CSCE CONFERENCE

SOVIET BLOC LEADERS CALL FOR ECONOMIC COOPERATION

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—THE LEADERS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, HUNGARY AND POLAND SPOKE AT THE HELSINKI EUROPEAN SECURITY SUMMIT THURSDAY, REPORTS THE EAST GERMAN DAILY NEUES DEUTSCHLAND. EACH OF THEM EMPHASIZED THE PRESENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:

* GUSTAV HUSAK OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA: "MUTUALLY ADVANTAGEOUS ECONOMIC COOPERATION IS AN IMPORTANT STABILIZATION FACTOR....WE THINK THAT (THERE ARE)...INEXHAUSTIBLE NEW OPPORTUNITIES FOR SUCH COOPERATION."

* EDWARD GIEREK OF POLAND: "THE CONFERENCE RESOLUTIONS OF ECONOMIC RELATIONS REQUIRE THAT THE MATERIAL BASIS FOR PEACE BE EXPANDED: THE FREE DEVELOPMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRIAL, SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL COOPERATION."

* JANOS KADAR OF HUNGARY: "WE GREET THE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR COOPERATION IN SCIENCE, THE ECONOMY AND TRADE. (WE) ARE ALSO INTERESTED IN THE EXTENSION OF ECONOMIC COOPERATION INTERNATIONALLY IN THE FUTURE."

FINANCIAL TIMES PUSHES ECONOMIC ISSUES AT CSCE TALKS

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—REPORTING ON LIKELY PROGRESS IN EAST-WEST RELATIONS FOLLOWING THE HELSINKI SUMMIT, DAVID LASCELLES, EASTERN EUROPEAN CORRESPONDENT FOR THE LONDON FINANCIAL TIMES, STRESSES THE POSITIVE POTENTIAL OF THE CSCE AGREEMENTS ON ECONOMIC COOPERATION—VIRTUALLY IGNORED BY THE WESTERN PRESS. "COMECON HAS A GENUINE INTEREST IN COMMERCIAL EXCHANGES," LASCELLES CONCLUDES, "WHICH MAKES IT LESS LIKELY THAT IDEOLOGY OR POLITICS WILL INTERVENE."

NEW BEHAVIOR PATTERNS DUE FOR SOVIETS, SAYS FORD IN HELSINKI

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—IN HIS SPEECH TO THE FINAL HELSINKI SESSION, PRESIDENT FORD YESTERDAY WARNED THE SOVIETS THAT THE SUCCESS OF DETENTE DEPENDS ON "NEW BEHAVIOR PATTERNS" WHICH THE SOVIETS MUST ADOPT. FORD CALLED ON THE SOVIETS TO SUBMIT TO LIBERALIZATION AND DEMOCRATIC PLURALISM FOR THE SAKE OF HUMAN RIGHTS.

FORD ADDED THAT HE HAD COME TO HELSINKI "BECAUSE THE LEADERS OF 34 OTHER GOVERNMENTS ARE HERE," REPORTS TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST.

COSTA GOMES SPEAKS AT HELSINKI

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—PORTUGUESE PRESIDENT COSTA GOMES ASKED OTHER COUNTRIES NOT TO INTERFERE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF HIS COUNTRY DURING HIS ADDRESS AT THE EUROPEAN CONFERENCE ON SECURITY AND COOPERATION, REPORTS TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST. GOMES ALSO DECLARED THAT DECOLONIALIZATION IS A KEYSTONE OF PORTUGUESE POLICY. WHILE IN HELSINKI, GOMES MET WITH ERICH HONNECKER, HEAD OF THE SOCIAL UNION PARTY OF EAST GERMANY.

WASHINGTON POST REPORTS FORD, KISSINGER DISCOURAGED

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—IN ITS FRONT-PAGE COVERAGE OF THE HELSINKI SUMMIT, TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST EMPHASIZES SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER'S AND PRESIDENT FORD'S DISCOURAGEMENT OVER THE PRESENT COURSE OF U.S. FOREIGN POLICY. WRITING FROM FINLAND, POST CORRESPONDENT CARROLL KILPATRICK NOTES, "KISSINGER IS REPORTED TO BE DISCOURAGED ABOUT PROGRESS ON SALT II DISCUSSIONS AS WELL AS ABOUT THE OUTLOOK IN THE MIDDLE EAST....THROUGHOUT THE CONFERENCE THE PRESIDENT AND KISSINGER HAVE BEEN PREOCCUPIED WITH THEIR FAILURE TO PERSUADE CONGRESS TO LIFT THE TURKISH ARMS EMBARGO AND BY...COMMUNIST GAINS IN PORTUGAL."

