote in Michigan and New York State was 100,000 in each. Had the U.S. Labor Party been

running candidates nationwide, as in an election for U.S. President, a comparable level of support for the Labor Party would have netted over one million votes.

II The Extent of the Fraud

Michigan

Michigan's Governor William Milliken was credited with winning re-election by a margin of about 100,000 votes — on the order of magnitude of the number of votes stolen from his Labor Party opponent Peter Signorelli. There are no reported official returns as yet.

In the week preceding election day, Flint, Michigan, was buzzing with "red politics." One Chevrolet factory was straw-polled and found to be 50 per cent Labor Party voters. Other straw polls yielded a projection of 20 to 30 per cent of the workers prepared to vote Labor. Forty out of the 500 individuals who were called during a Flint radio program announced that they were going to vote for Signorelli, who was broadcasting at the time. Massive Labor Party crosspenetration of the working class in the city and surrounding areas had been achieved through expanding the sales of New Solidarity (newspaper of the National Caucus of Labor Committees and U.S. Labor Party) to 700 copies per week. The campaign of John Dicks for Congress in the Flint district had received wide — albeit grudging — coverage in the area's mass media.

Flint was one of those Michigan cities where workers most consistently identified with the USLP as "the Party" and "our Party." The Labor Party estimates it received 18 percent of the working-class vote in Flint, around 15,000 in total.

Yet the official vote total recorded for Peter Signorelli in the entire city of Flint, Michigan was 14! He was credited with 37 votes in all of Genesee County, out of 119,000 total votes.

In the Detroit precinct in which gubernatorial candidate Signorelli cast his vote, the official USLP vote total was 0!

In polling places throughout the city of Detroit, thugs wearing jackets bearing United Auto Workers emblems were intimidating voters and leafletting inside the polls. Photographs of several of these individuals will be made available to legal authorities.

In a ten-day, low-key campaign for Detroit Common Council in 1973, the USLP's Suzanne Ketcham officially received 3,096 votes, at a time when New Solidarity had not yet penetrated the Michigan working class on the present mass scale. Yet in 1974, the Labor Party's Peter Signorelli was credited with less than 500 votes in all of Wayne County, which includes Detroit.

A conservative estimate of the actual vote yields 24,000 USLP votes for the city of Detroit — 6 per cent of the total cast — and approximately 100,000 Michigan statewide votes, 4 per cent of the total.

New York State

In New York State, there are no "official" election results as yet. In Buffalo the USLP has been the hegemonic working-class political organization for more than a year. In the 1973 elections, the Labor Party candidate for City Council, Phil Valenti, was credited with 1,600 votes (1½ percent). In 1974, after 7,000 Buffalo residents signed the petition to place Ira

Liebowitz on the USLP ballot slate for Congress in the 37th district, and after Liebowitz had demolished his Democratic opponent in a broadcast debate, Labor Party organizing results were strawpolled at 23 per cent for the city as a whole, and up to 50 per cent in some areas of highest penetration.

Yet the Labor Party statewide slate was credited with 120 votes for the entire city of Buffalo, a fraction of 1 per cent.

In Rochester three individuals joined the Labor Committees in anger after their votes were obviously not recorded — the official USLP tally in their precincts was 0.

In Syracuse, where the Labor Party had dominated the airwaves in a fashion unprecedented for a working-class party, where USLP Common Council candidate Janine Scholnick received 3,000 signatures to appear on the ballot, the Labor Party was universally straw-polling higher than 10 per cent, and was receiving massive support in broadcast audience response.

Yet the official vote recorded for the Labor Party statewide slate in Syracuse was 64 votes, a fraction of one per cent.

In New York City official returns are still unavilable two weeks after the election. But glimpses at returns in the hands of the "major daily" press corps reveal thousands of precincts in which no Labor Party voters' votes were counted. In many of these precincts Labor Party and labor Committee members and close contacts lived and voted.

On Manhattan's West Side, scene of more than 200 street rallies and the sales of thousands of copies of New Solidarity, USLP gubernatorial candidate Tony Chaitkin was credited with a mere 28 votes, less than his official 82 votes in that district in his 1973 New York City mayoral bid.

Throughout New York State, around 10 per cent and sometimes more of the votes for U.S. Senator and for New York governor were being counted in the "blank, void or wasted" official column, far beyond the normal 2-3 per cent.

Labor Party members began canvassing of neighborhoods with high Labor Party penetration after press reports indicated a ridiculously low vote total. In some districts more affidavits attesting to a USLP vote were collected than were recorded on the machines. In the Bronx, potential affidavit signers have been cajoled with bribes and threatened by thugs; in one case an individual who determined to sign a Labor Party affidavit before a notary, found the neighborhood notary public had been threatened and refused to witness his signature.

North Carolina

Nearly 20,000 North Carolina voters signed the petition to place the Labor Party on the 1974 ballot. This marked the first time in history a revolutionary party had achieved such "third party" status in statewide and congressional races. The Democratic Party convention and the state's AFL-CIO gathering were typical scenes of bitter denunciations and dire warnings of the New Power in the world. The Labor Party organizing presence reached into every corner of the population's life as campaign tours hit urban centers and tobacco and textile factories, bringing unprecented political excitement and polarization to the southern working class.

Yet the official vote recorded for the USLP in the 9th Congressional District which includes Charlotte was only 1.5 per cent of the total. This compares with the 4.5 and 5 per cent USLP figures in the two immediately past city elections in Charlotte, the prime base of Labor Party strength in the state. Whole sections of the population had their votes simply wiped out in the returns, and the statewide USLP official results — 11,972 for Attorney General candidate Marion Porter — were probably substantially lower than the actual vote received in Greensboro and Charlotte simply taken together.

In Charlotte, D.J. Grier, an employee of the family of Fred Alexander, "boss Democrat" in Charlotte's black ghetto, stood outside a polling place with a bull whip. He ripped Labor Party leaflets out of voters' hands saying, "You don't need that." He told USLP Senatorial candidate Rudy Nesmith, "You don't know what might happen in this neighborhood, you might get shot." While Grier intimidated voters throughout the day, his wife observed his actions without comment — she was the polling supervisor for the precinct! No Labor Party organizer was allowed in the polls, the third party having "failed to achieve" official pollwatcher status.

Philadelphia

The most concentrated fraud took place in the south Philadelphia area of Pennsylvania's 3rd Congressional District. As will be described in the next section of this brief, Labor Party organizing in Philadelphia had brought about a particularly intense political excitement, as straw polls and the predictions of observers in all parties indicated a USLP vote of anywhere from 10-30 per cent.

Yet on election night, voters watching televised "election returns" were treated to an incredible, insulting spectacle:

First "returns" reported were 50,000 votes for incumbent Congressman William Barrett, 5,000 for USLP challenger Bernard Salera. Later "returns" were given as Barrett 90,000, Salera 2,000. The final official Salera vote total was given as 1,086!

III Key Races: Philadelphia and Boston


Philadelphia

Early in the 1974 campaign season, Congressman William Barrett's organization recognized Barrett's

Labor Party opponent Bernard Salera as a distinct, unprecedented threat to score an upset. Barrett's lawyers went into Pennsylvania Commonwealth court in September to attempt to have Salera kept from the ballot. During the course of a legal battle which lasted until the week before the election, Barrett's lawyers vowed that they would go all the way to the United States Supreme Court if necessary to remove the Salera threat.

While Barrett's men were huddling with the judges, local South Philadelphia Committeemen of the Democratic Party were among the hundreds of workers and others in the Philadelphia area who were brought into organizing with the USLP campaign: trade union leaders, ex-Communist Party members and predominantly Italian-American garment workers were among the outstanding organizers who emerged.

In the last three months of the campaign, the weekly street sales of New Solidarity in the Philadelphia region jumped from 1,400 to 4,200 (see chart #2). In September the Italian language edition of New Solidarity was introduced into South Philadelphia, causing great excitement among layers of former socialist organizers concerned with the struggle against Rockefeller being led by the Labor Committees in Italy. The Salera campaign was joined by politically awakened welfare rights activists who spread the organizing of New Solidarity sales networks into ghetto housing projects. By election day, worker sales networks in area plants and neighborhoods constituted up to 20 per cent of the distribution of the newspaper, with heavy penetration of the steel, electrical, and garment industries.



In October the Republican Party in South Philadelphia offered to support the Salera candidacy and to supply the Labor Party with poll-watchers in return for USLP backing of Republican candidates for lesser offices.

From that point on more and more Democratic Party local committeemen and committeewomen throughout the region began to get out the Labor vote and serve as New Solidarity distributors.

A few days before the election, Pennsylvania Governor Milton Shapp came to South Philadelphia to urge support for the non-campaigning Barrett; Shapp personally ordered the Philadelphia police to arrest and remove Bernard Salera from one political gathering.

Following is the record of harassment of voters in South Philadelphia by agents of the Democratic Party in the 2nd Congressional District. This record is taken directly from the log maintained by the U.S. Labor Party of telephone calls into and out of its Philadelphia headquarters on November 5, 1974.

10:20 A.M. — An Anonymous man called. He reported that two cars full of men were going through the 39th Ward threatening to break the bones of those who refused to vote the ticket the goons wanted them to. He identified the thugs as Leland Beloff's men. He described the cars in which they were cruising as a red Cadillac with a white top, Pennsylvania license number 53E186 and a white Lincoln with a black top, Pennsylvania license number 09R601.

11:06 A.M. — Mrs. R. called. She reported that two cars full of men were "assisting voters" in the 39th Ward, 8th, 27th and 28th Divisions. She said the men were escorting the voters into the booths and telling them how to vote.

12:00 noon — Another anonymous man called. He reported that goons were at the polls in the 39th Ward, 8th Division. They stood in the back drinking and coerced voters.

12:26 P.M. — An anonymous woman voter called from the 39th Ward. She stated that she was extremely upset about threats being made. She said: "This is terrible. Please stop this."

12:39 P.M. — The Philadelphia office of the FBI called, having been informed by the Committee of 70 election watchdogs of our complaint. After being given more details, FBI agent Thomas Sherman said he would call Mr. Sutton in the U.S. Attorney's office.

3:05 P.M. — Mrs. F. called from the 39th Ward, 3rd Division. She stated that suspicious characters, whom she knew to be loan sharks, were hanging around the polls.

