SOVIET SCIENTISTS ANNOUNCE NEW APPROACH TO LASER FUSION

JULY 22 (IPS) — DR. Y. V. AFANAS'EV, AND DR. N.G. BASOV OF THE USSR'S LEBEDEV LASER FUSION GROUP, ANNOUNCED A REVOLUTIONARY NEW APPROACH TO LASER FUSION. IF SUCCESSFULLY DEMONSTRATED EARLY NEXT YEAR WHEN THE HIGH ENERGY LASER FACILITIES AT THE LEBEDEV INSTITUTE BECOME OPERATIONAL, THIS NEW APPROACH WOULD MEAN THAT LASER FUSION PROTOTYPE POWER PLANTS COULD BE CONSTRUCTED IN THE LATE 1970S.

IN BASIC TERMS, THE NEW APPROACH IS EXPECTED TO ACHIEVE HIGHER ENERGY GAINS THAN WHAT HAD BEEN PREVIOUSLY PROJECTED. (ENERGY GAINS IS THE RATIO OF THE AMOUNT OF FUSION ENERGY PRODUCED VERSUS THE AMOUNT OF LASER ENERGY USED TO IGNITE THE FUSION REACTION.) AFANAS'EV AND BASOV PROPOSE USING RELATIVELY LARGE, THIN SHELLED, HOLLOW, LAYERED PELLETS, 1 CENTIMETER IN RADIUS. THEY CALCULATE THAT THIS WOULD GIVE ENERGY GAINS UP TO 1000 AT LEAST 10 TIMES GREATER THAN WHAT U.S. SCIENTISTS HAVE PROJECTED WITH THEIR PELLET DESIGNS. THE LONG PULSE DURATION OF 100 BILLIONTHS OF A SECOND USED WITH THIS NEW APPROACH WOULD MEAN THAT EXISTING CARBON DIOXIDE GAS LASER TECHNOLOGY COULD BE USED IN ACTUAL POWER PLANTS. MORE DETAILS WILL BE GIVEN IN A FUTURE ISSUE OF NEW SOLIDARITY.

THE BREAKTHROUGH WAS REPORTED IN THE JANUARY 20 ISSUE OF THE SOVIET JETP LETTERS PHYSICS JOURNAL WHICH HAS RECENTLY REACHED THE U.S.

SOVIET SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE ENDS WITH APPEAL FOR DEVELOPMENT

JULY 22 (IPS) — THE LARGEST INTERNATIONAL GATHERING OF SCIENTISTS EVER ASSEMBLED TO DISCUSS DISARMAMENT CONCLUDED A FIVE-DAY SYMPOSIUM IN MOSCOW ON JULY 19 BY ISSUING AN APPEAL TO SCIENTISTS WORLDWIDE TO MOBILIZE FOR ARMS REDUCTIONS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

OVER 400 SCIENTISTS FROM 62 COUNTRIES DRAFTED A PROGRAM THAT INCLUDES SUPPORT OF THE UN RESOLUTION FOR A 10% REDUCTION IN ARMS EXPENDITURES AND THE CONVENING OF INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES TO SPECIFY CONCRETE STEPS FOR DISARMAMENT AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN THE THIRD WORLD.

DR. MORRIS LEVITT OF THE U.S. LABOR PARTY RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT STAFF REPRESENTED THE FUSION ENERGY FOUNDATION AT THE SYMPOSIUM ON THE SCIENTISTS' ROLE IN THE STRUGGLE FOR DISARMAMENT WHICH WAS ORGANIZED BY THE WORLD FEDERATION OF SCIENTIFIC WORKERS AND HOSTED BY THE SOVIET CENTRAL COUNCIL OF TRADE UNIONS.

