CORNERED SADAT RAVES ABOUT WAR

JULY 27 (1PS)—EGYPTIAN PRESIDENT ANOUAR SADAT HAS CALLED THE EGYPTIAN ARMY TO BE ON FULL ALERT, HE ANNOUNCED AT A PRESS CONFERENCE THIS MORNING IN KHARTOUM. HE ADDED THAT DIPLOMATIC ATTEMPTS NOW ARE OF NO VALUE, AND THAT EGYPT IS PREPARED FOR WAR, REPORTS RADIO SWEDEN DAGERS EKO THIS MORNING.

IRAQ SUPPORTS CSCE CONFERENCE

JULY 27 (IPS) -- THE IRAQI GOVERNMENT IS LOOKING FORMARD TO A RAPID CONVENING OF THE THIRD PHASE OF THE EUROPEAN SECURITY AND COOP-ERATION COUNCIL AT HELSINKI, ACCORDING TO AN EDITORIAL IN THE JULY 20 ISSUE OF ATH-THAWRA, DAILY OF THE IRAQI ARAB BAATH SOCIALIST PARTY. THE EDITORIAL SUPPORTED THE EFFORTS OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES TO REALIZE "TRUE CONSTRUCTIVE DETENTE WHICH WILL BRING GOOD TO EUROPE AND THE WHOLE WORLD," AND DENOUNCED ATTEMPTS TO LINK THE CONFERENCE WITH THE ISSUE OF ARAB GULF SECURITY AS A "TACTIC TO SPLIT THE SERIOUS EFFORTS" OF THE CONFERENCE.

PORTUGUESE TROOPS DEFENDING LUANDA

JULY 27 (1P5)—THE 30,000 PORTUGUESE TROOPS STATIONED IN ANGOLA RECEIVED DEFINITE ORDERS LAST WEEK TO JOIN THE PRO-SOVIET POPULAR MOVEMENT FOR THE LIBERATION OF ANGOLA (MPLA) IN DEFENSE OF LUANDA IF NECESSARY. NATIONAL LIBERATION FRONT (FNLA) TROOPS WERE RE-PORTED LAST WEEK TO BE MARCHING ON THE CAPITAL CITY.

THE POST REPORTS THAT THE FNLA TROOPS ARE LED BY A ROBERTO. BROTHER-IN-LAW OF CIA-BACKED JOSEPH MOBUTU. THE PRESIDENT OF ZAIRE. THE FNLA HAS RECEIVED CONSIDERABLE BACKING FROM MOBUTU'S MILITARY FORCES SAYS THE POST.

TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES REPORTS TODAY THAT THE PORTUGUESE GOVERNMENT HAS TERMINATED ITS COMMITTMENT TO THE MPLA AND REVERSED THE SUPPORT ORDER PREVIOUSLY GIVEN TO TROOPS. AP AND UPI REPORTS CONCUR WITH THE WASHINGTON POST, WHICH REPORTS THAT CONTINUED MILITARY SUPPORT OF THE MPLA WAS THE MAJOR TOPIC OF DISCUSSION AT LAST WEEK'S ARMED FORCES MOVEMENT (MFA) CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY MEETING.

I.G. METALL SAYS FOP PROPOSAL REMINISCENT OF THIRD REICH

JULY 27 (IPS)—THE WEST GERMAN AUTO AND METAL WORKERS UNION, I.G. METALL, YESTERDAY DENOUNCED FREE DEMOCRATIC PARTY SPOKESMAN MARTIN BANGMANN'S DEMAND FOR A GENERAL WAGE FREEZE IN WEST GERMANY. ACCORDING TO THE WEST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY NEWSPAPER UNSERER ZEIT YESTERDAY, THE NATIONAL UNION DECLARED THAT BANGMANN'S DEMAND "REMINDS US OF THE THIRD REICH," AND OVERSTEPS THE LIMITS OF RESPONSIBLE POLICY.

COLT GUNS IN HANDS OF BLACK SEPTEMBER TERRORISTS?

JULY 27 (IPS)—SARKIS G. SOCHANALIAN, THE MERCHANT WHO HAD CONTRACTED FOR THE ARMS SALES INTO LEBANON, SUGGESTED AT A MORNING PRESS GATHERING IN BEIRUT FRIDAY THAT THE RECENT ARMS SHIPMENTS EARMARKED FOR LEBANON WERE REPOUTED AND ARE NOW SOMEWHERE IN EUROPE. THE WEAPONS DISPATCHED FROM THE COLT INDUSTRIES PLANT IN HARTFORD, CONN. FAILED TO ARRIVE IN LEBANON AFTER THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL (NSC) AND THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT CANCELLED SOCHANALIAN'S EXPORT LICENSE.