WEST GERMAN CHANCELLOR UNDER PRESSURE

WIESBADEN, BRD, AUGUST 2 (IPS)—UNDER THE EXTREME PRESSURE OF THE HELSINKI SUMMIT MEETING OF THE CONFERENCE ON SECURITY AND COOPERATION IN EUROPE, WEST GERMAN CHANCELLOR HELMUT SCHMIDT WAS OBSERVED TO HAVE THROWN A CIGARETTE AT A DUCK SWIMMING IN A POND IN THE FINNISH CAPITAL, WEST GERMAN REPORTERS REVEALED TODAY.

SULZBERGER PARANOID ABOUT CSCE

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—WRITING IN TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES ABOUT THE CURRENT SUMMIT MEETING OF THE EUROPEAN CONFERENCE ON SECURITY AND COOPERATION, C. L. SULZBERGER REVEALS A DEEP-SEATED FEAR OF SOVIET MOVES TOWARD DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE AT THE CONFERENCE. SULZBERGER COMPARES THE HELSINKI MEETING TO LENIN'S ARRIVAL AT THE FINLAND STATION WHICH "MARKED THE START OF A FINAL PHASE IN THE (RUSSIAN) REVOLUTION...AND PROVIDED...A POWERFUL BASE FOR COMMUNIST DOCTRINE'S INTERNATIONAL SPREAD."

FINANCIAL TIMES VIEWS PORTUGAL AS LITMUS TEST FOR EUROPEAN CPS

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—VIRTUALLY CONCEDED THAT SUPPORT FOR PORTUGAL HAS BECOME A LITMUS TEST FOR THE EUROPEAN COMMUNIST MOVEMENT, FINANCIAL TIMES CORRESPONDENT LESLIE COLITT REPORTS THAT THE SAME "DISSENTING" COMMUNIST PARTIES WHO HAVE HINDERED PROGRESS TOWARD

THE PLANNED BERLIN CONFERENCE OF WORLD CPS ARE ALSO "HIGHLY CRITICAL OF THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST LEADER ALVARO CUNHAL AND HIS POLICY OF NON-COOPERATION WITH OTHER LEFT-WING PARTIES IN PORTUGAL." COLITT WRITES THAT THE PRESENCE IN EAST BERLIN OF DR. CUNHAL, "ADVOCATING SOVIET VIEWS TO THE EXCLUSION OF ALL OTHERS, IT IS SAID, WOULD BE ENOUGH TO SPLIT THE EUROPEAN COMMUNIST MOVEMENT EVEN FURTHER."

* THE FRENCH DAILY LE MONDE WRITES TODAY OF PURGES OF OFFICERS AND LEAFLETS CIRCULATING AMONG SOLDIERS.

* UPI QUOTES EXPRESSO, THE WEEKLY OF PORTUGAL'S POPULAR DEMOCRATIC PARTY (PPD), AS SAYING THAT "NOTHING CAN BE SOLVED WITHOUT AN ARMED CONFRONTATION."

* THIS WEEK'S MANCHESTER GUARDIAN PUBLISHES A "COUNT OF GUNS" (A SCORECARD OF WHICH MILITARY UNITS ARE WITH WHICH FACTION) FOR THE BENEFIT OF ITS READERSHIP.

COPCON REORGANIZATION IN PORTUGAL

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--JAIME NEVES, A COMMANDER OF PORTUGAL'S COPCON (SECURITY FORCES) UNITS NEAR LISBON, EIGHT OTHER OFFICERS AND FOUR SERGEANTS HAVE BEEN "TRANSFERRED TO ARMY GENERAL HEADQUARTERS IN THE INTERESTS OF DISCIPLINE, AUTHORITY AND A CORRECT POLITICAL LINE," REPORTS YESTERDAY'S LONDON FINANCIAL TIMES, QUOTING A COPCON COMMUNIQUE. NEVES IS HOSTILE TO THE PRO-PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY PRIME MINISTER GONCALVES, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S FRENCH DAILY LE MONDE.