SOVIETS CALL FOR THREE-WAY THIRD WORLD DEVELOPMENT

JULY 22 (IPS) — A COMMENTARY IN THE SOVIET NEWSPAPER PRAVDA HAS CALLED FOR THREE-WAY COOPERATION BETWEEN THE ARAB STATES, AFRICA AND THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES IN DEVELOPING AFRICAN AGRICULTURE AND INDUSTRY. THE JULY 20 ARTICLE BY YURI TSAPLIN DESCRIBES THE VAST POTENTIAL OF THE AFRICAN CONTINENT, WHICH THROUGH ARAB INVESTMENT COULD BE MADE TO FLOURISH. TO ENSURE SUFFICIENT CAPITAL INPUTS FOR INDUSTRIAL PROJECTS, TSAPLIN STATES, A COMMON DEVELOPMENT PLAN MUST BE WORKED OUT. "MANY OBSERVERS IN AFRICA AND THE MIDEAST EXPRESS THE OPINION THAT SUCH PROJECTS COULD BE LINKED WITH PROGRAMS OF ECONOMIC COOPERATION WHICH ARE ALREADY BEING CARRIED OUT IN VARIOUS STATES OF THE REGION BY THE SOVIET UNION AND OTHER COUNTRIES OF THE SOCIALIST COMMUNITY."

PRAVDA STATES THAT THE RECENTLY-CONCLUDED MEETING OF THE JOINT MINISTERIAL COMMITTEE OF THE LEAGUE OF ARAB STATES AND THE ORGANIZATION OF AFRICAN UNITY IN CAIRO TOOK THE FIRST STEP TOWARD ACHIEVING THESE OBJECTIVES. "NOW IT IS TIME TO MOVE TO CONCRETE ACTIONS."

PCP CALLS ON PSP BASE TO JOIN IN BUILDING SOCIALIST PORTUGAL

JULY 22 (IPS) — A PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) COMMUNIQUE REPRINTED IN TODAY'S L'HUMANITE STATES THAT "THE PEOPLE HAVE THWARTED THE MARCH ON LISBON...(BUT) THE FAILURE OF THE LISBON MARCH DOES NOT END THE ATTEMPTS FOR A RIGHT WING ALTERNATIVE. REACTION CONTINUES ITS SCHEMING INSIDE AND OUTSIDE (OF THE COUNTRY)."

THE PCP CALLS FOR UNITED ACTION "TO CARRY OUT THE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC TRANSFORMATIONS ALLOWING PORTUGAL TO GO TOWARDS SOCIALISM" AND APPEALS TO THE BASE OF THE PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST PARTY (PSP) TO ASSIST IT IN CONSOLIDATING "THE FINAL VICTORY OF THE REVOLUTION." RATIONING OF WATER IN EFFECT THROUGHOUT ITALY

JULY 22 (IPS) — THE DEVASTATING EFFECTS OF THE MUNICIPAL DEBT CRISIS HAVE BEEN EXACERBATED BY DRY SUMMER WEATHER, CAUSING RATIONING OF WATER THROUGHOUT ITALY. TODAY UNITA, DAILY NEWSPAPER OF THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY, REPORTED THAT PROTESTS ARE BEING LED IN PUGLIA AND NAPLES AGAINST THE DRASTIC CUTS OF WATER CONSUMPTION IN THESE MAJOR CITIES. RESIDENTS OF PUGLIA RECEIVE WATER ONE HOUR A DAY; WHILE IN NAPLES, ALREADY CHARACTERIZED AS A "DUNG PIT" BY THE MAJOR PRESS, WATER IS AVAILABLE FOR SHORT PERIODS ONCE EVERY SEVERAL DAYS.