IN LIGHT OF THE RECENT REVELATIONS OF NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL CONNECTIONS TO THE BLACK SEPTEMBER ORGANIZATION. THERE IS RISING SPECULATION THAT THE WEAPONS HAVE BEEN RE-ROUTED TO EUROPEAN BLACK SEPTEMBER OPERATIVES ON ORDERS OF THE NSC. THE STATE DEPARTMENT ORIGINALLY APPROVED THE SALE OF COLT WEAPONS TO "RE-TAIL MERCHANTS" IN LEBANON AT THE HEIGHT OF THE LEBANESE CIVIL WAR.

U.S. BOURGEOIS PRESS JITTERY ON CSCE

JULY 27 (IPS)—THE LEAD EDITORIAL IN TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES CALLS THE HELSINKI SUMMIT OF THE CONFERENCE ON SECURITY AND COOPERATION IN EUROPE (CSCE) MERELY "SYMBOLIC." FEIGNING OBLIVION TO THE SOVIET BLOC'S ECONOMIC AND DIPLOMATIC STRENGTH BASED ON ITS WORLD TRADE PROPOSALS. THE TIMES EXPLAINS THAT THE PRESIDENT'S MISSION TO POLAND. RUMANIA, AND YUGOSLAVIA. AFTER HELSINKI. SHOULD STRIVE TO ENCOURAGE THESE COUNTRIES TO BREAK AWAY FROM MOSCOW.

THE BALTIMORE SUN ALSO LAMELY RECOMMENDS THAT PRESIDENT FORD CRACK DOWN ON "SOVIET HEGEMONY" OVER EASTERN EUROPE.

PEKING PRO-NUCLEAR WAR, NOTES IZVESTIA

JULY 27 (IPS)—THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT NEWSPAPER IZVESTIA REMARKED JULY 23 ON CHINESE DEPUTY PREMIER TENG HSAID PING'S RECENT REPETITION TO JAPANESE JOURNALISTS OF THE "WORN-OUT RECORD" OF MADIST ANTI-SOVIETISM. IZVESTIA EMPHASIZED THAT TENG ADDED THE "WELL-KNOWN PEARL FROM THE QUOTATIONS OF MAO" ON NUCLEAR WAR. THAT "IF HALF OF HUMANITY WERE DESTROYED. THE OTHER HALF WOULD REMAIN AND IMPERIALISM WOULD BE FULLY DEMOLISHED."

MADIST GANG IN SPAIN INCREASES ITS TERRORIST ACTIVITIES

JULY 27 (IPS)—THE MADIST ANTI-FASCIST REVOLUTIONARY FRONT (FRAP) HAS RECENTLY EXPANDED ITS TERRORIST ACTIVITIES THROUGHOUT SPAIN.
REPORTS THE JULY 22 LONDON TIMES. LAST WEEK, A FRAP BOMBING IN MADRID KILLED A POLICEMAN AND WOUNDED ANOTHER. ANOTHER FIRE-BOMBING TARGETED A POLICE STATION LAST FRIDAY. THE DAY BEFORE YESTERDAY, THE GROUP BOMBED FRANCO'S HEADQUARTERS IN VALENCIA.
FRAP HAS MADE IT KNOWN THAT IT INTENDS TO EXPAND ITS "VIOLENT ACTIVITIES AGAINST FASCISM." - ACTIVITIES SIMILAR TO TYPICAL CIA COUNTERGANG SET-UPS WHICH CREATE A POLICE BACKLASH OR SEARCH-AND-SEAL OPERATIONS.

FREAK FROST WAVE EXTENSIVELY DANAGES AGRO-PRODUCTION IN BRAZIL

JULY 27 (1PS)—THE BRAZILIAN COFFEE INSTITUTE REPORTED THIS WEEK THAT A FULL 70 PER CENT OF ALL COFFEE TREES IN THE COUNTRY HAVE BEEN DESTROYED TO THE ROOTS BY A FREAK FROST THAT IS SWEEPING THROUGH THE SOUTHERN AGRICULTURAL BELT. THE FROST WAVE WILL NOT EFFECT THIS YEAR'S CROPS WHICH HAVE ALREADY BEEN HARVESTED. HOWEVER NEXT YEARS HARVEST WILL BE REDUCED BY AN EXPECTED 50 PER CENT.

OTHER CROPS HAVE BEEN SERIOUSLY DAMAGED BY THE FROST AS WELL AS EXTENSIVE PASTURE LANDS, IMMEDIATELY THREATENING SIX WILLION HEAD OF CATTLE IN THE AGRICULTURAL STATE OF PARANA.

