I. INTERNATIONAL

SADAT REITERATES PEACE HOPES, BALANCING ACT

JUNE 23 (IPS)--IN AN INTERVIEW WITH THE LEBANESE DAILY AL-ANWAR, EGYPTIAN PRESIDENT SADAT HAS REITERATED STRONGLY HIS INTENTION TO AVERT A NEW CIA-PROVOKED MIDDLE EAST WAR. SADAT ALSO MAIN-TAINED HIS POSE OF "NEUTRALITY" IN WORLD POLITICS WITH ATTACKS ON BOTH THE U.S. AND THE SOVIET UNION, BUT CLEARLY CAME OUT FOR PEACE WITH ISRAEL ALONG LINES PROPOSED BY THE SOVIETS.

SADAT DECLARED THAT "ONE MUST THROW AWAY ANY THOUGHT OF KICK-ING ISRAEL INTO THE SEA," AS THE SOVIET UNION HAS REPEATEDLY EMPHASIZED THAT EGYPT'S ARMIES MUST NOT ATTACK ISRAEL WITHIN HER 1967 BORDERS. SADAT ALSO EXPOSED U.S. NUCLEAR CONFRONTATION PLANS WITH THE STATEMENT THAT KISSINGER HAD TOLD HIM, "THE U.S. WOULD ENTER ON ISRAEL'S SIDE" IN A WAR AND "WOULD NEVER ALLOW SOVIET WEAPONS TO CONQUER U.S. WEAPONS." BUT SADAT THEN STRONGLY ATTACKED THE SOVIETS FOR NOT CANCELLING EGYPT'S \$2 BILLION DEBT, ADDING THAT "FORD AND KISSINGER BEAR NO ANIMOSITY TO-WARD EGYPT."

THE SAME BALANCING EFFORT CAME THROUGH IN SADAT'S ONLY ATTACK ON ISRAEL, A DENUNCIATION OF THE DAYAN-PERES FACTION'S PROPOSED NEGOTIATING MAP FOR ISRAEL'S BORDERS WHICH MOULD ANNEX THE GOLAN HEIGHTS. SADAT DENOUNCED IT AS, "AN ATTEMPT TO OUST KISSINGEER."

SOVIET DELEGATION MEETS ARAFAT, ASSAD IN DEMASCUS

JUNE 23 (IPS) -- A HIGH-RANKING SOVIET DELEGATION LED BY SOVIET LEADER BORIS PONOMAREV MET YESTERDAY WITH PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION BOSS YASSER ARAFAT IN DAMASCUS, SYRIA. MHILE NO DETAILS OF THE MEETING HAVE YET BEEN RELEASED, PONOMAREV MAS EXPECTED TO TAKE A HARD LINE AGAINST RECENT MOVES BY ARAFAT, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE SYRIAN GOVERNMENT, TO PURGE THE PLO OF PRO-SOCIALISTS AND FORGE AN "ANTI-ZIONIST" CIA-BACKED "EASTERN FRONT" TO PULL HESITANT PRESIDENT SADAT OF EGYPT INTO A NEW MIDDLE EAST WAR.

IN A SPEECH PRECEDING THE MEETING WITH PONOMAREY, ARAFAT CHARGED THAT ISRAEL WAS PREPARING A PREEMPTIVE STRIKE AGAINST SYRIA AND THAT KISSINGER WAS "MANEUVERING TO HELP ISRAEL GAIN PRECIOUS TIME."

PONOMAREV ALSO MET YESTERDAY WITH SYRIAN DICTATOR HAFEZ ASSAUTING THE SYRIANS DESCRIBED AS DISCUSSIONS "AIMED AT CONSOL-IDATING TIES" BETWEEN THE USSR AND SYRIA.