PCI LEADER SAYS PARTY WILL OPEN CZECH QUESTION; ATTACKS CPUSA

ROME, JULY 22 (IPS) — ALFREDO REICHLIN, DIRECTOR OF THE WEEKLY MAGAZINE RINASCITA OF THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (PCI) AND A MEMBER OF THE PARTY NATIONAL DIRECTION, SAID IN A TELEPHONE INTERVIEW HERE YESTERDAY THAT THE PCI WILL "PROBABLY" RAISE THE QUESTION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AT THE BERLIN CONFERENCE OF EUROPEAN COMMUNIST PARTIES. "WE ATTACK RUSSIA BECAUSE THE SOVIETS MOVED TANKS INTO PRAGUE," REICHLIN STATED. HE ALSO ADDED THAT THE PCI WOULD REFUSE TO SIGN A MAJORITY DOCUMENT WHICH CONDEMNED THE SECOND INTERNATIONAL-BACKED CAMPAIGN TO RE-OPEN THE "CZECH QUESTION."

REICHLIN, WHO SEVERAL WEEKS AGO, TOLD A ROME COMMUNIST AUDIENCE THAT THE PCI INTENDS TO BRING OUT A "NEW INTERNATIONAL POLICY LINE," ATTACKED THE COMMUNIST PARTY USA AS A "SENILE BUNCH OF SECTARIANS" FOR TAKING ISSUE WITH THE PCI OVER THEIR BETRAYAL OF THE PORTUGUESE REVOLUTION.

COLT INDUSTRIES SUPPLIED LEBANESE PHALANGISTS

JULY 22 (IPS) — A DOCUMENT RECENTLY SUBMITTED TO CONGRESS INDICATES THAT IN EARLY MAY, THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT LICENSED HARTFORD-BASED COLT INDUSTRIES, INC., TO SELL AN ESTIMATED \$163,680 WORTH OF REVOLVERS, PISTOLS, AND AMMUNITION TO "RESPONSIBLE CHRISTIAN ELEMENTS" IN LEBANON, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S BALTIMORE SUN. THE DEAL OCCURRED JUST PRIOR TO A ROUND OF ATTACKS BY RIGHT-WING CHRISTIAN PHALANGISTS ON LEBANESE LEFTISTS.

THE SUN FURTHER REPORTS THAT THE U.S. EMBASSY IN BEIRUT HAD APPROVED THE SALE OF GUNS BY ARMS DEALER SARKIS SOGHANALIAN. THE STATE DEPARTMENT TODAY TOLD IPS THAT SOGHANALIAN IS AN AGENT OF COLT WHO OFTEN SHUTTLES BETWEEN THE U.S. AND LEBANON.

EARLIER THIS MONTH, COLT DENIED ACCOUNTS OF GUN SHIPMENTS TO LEBANON REVEALED IN THE HARTFORD COURANT AND ON A HARTFORD RADIO STATION, WTIC. REPRESENTATIVES OF COLT INDUSTRIES TESTIFIED BEFORE THE HOUSE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE ON THURSDAY REGARDING COLT'S INVOLVEMENT IN ILLEGAL GUN SALES.

MPLA HEGEMONIC IN ANGOLA

JULY 22 (IPS) — IN ANGOLA, THE POPULAR MOVEMENT (MPLA) IS ACCEPTED AS THE LEADING POLITICAL FORCE, ACCORDING TO HESSEN RADIO (HESSISCHE RUNDfunk) IN WEST GERMANY, THIS MORNING. ACCORDING TO THE BROADCAST, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE RULING MFA IN PORTUGAL SAID THAT THE PORTUGUESE ARMY WOULD INTERVENE IN FAVOR OF MPLA IF THE CIA'S NATIONAL FRONT (FNLA) ATTEMPTED AN ASSAULT ON LUANDA.

ENEMIES OF ZAIRE'S CIA PRESIDENT "RESPONDING" TO PRO-COMMUNIST VICTORY IN ANGOLA

JULY 22 (IPS) — ACCORDING TO THE JULY 14 GUARDIAN, A BRITISH WEEKLY, "NEWS REACHING ANGOLA SUGGESTS THAT PRESIDENT MOBUTU (OF NEIGHBORING ZAIRE)...IS IN A FAR WEAKER POSITION THAN IS NORMALLY ASSUMED. HIS ENEMIES HAVE BEEN FOLLOWING EVENTS IN ANGOLA AND LARGE SECTIONS ARE RESPONDING TO THE IDEOLOGICAL TRENDS IN ANGOLAN POLITICS."