3:30 P.M. — The U.S. Labor Party called the U.S. Attorney's office to check their progress. One Mr. DeLucas said that Mr. Sherman had left a note saying that the coercion we reported was not a federal offense; and should be taken up with the Philadelphia District Attorney. DeLucas read the federal statute that said coercion had to involve forcing someone to

vote for or against a candidate in a federal, not merely a state election. The Labor Party informed him that the harassment was occurring in a federal election; a Congressional election. He then said, "Oh, Mr. Sherman didn't tell me that," and agreed to have the FBI investigate.

3:45 P.M. — The original anonymous caller called again to report that the two cars were at the 2300 block at South 8th Street, and that the men were forcing people to vote for the entire Democratic Party slate.

During the day, Joe Glickstein, brother of Republican leader Ben Glickstein, called to report from his pollwatching station at 2nd and Rosebury in the 39th Ward. He said he had complained to John Kehner of the Committee of 70 that Beloff's men were intimidating voters.

Later Kehner called the Labor Party to report that he had spotted the two cited automobiles and confirmed their identification as belonging to Beloff. He said Beloff was a Democratic leader who had switched over from the Republican Party.

The next day, November 6, the U.S. Attorney's office called again. Mr. Sherman asked if the Labor Party would tell him the names and addresses of people to talk to about the intimidation. The Labor Party could not supply such names and addresses, and asked Sherman how the government's investigation was going. He replied that he was not at liberty to say, but that a great deal was being investigated. He advised the Labor Party to speak to the Attorney General's office in Washington, D.C., to find out about the investigation.

Boston

In the closing weeks of the Boston campaign, Labor Party street rallies broke through the tension generated by the "busing" conflict. The Labor Party had long been identified as the group that was fighting the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration (LEAA), domestic arm of the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency. CIA-LEAA agents including the Mayor's Assistant for Police Affairs Robert Kiley, uncovered in Boston City Council hearings as one-time Chief of CIA covert operations in the U.S., were identified to the Boston working class as being responsible for deliberate trumping-up of the racial conflict, in concert with Rockefeller-controlled news media.


The Labor Party intervened to break up the controlled environment designed for race war. There was tremendous tension at the rallies. Crowds of 40 to 50 workers would gather around, many yelling at the organizers to stop talking, many others shouting back for them to continue. The campaign successfully diverted racial polarization into political polarization versus Rockefeller and the CIA.

In the "racially agitated" white working-class precincts of South Boston, Sherman polled 11 per cent overall and up to 17 per cent in one ward. In Ward 14, covering most of the Roxbury black ghetto, Sherman received 11.7 per cent.

In towns surrounding Boston — which include an industrial belt of rubber, auto and electrical plants,

the Labor Party had higher percentages than in Boston. In Dedham, where there is definite evidence of fraud, the USLP was credited with 13.2 per cent of the total vote. A campaign focal point, downtown Dedham was the site of regular Labor Party rallies to penetrate the surrounding industrial-belt towns of Westwood, Needham and Norwood.

taking the very minimum figure of 10 per cent of the total working-class neighborhood vote, achieved routinely in Richmond, Virginia; Boston, Mass.; and San Francisco, California, that 10 per cent figure was applied to those areas in Michigan where more organizing presence and New Solidarity crosspenetration was consistently attained than in the other




Labor Party's high penetration in working-class areas of the City of Boston yielded 11.7 per cent average vote citywide. Anti-LEAA "regular" vote counters ensured a minimum of vote stealing by Kiley-LEAA apparatus.

IV Vote Analysis and Projection Method

The most precise projection of the actual Labor Party vote was done for regions of maximum organizing penetration of the industrial working class, such as Detroit and other cities and suburbs of Michigan.

On the basis of Michigan factory straw-polls that ran to 30 per cent USLP support and higher, and states which recorded the official 10 per cent of the working-class mark. Only in Pontiac and Flint was the projected percentage increased to 18 per cent of the working-class vote, and in Macomb County suburbs of Detroit to 15 per cent, reflecting the extraordinarily deep Labor Party penetration of these areas, while taking into account standard patterns of Labor Party supporters not voting or voting for Democrats. For other social classes in all these areas, or for other



The highest percentage of USLP votes came from black working class areas, especially those affected by unemployment. areas not directly moved by Labor Party organization, the projection has been drastically pared down. Following are excerpts from the Michigan analysis:

In the city of Detroit there are 24 electoral districts, with 30,000 registered voters and approximately 15,000 persons actually voting per district. These districts break down to 4 classified as "ghetto," figured at 5 per cent of the vote, summing to 3,000 USLP votes between them; 7 classified as "ghetto working class" figured at 7 per cent of the vote, summing to 7,500 USLP votes; 8 classified as "general working class," figured at 10 per cent of the vote, summing to 12,000 USLP votes; 5 classified as "petit-bourgeois" figured at 2 per cent of the vote, summing to 1,500 USLP votes.

This gives 24,000 or approximately 6 per cent of the

Detroit votes to Labor Party gubernatorial candidate Peter Signorelli.

In Oakland County the total vote of 290,000 includes approximately 150,000 working-class votes. Taking 18 per cent of the 50,000 workers' votes in the city of Pontiac, and 10 per cent of the 100,000 workers' votes in Pontiac suburbs, 19,000 USLP votes are projected for Oakland County as a whole.

In Saginaw 30,000 out of 40,000 are working-class votes. Taking 5 per cent of these on the basis of direct but somewhat lessened USLP presence, gives 1,500 projected USLP votes in Saginaw.

Washtenaw County, discounting the Ann Arbor University population altogether, contains 20,000 working-class votes out of the 70,000 total cast. Taking 10 per cent of this — very conservative based on excellent political motion in Ypsilanti — yields 2,000 projected USLP votes. For Grand Rapids, Jackson, and Kalamazoo the projection was based on 8 per cent of the working class vote; for Lansing 7 per cent. For the rest of the state — non-urban, agricultural areas, a rock-bottom one per cent of the vote was projected — yielding 15,000 out of 1,500,000. By this method, a minimum 100,000 votes must be projected for the statewide U.S. Labor Party slate in Michigan, or about 4 per cent of the overall vote cast.

V CIA Machine Politics

From 1971 through 1973 the Central Intelligence Agency took over direct control of the production and operation of voting machines in the United States. As a result of this discovery by a team of International Press Service reporters, it can now be conclusively determined that the November 5 elections were a fraudulent joke on the entire American public. Not only were more than a quarter of a million votes stolen from the U.S. Labor Party, but conservative Republicans and other anti-Rockefeller politicians undoubtedly were defeated by the CIA and not the voters

In 1973, a Joint Strike Force of the U.S. Department of Justice, operating out of Buffalo, N.Y., brought about the indictment of top officers of the Automatic Voting Machine Company of Jamestown, N.Y.. Most members of AVM's Board of Directors and all the corporate officers were replaced.

The only directors who survived the takeover were Harvey M. Krueger, Senior Partner of the Rockefeller investment banking firm Kuhn, Loeb & Co.; Spencer R. Hackett, Vice President of the Mellon Bank of North America; Jerome A. Early, Staff Vice President for Strategic Planning, Rockwell International; and Robert M. Entwhistle of AVM's Pittsburghlaw firm Miller, Entwhistle and Duff.

The man brought in as the new Chairman and President of AVM was Harold J. Ruttenberg, one of America's top counterinsurgents.

Harold, together with his brother Stanley, began his spooky career as anti-Communist "labor organizers" with Phillip Murray and the Steelworkers Organizing Committee. Harold became of research for the United Steelworkers of America. During World War II, while retaining his ties to the Steelworkers, Harold became a speed-up specialist as Assistant Director of the Steel

Division of the corporativist War Production Board, and served on the War Labor Board as well.

In 1942 Harold Ruttenberg co-authored a book on the virtues of labor-management corporativist coparticipation, entitled "The Dynamics of Industrial democracy." The other author was Steelworkers Vice President Clinton Golden, an editor of the magazine "Human Relations" — published by Rockefeller's Tavistock Institute, designer of labor brainwashing programs worldwide.

After the war, Harold Ruttenberg hooked up with "international affairs" industrialist Cyrus Eaton, who formed the Portsmouth Steel Company and made Ruttenberg its Executive Vice President. From that point on, Harold was transformed into a "capitalist", later buying and selling steel-related companies. He now had his own laboratory for trying out the latest Tavistock methods of controlling labor, especially USWA members.

Meanwhile, Ruttenberg's brother Stanley became a prominent labor "insider" in the Rockefeller cabal. From 1948 through 1962 he was Director of Research and Chief Economist for the Congress of Industrial Organizations and then the AFL-CIO. Throughout the late 1940s, he "went to meetings in Berlin, Frankfurt, Munich, Stockholm, Rome and Paris," officially working for the International labor Organization and the "World Confederation of Free Trade Unions," but in actuality setting up CIA control of the European labor movement.

Through the 1950s and 1960s, Stanley Ruttenberg was officially listed as State Department and Labor Department "labor specialist" and "manpower specialist." He became a director of Laurance Rockefeller's "Resources for the Future" zero-growth propaganda group. He published an important manpower planning study for the national Planning Association, on which he serves with Zbigniew Brzezinski, Leonard Woodcock and other members of the Rockefeller Trilateral Commission — all colleagues of Steelworkers President I.W. Abel.

The workers at Automatic Voting Machine are organized into "autonomous work teams" under a fascist, corporativist structure in AVM's Jamestown, New York, headquarters. The labor-management programs in Jamestown were set up for at least 15 companies by Eric Trist, British Intelligence officer specializing in psychological warfare and a leader of the Tavistock Institute, and by Cornell University.

Workers encountered in Jamestown streets by IPS reporters referred to these programs as "garbage," "awful," and "They're brainwashing us."

Keith Spaulding, vice President of the automatic Voting Machine Company, assured IPS reporters that voting machines can easily be fixed in any way desired. Levers can be disengaged from counters. Machines can be rigged so that a vote for one candidate becomes a vote for his opponent. Spaulding stated that all that was required for a thorough rigging was for the "proper political climate" to exist so that the "election officials would look the other way."

