HUMANITE ALSO REPORTED TODAY A RELEASE FROM THE SOVIET PRESS AGENCY TASS, STATING THAT THE EXCHANGE RUPLE USED WITHIN THE EASTERN EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY, COMECON, MIGHT BE USED AS A BASIS FOR WORLD TRADE.

TIMES ARTICLE STATES THAT THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE STATEMENT IS THAT "IT
IT SEEMED TO SHOW A SHIFT FROM THE MORE TRADITIONAL COMMUNIST LINE
THAT EUROPE SHOULD NOT BE DIVIDED UP
BETWEEN EAST AND
WEST," INDICATING A LOOSENING OF TIES BETWEEN THE WEST EUROPEAN COMMUNIST PARTIES AND MOSCOW. THE STATEMENT WENT UNREPORTED BY EUROPE'S MAJOR DAILY

## LØNDØN-RØCKEFELLERAXIS ESCALATES BLACKMAIL - AGAINST IRAG

RECENT TRIP TO THE U.S. MET WITH NELSON ROCKEFELLER AND JAMES SCHLESINGER, AND WAS CONCEDED MILITARY SUPPORT AND ASSISTANCE. UNDER COVER OF A MILITARY MISSION, WASHINGTON "NOW MANTS TO ESTABLISH ITSELF THERE." DASING ITS REPORTS ØN ARAR PRESS SERVICE ETLEASES, DIE WELT GOES TO RE-VEAL THAT THE U.S.IS "IN QUIET" PREPARING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A "LEGAL MILITARY PRESENCE ALONG THE PERSIAN GULF." ## U.S. TO SUPPLY LEBANON WITH ARMS

(ASSOCIATED WITH-KISSINGER) IN FAVOR OF THE GENEVA CONFERENCE.
