## I. INTERNATIONAL PRESS ROUND-UP

### IRAQI PROPOSES NON-DOLLAR-BASED MONETARY SYSTEM

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- IRAQ SHOULD CALL FOR "A NEW WORLD MONETARY SYSTEM" NOT BASED ON THE U.S. DOLLAR WHICH WOULD INCLUDE THE PARTICIPATION OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, ACCORDING TO DR. ABDUL AL-SAGBAN, WRITING IN THE JULY 29 EDITION OF THE BAGHDAD OBSERVER.

"WE SHOULD CALL AND WORK FOR A NEW WORLD MONETARY SYSTEM WHICH WOULD BE RID OF THE DOMINATION OF THE AMERICAN DOLLAR, AND HAVE SUFFICIENT ROOM FOR THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES AND OTHERS WHICH ARE STILL OUTSIDE ITS MEMBERSHIP," WROTE DR. SAGBAN, "AS WELL AS FOR THE NEW FORCES REPRESENTED IN THE ARAB AND NON-ARAB OIL REVENUES."

DR. SAGBAN ALSO CALLED FOR "COORDINATION BETWEEN THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLANS OF THE ARAB COUNTRIES," AND ADDED THAT SUCH COORDINATION WOULD FACILITATE AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE ARABS AND "THE EEC (EUROPEAN COMMON MARKET), AFRICAN STATES, AND SOCIALIST COUNTRIES."

### NORTH VIETNAM, CAMBODIA HOLD TALKS

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- LE DUAN, FIRST SECRETARY OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE NORTH VIETNAMESE COMMUNIST PARTY HELD MEETINGS WITH TOP LEVEL CAMBODIAN LEADERS, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES. RADIO HANOI REPORTS THAT THERE WAS "COMPLETE UNANIMITY OF VIEWS IN ALL QUESTIONS RAISED" AND THAT THE "RECENT VISIT AND TALKS ARE HIGHLY SIGNIFICANT AS THEY TOOK PLACE WHEN THE SITUATION IN VIETNAM, CAMBODIA AND LAOS HAS FUNDAMENTALLY CHANGED." RECENT CIA-INSPIRED RUMORS REPORTED IN THE BANGKOK PRESS SAID THAT CLASHES ON THE CAMBODIAN-VIETNAMESE BORDER WERE "EXPECTED IMMINENTLY."

### ARGENTINA NEGOTIATES WITH COMECON

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- THE ARGENTINE AMBASSADOR TO THE SOVIET UNION REQUESTED A MEETING WITH THE HEAD OF THE EAST BLOC ECONOMIC COMMUNITY (COMECON), NICHOLAI FADDEEV, REPORTS THE SOVIET NEWSPAPER PRAVDA AUGUST 1. THE TWO MET TO DISCUSS "QUESTIONS OF MUTUAL INTEREST."

COMECON HAS RECENTLY ARRANGED TRADE EXCHANGES WITH SEVERAL NON-MEMBER COUNTRIES, INCLUDING IRAQ AND MEXICO.

CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATS CHARGE POLAND WITH BLACKMAIL

WIESBADEN, BRD, AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- WEST GERMAN CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION (CDU) SPOKESMAN GERHARD REDDEMANN TODAY CHARGED THAT POLAND HAS MADE "BLACKMAIL DEMANDS" FOR TRADE CREDITS FROM WEST GERMANY AND WAR REPARATIONS PAYMENTS IN RETURN FOR THE EMMIGRATION OF GERMAN ETHNICS IN POLAND, THE SUEDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG REPORTS TODAY. THE SAME ATTACK HAS BEEN MADE BY SEVERAL CDU REPRESENTATIVES.

SCHLESWIG HOLSTEIN: ALL APPLICANTS FOR TEACHING JOBS HIRED

WIESBADEN, BRD, AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- THE WEST GERMAN STATE OF SCHLESWIG-HOLSTEIN, LED BY CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION CHAIRMAN GERHARD STOLTENBERG, HAS DECIDED TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF TEACHERS IN THE STATE TO NEARLY 500 IN SPITE OF SEVERE BUDGET CRISIS, REPORTS TODAY'S FRANKFURTER ALLGEMEINE ZEITUNG.

CUNHAL WARNS THAT REVOLUTION IS IN DANGEROUS PHASE

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY HEAD ALVARO CUNHAL WARNED IN EVORA, PORTUGAL THAT THE PORTUGUESE REVOLUTION IS ENTERING "A DANGEROUS AND DIFFICULT PHASE", EXEMPLIFIED BY THE CONTINUING INABILITY OF THE GOVERNMENT TO FORM A NEW RULING COALITION. REPORTED IN TODAY'S L'HUMANITE, THE CUNHAL STATEMENT IS FOLLOWED UP BY REPORTS THAT PRESIDENT COSTA GOMES MAY RESTRUCTURE THE PRESENT 3-MAN EXECUTIVE BODY, AND THAT OTELO CARVALHO HAS REFUSED THE POST OF VICE MINISTER, PRESUMABLY WITH THE BACKING OF CERTAIN SECURITY POLICE UNITS WHO WISH TO MAINTAIN THEIR "AUTONOMY."