For decades up through the 1960's the other voting machine company in the U.S. was the Shoup Company. In 1969 the Shoup Voting Machine Company of Pennsylvania was bought by Macrodyne Industries

of California, an aerospace sub-contractor with no other non aerospace divisions. Immediately after this the United States Department of Justice brought indictments of top officers of the Shoup Company. In 1971 the Shoup officers were convicted and sent to prison on a variety of "Watergate"-style charges, including bribery, and conspiracy to extract kickbacks. The entire corporate officer staff of Shoup was then purged and replaced by the Macrodyne management, which set up the "International Election Systems" Company of Burlington, New Jersey, Mr. Ransom Shoup and his son set up a new R.F. Shoup Company, minus the rights to patents and marketing of the Shoup Machines. In March of 1973 Shoup was sued by Macrodyne in Eastern District Federal Court of Pennsylvania for the "theft of (his own) secrets." Mr. Shoup remains embroiled in this suit today.

AVM, Shoup and "International Elections Systems" between them account for all of the manufacture of voting machines and all of the training of voting machine mechanics. AVM brings mechanic trainees to its Jamestown headquarters for a schooling, and also sets up training in other cities for various boards of elections. Macrodyne-International brings mechanic trainees to its jet aircraft engine production facilities in Burlington, N.J. to train them.

Since 1971 the CIA has moved to insure that no one would even notice what would otherwise be obviously suspicious election results. The cases cited below are illustrative of trends throughout the U.S..

CIA Takes Over City Elections: New York

During the Second World War, James Sickett was an officer with the Office of Strategic Services — predecesor to the CIA. He penetrated with U.S. forces "to the border of Czechoslovakia." He admits to being assigned to several army divisions attached to the military police. After V.E. day he was assigned to Vienna, Austria as an expert in the Hungarian language. At the end of this service he "went into business for himself."

In the late 1940's, Mr. Sickett joined — was planted in — the New York City government election supervision machinery at a lowly \$2,000 per year salary.

In 1973, the New York City Board of Elections was shaken up by the New York State government under Nelson Rockefeller. A court declared the entire set-up of the Board to be unconstitutional, and the legislature reconstituted it, establishing a new post of Executive Director. James Sickett was placed in that post, with full power to make up the ballot in any way he chooses. Mr. Sickett told a reporter for the International Press Service that U.S. government intelligence officers and FBI men have frequently worked through his office, checking personnel and other matters.

The CIA's domestic arm, the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration (LEAA) set up the Bureau of Planning and Operations within the New York Police Department during the "anti-corruption" shakeup surrounding the LEAA-funded Knapp Commission. This Bureau is now in charge of elections in New York City.

Under Planning and Operations, policemen now go to voters' residences to check out "if so-and-so really lives here." They are corroborating voter registration cards which require the voter to supply the police with his occupation and his employer's name.

After the polls close, policemen in every voting place take tallies along with neighborhood officials and bring the tallies to the stationhouse. From there cops under Planning and Operations supervision send statements of precinct-by-precinct returns to the local Boro Boards of Election, and to a newly-created press syndicate, the "News Election Service."

This press syndicate then tallies and publishes any returns it wishes. Throughout the country, the syndicate — made up of Rockefeller-dominated outlets such as the Associated Press, the New York Times and others — routinely threw away Labor Party election returns. Voters who wished to discover the complete results of the election were told that none existed. The New York Board of Elections plans to release an "official return" about three weeks after the election; the legal time limit for challenging the election as fraudulent is 20 days.

Buffalo

In Buffalo a Computer task force has been set up to process election returns for Erie County. Programming of the computers was done by the Calspan Corporation, a "think tank" set up by Cornell University and paid by the Defense Department, the FBI and the LEAA to research weather modification, labor brainwashing programs, "community control" of the black ghetto and other CIA projects. The same computers are also programmed by Calspan to handle virtually all police intelligence data for Erie County, and all mental hospital information for Erie County.

Philadelphia

In 1973, a U.S. Justice Department Strike Force, operating out of Philadelphia, prosecuted Maurice S. Osser, then Chairman of the three-man City Commission which supervises Philadelphia's elections. Osser was sent to Lewisburg Federal Prison on charges relating to "misuse of his authority."

When called by an IPS investigative reporter, the

Philadelphia office of the LEAA directly lied in stating that "the Federal government was not involved" in Watergating Osser. Mr. Osser's replacement, Francis Patterson, was also struck by a case of nerves when he replied "I'm not going to give my life history away" when asked if he had worked with U.S. intelligence agencies.

Washington State

In Washington State's 3rd Congressional District, Labor Party candidate Evelyn Olafson's Democratic Party opponent was Don Bonker, the Clerk of Clark county who had organized the introduction of computers into the elections; Olafson's Republican opponent was Ludlow Kramer, Washington Secretary of State, whose office oversees the election! Kramer became famous when he organized the notorious "People in Need" food distribution set-up for the Symbionese Liberation Army in California.

Chicago

In the Spring of 1973, the chairman of the Chicago Board of Elections was "booted upstairs" into an open post of County Clerk. To fill his vacancy, an Illinois Circuit Court judge for Cook County formed a threeman screening panel, which decided under pressure from the Independent Voters of Illinois, an Anti-Daly organization, to pass up the other two existent members of the Chicago Board of Elections for the Chairman's post.

Instead, on July 2, 1973, the judge appointed John Hanley Chairman of the Board of Elections as a man of "no political background." Two days before, Hanley had "retired" from 36 years as one of the top intelligence officers of the U.S. government. He was a naval intelligence officer under Admiral Halsey during World War II, and he retired as an Admiral. During the 1960's he was in charge of the United States Secret Service for Europe, Africa, and the Middle East, stationed in Bonn, Paris and London. He was the Commissioner of Interpol for Counterfeiting. From 1969 to his "retirement" in 1973, he was the Chicago station chief of the U.S. Secret Service.

Hanley's secretary, in her conversation with IPS stated, "I've got a real James Bond for a boss."

Key Points in CIA Takeover of Elections

Jamestown, N.Y. 1973

U.S. Justice Dept. indicts top officers of Automatic Voting Machine Company. Mellon and Rockefeller bankers on Bd. of Directors remove all officers and appoint top CIA-Tavistock agent Harold Ruttenberg AVM's new chairman. Labor-management programs at AVM and 14 other Jamestown comapnies were set up by Eric Trist, British intelligence officer and leader of Tavistock. Voting machine mechanics of city boards of elections are brought to Jamestown and trained by AVM.

Pennsylvania

1969-73

U.S. Justice Dept. indicts top officers of Shoup Voting Machine Company immediately after Shoup is brought by aerospace contractor Macrodyne Industries of California. 1971 — Shoup top officers

sent to prison on "Watergate" charges; all officers replaced by Macrodyne. 1973 — R.F. Shoup, who had formed a new company, is sued in federal court for "theft of secrets" — i.e., attempting to use patents he developed.

Mechanics who fix voting machines are brought to jet engine factory in Burlington, N.J. to be trained by Macrodyne-Shoup, now renamed "International Election Systems".

New York City

1973

New York State courts and legislature under Governor Rockefeller break up "unconstitutional" NYC Board of Elections, create new post of Executive Director. James Sickett is appointed, with sole power to design ballot. Sickett is "activated" after being planted by CIA in late 1940s following distinguished spy career in Europe. He was stationed in Vienna,

Austria as a Hungarian expert. As an OSS officer, he penetrated with U.S. forces "to the border of Czechoslovakia". Sickett states that "U.S. intelligence officers and FBI men have frequently operated through my office, checking on personnel and other matters." LEAA-run Bureau of Ops. and Planning supervises election procedures, releases returns.

Chicago 1973

Chairman of Board of Elections is appointed to fill County Clerk's vacancy. Circuit court judge bows to pressure of anti-Daly "Independent Voters of Illinois" and brings in "non-political" new chairman, John Hanley. Hanley had "retired" 2 days before from 36 year career as one of top CIA men in America: Admiral in Naval Intelligence, head of U.S. Secret Service for Europe, Africa, and Mideast. and "Counterfeiting Commissioner" for Interpol.

APPENDIX I: PENDING AND CONTEMPLATED LEGAL ACTIONS REGARDING ELECTION FRAUD AS OF NOV. 21, 1974

Philadelphia Region: The United States Labor Party will go into Philadelphia Common Pleas Court to ask for an order allowing the USLP to examine voting machines in at least one of several ward subdivisions in which substantial proof of fraud exists. the deadline for this action is November 25, after which machine counters will be reset to zero.

The first machine to be examined is for Ward One, Division 2, in which USLP Congressional candidate Bernard Salera was credited with nine votes. At least 15 people there have affirmed that they voted for Salera, five have given the Labor Party notarized affidavits and five more are committed to do so. In another area of high Labor Party support and low official vote tally, at least six individuals are committed to canvassing for such affidavits; the voting machine for this subdivision will be the second one examined.

If the mechanic provided by the Board of Elections declares that there is nothing wrong with either machine, the affidavits of unrecorded votes will be taken to the Philadelphia District Attorney and the United States Attorney to demand an investigation and the preservation of evidence. If direct evidence of tampering is discovered, the Labor Party will demand the same relief in addition to a delay in the certification of the election.

The U.S. Attorneys for Delaware and southern New Jersey will be contacted concerning fraud in congressional elections there, with citation of suspicious voting patterns.

North Carolina:

The Mecklenburg County Board of Elections holds a hearing November 21 to receive evidence of vote stealing and electoral interference by Democratic Party worker D.J. Grier, who wielded a whip at the polls. Board members have stated in advance however, that they will decide to take no action because the "results would not effect the outcome of

the elections!" The Labor Party will point to the suspiciously uniform pattern of the official results — 1.4 per cent to 3.4 per cent range, as opposed to 0 per cent to 22 per cent in the same wards in last year's elections in Charlotte. An investigation will be demanded into the background of Kent Crawford, the sole voting mechanic for Mecklenburg County, a "New Leftist" with the CIA-run New American Movement who was trained at Jamestown, New York by the Automatic Voting Machine Company.

On election day the Board of Elections refused to order the arrest or even an investigation of Mr. Grier and stated that this was a matter for the Labor Party to take up with the police. The Labor Party will demand state or federal authorities move against both Grier and Board of Elections Executive Secretary William Culp, who refused to act even though Section 48, Paragraph 163 of the North Carolina General Statutes requires him to maintain order and authorizes him to order arrests and deputize poll officials or private citizens to make arrests or to expell disrupters from the polling place.

The Labor Party will demand that the state government suspend certification of the election races involving U.S. Labor Party candidates. To this date the Charlotte-based United States Attorney refuses to discuss the case "because it is secret."