FORMATION OF PRO-SOCIALIST "ARMY DEMOCRATIC MOVEMENT" IN PORTUGAL

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--A PRO-SOCIALIST "ARMY DEMOCRATIC MOVEMENT HAS BEEN ORGANIZING SECRETLY FOR SOME TIME" AND WILL SOON "MATCH THAT OF THE REVOLUTIONARY GROUPS," REPORTS TODAY'S MANCHESTER GUARDIAN.

MEANWHILE, MARIO SOARES, HEAD OF THE PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST PARTY, WHILE SPEAKING AT A SECOND INTERNATIONAL GATHERING IN STOCKHOLM, REPORTED HEAVY SOCIALIST SUPPORT IN THE PORTUGUESE ARMY, ACCORDING TO A UPI DISPATCH TODAY.

PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST ADMITS LINK TO CHINA

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--ACCORDING TO THE SECRETARY OF THE PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST PARTY YOUTH ORGANIZATION, THE FOREIGN MINISTRY OF PORTUGAL IS AWARE THAT HIS PARTY IS OPENLY SUPPORTED BY RED CHINA. THIS ADMISSION APPEARED IN AN INTERVIEW BETWEEN THE YOUTH SECRETARY AND THE WEST BERLIN NEWSPAPER EXTRA-DIENST.

FOURTH INTERNATIONAL WANTS TO FREE
PORTUGUESE WORKING CLASS OF ITS "STALINIST" CONTROLLERS

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—ALAIN KRIVINE, MEMBER OF THE POLITBURO OF THE REVOLUTIONARY COMMUNIST LEAGUE (FRENCH SECTION OF THE SO-CALLED TROTSKYIST FOURTH INTERNATIONAL), WRITES IN TODAY'S LE MONDE THAT, DESPITE ITS GROWTH FROM 3,000 TO OVER 100,000 MEMBERS IN ONE YEAR, THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) DOES NOT REALLY CONTROL THE PORTUGUESE WORKING CLASS.

KRIVINE WRITES THAT THE PORTUGUESE TROTSKYIST ORGANIZATION (LCI) IS FIGHTING FOR DEMOCRACY IN PORTUGAL BY TRYING TO UNITE SOCIALIST AND COMMUNIST WORKERS INTO CENTRALIZED "WORKERS' COMMITTEES" FROM WHICH WILL EMERGE "A TRUE WORKERS' GOVERNMENT" FREE OF "STALINIST" CONTROL.

CHOLERA IN PORTUGAL

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—NINETEEN CASES OF CHOLERA WERE REPORTED IN PORTUGAL'S NORTHERN CITY OF OPORTO, ACCORDING TO THE ITALIAN DAILY LA STAMPA.

NO INCREASE IN TROOPS TO ANGOLA

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—"WE CANNOT ALLOW THE FNLA (CIA NATIONAL FRONT) TO OCCUPY LUANDA, BUT AN INCREASE IN THE FORCES OF THE PORTUGUESE ARMY IN LUANDA IS RULED OUT," SAID PORTUGUESE GENERAL CARLOS FABIAO, ACCOMPANIED BY ADMIRAL ROSA COUTINHO WHILE IN ANGOLA, REPORTS TODAY'S NEUES DEUTSCHLAND, THE PAPER OF THE EAST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY.

MILITARY OFFICERS ARRESTED IN SPAIN

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—SEVEN OFFICERS BELIEVED TO BE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTERINSURGENT MILITARY DEMOCRATIC UNION WERE ARRESTED IN SPAIN WEDNESDAY, THE AUGUST 1 FINANCIAL TIMES REPORTED. THEY WERE CHARGED WITH ILLEGAL ASSOCIATION WITH THE DEMOCRATIC JUNTA AND POSSESSION OF SUBVERSIVE MATERIALS SUPPORTING THE PORTUGUESE ARMED FORCES MOVEMENT.