CIA URGANIZES FASCIST GANGS IN THAILAND

JULY 27 (IPS)—THAT MILITARY OFFICERS, TRAINED BY THE CIA IN COUNTERINSURGENCY AND INTELLIGENCE OPERATIONS, ARE ORGANIZING A NETWORK OF PARAMILITARY FASCIST ORGANIZATIONS WHICH HAVE ENGAGED IN VIOLENT ATTACKS ON LEFT-WING STUDENTS AND STRIKING WORKERS. ONE GROUP, THE NAVAPOL, REPORTEDLY FUNDED BY CHINESE BUSINESSMEN, IS LED BY A GROUP OF RIGHTEST ARMY OFFICERS, INCLUDING GENERAL WALLOP ROJANANAMISUT, THE RECENTLY RETIRED HEAD OF THAI MILITARY INTELLIGENCE.

ACCORDING TO FAR EAST ECONOMIC REVIEW (THE JULY 25 ISSUE). THE GENERAL HAS A THEORY OF THAI SOCIETY RESTING ON TWO FOUNDATIONS - "THE TEMPLE AND THE PALACE." GENERAL WALLOP TOLD THE REVIEW: "I GOT THIS IDEA IN 1953 WHEN I WENT ABROAD FOR THE FIRST TIME FOR FURTHER STUDY IN PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE IN THE UNITED STATES."

CARRILLO ORGANIZATION FORMED IN TOILET

JULY 27 (IPS)—A TWO PAGE FEATURE IN TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST RE-VEALS THAT THE WORKERS' COMMISSIONS IN SPAIN WERE "FOUNDED IN 1958 AT A SECRET MEETING OF A PRIEST, A COMMUNIST MINER AND A MARXIST LAWYER IN A BATHROOM IN AN ASTURIAS MINING TOWN." THE POST CLAIMS THAT SANTIAGO CARILLO'S DEMOCRATIC JUNTA HAS HAD DEEP PENETRATION INTO THE WORKERS COMMISSIONS EVER SINCE.

THE WOODCOCK LETTERS

MEN YORK, JULY 27 (IPS)—IPS HAS JUST OBTAINED COPIES OF LETTERS WRITTEN BY LEONARD WOODCOCK OF THE UNITED AUTOMOBILE NORKERS (UAN) WHICH CONFIRM AN IPS REPORT OF THO DAYS AGO THAT WOODCOCK IS INVOLVED IN USING UNION FUNDS TO HELP FINANCE THE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST PARTY (PSP).

THE DOCUMENTS, WHICH WILL BE PUBLICLY EXPOSED IN THE NEXT ISSUE OF NEW SOLIDARITY, INCLUDE A JUNE 26 LETTER BY WOODCOCK TO A MR. MATEUS IN LISBON EXPRESSING REGRETS THAT HE COULD NOT ATTEND THE RECENT GATHERING OF SECOND INTERNATIONAL AND CIA AGENTS IN THAT CITY! A LETTER WRITTEN BY WOODCOCK LAST OCTOBER 2! TO PRESIDENT FORD, WITH COPIES TO MARIO SOARES AND HENRY KISSINGER. CALLING ON FORD "TO EXTEND MAXIMUM MATERIAL ASSISTENCE, AT THE EARLIEST DATE, TO PORTUGAL" TO STOP "DICTATORSHIPS OF THE RIGHT AND OF THE LEFT"! AND A RESOLUTION BY THE UAW EXECUTIVE ON FEB. 18, DE-NOUNCING DEMONSTRATIONS BY THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) AS AIMED AGAINST "FREEDOM OF ASSEMBLY AND OF SPEECH."

MODDCOCK'S LETTER TO THE PSP APOLOGIZING FOR NOT ATTENDING THE LISBON CONFERENCE SAYS IN PART: "THE UAW, ALONG WITH THE REST OF THE WORLD, FOLLOWS WITH TREMENDOUS INTEREST THE STORY OF YOUR UNFOLDING STRUGGLE FOR FREEDOM AND SOCIAL JUSTICE IN THE CONTEXT OF DEMOCRATIC SOCIALISM. IT IS, THEREFORE, ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY FOR ME TO STAY HERE, AT THE SIDE OF MY MEMBERS, TO CONTINUE TO PERFORM MY DUTIES AGAINST THE MOUNTING PRESSURE OF A DISTRESSED ECONOMY."

POLICE CHARGE ASSAILANT IN SAN FRANSISCO

SAN FRANSISCO, JULY 27 (IPS)—THE SAN FRANSISCO POLICE HAVE ARRESTED AND CHARGED JAMES KEYS IN THE PROVACATEUR-DISRUPTION OF A U.S. LABOR PARTY CAMPAIGN RALLY HERE YESTERDAY. KEYS. A SELF-ADMITTED METHADONE ADDICT. WAS CHARGED WITH TWO COUNTS OF FELO-NIOUS ASSAULT FOR HIS ATTACK OF A LABOR PARTY ORGANIZER AND A POLICEMAN. THE USLP WILL INVESTIGATE SAN FRANSISCO AREA METHADONE CENTERS TO ESTABLISH CIA CONNECTIONS TO THE ASSAULT.