Michigan:

Voters in ten precincts in Wayne County, Mich., two precincts in Pontiac and one precinct in Flint are committed to present notarized affidavits affirming their votes for USLP gubernatorial candidate Signorelli; in each of these precincts, promised affidavits already sum to more than the officially recorded Labor Party vote.

USLP general counsel Jay Carlisle is in Michigan to determine the legal course to be taken. The U.S. Attorney in Detroit is the Labor Party's adversary in its suit against FBI harassment.

New York:

Despite harassment of potential witnesses to election

fraud in New York City (see Fraud section of brief), affidavits are now in Labor Party possession providing sufficient evidence to force the New York State Supreme Court to allow inspection of the voting machine in the district where the affiants voted. The suit will be filed during the week of November 25, charging denial of civil rights. Other recourse is more difficult: the District Attorney for that section of New York City, Mario Merola, previously quashed an investigation of attempted gunshot murder perpetrated against Labor Party organizers outside Bronx' Lincoln Hospital Methadone Detoxification Clinic earlier in 1974.

An additional obstacle is that inspection of voting machines requires the payment of between \$100 and \$400 per machine by the plaintiff.

Buffalo:

On election day polling officials denied USLP pollwatchers access to viewing the backs (counters) of voting machines in ten locations.

Board of Elections Commissioner Carlsen informed the Labor Party that the only canvass to give voting breakdowns by election district was that available from the Computer Task Group. The result from the Computer Task Group for Fillmore Ward, district 28, showed zero votes for USLP gubernatorial candidate Chaitkin. Four affidavits were then gathered from voters in that district stating that they had voted for Chaitkin, and the Labor Party held a press conference at the Board of Elections to break the news. After the press conference, Commissioner Carlsen informed the Buffalo Evening News that Chaitkin had received five votes in Fillmore District 28.

The U.S. Attorney for Buffalo will be presented with the cases including multiple vote fraud perpetrated in Rochester. The U.S. Attorney has, however, previously refused to take action on Labor Party complaints of over one hundred instances of electoral interference.

APPENDIX II: FBI HARASSMENT

History of FBI-Justice Department Harassment of the U.S. Labor Party

The Justice Department has launched a year-long offensive against the United States Labor Party, specifically stating their intention to smash it. U.S. Attorney General William Saxbe and FBI Director Clarence Kelley are themselves defendants in a suit brought by the USLP in response to a raid on the LP's Detroit office. The Detroit Police held LP members at gunpoint and stole the names of Labor Party supporters in "an attempt to retrieve a kidnapped" FBI agent who had infiltrated the USLP. Given the massive, illegal harassment of the USLP by the Justice Department and the FBI, no competent investigation of the charges of electoral fraud can be undertaken by these agencies. Unless the Congress is prepared to consent to a complete whitewash at the hands of the U.S. Attorney, it must immediately begin an independent investigation.

The following account highlights the FBI-Justice Department campaign against the USLP's electoral activities.

Cleveland, April 1974 — William Rini was approached by the FBI on or about Feb. 6 and asked to infiltrate the USLP. Information given to the FBI on the morning of March 27 led to the illegal surveillance and detention of Labor Party members by the police at Cleveland State University and Case Western University. Rini states in his affidavit that the FBI requested information on the "weaknesses of Cleveland Labor Committee members and psychological profiles." The nature of the information sought by the FBI proves conclusively that they sought to disrupt the USLP activities rather than prevent "illegal activity."

Detroit, Aug. 1973 — Playing on the fears of Helen Bates, the mother of a Labor Party member, the FBI pumped her for information on the USLP. The agent reported to Bates that the "emphasis is on the Labor Committee among left organizations today." Agents visited her home on three occasions and made phone contact at least 12 times. When they asked her if she "had ever taken truth serum" and then scheduled the next meeting at FBI headquarters, she broke off contact with the FBI.

June 1974, Detroit Raid — The USLP is currently seeking injunctive relief and \$4 million in damages from the FBI, U.S Attorney and the Detroit Police for interference in the Party's Michigan electoral campaign. The suit was filed following USLP discovery and exposure of FBI agent and demolition expert Vernon Higgins as an infiltrator and FBI-directed saboteur of USLP electoral campaigns.

Higgins was running as a USLP candidate for Michigan State Legislature in a blatant attempt to discredit the Party and mislead Michigan voters. The exposure of Higgins was followed by the June 20th illegal search at gunpoint and ransacking of the Labor Party's offices during which material was stolen by officers L. Blane, G. Terrell, Ganbin, R. Persyn, D. McKinnen and five policemen or FBI agents who refused to identify themselves.

William Jones, the agent who requested the search, had visited the home of National Committee member Richard Cohen on June 4, 1973, a year prior to the FBI-directed raid. The continuity in personnel indicates the consistency with which the FBI spied upon and harassed the USLP.

Philadelphia, July 18 — Nineteen-year-old Gail Roeshman was kidnapped and brainwashed with the full knowledge and active complicity of the FBI while she was campaigning for USLP candidate for Congress, Bernie Salera. Gail Roeshman was kidnapped by her parents on July 18 and held for brainwashing by convicted criminal Ted Patrick. In a sworn deposition Gail stated that her father, Ben Roeshman, had spoken to the Philadelphia FBI about his plans. The FBI informed him that "his actions were legal." Though Roeshman's actions were in clear violation of the so-called Lindberg kidnapping law, he had the FBI's full assurance that they would do nothing.

On July 30 the USLP received a handwritten letter from Gail in which she stated, "Do not try to get me, I'm being watched. Stop watching my house — you're


being watched...I've (and You've) got FBI, Philadelphia Cop Fencl, State Police, etc., watching us." FBI agents and U.S. Attornies in Philadelphia and Miami confirmed Gail's allegations by their repeated refusal to investigate the evidence that the USLP offered them.

Charlotte, North Carolina, Dec. 1973 — While attempting to recruit Bernard Todd, a former member of the Revolutionary Youth Movement (RYM) as an informer, two FBI agents stated that RYM was an "enemy of the government," that they were "going to bust RYM" and suggested that "people were likely to get hurt." The agents evidenced

detailed knowledge of Todd's personal history. They informed him that he could be charged with several Federal offenses, but that "if you help us, we can help you."

Charlotte, May 1974 — FBI agent Walter Baker visited Jack Gibbs, the father of a USLP member seeking information on the Party. Throughout the United States, similar reported instances of FBI harassment and intimidation of USLP contacts, members and members' relatives have occurred in 15 to 20 cases. Affidavits documenting all cited incidents are available on request.

Brief on World Starvation Emergency Food Program

At the present moment, humanity is faced with the most catastrophic famine and mass slaughter in history. Since this summer, more than 20 million people have starved to death in India, Bangladesh, East Africa, the Sahel, and Central and South America. This famine is not the result of natural disasters. It is instead the result of the deliberate sabotage of food production and distribution by supranational agencies operating in their own political and economic interests. These 20 million deaths are mass murder, mass murder planned and carried out by the cabal organized and led by the Rockefeller family.

Unless immediate action is taken to provide massive food shipments from existing reserves to the starving countries and to immediately expand food production world-wide, more than 90 million human beings will die within the next few months. The implementation of such an Emergency Food Program is the most urgent task facing the world today.

This Labor Committee brief details the precise extent of genocide by starvation, the men responsible for it, and what can be done to stop it.

The Extent of Genocide

The magnitude of the loss of life occurring today is best indicated by the fact that, during the months of October and November, 1974, the total world population declined, probably for the first time since the Great Plagues of the mid-seventeenth century. The entire natural growth of some 20 million births was more than wiped out by mass death from starvation. If the present phase of devastation is allowed to continue for even another month, the world will have suffered a net contraction in population for the entire year of 1974

The center of this mass death is the Indian Subcontinent. Three years of acute disintegration has plunged the population of India and Bangladesh into utter collapse. In India, the states of Bihar, West Benegal, Kerala, Rajasthan, Orissa, Maharastra and Gujarat, a total of 250 million people, are all faminestricken. In non-famine years, the average caloric intake had been reduced to a bare subsistence minimum of about 2000 calories a day. Today, in the famine regions, the maximum diet is 1,600-1,800 calories a day. More than 60 million people are being wholly supported through government supplies of only 1,000 calories a day.

In Bangladesh food consumption had already dropped to the totally marginal level of 1,850 calories a day by 1972. Today, more than 20 million people, nearly one third of the entire population, are virtually without food, and have been since early this September. Of these people, six million are in

government "gruel camps." Here they are fed token rations of 300 calories a day, a single bowl of thin gruel. The "luckier" 15 million on the rations of the "fair price stores" are receiving little better — 700 calories a day. Throughout the Subcontinent, men, women, and children are reduced to utter desperation, eating the bark off trees, digging for roots, grass, worms, insects — anything to keep alive.

Under these conditions, genocide can be the only result. A human being requires approximately 3,000 calories a day for normal activity and health, 2,000 calories for bare subsistence if any activity at all is to be maintained. The absolute minimum to merely preserve life, without any physical activity at all is 1,600 calories a day. If food supplies are cut below this level, an individual's body will begin to consume itself, starting with fat supplies, then muscles, then organs, until the person collapses in complete exhaustion and death. For the already critically undernourished population of the Subcontinent, an intake of only 300 calories a day means that death is inevitable within seven weeks; on 700 calories a day death will result within 10 weeks; and on 1.000 calories a day, within three months. With famine in some areas already approaching a duration of three months, death rates in the thousands of "skeleton camps" where human beings lie row upon row amid the stench of their own excrement, are above 5 per thousand per day - a death rate of more than 300,000 deaths per day on the Subcontinent as a whole.

It is conservative to estimate the total deaths thus far in Bangladesh at 6-8 million and those in India at 12-15 million. Without a reversal of the present situation in the next few weeks an additional 60 million will inevitably die by year's end.

As the massive depopulation of the Indian Subcontinent proceeds, the famine begun last year in Sahelian Africa is continuing and spreading. More than five million people in the worst affected regions have already died; the slaughter has now extended to Ethiopia and Tanzania.

A fully comparable situation on a smaller scale exists in Honduras and Central America, where the recent hurricane was the final blow to already collapsing economies. More than 600,000 people are now virtually without food supplies.

Nor is the havoc limited to the devastated "Fourth World" countries. In Brazil, the mass murder proceeds less dramatically, but no less massively. A full 40 per cent of Brazil's 100 million people receive insufficient calories; and two thirds receive a generally deficient diet. The consequence of this slow starvation has been a soaring increase in the incidence of all disease and of disease mortality.