TETHER BLASTS KISSINGER'S THIRD WORLD ARM-TWISTING,
DEMANDS DEVELOPMENT

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—BREAKING THE PRESS BLACK-OUT ON CURRENT THIRD WORLD ORGANIZING TRIUMPHS AT THE UNITED NATIONS, C. GORDON TETHER USED HIS INFLUENTIAL FINANCIAL TIMES LOMBARD COLUMN FRIDAY TO SCORE U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER'S "LATEST PERORATIONS ON THE SHORTCOMINGS OF THE THIRD WORLD." "IT HAS TO BE REMEMBERED," HE POINTED OUT, "THAT FOR SOME TIME...NO COUNTRY HAS BEEN WORKING HARDER THAN THE U.S. TO MAKE IT (THE NEW ECONOMIC ORDER) THE SUBJECT OF CONFRONTATION AND BLOC POLITICS." HE ATTRIBUTED THIS TO THE "INTRANSIGENT U.S. ATTITUDE ON INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC COOPERATION."

TETHER CLOSED WITH A CALL FOR A "FUNDAMENTAL" CHANGE IN AMERICAN ATTITUDES FOR "THE FUTURE ECONOMIC WELL-BEING OF THE WORLD."

LEFT LABOUR MOUNTS CAMPAIGN AGAINST GOVERNMENT POLICY

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--THE COMMUNIST PARTY-INFLUENCED TRIBUNE GROUP OF THE BRITISH LABOUR PARTY HAS LAUNCHED A VIGOROUS CAMPAIGN AMONG TRADE UNION AND LOCAL LABOUR PARTY CONSTITUENCIES TO FORCE THE CURRENT WILSON GOVERNMENT TO ABANDON ITS DE FACTO COALITION WITH THE CONSERVATIVE PARTY AROUND ANTI-WORKING CLASS AUSTERITY POLICIES, REPORTS THE LONDON DAILY EXPRESS. LAUNCHING THE CAMPAIGN, WHICH WILL CULMINATE IN THE LABOUR PARTY CONFERENCE IN OCTOBER, TRIBUNE CHAIRMAN SYDNEY BIDWELL SAID, "THE GOVERNMENT IS CURRENTLY PRACTISING COALITION POLITICS. IT IS OUR FEAR THAT THE LABOUR PARTY IN THE COUNTRY COULD BE CUT TO RIBBONS."

LIBYAN-CIA GUN-RUNNING OPERATION UNCOVERED

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--EGYPTIAN AUTHORITIES HAVE "UNCOVERED A SUPERVISED NETWORK THAT ALLEGEDLY SUPPLIED ARMS" TO TERRORIST GROUPS IN ARAB COUNTRIES UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE CIA-LIBYAN LEADER COLONEL MUAMMAR QADDAFI, REPORTS TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST, QUOTING THE EGYPTIAN NEWSPAPER AL-AHRAN. THE NETWORK IS REPORTED TO HAVE OPERATED UNDER THE COVER OF THE LIBYAN COMPANY CALLED THE "AFRICAN IMPORT-EXPORT CO.," WITH HEADQUARTERS IN TRIPOLI AND OFFICES IN SEVERAL WESTERN EUROPEAN COUNTRIES. THE DIRECTOR OF THE COMPANY IS THE COUSIN OF QADDAFI.

SYRIAN POPULATION PROVOKED AGAINST IRAQ

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--MOBS HAVE ATTACKED THE ALEPPO, SYRIA HEADQUARTERS OF THE ARAB BA'ATH PARTY PROTESTING THE SHORTAGE OF WATER FLOWING FROM THE EUPHRATES RIVER, REPORTS TODAY'S BALTIMORE SUN. IN RESPONSE TO THE DISTURBANCES, A SYRIAN GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL IN ALEPPO WAS QUOTED AS SAYING, "IF THE SYRIAN GOVERNMENT DOES NOT REDUCE THE WATER FLOWING TO IRAQ," THE COUNTRY'S POPULATION WILL DIE FROM THIRST.