OPEN SIGNS OF SOVIET MOVES TO PRESSURE THE CIA-ALLIGNED SYRIAN REGIME FOR PEACE, HAVE EMERGED THIS WEEK, INCLUDING A HIGHLY CRI-TICAL ARTICLE ON SYRIA IN THE EAST GERMAN COMMUNIST WEEKLY HORIZONT AND ACTIVE ANTI-GOVERNMENT CAMPAIGNING BY THE SYRIAN COMMUNIST PARTY. ACCORDING TO THE WASHINGTON POST, THE SYRIAN COMMUNISTS ARE LEADING A PARLIAMENTARY DEBATE OVER ASSAD'S PRO-MESTERN POLICIES.

SYRIANS THREATEN ISRAEL WITH "ANOTHER OCTOBER LESSON"

JUNE 23 (IPS)--SYRIA'S OFFICIAL ATH-THAWRAH NEWSPAPER YESTERDAY ATTACKED THE ISRAELI LABOR PARTY'S "MAP" FOR ISRAEL'S BOUNDAR-IES ISSUED LAST WEEK--AS "A DEMONSTRATION OF ARROGANCE." ATH-THWARAH, RESPONDING AS INTENDED BY THE HARLINERS IN ISRAEL WHO FORMULATED THE MAP AS A CIA-GUIDED WAR PROVOCATION, FURTHER BARKED THAT "ISRAEL NEEDS ANOTHER OCTOBER LESSON," AN ALLUSION TO THE 1973 "OIL HOAX" WAR. THE "MAP" INCLUDES THE GOLAN HEIGHTS BORDER REGION WITHIN ISRAEL.

IN RELATED POSTURINGS, SYRIA'S FOREIGN MINISTER KADDAM ENGAGED IN PREVIOUSLY UNSCHEDULED TALKS WITH U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER THIS WEEKEND, AND EMERGED TO DECLARE HIS REJECTION OF "EVERY AGREEMENT" DISCUSSED IN WASHINGTON, D.C. ACCORDING TO TODAY'S WEST GERMAN NEWSPAPER DIE WELT.

CDU LEADER CALLS FOR SCHACHTIAN GROWTH

JUNE 23 (IPS)--HANS FILBINGER, CONSERVATIVE PRIME MINISTER OF THE STATE OF BADEN-NUERTTEMBERG, HAS CALLED FOR AN EXPLICIT POLICY OF ECONOMIC GROWTH IN MEST GERMANY, BASED ON CORPORATE COST-REDUCTION AND WORKING CLASS AUSTERITY. SPEAKING BEFORE THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION (CDU) IN MANNHEIM, FILBINGER SAID THAT, "MORE EMERGY IS NECESSARY" TO MAINTAIN LIVING STANDARDS AND GENERATE A THREE TO FOUR PER CENT RATE OF GROWTH. "LET ME SAY IT EXPLICITLY," HE ADDED, "AMOEVER POLEMICIZES AGAINST NUCLEAR EMERGY IS ENDANGERING TOMORROW'S JOBS."

FILBINGER CONTINUED BY STATING THAT: "GROWTH HAS NOTHING TO DO WITH HELPING CORPORATIONS MAXIMIZE PROFITS," INDICATING THAT HIS GROWTH PROPOSAL MOULD INVOLVE A RESTRUCTURING OF THE GERMAN ECONOMY ALONG LINES PIONEERED BY HITLER'S FINANCE MINISTER, HUALMAR SCHACT, WHO UPHELD MASSIVE DEBT BURDENS THROUGH MAXIMUM AUSTERITY MEASURES AGAINST THE WORKING CLASS.