Infant mortality has more than doubled in the past 10 years and now averages nearly 15 per cent for the country as a whole. In some regions 28 per cent of all infants die in the first year. The average death rate for children during the first five years of life is estimated to be above 30 per cent. At the present time more than 2 million children under the age of five die each year in

The incidence of all disease is colossal. Malaria has risen by 12.5 times in the past few years. Eighty-nine per cent of all children examined in one recent study in Sao Paolo had intestinal parasites. Over 12 million Brazilians are afflicted with "chagas." An epidemic of meningitis, one of many new strains developing in the catastrophic conditions of Brazil, is still growing. Already 40,000 have died. While meningitis death rates in well-fed populations never rise above 4 per cent, in Brazil, the death rate is between 10 and 20 per cent. Who Is Responsible?

What is the reason for this mass slaughter? Who has caused it?

These millions of deaths are not the result of any natural catastrophe. The 20 million human beings in the Indian Subcontinent are being consciously murdered. This genocide by starvation and famine is the horrendous crime of the supranational cabal led by the Rockefeller Family.

The present famines are the first result of a general plan which is explicitly aimed at wiping out one billion human beings in the next decade. The famines are caused by the systematic withholding of the means of producing food — fuel, fertilizer, and the credit to buy them, and of food itself from the populations of the Indian Subcontinent and other "Fourth World"

This plan for genocide on an unprecedented scale is explicitly laid out in the publications of the supranational institutions which in turn carry them out.

John D. Rockefeller III has himself personally stated the capitalist necessity to reduce the world population by one billion. The September 1974 report of the World

Bank, run by Rockefeller crony Robert McNamara*, details exactly who is to be eliminated. The entire "Fourth World", a concept coined by the Rockefellercontrolled Trilateral Commission, is to be written off. The area of South Asia, Africa, and most of Latin America with the exception of "redevelopment pockets" in the Rio de la Plata and elsewhere is doomed. This entire region is "uncreditworthy" by the World Bank - that is, incapable of providing the loot required by the continued existence of Rockefeller financial interests. The verdict of the report is clear — these countries are to be squeezed of the last ounce of debt service on the \$25 billion they presently owe major banks. They will then be liquidated as unnecessary costs. So-called "redevelopment areas" like Brazil, are to be only more slowly drained of their population and wealth.

While the genocidal policy outlined in the World Bank report is covered by the proper banking language and niceties, in other cabal publications of the cabal it stands nakedly expressed. In October, 1974, the President of Rockefeller University presented an award to Jay Forrester for his work in the Zero-Growth propaganda. Forrester's work was outlined in a report by his assistant, Dale Runge.

This report states that basic method by which genocide is being carried out - the total withholding of the means of food production and food itself from selected populations. Food relief is declared "unethical;" it leads only to greater population increases in the future. The "ethical" alternative offered is "triage":

> "The basic idea of triage is to place food short countries into three categories: those that will probably survive without help; those who could survive with help; those that are hopeless. Aid should be allocated only to those in the middle category."

India, Bangladesh, Africa and much of Central and South America have been written off as "hopeless." Their populations will starve to death.

[&]quot;Robert McNamara: Prior to becoming head of the World Bank. McNamara was Secretary of Defense in the Kennedy and Johnson Administrations. He was recommended and effectively chosen for his post at the World Bank by Robert Lovett, who was connected to the banking investment house of Brown Brothers Harriman, which is interlocked with Rockefeller interests. McNamara is a member of the Board of Trustees of the Ford Foundation, which worked hand in glove with the Rockefeller Foundation around the world.

The former head of the World Bank was John McCloy. Before coming to the World Bank, he was chairman of the Rockefeller owned Chase Manhattan Bank. He served as a key figure in reorganizing the post World War II European economy for Rockefeller interests, and was a key figure in the 1964 military coup in Brazil. In 1971, McCloy negotiated the agreement by which the OPEC nations began cutting back on oil production. He is currently Chairman of the Trustees of the Ford Foundation.

Those countries thus condemned may have a temporary reprieve if they agree to carry out the policy of "population control"—triage, on their own:

"Continuous food aid to any country should be made effectively subject to two binding minimum restraints: quantitatively expressed plans and specified means of implementing agricultural improvement and reducing birth rates. A country which chooses not to subscribe to and implement these restraints takes humanitarianism into its own hands and should be left to its own destiny in the future."

Precisely what this means in practice is illustrated by the October 1974 meeting of the Aid Bangladesh Consortium, representing major governmental and banking creditors. The World Bank presided over the meeting. The terms dictated to Bangladesh for any further, even token credit were: population control, based on forced sterilization and forced abortion; agriultural reform, based on converting land now producing rice to jute production for export.

In February of this year the World Bank "predicted" that 30 million would die this year of starvation. This has occurred. The following details the methods by which this "prediction" was put into effect, by which the first installment of one billion deaths was made.

I.The Withholding of Fuel. As a result of the 400 per cent increase in the price of oil, the farmers of Indian and Bangladesh were unable to purchase the fuel they needed for agriculture. In particular, there was inadequate fuel to run the irrigation pumps of the dryer regions of India, leading to a direct loss of grain through lack of moisture. This increase and the accompanying withholding of oil was initiated by the major oil firms and the oil producers in December, 1973. It is no secret that the oil firms are owned or controlled by the Rockefellers. It is only slightly less well-known that the "governments" of Iran, Saudia Arabia, Algeria and Libya were installed and are controlled by the United States Intelligence Agency (CIA). The CIA since its inception has acted purely as a private executing agency of the Rockefeller Family and associated financial interests. The Rockefeller Family was intimately involved with the origin of the CIA. The Rockefeller control of the other "OPEC" states such as Venezuela and Indonesia is well-known.

II.The Withholding of Fertilizer. The vast bulk of the decline in grain production in India and Bangladesh is the result of a shortage of fertilizer. In June, 1974, shipments of fertilizer to the Subcontinent were held up by the fertilizer producers. Fertilizer companies demanded payment on the basis of new prices which were 100 per cent above the old ones. As a result of high prices rises and inadequate cash or credit available to buy sufficient fertilizer, India suffered a fertilizer shortage of one million tons; Bangladesh suffered a shortage of more than 200,000tons. The direct consequence of these shortages was the reduction of the Indian crop by more than 10 million tons, and that of Bangladesh from 19.5 million tons to 13 million tons.

Since the mid 1960s the world fertilizer trade and production has been entirely taken over by the Rockefeller-controlled oil companies and other Rockefeller interests: W.R. Grace, in the United States; Ultrafertil in Brazil; Coromandle Ltd. in India itself; Sumitamo Durez of Japan; Ste. Atlantiques d'Enggries Chemiques of France. The rich phosphate rock deposits in Sengala and Toga are all owned or controlled by Rockefeller. Under Rockefeller orders worldwide fertilizer production has been cut back to such an extent that many plants are running at only 85 per cent or even 60 per cent of capacity. Under Rockefeller orders, fertilizer has been denied to both the famine areas; the fertilizer supply to the farmers of North America and Europe who could produce the food necessary to replace that lost in the underdeveloped areas, has also decreased.

III. Withholding of Credit — Draining of Foreign Exchange.

That sector condemned by the World Bank to destruction is being stripped of credit and foreign exchange necessary to import food. Debt service which increased by 60 per cent last year to \$1.6 billion for the "lower income countries" naturally takes the first chunk of exchange. Then comes the more than \$5 billion in additional import costs attributable to the oil and fertilizer hoaxes. Since the total imports of the condemned countries has already been falling since 1971, the combined impact is to reduce the total exchange available for all non-fuel imports, including food, by more than 75 per cent. At the same time, the flow of new credit, which now becomes essential for mere existence, is cut off. The net flow of credit to South Asia, for example, is now less than half what it was in 1965, in absolute terms, and even less when inflation is counted in.

At its meeting in May 1974 the Aid India Consortium eliminated all new aid to India and determined that all loans would be allocated only to pay the \$770 million in debt service falling due in 1974.

The refusal to grant credit by the World Bank and other supranational agencies forces the least developed nations to loot themselves for goods to export in order to gain foreign exchange. In primitive agriculture, such looting leads directly to the collapse

of the food production system and so-called "natural" disasters. Bangladesh has been forced to simultaneously attempt to maintain jute exports and grow the rice needed for survival. As a direct result, the labor needed for maintaining of irrigation and flood control works has not been available. The deterioration of these works is the immediate cause of the disastrous flooding which devastated the Bengali rice crop in August, destroying 15-25 million tons of grain, immensely aggravating famine conditions.

Similarly, the nations of the Sahel have been forced to produce ever greater quantities of beef for export. This process resulted in overgrazing, the destruction of the soil cover, the loss of soil moisture and the current devasting drought. Even with the drought, the process of looting continues. While production for domestic consumption in drought-ravaged Mali has sunk from 60,000 tons in 1967 to 15,000 tons of food today, export crop production, notably high protein peanuts, have increased. Similarly, the Sahel country of Chad is receiving an \$8.5 million IDA credit in order to improve its road used for the export of cotton. In the meantime, the roads used for delivery of food to the starving nomads remain impassable.

In exactly the same way, the collapse of Tanzania farming and food production is a direct result of the "ujammization", the forced development of export oriented agricultural communes. In the wake of the chaos and exhaustion caused by this program, Tanzanian food production dropped by more than 80 per cent.

The barbaric dictatorship of the Brazilian junta was installed by Rockefeller's CIA to carry out the necessary reduction in domestic consumption necessary for export orientation, a prerequisite for the current investment now pouring into the Brazilian export sector. While disease rates have skyrocketed, medical expenditures have dropped by more than a third.

As the ICLC has previously documented (see Brief to the United States Congress on Rockefeller), the network of world credit is controlled by a handful of New York banks, all of which are coordinated with the Rockefellers' own Chase Manhattan, and by international credit agencies organized by the World Bank. The World Bank itself is wholly staffed at the top by Rockefeller agents like Robert McNamara.

IV. The Withholding of Food.

The starving countries have been denied the necessary food imports by the enormous increase in grain prices and by the denial of credit. Additionally, the necessary immediate famine relief essential to stop the massacre already precipitated by Rockefeller actions is being systematically withheld in an incredibly brutal game in which the governments of the starving countries are forced to beg for food they never get.