EDITORIAL PRAISE FOR WEST GERMAN TRADE UNION AGENT

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--CONSERVATIVE FRANKFURTER ALLGEMEINE ZEITUNG EDITORIALIST GUENTHER VETTER TODAY PRAISED THE PROPOSAL FOR A GENERAL WAGE FREEZE MADE RECENTLY BY WEST GERMAN TRADE UNION CONFEDERATION (DGB) CHAIRMAN AND TRILATERAL COMMISSIONER HEINZ OSCAR VETTER. ACCORDING TO THE WRITER, "WE ARE NOW IN A SITUATION SIMILAR TO THAT JUST AFTER WORLD WAR II--POINT ZERO....THE DGB CHAIRMAN'S REMARKS NOW ALLOW US TO HOPE THAT TRADE UNION REPRESENTATIVES COULD SHOW AN UNACCUSTOMED WILLINGNESS TO COOPERATE."

LEADERSHIP CRISIS HITS WEST GERMAN CHRISTIAN DEMS

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--THE CONSERVATIVE WEST GERMAN DAILY FRANKFURTER ALLGEMEINE ZEITUNG PLEADED IN A COMMENTARY TODAY THAT HELMUT KOHL, CHAIRMAN OF THE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRACY (CDU), "PROVE...THAT HE IS THE UNLIMITED LEADERSHIP FIGURE OF THE CDU." THE NEWSPAPER NOTED IN ADDITION THAT KOHL NEVER EVEN GOT UP TO SPEAK AT A RECENT EMERGENCY SESSION OF THE NATIONAL PARLIAMENT ON THE BURNING POLITICAL QUESTION OF WEST GERMAN ENDORSEMENT OF THE SECURITY AND COOPERATION ACCORDS IN HELSINKI.

FLOODS HIT SUBCONTINENT

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--FLOODS ARE SWEEPING ACROSS THE NORTHEAST OF INDIA AND BANGLADESH IN THE INITIAL PERIOD OF SUMMER MONSOON RAINS. THE AUGUST 1 LONDON TIMES REPORTS THAT OVER 10 MILLION ARE AFFECTED IN THE INDIAN STATES OF ASSAM AND BIHAR AS THE GANGES AND BRAHMAPUTRA RIVERS SWELL TO DANGER POINTS.

REPORTS IN THE INDIAN DAILY PATRIOT JULY 29 INDICATE THAT EIGHT VILLAGES ARE UNDER WATER IN THE DISTRICT OF RANGPUR IN BANGLADESH, WHERE THE SURMA RIVER HAS BROKEN EARTHEN EMBANKMENTS.

DELHI BANS SACRED COWS

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF NEW DELHI, THE INDIAN CAPITAL, ANNOUNCED RECENTLY THAT ALL COWS FOUND WANDERING THROUGH THE STREETS AND OBSTRUCTING TRAFFIC WILL BE PICKED UP AND PLACED IN ENCLOSED PASTURES AND LATER RESOLD AT LOW PRICES, ACCORDING TO LE FIGARO JULY 31. THIS FIRST RULING BY ANY INDIAN MUNICIPALITY WILL AFFECT 20,000 COWS THAT NOW WANDER THROUGH THE CAPITAL.

II. CONTINENTAL PRESS

NEW YORK TIMES DEMANDS U.S. EMBARGO OF SOVIET GRAIN PURCHASES

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--CONGRESS MUST IMPOSE AN EMBARGO ON FURTHER SOVIET GRAIN PURCHASES UNTIL THEIR "INFLATIONARY IMPACT" CAN BE ASSESSED, EDITORIALIZES TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES. THE EDITORIAL MOOTS AN IMPENDING HYPERINFLATIONARY EXPLOSION CAUSED BY GRAIN SALES TO THE USSR AND COVERS A WEEK-OLD SCARE STORY OF DROUGHT IN THE MIDWEST TO SUBSTANTIATE ITS OBJECTIONS TO A SOVIET GRAIN DEAL.