ZAIRE WAS REGARDED BY THE CIA AS ONE OF ITS FIRM BASES IN AFRICA UNTIL ITS RECENT ECONOMIC COLLAPSE.

INDIRA GANDHI BRINGS EMERGENCY RESOLUTION TO PARLIAMENT

NEW YORK, JULY 22 (IPS) — INDIAN FOOD AND AGRICULTURE MINISTER JAGJIVAN RAM PRESENTED PRIME MINISTER INDIRA GANDHI'S RULING CONGRESS PARTY EMERGENCY DECREE FOR PARLIAMENTARY RATIFICATION AND EXTENSION TODAY, ACCORDING TO UPI REPORTS THIS MORNING.

RAM THUS INITIATED MOTIONS WITHIN THE LOK SABHA (LOWER HOUSE) WHILE THE UPPER HOUSE PASSED THE SAME RESOLUTION BY A VOTE OF 136-33. THE UPPER HOUSE VOTE CAUSED THE OPPOSITION LEADERS WITHIN THE PARLIAMENT TO WALK OUT IN PROTEST.

THE LOK SABHA VOTE ON THE EMERGENCY DECREE IS EXPECTED TOMORROW.

GANDHI ATTACKS WESTERN PRESS

JULY 22 (IPS) — SPEAKING AT A MEETING OF STATE LABOR MINISTERS, INDIAN PRIME MINISTER GANDHI STRONGLY CRITICIZED THE REPORTING BY THE WESTERN PRESS OF THE SITUATION IN INDIA. ACCORDING TO THE LONDON TIMES, MRS. GANDHI IRONICALLY REMARKED: "THOSE WHO SWEAR BY DEMOCRACY NOW WOULD HAVE BEEN THE FIRST, IF THERE HAD BEEN CHAOS, TO SAY: 'SEE, WE ALWAYS SAID THAT DEMOCRACY COULD NOT WORK IN A POOR ILLITERATE COUNTRY LIKE INDIA'". MONSOON FLOODS HIT INDIA, PAKISTAN, BANGLADESH

JULY 22 (IPS) — AT LEAST 300 PEOPLE HAVE DIED AND 1.5 MILLION LEFT HOMELESS AS THE MONSOON RAINS HAVE BROUGHT FLOODS TO INDIA, BANGLADESH AND PAKISTAN. THE ANNUAL RAINS HAVE CAUSED MORE THAN HALF A MILLION HOMELESS IN PAKISTAN ALONE OVER THE PAST FEW DAYS. THE FLOODS COVERED A 1,737 SQUARE MILE AREA IN THE PUNJAB REGION OF PAKISTAN, REPORTS TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST.

OPEC-THIRD WORLD MOVE ONE STEP CLOSER TO IDB:
SET UP \$6B COMMODITIES FUND

UNITED NATIONS, NEW YORK, JULY 22 (IPS) — A GROUP OF OPEC AND NON-OPEC DEVELOPING COUNTRIES MEETING IN GENEVA THIS WEEK UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE COMMODITIES COMMITTEE OF UNCTAD (UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCE ON TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT) HAVE AGREED TO SET-UP A \$6 BILLION FUND TO SUPPORT THIRD WORLD RAW MATERIAL PRICES, A UNITED NATIONS SPOKESMAN CONFIRMED HERE TODAY.

THIS COMMODITIES FUND, A RESULT OF COOPERATION BETWEEN UNCTAD, OPEC AND THE REST OF THE THIRD WORLD, REPRESENTS A MAJOR STEP FORWARD FOR THE COALESCING OF A PRO-DEVELOPMENT BLOC AND A CRITICAL SETBACK FOR KISSINGER-LED ATTEMPTS TO SABOTAGE SUCH A FORMATION VIA HIS "CASE-BY-CASE" APPROACH ON COMMODITIES.