Since last year, the price of wheat and rice have more than doubled. This price increase is wholly a product of the intense speculation and massive hoarding carried out by a handful of major grain dealers led by Continental and Cargill. In 1973 alone, while government and farmers stocks of grain were being depleted, the amount of grain in the hands of private dealers in the United States rose by more than 100 per cent to 8 million tons, a process which is continuing.

Sitting on this enormous hoard, the grain companies are refusing even normal business credit to the "Fourth World". In July a ship owned by Continental sat for weeks in Bangladesh's Chittagong harbor. The wheat in its hold rotted and the Bengalis starved on the shore, because Continental would not allow one grain of wheat to be unloaded until every penny of the price had been paid in cash.

A similar withholding of grain by Australian corporations occurred earlier this year. In the Sahel, the International Development Agency has granted the pitiful sum of \$14 million to be divided among the six West Sahel nations for drought relief, a grant of less than 50 cents per capita! The amounts of food aid supplied are similarly miniscule, amounting to no more than a few hundred calories a day per capita in the affected areas.

The World Food Conference Hoax

The World Food conference and the charade carried out there around famine relief was organized by Rockefeller flunky Secretary of State Henry Kissinger precisely to cover up the real responsibility for the mass murder. For two weeks, Rockefeller agents John A. Hannah* and A.H. Boerma, head of the FAO, pretended to solicit aid for the starving. The tremendous fraud behind this effort was the explicit assumption that no food reserves were available, and that any food relief must be taken out of the consumption of the advanced countries. Under this cover export restrictions such as the grain export ban imposed by Canada, which further strengthened Rockefeller grip on food supplies, were instituted. The CIA-controlled press played up mass murder of millions in the Subcontinent as an argument for reduced food consumption in the United States and Western Europe.

The United Nations' Food and Agricultural Organization's own statistics totally belie the claim that sufficient reserves do not exist. A least 105 million tons of grain are in stocks at this time, not counting the reserves of the Soviet Union and China. This is vastly more than the 11 million tons supposedly solicited at the World Food Conference and the approximately 30 million tons actually needed for relief.

The organizers of the World Food Conference hoax, the powers behind the grain firms, the men who control credit and fertilizer are all the same. Lester

was the first chairman of the group charged with implementing the program that became known as Point 4 and later evolved into the U.S. International Development Program." At the Rome Conference itself the Rockefeller Family further ensured its stranglehold over world food supplies by the fact that the major United States proposals for a World Food Council international police apparatus were written by one Colin McClung, a Rockefeller Foundation staff member:

^{*}John Hannah, acting as Deputy Secretary General of the World Food Conference, which was staffed by the Rockefellers with Rockefeller Foundation staff workers. Hannah admitted to IPS in a meeting of non-governmental organization in preparation for the food conference: "I have been involved in one way or another with the problems of poor people in the poor countries ever since President Truman in 1949 asked me to serve on International Development Advisory Board. Nelson Rockefeller, our Vice-President designate,

Brown, chief spokesman of the phony grain reserves scheme, heads the Rockefeller Foundation-funded Overseas Development Council. The large food firms are financed nearly 100 per cent by the major New York banks, controlled by the Rockefeller Family. The famines are no natural disaster. They are the planned implementation of the Rockefeller Family's depopulation and Zero Growth program. The Rockefellers and those who work with them and for them are guilty of mass murder — the extent of which far exceeds the crimes of Adolph Hitler.

What Can Be Done

The mass murder can and must be stopped. There is no objective barrier to stopping the immediate famine and preventing any recurrences. Only the plans of the Rockefeller faction stands in the way of immediate action. If we allow this to be a barrier, the more than 90 million now facing death will die within months. Next year's famines will be even more catastrophic.

The following program of action constitutes the immediate steps to be taken.

1) The United States, Canada, Australia and other agricultural producer countries, utilizing a portion of the more than 90 million tons of grain now in reserve, must immediately send sufficient grain to India, Bangladesh, the African Sahel, Ethiopia, and Honduras to guarantee the satisfaction of minimal dietary requirements to the entire population of those areas.

According to ICLC Intelligence estimates, based on government and other official sources, approximately 20 to 30 million tons of grain is required to prevent immediate mass starvation in the affected areas. Although this constitutes a substantial fraction of total reserves, its allocation would by no means exhaust these reserves. More importantly, this emergency allocation can be made without infringing on either domestic consumption in the producer countries or

export requirements of those same countries. In other words, contrary to official Rockefeller propaganda, the genocide can be halted on the spot without sacrificing the diets of the rest of the world's working class population.

2) Appropriate measures must be taken now to guarantee the expansion of 1975 grain crops to necessary levels.

| a. Guarantee adequate supplies of fertilizer and fuel to farmers. At present there are approximately 10 million tons of idle capacity in the fertilizer industry. Its utilization, coupled with a relatively small investment of several billions of dollars in a "crash" program to expand fertilizer production capacity—taking advantage especially of the now-wasted resources of the aerospace-defense sector—could result in doubling fertilizer production before the 1976 plantings.

The manifest feasibility of such a "crash" effort can be demonstrated by reference to the example of similar such efforts during World War II.

The implementation of such a crash program will lead to an increase in food production world-wide by 500 to 700 million tons. This is sufficient to eliminate gross malnutrition in every country in the world.

b. Guarantee to all farmers low-interest credit sufficient to eliminate all financial restrictions on full capacity use of present agricultural technology and arable land. This should be financed by taking capitalists' speculative income, not working class income.

3) Declare a moratorium on all farm and Third World debt.

Eliminating Third World as well as farm debt, combined with the guarantee of low-interest credit, will allow the rapid reconstruction of the destroyed irrigation systems in, specifically, India, Bangladesh and the Sahel, in addition to the immediate reinvigoration of food production in the industrial sector.

Bill for Emergency Food Relief For Presentation in United States Congress

In view of the catastrophic starvation which now faces more than 90 million people in many countries who are in peril of immediate death, and in view of the already massive loss of life which threatens immediately the well-being and existence of every human being in the world, the following emergency measures to relieve famine and expand food production are hereby enacted by the Congress of the United States.

- I. Congress will immediate Emergency Famine Relief. An Emergency Relief Administration is hereby empowered to use existing provision of PL 480 to immediately purchase 10 million tons of grains suitable for human consumption from the reserves of trading companies and farmers. Existing government reserves must also be used for famine relief. The Emergency Relief Administration is to organize and fund the dispatch of this aid to the famine stricken areas of Bangladesh, India, the Sahel, East Africa and Central America. Such aid is to be dispatched as rapidly as is physically possible. It is to be dispatched without regard to the financial conditions of the recipient governments, political agreements, or previously existing arrangements.
- II. Congress will empower the Emergency Relief Administration to consult with other governments with the aim of arranging further aid to famine-stricken areas.
- III. Congress will ensure that the special purchases of the Emergency Relief Administration are made at the market price from farmers and at the fixed price of \$2.00 per bushel from major grain trading companies.
- IV. Congress will exact penalties against hoarding. Any official of any grain trading or food processing corporations who other reloses to sengrain at the set price or who conceals the amount of grain in their possession, or who buys grain beyond immediate needs with the intent to force prices upwards, are guilty of the crime of hoarding and speculation. They are directly responsible for the loss of life resulting from these illegal actions.

The United States Justice Department is hereby empowered to set up appropriate thorough inspection and investigation services, in cooperation with the Emergency Relief Administration to enforce this law. Those found guilty of hoarding or speculation are to be sentenced to death or imprisoned for life.

- V. Congress shall use its powers to immediately expand fertilizer production.
- A. Under the powers of the Defense Production Act of 1950, the Departments of Agriculture and Commerce shall order the fertilizer companies to expand production to full capacity.
- B. A Government Fertilizer Industry is hereby established with the immediate task of increasing fertilizer capacity in the United States by 50 million tons within the next two years. Under the Defense Production Act, the GFI is to have full power to purchase all necessary capital equipment and materials and employ whatever labor is required to achieve this goal.
- VI. Congress will ensure the credit supply required to expand food production. Credit at interest rates not exceeding 2 percent per annum are to be allocated by the Farm Credit Administration to all farmers in the amounts necessary for purchase of all fertilizer, fuels, seed, and agricultural equipment necessary for full agricultural production.
- VII. Congress hereby declares a moratorium on the payment of debt service on all farm debt in the United States, effective immediately. Furthermore, all debts owed to the United States government and to private individuals and corporations by the governments, private individuals, and corporations of the continents of Asia, Africa and Latin America are hereby suspended.
- VIII. Congress empowers the Emergency Relief Administration to appropriate an initial \$5 billion. An initial appropriation of \$4 billion is to be made to the Government Fertilizer Industry.

Fusion Energy Foundation Established

NEW YORK, Nov. 24-(IPS)- A group of twenty scientists and pro-fusion advocates meeting in the Hotel Tudor here yesterday took the historic step of founding the Fusion Energy Foundation (FEF).

With most of their colleagues reduced to mere instrumentalities of Rockefeller's fascist planning apparatus, the handful of scientists on the FEF and in its immediate periphery represent the germ of an organization that will eventually free all of science from the Rockefeller death grip. Until now the only organized political thrust for fusion power has been from the Labor Committees. Now the germ of a united front between scientists and broad layers of the supportive population has been created.

The Pioneers

Coming together to form the scientific advisory body of the new body are three of the most important contributors, the pioneers in the development of fusion research.

Robert Moon, Winston Bostich and Louis. Defying the laws of capitulation to criminal budgets and mediocrity, they are establishing the working class' first scientific center, an Atomic Energy Foundation for the working class.

Professor Robert Moon of the physics department at the University of Chicago, a co-worker of Enrico Fermi and Leo Szilard, proposed one of the first deuterium trapping experiments in the early 1930s.

Prof. Winston Bostich, head of the physics department of Stevens Institute of Technology, has worked on the magnetic pinch approach to fusion since the 1950s and was the first person to explain magnetic filament effects in high density plasma discharges;

Dr. Louis Gold of the Biopolis Corp. of Washington, D.C., originator of numerous innovations in low energy laser fusion theory and a pioneer in high density plasma work.

The body elected a pro-temp Board of Directors which includes: Larry Bogart, the coordinator of over two-hundred anti-fission groups under the Citizens Energy Council, Mr. Russel Johnson, a national leader of the American Friends Service Committee, Chuck Steves and Dr. Moe Levitt, Labor Committee fusion experts and Dr. Fred Howard of the Yale Computer Science Department.