DIE WELT DEMANDS TAXES TO AVERT DEBT MORATORIA

JUNE 23 (IPS) -- STATE BANKRUPTCIES ARE IMMINENT IN THE WESTERN IN-DUSTRIAL COUNTRIES, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S ISSUE OF THE RIGHT-WING WEST GERMAN DAILY, DIE WELT. SUCH BANKRUPTCIES WILL LEAD TO DEBT MORATORIA UNLESS SUFFICIENT TAX INCOME IS INFORCED, SAID DIE \bigcirc

WELT'S LEAD EDITORIAL, "IN THE TWENTIETH CENTURY WE HAVE EXPER-IENCED STATE BANKRUPTCIES--IN WHICH GOVERNMENTS DECLARE THEIR INABILITY TO MEET PAYMENTS, ENACT A MORATORIUM FOR THOSE PAYMENTS, AND WRITE OFF THEIR DEBTS, IN PART OR ALL TOGETHER--OWLY IN LATIN AMERICAN AND BALKAN COUNTRIES." NOW, UNPRECEDENTED PEACETIME EX-PANSION OF STATE DEBT HAS CREATED THE SAME SITUATION IN THE IN-DUSTRIALIZED SECTOR.

DIE WELT ATTACKS "PARLIAMENTARY DEMOCRACY" ON THE GROUND THAT EVEN THE OPPOSITION NO LONGER ACTS AS A BRAKE ON PUBLIC SPENDING, BUT REMAINS UNFILLING TO PRESS UNPOPULAR AUSTERITY MEASURES. LONDON SUNDAY TELEGRAPH CALLS FOR FASCIST GANGS TO FIGHT LEFT

JUNE 23 (IPS)--FEARFUL OF THE CURRENT GOVERNMENT'S INABILITY TO CONTAIN THE GROWING COMMUNIST INFLUENCE IN THE TRADE UNIONS, THE BRITISH SUNDAY TELEGRAPH HAS CALLED FOR THE FORMATION OF FASCIST GANGS AGAINST TRADE UNIONS. PEREGRINE WORSTHORNE, COLUMNIST FOR THE SUNDAY TELEGRAPH, YESTERDAY CALLED FOR THE FORMATION OF A "MILITANT RIGHT" TO FIGHT LEFT-WING INFLUENCE. "GIVEN THE CONSERVATIVE PARTY'S RELUCTANCE TO EXPLOIT THE PRIMITIVE INSTINCTS OF THE RIGHT IN THE WAY THAT THE SOCIALISTS AROUSE THE PRIMITIVE INSTINCTS OF THE LEFT, "WRITES WORSTHORNE, "INFLATION AND LAW-LESSNESS IN GENERAL WILL BE-BRITAIM'S FUTURE. IF INFLATION IS TO BE BEATEN, THE BRITISH BODY POLITIC MUST ENTER THE FIGHT WITHOUT ITS RIGHT ARM TIED BEHIND ITS BACK. BRITISH PRIME MINISTER WILSON: "CAN'T BREAK IMMUTABLE LAWS"

JUNE 23 (IPS) -- INVOKING THE TRADITIONS OF BRITISH "SCIENTIFIC" EMPIRICISM, PRIME MINISTER HAROLD WILSON HAS WARNED COMMUNIST-INFLUENCED TRADE UNIONISTS THAT THEIR DEMANDS FOR LIVING WAGES BREAK THE "IMMUTABLE LAWS" OF THE UNIVERSE. WILSON'S STATEMENT CAME UNDER OBVIOUS PRESSURE FROM SPREADING INDUSTRIAL UNREST AND THE BRITISH COMMUNIST PARTY'S PROGRAM FOR ECONOMIC REGENERATION THROUGH EXPANDED TRADE WITH THE EAST BLOC AND THIRD WORLD. WILSON SAID: "THERE CAN BE NO APPEAL AGAINST THE IMMUTABLE LAWS, WHICH HAVE RULED EVER SINCE MAN BECAME AN ECONOMIC SOCIAL ANIMAL, THAT YOU CANNOT TAKE A QUART OUT OF A PINT POT: THAT YOU CANNOT TAKE OUT MORE THAN YOU PUT IN."