GRAIN COMPANY CHARGES GOVERNMENT WIRETAPS, INFILTRATION

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--A SPOKESMAN FOR COOK INDUSTRIES, THE MEMPHIS-BASED GRAIN TRADING COMPANY THAT IS THIRD ONLY TO THE ROCKEFELLER-CONTROLLED CARGILL AND CONTINENTAL GRAIN, HAS CHARGED THE GOVERNMENT WITH TAPPING ITS TELEPHONES AND PLACING "AT LEAST TWO UNDERCOVER AGENTS" IN ITS OFFICES. COOK INDUSTRIES, ALONG WITH THE ARGENTINA-BASED BUNGE CORPORATION, HAS BEEN UNDER INTENSIVE ATTACK IN CONNECTION WITH THE HOKED-UP GRAIN INSPECTION SCANDAL IN NEW ORLEANS. THE COOK CHARGES WERE COVERED IN AN AUGUST 1 UPI RELEASE.

TERRORISM ON THE RISE IN U.S.

AUGUST 2 (IPS)--THE WASHINGTON POST TODAY REPORTED THE RELEASE OF NEW FIGURES ON TERRORISM BY THE CALIFORNIA STATE ATTORNEY GENERAL EVELLE YOUNGER. YOUNGER STATED THAT BOMBINGS DUE TO TERRORIST GROUPS HAVE RISEN OVER 100 PER CENT THIS YEAR AND THAT THIS IS AN INDICATION THAT THE NUMBER OF TERRORIST GROUPS IS ON THE RISE.

ENCEPHALITIS EPIDEMIC IN MISSISSIPPI

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—AN ENCEPHALITIS EPIDEMIC IN MISSISSIPPI HAS CLAIMED 11 LIVES SO FAR, ACCORDING TO STATE HEALTH OFFICIALS CITED IN TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST. THE DISEASE—GENERALLY ASSOCIATED WITH THIRD WORLD LIVING CONDITIONS—BROKE OUT IN MISSISSIPPI LAST MONTH.

MILITARY MAN ATTACKS CABAL

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—RETIRING SUPERINTENDENT OF THE NAVAL ACADEMY AT ANNAPOLIS, VICE ADMIRAL WILLIAM P. MACK, MADE A STINGING ATTACK ON CABAL POLICY MAKERS AND DELIVERED A DIRECT ATTACK ON SECRETARY OF STATE JAMES SCHLESINGER'S DOCTRINE OF "LIMITED NUCLEAR WAR." "WE CANNOT AFFORD THIS WAY OF LIFE IN THE GOVERNMENT IN THE FUTURE, FOR THE INTERVALS GIVEN AS FOR DISCUSSION AND DECISION WILL BE INCREASINGLY SHORTER....IF WE ARE WRONG AGAIN, THERE MAY NOT BE ANY TWENTIETH CENTURY CIVILIZATION AS WE KNOW IT," SAID MACK.

MACK RECOUNTED HOW MOST OF THE DISSENTERS OF CABAL POLICY "WOUND UP EITHER FAR FORWARD IN VIETNAM (TO BE SHOT) OR FAR TO THE REAR IN ICELAND." MACK "WAS TOLD TO BE QUIET OR I'D WIND UP IN VIETNAM," AND URGED MILITARY OFFICERS "TO CULTIVATE AN OPEN STATE OF MIND" AND TO "LISTEN TO OTHERS—THEY MAY BE RIGHT." TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES REPORTS MACK'S COMMENTS.

III. LATIN AMERICAN PRESS ROUND-UP

PRO-COMMUNIST STUDENTS MASSACRED IN EL SALVADOR

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—SEVEN STUDENTS ARE DEAD, 15 INJURED AND OTHERS REPORTEDLY MISSING FOLLOWING A POLICE-ORCHESTRATED RIOT IN SAN SALVADOR FRIDAY. ACCORDING TO THE MEXICAN PRESS, A 2,000 STUDENT DEMONSTRATION, LED BY THE PRO-SOVIET SALVADORIAN COMMUNIST PARTY, WAS DISPERSED BY TANKS AND ARMED SECURITY FORCES, WHO INDISCRIMINATELY OPENED FIRE ON THE STUDENTS. THE STUDENTS WERE PROTESTING THE HIGH COST OF LIVING, THE MISS UNIVERSE PAGEANT AND THE PRESENCE OF UNIFORMED MILITARY ON CAMPUS.