Also in attendance were representatives of two energy policy bodies of the United Nations and a "representative" from the Rockefeller-controlled Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) who dispatched essentially to spy on the proceedings.

Not Just Another Meeting

The day-long conference-symposium focused on a discussion of the social process by which creative scientific work is possible, examining the qualities of the creative human mind. The handful of scientists in attendance, were in the best position to carry out this discussion, representing the potential for the reestablishment of science according to the criteria imposed by the necessity of human progress and development.

Bostich, Moon and Gold saw Rockefeller-aligned forces draw the noose of fusion sabotage around their work, denying them funds, access to information and at times even access to each other. They saw Rockefeller's scientific henchmen, frauds and incompetents, like Robert Oppenheimer and Edward "Madman" Teller build reputations for themselves as "atomic experts," first by stealing their work and most recently by sabotaging fusion research.

The situation is changing. The tens of thousands of workers reading this newspaper are struggling with and mastering the essential point of the latest fusion research and developing an understanding of fusion technology. For the first time since World War II, workers are beginning to see science as their possession — a tool that can solve their problems. The more than 300,000 votes for the U.S. Labor Parety in the recent elections were votes in support of the Labor Party's program calling for the brute force development of fusion power, votes implicitly in support of the work of scientists like Gold, Moon and Bostich.

These scientists are thus being made aware that their real constituency is the working class. The intellectual ferment created within the working class by the discussion fusion power has initiated by the activities of the Labor Committees has had remoralizing effect on fusion scientists. It has given them the courage to put themselves knowingly on the line and attend yesterday's meeting.

This handful of "scientific cadre," along with their supporters, will now organize their colleagues to join the FEF while joining with the Labor Committee in fostering an intellectual renaissance within the working class.

A Question of Survival

Labor Committee chairman Lyn Marcus set the context for the whole session when in his opening remarks, he said: "The problem we are discussing here is not a technical one of fusion, per se. The problem is one of human survival."

Marcus went on to clearly delineate the ecological catastrophe that would destroy human civilization by 1990 unless fusion power is developed by the middle of the next decade. Stressing the genocidal nature of Rockefeller's policies and the suppression of fusion research by his henchmen like Edward Teller, Marcus counterposed as the only possible alternative the renaissance of unfettered scientific creativity. "We must not concern ourselves with so-called absolute time schedules," Marcus stated referring to well-publicized Rockefeller-authored projections that fusion power could not be developed until 1990 "at the earliest." There is no such thing as an absolute time schedule. We must specify what is needed - the application of a fusion power technology by the mid-1980s at the latest - and then organize our research and resources to meet that target date. We are capable of accelerating the rate at which creative scientific development takes place, Marcus stated.

In response, physicists and others present drew upon their experiences, especially with the wartime Manhattan Project that created the atomic bomb, to specify the only condition under which such a creative flowering could take place: broad financial support and complete freedom of inquiry in an atmosphere of intellectual collaboration among morally self-disciplined, creative scientists.

Prof. Bostich raised the fear of bureaucratization and heavy handed interference with creative work that lingers as an afterthought in the minds of most scientists who worked on the brute force Manhattan project, and who suffered through the post-war Dark Ages. Both he and Professor Moon described the tendency of the leadership of the project and various funding agencies during the post-war era to view the scientists as just so many soldiers, or platoons of workers at their desks grinding out daily assignments.

Marcus answered their fears directly, stating that a "multifarious" approach to problem solving was necessary, that creativity could not be mass produced as if it were some assembly line product. (See accompanying box.)

Prof. Moon concretized Marcus' comments by drawing upon his experience. Creativity is a social experience that is fostered by the free exchange of ideas among small groups of creative individuals, he stated as he recalled memories of the Manhattan Project. Describing how the Manhattan project actually worked, despite the wishes of

its military and bureaucratic overseers, Moon stated, "There is an inter-personal method of knowing which comes about when people get together and share ideas.New ideas pop up which are beyond anything that anyone...thought might happen."

Prior to this exchange, Labor Committee fusion expert Chuck Stevens had outlined the general parameter of a brute force fusion development program. Stevens demonstrated that only fusion power would be an actual source of new "net" energy. A fusion power plant, would produce two times as much energy in its first year of operation as all the energy that had been put into its production. In fission, fossil fuel or solar energy production no such net increase in energy production could take place. Dismissing the arguments a number of speakers who had proposed solar energy as a less risky alternative to fusion power development, Stevens demonstrated that the most efficient way to use solar energy would be to use fusion power to expand agricultural production and as a by-product enlarge solar energy "capture" through photosynthesis.

The computer print-out sent to the conference by the AEC's Controlled Thermonuclear Research (CTR) division, a Mr. Rice, spoke in defense of the AEC's criminal sabotage of fusion research. Rice whined about irresponsible scientists who were wasting the taxpayers' money on "fruitless endeavors," fulfilling his initial announcement that he would offend the participants' intelligence with his remarks.

Marcus answered Rice countering "that the creative individual must be intrinsically trusted...there must be

complete trust for scientific progress to take place."

The basis for the Rockefeller-inspired zero-growth movements is the fear of scientific progress that overcomes decaying bourgeois culture — a moral cancer that could destroy human creativity itself in the interest of saving capitalist control over production." Marcus went on. We should not fear progress or the problems that are its "byproducts," as is proposed by these modern day barbarians. These so-called problems merely define the next challenge — challenges which science must solve. (See accompanying box.)

Reaching Outward

The Fusion Energy Foundation (FEF) will immediately begin reaching out to the large numbers of independent scientists who are now at work in isolated pockets or as individuals in the hostile environment of a rotting bourgeois society. These scientists will once again be given the intellectual environment and political support to make the creative advances now required to prevent ecological holocaust and human destruction over the next decade.

The FEF will be developing and disseminating the most comprehensive assessments about current fruitful lines of development of fusion power.

Simultaneously, through the publication of articles in this newspaper and through the circulation of such documents as the forthcoming Fusion issues of the Campaigner, the FEF will keep the working class abreast of the latest developments in fusion technology. This augmentation of intellectual ferment in the working class will in turn lay the basis for a scientific renaissance.

FUSION MEETING DEBATE ON HUMAN CREATIVITY

The following is an edited exchange between Profs. Moon and Bostich, and Lyn Marcus. The exchange clearly outlines the essential subjective features of crash scientific program of the type we are proposing for fusion power development, as such it represents in cameo form the type of creative free "exchange of ideas" the speakers refer to.

LYN MARCUS — Dr. Bostich has hit upon a very significant problem which is an included problem that we have to face, and it's a problem which faces socialists in particular. There's an insufficient recognition of the subjective element in human progress. That we have to focus effectively on giving a great deal of freedom and facilities and resources to individual teams which constitute themselves and deconstitute themselves when their specific purpose is completed.

PROF. MOON — I've just jotted down a few things here that I'd like to bring to your attention. The Manhattan project was born after the discovery of the neutron in '32 and then fission in '38 by Hans Strauss. It put scientists to work all over the world in their little laboratories, verifying the various natures of fission. And then the scientists of their own accord went into secrecy. Well, this was one of the first times it seemed that there might be a possibility to get energy from nuclear reactions.

But what I'd like to say is, the atmosphere, that existed at that time, in the first place we had this self-imposed secrecy and went to work on neutron diffusion — that's what we called it. The main thing was a group of scientists were brought together, they were fed work, there was no question about patents or anything of that sort, they were working for the good of the country. There was no — such as we have experienced since then —

there was no long term writing of proposals and writing of reports and so on. The question is: how do you really do research, if there is as crisis on, and you have got to spend a great deal of time writing reports and getting referrees to approve them — particularly if it's a new idea? You didn't have to do this on the Manhattan Project. You just went ahead. This is exactly what happened. Scientists worked, and they worked together. They worked on any idea that came to their minds. No stone was left unturned.

This was one of the great things about the Manhattan Project. And we had information meetings — once or twice a week the scientists got together and discussed all the things that were going on. And there was no self-pride involved at all. We were all reduced to the same level and fighting for the same thing.

If we are ever going to go ahead on fusion, it seems to me something of the order of the Manhattan Project (is needed) in which scientists can come together and work and which funds are given and questions are not asked.

PROF. BOSTICH — Let's remember this when we're talking about crash programs. They are not necessarily an answer to the problem. They have inherent difficulties, inherent poisons built into them. They have the seeds of their own destruction built into them. Also, with the situation in fusion now, there are big centers that have their own programs that are already fairly big. There are these empires and the power brokers of these empires and they aren't going to take kindly to a kind of dismemberment of their empire and a pooling of their resources. I don't know how a crash program is going to come about. I really don't see how to organize it. Maybe somebody else does but it looks difficult to me.

So we have a problem of social development here which I think ought to be integral to our approach. What we have

to do is to be multifarious, but have an overview of what we're doing. We can't say, "well, what is the effective approach; this is our policy; now everybody work within this policy." We've got to get away from that bureaucratic approach to scientific development. It doesn't work, because scientific development always is based upon the individual and small group who activates the creation of a hypothesis and the initial experimental demonstration of the hypothesis which then is ready to be assimilated as a part of general policy. What we need in this case, is we need a crash program - but a crash program, I think. has to be not unilinear. It has to be based on fostering every productive line of experiment. Which means essentially fostering a lot of small hypothesis chasing individual groups based on general experience and competence.

This kind of thing which, while it's indirect in respect to the fusion question itself, is fundamental to getting the kind of progress we want. We must have a social conception of the necessary conditions of scientific achievement as well as the overall funding and general targets which we work for.

Our job is to create a culture in which there is a large proliferation of scientific skills. These skills then have to be given the means to realize their potential. This has to be done in cognate with the raising the cultural level of the entire population, and I think our method of social control is the one by which we are going to be able to achieve these objectives.

Our ability to win this fight for getting back to the idea of progress, away from the idea of zero growth and stagnation proliferated recently, is based on the constituency of the skilled and semi-skilled American worker and his brother in Europe and other parts of the world and the anguish of the underdeveloped countries which need this. And it's to the extent that we make these policies and needs comprehensible to this political constituency which demands that qualified physicists and engineers will be developed, will be given the facilities to realize their potential as individuals and groups to produce the demonstrations of experimental feasibility of hypothesis. We can then — as a source, as a warehouse of ideas — select those demonstrated feasibilities for actual large scale social practice.