SENATORS URGE SAFEGUAROS AGAINST NUCLEAR NEAPONS

JULY 27 (IPS)—SENATORS JOHN PASTORE (D-R.I.) AND MALTER MON-DALE (D-MINN.) INTRODUCED A RESOLUTION INTO THE SENATE YESTERDAY "URGING PRESIDENT FORD TO SEEK INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION IN STRENGTHENING THE SAFEGUARDS AGAINST THE USE OF NUCLEAR MEAPONS FOR NON-PEACEFUL PURPOSES." ACCORDING TO THE BALTIMORE SUN TODAY.

SENATORS CHARGE POST COLUMNISTS LIE

JULY 27 (IPS)—IN A LETTER TO THE WASHINGTON POST TODAY, JOHN CULVER (D-IOWA), PATRICK LEAHY (D-VT.), AND GARY HART (D-COLO.). ALL MEMBERS OF THE ARMED SERVICES COMMITTEE, CHARGED THAT EVANS AND NOVAK WASHINGTON POST COLUMNISTS MISREPRESENTED THEIR DISCUSSIONS WITH CERTAIN HIGH RUSSIAN OFFICIALS, CONCERNING ARMS RESTRAINT NEGOTIATIONS IN THE INDIAN OCEAN, IN THEIR JULY 21 COLUMN. THE SENATORS' LETTER STATES THAT THEIR WAS A CLEAR "INDICATION OF INTEREST" FROM THE SOVIETS WHILE EVANS AND NOVAK REPORTED THAT THE SENATORS MET ONLY "ICY INDIFFERENCE."

STATE DEPARTMENT CLASSIFIED CABLES, WHICH THE SENATORS INDI-CATE WERE ILLEGALLY LEAKED, WERE MISQUOTED IN THE COLUMN, THE SENATORS STATED.

USLP PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE LAROUCHE TOURS CHICAGO, DETROIT REGIONS

DETROIT, JULY 27 (IPS)—ADDRESSING AN AUDIENCE OF 175 WORKERS AND U.S. LABOR PARTY ORGANIZERS HERE, USLP PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE LYNDON H. LAROUCHE JR. STRESSED THAT HE WAS SPEAKING TO THE GROUP NOT AS "THE MASSES" BUT AS ORGANIZERS.

"HOW DOES A SMALL GROUP LIKE THE LABOR PARTY CHANGE THE WORLD BY THE FORCE OF ITS IDEAS," LAROUCHE ASKED. ORGANIZERS HAVE TO UNDERSTAND THE CONCEPTIONS NECESSARY TO CONVEY TO OTHERS THE METHOD THE ORGANIZATION USES TO EFFECT WORLD POLITICS, LAROUCHE SAID.

TODAY'S DETROIT CAMPAIGN RALLY WAS PRECEDED BY A TWO-DAY LAROUCHE TOUR THROUGH THE CHICAGO REGION. LAST NIGHT IN CHICAGO.

LAROUCHE ADDRESSED A RALLY OF 80 SEASONED ORGANIZERS. CORE LABOR
PARTY MEMBERS FROM THE REGION.

"WHEN WE GO INTO BATTLE, WE PICK A TARGET TO WIN." LAROUCHE SAID IN CHICAGO REFERRING TO THE LABOR PARTY LAUNCHING THIS WEEK OF A CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE KRESEGE-K MART CHAIN, KRESEGE HAS ILLEGALLY LOCKED OUT ORGANIZERS FROM SHOPPING CENTERS AROUND THE COUNTRY, "EACH BATTLE HAS TO PREPARE WORKERS FOR THE NEXT BAT-TLE,"

"OUR PROBLEM IS NOT NUMBERS OF PEOPLE WHO WIL VOTE FOR THE LABOR PARTY IN ANY HONEST ELECTION. BUT THERE IS NO SUCH THING AS AN HONEST ELECTION..." LAROUCHE CONTINUED. "WE HAVE TO HAVE THE MUSCLE TO WIN. WE HAVE TO HAVE THE FORCES BEHIND US WHO WILL SEE TO IT THAT WE BECOME THE GOVERNMENT. THEY LL TAKE CARE OF THE POLL WATCHING ONCE THEY WANT US IN POWER." LARQUCHE WINDS UP HIS MIDNEST TOUR TOMORROW IN FLINT, MICH. WHERE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBER OF THE LABOR ORGANIZERS DEFENSE FUND. ATTORNEY MAX DEAN, HAS ORGANIZED A \$15 A PLATE BENEFIT DINNER FOR THE CANDIDATE.

THE DETROIT AND CHICAGO USLP RALLIES WERE ATTENDED BY BROADLY REPRESENTATIVE AUDIENCES. FROM MAJOR PLANTS IN BOTH REGIONS.