BRAZILIAN COMMUNIST PARTY HEAD CALLS FOR INTERNATIONAL MOBILIZATION

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—IN A STRIKINGLY INTERNATIONALIST DECLARATION, BRAZILIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (PCB) GENERAL SECRETARY LUIZ CARLOS PRESTES MADE AN APPEAL TO THE WORKING-CLASS AND COMMUNIST PARTIES OF THE WORLD TO MOBILIZE AGAINST THE FASCIST BRAZILIAN DICTATORSHIP SO THAT THE PCB CAN PARTICIPATE IN "THE DEFEAT OF FASCISM AND IN STRUGGLING FOR PEACE, DEMOCRACY AND SOCIAL PROGRESS." WRITING IN THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY'S WEEKLY JOURNAL FRANCE NOUVELLE, PRESTES STATED THAT IMPERIALISM USES "THE FASCIST DICTATORSHIP AND THE CHEAP LABOR OF BRAZILIAN WORKERS AS INSTRUMENTS OF STRUGGLE AGAINST THE INTERNATIONAL WORKING CLASS."

FRENCH PRO-EAST-WEST TRADE FIRM WILL PRODUCE PLANT FOR PORTUGUESE COMPANY

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—THE FRENCH INDUSTRIAL FIRM CREUSOT-LOIRE, KNOWN FOR ITS EXTENSIVE PRODUCTION CONTRACTS WITH EAST BLOC COUNTRIES, WILL BUILD AN ANILINE DYE PLANT FOR A PORTUGUESE CONCERN NAMED SOCIATE AMMONIACO PORTUGUES, ACCORDING TO THE LATEST EDITION OF THE FRENCH DAILY LE MONDE. THE PLANT WILL REPORTEDLY COST \$43 MILLION.

V. ORGANIZING AND INTELLIGENCE

WEST GERMAN FBI FOLLOWS INTERNATIONAL SCRIPT

WIESBADEN, BRD, AUGUST 2 (IPS)—A SPOKESMAN OF THE WEST GERMAN RAILWAY UNION TODAY INDICATED TO A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE EUROPEAN LABOR COMMITTEES (ELC) THAT THE BUNDESVERFASSUNGSSCHUTZ (WEST GERMAN FBI—BVS) HAS ADVISED HIS UNION NOT TO ESTABLISH CONTACT WITH THE ELC. EARLIER THIS YEAR, THE UNION CALLED FOR A MORATORIUM ON DEBT SERVICE OWED BY THE GOVERNMENT-OWNED WEST GERMAN RAILROAD. THE SPOKESMAN DECIDED NOT TO HEED THE BVS ADVICE.

LABOR PARTY CANDIDATE RESCUED FROM APARTMENT HOUSE FIRE

BALTIMORE, MD., AUGUST 2 (IPS)—THIS MORNING CAROL HARTMAN, LABOR PARTY CANDIDATE FOR PRESIDENT OF BALTIMORE CITY COUNCIL, AND HER FOUR CHILDREN WERE RESCUED FROM THEIR SECOND STORY APARTMENT AS THE BUILDING THREATENED TO COLLAPSE IN FLAMES FROM A FIRE IN A STORE DIRECTLY BELOW. THE FIRE IS ESTIMATED TO BE THE WORK OF AN ARSONIST.

MRS. HARTMAN'S MAJOR OPPONENT IS PRESENT CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT ORLINSKY—A WELL-KNOWN LEAA OPERATIVE WHOSE CONNECTIONS TO MAFIA ACTIVITIES ARE PRESENTLY UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE LABOR PARTY. TWO OTHER OPPONENTS OF ORLINSKY HAVE COMPLAINED OF HARASSMENT, AND ONE HAS DROPPED OUT OF THE RACE BECAUSE OF THE HARASSMENT.

THE BALTIMORE LABOR PARTY IS REQUESTING THAT THE STATE ATTORNEY CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION INTO THIS INCIDENT AND THE ENTIRETY OF BALTIMORE ELECTION HARASSMENT.