But this relationship, I think, must be much more clearly understood. And it is our specific responsibility, particularly from the standpoint of my organization, to deal with that problem. We have to integrate a working concept of how scientific development occurs in society together with the problem of a mass policy of this type. We know from the entire history of the human mind, we know that the mediation of creativity is the creation of hypotheses by individuals often working as individuals or small groups. This demands laboratory and cognate facilities for these individuals and groups be made available with a great deemphasis on saying what are you going to do as a result of getting these facilities. You must be giving considerations along the line Dr. Bostich indicated. We must consider the kinds of sociological problems that come with the furthering of scientific creative development, and we must incorporate these things into our program. The fact that we as an organization are pushing this does not mean, as some might interpret, that we foresee a single policy which everybody gets in line with. Quite the contrary, we have to go through a mediating process which emphasizes individual mental capacity for generating new hypotheses. And it's your responsibility to feed back to us from your experience the empirical knowledge of this sociology.

PROF. MOON — I just want to say another word I forgot to say when I was up here. And this is in line with what both Prof. Bostich and Lyn Marcus have said, namely, on the Manhattan Project there was this great sharing of ideas. This is extremely important, to share ideas, to bring together scientists, they share ideas and they share

them freely. They're not thinking about what's in it for me, but rather, what's in it for the country, for the world, in this sharing of ideas. Out of this came new ideas. You find it at the scientific meetings where the scientists gather in little knots in the hallways and discuss problems. Out of this sharing of ideas come new ideas.

I might say that in order to have this sharing we had a little fight when we became the Manhattan Project. General Groves spoke in terms of what Lyn Marcus was talking about, the platoon arrangement. He wanted every scientist to work in his own little cell, not to tell the scientist next to him what he was working on. He thought this was the way to bring about national security. The scientists refused to work. And strangely enough, the scientists brought about a sufficient amount of pressure that General Groves gave in.

And so we had our information meetings, we had the sharing of ideas. We felt that we were the ones that had the knowledge about nuclear energy.

The following is an edited exchange between Mr. Rice, the automaton from the Atomic Energy Commission, and Lyn Marcus.

Marcus answers Rice's charge that scientists cannot be trusted with a description of the world historical identity of the creative scientist.

MR. RICE — I've been in the R&D business for quite a few years. And one of the basic, gut questions always is to what extent you give the contractor a free hand? The answer to that is very complicated, but it involves among other things, trust. It involves the matter of has that contractor shown not that they're not trustworthy, but that they're effective — that they spend their dollar in a very effective way.

LYN MARCUS — This is the area of creativity we are concerned with. Some of you know from personal experience that the creative person, when functioning as a creative person, does not fit the Rousseau social contract view of competitive individuality. The creative individual can be intrinsically trusted when being creative. There must be complete trust and that's the only basis for scientific progress.

The creative person has a completely different motivation than the so-called typical person as conditioned by this society. The creative person is not a person who will cheat society. He is incapable of cheating society as long as he is proceding from a creative identity.

What's the creative person's primary concern every morning? What's the agony of the creative person? The agony from which their identity is located? They know that over a period of time, over the period of their maturation, that they have done things that are original. They have synthesized new gestalts, which have a usefulness for mankind, generally. They know they've demonstrated this capacity. And the greatest fear the creative person has is that one morning he'll wake up and find that that capacity for creativity is gone. The creative person goes through all kinds of agony trying to cultivate and maintain that special quality of creativity for fear that somehow it will be lost.

The creative person knows that anything that involves moral prostitution, particularly in respect to the professional areas in which their identities are associated, will undermine their creative potential. The creative person will often leave a job because they find that their creativity is being stultified by the kind of identity which they are forced to adopt in that environment. Because they can feel, as they would say: "My mind won't last in this environment. I'll become a clod."

So the creative person can be trusted because the creative person's sense of identity in society is intimately associated with real achievement. The history of real achievements, disciplined achievement in scientific work, is the essential immediate superego of the creative

person. He doesn't do things irresponsibly. His past achievements and discipline guide him in determining what he regards as a responsible contribution.

I would suggest that, in general, a creative person in a creative environment, with a creative opportunity, can never cheat, will never propose an activity which is irresponsible.

Our problem is to develop disciplined, creative people. If we produce creative people, the creative person can be intrinsically trusted. The minute we begin to say: "Can we trust creative people; do we have to put checks on them?" we're going to lose. We're going to stultify creativity. We must recognize that the creative person has a different sense of identity than the average person in society is permitted to achieve. And that a creative person can be trusted.

The other aspect of this — and all of us who do creative work know this — know what we will permit and what we will not compromise with. We know that what we've achieved for ourselves in finding a creative identity in society rather than a routine identity is something which is the proper property of every human being. We want a society in which all human beings have a right to realize this creative potential, this sense of identity of being intrinsically trustworthy people who will not cheat society, who will always act in such a way that they know

that their existence is something useful to the human race. They will never do anything deliberately to soil that.

Now the principle upon which this achievement rests is the principle of trusting creativity. And our problem is to recognize it where it exists and to cultivate it where it does not yet exist. Under those principles the problem will be solved.

Because you put the scientist in a banalizing environment. You say, "well, we're not interested in science anymore; science has gone too far." You get these kind of Frankenstein ethics coming out: the mad scientist who's guilty of hubris and he's insulted the gods, the gods are going to destroy the environment or something hideous like that.

The basic principles of science are being rejected in our culture. We talk about the ecological problem: we produce a new crop, we have a new parasite — so what! So what! Everytime we change, we advance, we create a potential problem. That problem, in turn, defines the need for the next advance.

The problem should not be looked at as a reason not to undertake the advance, but rather the problems incurred by the advance become the basis for making further advances. They become the problems that define what further advances should be made.

Fusion Power Bill for The U.S. Congress

With the passing of this Bill the Congress of the United States commits itself to the development of nuclear fusion power and the future survival of the human race. To establish a national crash program for research and development of controlled thermonuclear fusion technology and energy production.

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the United States of America (assembled) in Congress, that this Act may be cited as the "Federal Fusion Energy and Technology Research and Development Act of 1974."

SECTION 1: The Congress hereby finds that:

- (a) The immediate development of controlled fusion is of priority concern to the Nation and World.
- (b) The major reason for the Nation's past failure to develop controlled fusion has been the lack of an aggressive research and development strategy designed to bring the necessary resources to bear on the problem.
- (c) The neglect of potential controlled fusion resources has led to deficiencies in the Nation's array of available material resources.
- (d) The Nation's energy and resource requirements can be met if a national commitment is made now to dedicate the necessary financial resources, to enlist our scientific and technological capabilities, and to accord the proper priority to developing controlled fusion to serve national needs, conserve vital resources, and protect the environment.
- (e) The urgency of the Nation's and World's resource problems requires a commitment similar to those undertaken in the crash development Manhattan and Apollo projects; it requires that the Nation undertake a long-range, top-priority, research and development program in cooperation with all interested nations of the world
- (f) In order to guarantee the integrity of such a crash development fusion program, Congress will initiate an immediate public inquiry into the possibility that criminal neglect and sabotage are responsible for the failure of the nation to have previously developed controlled fusion. This Congressional investigation will run concurrently with the implementation of the crash development fusion program.

GENERAL POLICY

SECTION 2: The Congress hereby declares as policy:

- (a) A National Department for Development of Controlled Fusion will be immediately established to carry out a national crash program of basic and applied research and developemnt, including demonstrations of practical applications, with respect to all applications of controlled fusion.
- (b) The Department for Development of Controlled Fusion (DDCF)

- will be directly responsible to Congress as a whole and will provide monthly public reports on progress of the crash program.
 - (c) The DDCF shall promptly make all records available for public inspection and copying at reasonable rates.

SECTION 3: The Congress authorizes and directs that, to the fullest extent possible, the Department for Development of Controlled Fusion authorized by this ACT shall design and execute its activities according to the following principles:

- (a) All patent and proprietory rights which bear upon controlled fusion or its development or applications will be held in abeyance.
 (b) The DDCF will cooperate with all other national and international efforts directed toward development of controlled fusion.
- SECTION 4: The Congress further authorizes the Department for Development of Controlled Fusion to:
- (a) Review the current status of all research efforts into controlled fusion and furnish a full report to the Congress and the Nation within two months after the enactment of this bill.
- (b) Form a committee of the Nation's leading scientists and engineers to review current and projected fusion research efforts and develop a detailed crash program beyond that program outlined herein. This review will be reported to Congress within 6 months of the enactment of this bill.
- (c) Obtain under the authority of the Congress all classified scientific information and other materials which relate to the development of controlled fusion (particularly laser and electrical beam fusion) and make this information available to the public.
- (d) Implement on an expanded crash basis the Atomic Energy Commission's Subpanel 11 Fusion Crash Program.
- (e) Initiate a massive educational aid and development program to supply the necessary physicists, engineers, and scientists for fusion research.
- (f) Make provisions to build a materials testing linear theta-pinch reactor within the next $\bf 6$ months.
- (g) Take possession of all existing governmental facilities (and in particular those of the Atomic Energy Commission and Department of Defense) which could contribute to fusion research.
- (h) Report all of its activities to the Congress and the Nation on a monthly basis.
- (i) Set up a national communications and translation network to transmit scientific data and reports as rapidly as possible.
- (j) Establish several national centers which would function in the same capacity as the Los Alamos Laboratory acted for the Manhattan Project. These "nerve centers" of several thousand scientists, engineers and technicians would command and coordinate the rapid development of the necessary industrial base for producing fusion technologies.

THE DEPARTMENT FOR DEVELOPMENT to fusion research under the control of the DDCF.

SECTION 5: The Congress hereby declares that:

(a) The Department for Development of Controlled Fusion will replace the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) and function under the same legislative authorization as the AEC until Congress completes its investigation of fusion sabotage. The President will temporarily appoint with the consent of Congress an eleven-man committee to take possession of the AEC and implement this bill. Their term will end within 6 months.

OF CONTROLLED FUSION

(b) All facilities currently engaged in the United States in research on fast breeder nuclear fission reactor research shall be transferred

APPROPRIATE AUTHORIZATION

SECTION 6: The Congress hereby authorizes the following appropriations for the crash development of nuclear controlled fusion:

(a) In the fiscal year of 1974, \$5,000,000,000 will be appropriated to the Department for Development of Controlled Fusion.
(b) In the fiscal year of 1975, \$20,000,000,000 will be appropriated to