THE UNCTAD GROUP IS PREPARING FINALIZED PROPOSALS FOR THE 76-NATION SUMMIT MEETING OF NON-ALIGNED COUNTRIES IN LIMA AT THE END OF AUGUST.

SPD TO RELEASE REPORT ON SERVICE CUTS IN WEST GERMANY

WIESBADEN, BRD, JULY 22 (IPS) — THE WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY, HAS AUTHORIZED AN ITEMIZED REPORT ON LARGE CUTBACKS IN SOCIAL SERVICES, ACCORDING TO THIS WEEK'S ISSUE OF DER SPIEGEL, THE GERMAN LANGUAGE EQUIVALENT OF TIME. THE SPD AUSTERITY REPORT ALSO CLASSIFIES ALL WEST GERMAN HEALTH, EDUCATION AND WELFARE SERVICES INTO A THREE-LEVEL TRIAGE SYSTEM. SOCIAL SERVICES WILL BE CLASSIFIED AS DEFINITELY TO BE CUT, POSSIBLY TO BE CUT, AND DIFFICULT TO CUT.

AFL-CIO SPOKESMAN SEES POSSIBLE NATO INTERVENTION IN PORTUGAL

WASHINGTON, D.C., JULY 22 (IPS) — ERNEST LEE, HEAD OF THE WASHINGTON, D.C.-BASED INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS DIVISION OF THE AFL-CIO, TOLD A REPORTER YESTERDAY THAT HE THINKS THAT NATO SHOULD CONSIDER AN INTERVENTION INTO PORTUGAL SINCE THAT COUNTRY IS A NATO

MEMBER AND IS PRESENTLY BEING SUBVERTED BY MOSCOW."

LEE ALSO SAID THAT "IT'S DESPICABLE THAT THE EUROPEAN SOCIALIST PARTIES HAVE NOT PROVIDED SUFFICIENT FUNDS TO MARIO SOARES AND THE OTHER DEMOCRATIC FORCES" SO THAT THE PCP AND THE MFA COULD BE STOPPED. HE INDICATED THAT THE AFL-CIO WOULD UNDOUBTEDLY DISCUSS THE PORTUGUESE SITUATION AT ITS COUNCIL MEETING THIS WEEK. HE EMPHASIZED THAT THE AFL-CIO IN THE U.S. AND ITS ALLIED TRADE UNIONS IN EUROPE WERE CONCERNED ABOUT PCP DOMINATION OF THE PORTUGUESE TRADE UNION MOVEMENT. "HOW WILL WE GET FUNDS INTO THE HANDS OF THE RIGHT PEOPLE?" HE SAID.

ERNEST LEE IS A FORMER MARINE OFFICER AND THE SON-IN-LAW OF GEORGE MEANY, INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENT OF THE AFL-CIO.

WOODCOCK BACKS SOARES AND PORTUGUESE COUNTERREVOLUTION

DETROIT, JULY 22 (IPS) — LEONARD WOODCOCK, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED AUTOMOBILE WORKERS (UAW), YESTERDAY STATED THAT HE "FULLY SUPPORTS MARIO SOARES AND THE PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST PARTY." WOODCOCK TOLD A REPORTER YESTERDAY THAT HE WAS PERSONALLY INVITED TO THE RECENT GATHERING OF SECOND INTERNATIONAL LEADERS IN LISBON BUT WAS UNABLE TO ATTEND. WHEN ASKED WHETHER THE UAW SENT SOME OTHER REPRESENTATIVE TO LISBON, WOODCOCK REPLIED: "THIS WAS A MEETING ONLY FOR INTELLECTUALS AND NOT OF ORGANIZATIONS."