AUGUST 2 (IPS)—U.S. LABOR PARTY SENATORIAL CANDIDATE ELIJAH BOYD TURNED AROUND A CASE OF BLATANT ELECTORAL HARASSMENT YESTERDAY IN NIAGARA FALLS, ELICITING A PROMISE FROM THE NIAGARA GAZETTE TO RETRACT A STORY WHICH ANNOUNCED THAT USLP CANDIDATE FOR MAYOR OF NIAGARA FALLS, BILL PERKINS, HAD DROPPED OUT OF THE RACE. THE ARTICLE CLAIMED THAT PERKINS HAD FORFEITED HIS CHANCE TO RUN AS A THIRD PARTY CANDIDATE BECAUSE HE DID NOT ENTER EITHER THE DEMOCRATIC OR REPUBLICAN PRIMARIES!

DURING HIS FOUR-DAY CAMPAIGN TOUR IN UPSTATE NEW YORK, BOYD HAS EXPOSED HARASSMENT OF THE USLP CAMPAIGNS IN INTERVIEWS WITH NEARLY 15 REPORTERS. YESTERDAY ON A LOCKPORT, N.Y. RADIO TALK SHOW, BOYD GAVE A FULL BRIEFING ON THE USLP EXPOSURE OF STATE DEPARTMENT-CIA-LEAA GUN- AND DRUG-RUNNING. BOYD WILL CAMPAIGN IN TORONTO TOMORROW.

VANCOUVER PROSECUTOR BLOCKS
INVESTIGATION OF ATTEMPTED ASSASSINATION

VANCOUVER, AUGUST 2 (IPS)—CROWN PROSECUTOR JOHN BETHEL JULY 31 INFORMED REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NORTH AMERICAN LABOR PARTY (NALP) THAT THERE IS INSUFFICIENT EVIDENCE TO PURSUE THE CASE OF ATTEMPTED MURDER OF NALP MAYORAL CANDIDATE ALAN LEVINSON, WHO LAST WEEK RECEIVED A HEAD WOUND REQUIRING 23 STITCHES AFTER ASSAULT BY PROFESSIONAL THUGS. BETHEL DEMANDED THAT THE NALP REPRESENTATIVES PRODUCE A BODY. WHEN IT WAS POINTED OUT THAT IF THE RCMP INVESTIGATION CONTINUES AT ITS SLOW PACE, THE BODY WOULD BE ALAN LEVINSON'S, BETHEL RESPONDED, "NOW THAT WOULD BE A CASE!"

LABOR PARTY REPRESENTATIVES ARE DEMANDING A FULL INVESTIGATION INTO THE ATTEMPTED ASSASSINATION, INCLUDING THE INVOLVEMENT OF THE CIA IN THIS AND RELATED OPERATIONS AGAINST THE NALP. THERE IS A TRAIL OF EVIDENCE LEADING TO THE LIKELY CONNECTIONS BETWEEN THE RCMP, THE FBI AND THE CIA.

* MR. LEVINSON OBSERVED THE RCMP USING SOPHISTICATED SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT IN THE LOCATION WHERE HE WAS EVENTUALLY ATTACKED. IN THE INTERVENING PERIOD, THE RCMP ARRESTED INDIVIDUALS FROM A HOUSE IN THE VICINITY, ON GROUNDS OF DRUG-RUNNING ACROSS THE CANADA-U.S. BORDER—OPERATIONS IN WHICH THE CIA AND FBI ARE NOTORIOUSLY INVOLVED.

* CONSTABLE MIDLAK, THE RCMP UNDERCOVER AGENT ASSIGNED TO HARASS THE LABOR PARTY, WAS REPORTED TO HAVE KILLED A PERSON THE MORNING AFTER THE ATTACK, ACCORDING TO THE VANCOUVER PRESS.

* MIDLAK HAD BEEN PROVED TO BE UNSTABLE WHEN, SEVERAL WEEKS AGO, HE PHYSICALLY ASSAULTED MR. LEVINSON.

THE LATEST ATTACK ON LEVINSON CAME ONLY A FEW DAYS AFTER THE NALP DISTRIBUTED A LEAFLET THROUGHOUT VANCOUVER CONNECTING NDP PREMIER DAVE BARRETT TO THE DRUG-RUNNING OF THE CIA-CONTROLLED