SCOOP DAZED IN SPRINGFIELD

SPRINGFIELD, MASS., JUNE 23 (IPS) -- "IT'S OK, IT'S NOT THEM," SAID MANCHURIAN CANDIDATE SCOOP JACKSON TO AN AIDE YESTERDAY WHEN A U.S. LABOR PARTY ORGANIZER HANDED HIM A POSTER DEPICTING JACKSON WITH A NUCLEAR MISSILE IN HIS HAND. THE MORE ALERT AID, SPYING NEW SOLIDARITY UNDER THE ORGANIZER'S ARM, GRABBED A PEN FROM SCOOP, YELLING, "YES IT IS THEM!"

JACKSON, AT A GATHERING OF 30 LOCAL POLITICIANS IN SPRING-FIELD, MASS., TOLD HIS LOCAL CAMPAIGN SPOKESMAN TO "LET THE USLP STAY, I KNOW HOW TO HANDLE THEM." WHEN A LABOR PARTY ORGANIZER AROSE AT SCOOP'S PRESS CONFERENCE TO BRIEF REPORTERS ON HIS MAO-IST CONNECTIONS, JACKSON WALKED OFF THE PODIUM MUTTERING, "NO ONE READS YOUR NEWSPAPER."

NEW MOUNTAIN LAKES TRIAL TO BEGIN

JUNE 23 (IPS)--FRESH FROM VICTORY IN NEWARK, NATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITTEES LEADERS COSTAS AXLOS, ELIJAH BOYD, AND DAN WASSERMAN NOW FACE RE-TRIAL IN MORRIS COUNTY, N.J. A MAY 1975 TRIAL ON LEAA-DIRECTED FRAME-UP CHARGES RESULTED IN A HUNG JURY AND A MISTRIAL. CHARGES AGAINST THE THREE RESULT FROM THE PLANTING OF WEAPONS IN A BORROWED CAR THE DEFENDANTS WERE DRIVING IN DECEMBER 1973, WHICH WERE THEN "DISCOVERED" BY AN LEAA-FBI CO-ORDINATED POLICE "DRAGNET OPERATION."

THE TRIAL MILL BEGIN ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 25. IN SUBURBAN MORRIS COUNTY, AN LEAA-CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENT. ALTHOUGH THE MORRIS COUNTY JURY IN THE FIRST TRIAL WAS PREDOMINENTLY MIDDLE-CLASS, THEY COULD NOT SWALLOW THE PROSECUTION'S CASE AND WERE UNABLE TO ARRIVE AT A VERDICT. THIS TIME THE DEFENSE TEAM INTENDS TO WIN A FULL ACQUITTAL.

COURT REPORTERS THREATENED BY LABOR PARTY IMPERSONATOR

NEWARK, JUNE 23 (IPS)—ACCORDING TO A REPORTER FROM A SMALL NEW JERSEY NEWSPAPER, SEVERAL REPORTERS WERE THREATENED IN THE NEWARK SUPERIOR COURT HOUSE LAST WEEK BY A WHITE MALE CLAIMING TO BE FROM THE "SOCIALIST LABOR PARTY." THE THREATS NECESSITATED THE PHYSICAL REMOVAL OF THE ASSAILANT BY THE REPORTERS PRESENT. ACCORDING TO ONE REPORTER, THE MAN ENTERED THE COURT ROOM AND BEGAN REPEATING THAT "ROCKEFELLER CONTROLS THE PRESS" AND THAT THEY HAD

BETTER COVER THE "NEWARK TRIAL."

THE ASSAILANT WAS DESCRIBED AS 5/8", ABOUT 100 POUNDS WITH DARK, CLOSE-CROPPED HAIR. HE WAS WEARING A JACKET AND TIE. FOLLOWING A BRIEFING ON THE "ALL STOPS OUT" HARASSMENT CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE LABOR PARTY, THE REPORTER THAT FIRST INFORMED THE LABOR PARTY HAS HAS AGREED NOW TO FILE AN AFFADAVIT ON THE INCIDENT, AND MEET WITH BONA FIDE LABOR PARTY SPOKESMEN.