WOODCOCK SAID THAT HE STRONGLY DISAGREED WITH STATEMENTS MADE THE DAY BEFORE BY ERNEST LEE, HEAD OF THE AFL-CIO INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS DIVISION AND SON-IN-LAW OF GEORGE MEANY. WOODCOCK DENIED THAT THE EUROPEAN SOCIALIST PARTIES HAD BEEN NEGLIGENT IN THEIR SUPPORT FOR THE PSP: "IT'S SIMPLY NOT TRUE. THE NEATHERLAND SOCIALISTS HAVE RAISED TENS OF THOUSANDS OF DOLLARS FOR THE PSP. THE SWEDISH AND WEST GERMAN SOCIALIST PARTIES HAVE ALSO SUPPLIED AMPLE FUNDS INTO PORTUGAL. AND FRENCH SOCIALIST LEADER MITTERRAND MADE A PERSONAL VISIT TO PORTUGAL THAT WAS VERY IMPORTANT."

WOODCOCK ALSO DISAGREED WITH MR. LEE'S SUGGESTION THAT NATO CONSIDER AN INTERVENTION INTO PORTUGAL TO BACK UP THE PSP. "THAT WOULD BE EXTREMELY DANGEROUS," HE SAID. "THAT WOULD PROVOKE OTHER DICTATORSHIPS OF THE LEFT THROUGHOUT EUROPE. I DON'T THINK THAT THE NATO COUNTRIES WOULD CONSIDER IT. WHEN FORD TRIED A HARD LINE AT THE RECENT NATO MEETING, HE WAS MET WITH A CHILLY RESPONSE BY THE EUROPEANS. IT JUST WON'T WORK."

RESEARCHER, GAVE SENATE TESTIMONY YESTERDAY ATTACKING SENATOR HENRY JACKSON'S PROPOSAL TO CREATE A CORPORATIVIST NATIONAL ENERGY PRODUCTION BOARD, EXPLICITLY LABELLING THE PROPOSAL AS FASCIST. STAUFFER SAID THAT THE "LOGIC" BEHIND THE FASCIST PROPOSAL, WHICH HE SAID WOULD PLACE "DICTATORIAL POWERS" ON ENERGY MATTERS ON A CORPORATIVIST PLANNING BODY, WAS COMPARABLE TO THAT "USED BY MUSSOLINI WHEN HE TRIED TO GET THE TRAINS TO RUN ON TIME."

FBI MONITORS COMMERCIAL CABLE TRAFFIC INTERNATIONALLY

THE SUN ALSO REFERENCES A NEW YORK DAILY NEWS REPORT WHICH ALLEGES THAT THIS FBI-NSA ACTIVITY, WHICH IS IN POSSIBLE VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW, WAS CARRIED ON WITH THE TACIT APPROVAL OF PERSONNEL AT THE CABLE COMPANIES INVOLVED.

FEDERAL GANG WAR ERUPTS! FBI BOMBS ATF OFFICE IN SAN FRANCISCO

JULY 22 (IPS) — TWO HOMEMADE BOMBS SHATTERED THE SAN FRANCISCO OFFICES OF THE U.S. TREASURY DEPARTMENT'S ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, AND FIREARMS DIVISION (ATF) LAST NIGHT, REPORTED THE SAN FRANCISCO CHRONICLE TODAY. LABOR PARTY STOPS RACE-RIOT IN NEW JERSEY

EAST ORANGE, NEW JERSEY, JULY 22 (IPS) — LAST NIGHT, THE LABOR PARTY STOPPED A LOCAL RACE-RIOT SCENARIO ENGINEERED BY FBI AND LEAA AGENTS IN COOPERATION WITH EAST ORANGE MAYOR WILLIE THOMAS. LABOR PARTY SPOKESMAN AT THE COUNCIL MEETING, DENNIS SPEED, BRIEFED THE COUNCIL ON THE RACE RIOT PLANS OF THE FBI. AS THE CROWD WAS DRIVEN TO THE POLICE STATION BY THE LOCAL AGENTS, LABOR PARTY REPRESENTATIVES BRIEFED ALL MEDIA OUTLETS IN THE AREA AS WELL