L'HUMANITE JOURNALIST ACQUAVIVA COMMENTS THAT THE DIFFICULTIES FACING THE GOVERNMENT SIMPLY REFLECT MUCH DEEPER INTERNAL PROBLEMS IN THE COUNTRY, POINTING OUT CONTINUING COUNTERREVOLUTIONARY PROVOCATIONS BY THE PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST PARTY AND OTHER OPPOSITION PARTIES.

#### RIGHT-WING HIGH COMMISSIONER REPLACED IN ANGOLA

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- SILVA CARDOSO, THE RIGHT WING PORTUGUESE HIGH COMMISSIONER IN ANGOLA, HAS BEEN RECALLED TO LISBON BY THE PORTUGUESE GOVERNMENT, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S L'HUMANITE, THE DAILY PAPER OF THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY.

ACCORDING TO THE REPORT, CARDOSO "WAS WELL KNOWN FOR HIS SYMPATHY FOR THE NATIONAL FRONT (FNLA)," A CIA-FOUNDED, CHINESE-SUPPLIED COUNTERGANG.

OBJECTIONS TO CARDOSO'S RECALL HAVE COME FROM THE NATIONAL FRONT AND THE NATIONAL UNION FOR THE TOTAL INDEPENDENCE OF ANGOLA (UNITA). UNITA IS AN ORGANIZATION ALLEGED TO HAVE COLLABORATED WITH THE PORTUGUESE COLONIALISTS, AND WHICH HAS CLOSE TIES TO RIGHT-WING FRENCH INDUSTRIALISTS.

#### CIA'S 'RED ARMY' STAGES TERROR ATTACK IN MALAYSIA

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- THE CIA'S ZOMBIE TERRORIST OUTFIT, "RED ARMY," TODAY STORMED THE UNITED STATES EMBASSY IN KUALA LUMPUR, MALAYSIA, AND SEIZED AN AS YET UNKNOWN NUMBER OF HOSTAGES, ACCORDING TO SEVERAL SOURCES.

DEMANDING THE RELEASE OF 7 TERRORISTS PRESENTLY IMPRISONED IN JAPAN, THE RED ARMY ZOMBIES SHOT THEIR WAY INTO THE EMBASSY, WOUNDING THREE SECURITY MEN, AND THREATENED TO BLOW UP THE BUILDING.

THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT HAS ANNOUNCED ITS WILLINGNESS TO MEET THE DEMANDS OF THE TERRORISTS. HOWEVER, A FINAL DECISION IS REPORTEDLY AWAITING THE OUTCOME OF DISCUSSIONS BETWEEN JAPANESE OFFICIALS AND OFFICIALS OF THE UNITED STATES STATE DEPARTMENT.

#### TITO CHALLENGES FORD TO ACHIEVE TOTAL ISRAELI PULLBACK

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- YUGOSLAVIAN PRESIDENT TITO STATED THAT ISRAEL MUST PULL BACK FROM THE ARAB OCCUPIED TERRITORIES AT A DINNER HELD FOR FORD IN BELGRADE YESTERDAY. TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES REPORTS THAT TITO CALLED FOR ISRAELI RECOGNITION OF PALESTINIAN INDEPENDENCE, WARNING THAT "A DANGEROUS CRISIS" WILL ENSUE IF ISRAEL DOES NOT PULL BACK. TITO FURTHER CRITICIZED KISSINGER'S STEP BY STEP DIPLOMACY, SAYING THAT IT IS "OBVIOUS THAT THE EFFORTS SO FAR HAVE NOT BEEN SUFFICIENT TO ATTAIN A DURABLE AND JUST SOLUTION."

#### SYRIA'S PRESIDENT ASSAD NERVOUS ABOUT LACK OF EGYPTIAN COOPERATION

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- SYRIAN PRESIDENT HAFEZ ASSAD SAID SATURDAY THAT "ARAB NATIONS ARE MOVING CLOSER TO WAR WITH ISRAEL," IN AN INTERVIEW IN THE LEBANESE NEWSPAPER AN NAHAR. ASSAD NERVOUSLY COMPLAINED THAT EGYPT WAS NOT FULLY COOPERATING WITH SYRIA IN SUPPLYING INFORMATION ON THE PROGRESS OF THE SINAI NEGOTIATIONS. ASSAD'S STATEMENT WAS MADE DURING A BRIEF VISIT TO DAMASCUS BY LEBANESE PRIME MINISTER KARAMI.

## INDIAN UNIONIST CALLS FOR CUT-OFF OF ECONOMIC AID TO INDIA

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- IN A LETTER RECEIVED BY SOCIALIST INTERNATIONAL HEADQUARTERS IN LONDON, ALL INDIA RAILWAYMEN'S FEDERATION HEAD GEORGE FERNANDEZ HAS ASKED THE SOCIALIST INTERNATIONAL, THE CIA-LINKED INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION OF FREE TRADE UNIONS (ICFTU) AND THE INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORT WORKERS FEDERATION TO LEAD A CAMPAIGN THAT WILL CUT OFF INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC AID TO INDIA, ACCORDING TO THE SUNDAY LONDON OBSERVER.

FERNANDEZ, A CIA AGENT LEADING VARIOUS EXTREME LEFT AND RIGHT WING UNDERGROUND MOVEMENTS AGAINST THE GANDHI GOVERNMENT'S PRO-DEVELOPMENT POLICIES, CLAIMED THAT MORE THAN 100,000 PEOPLE IN THE STATE OF BIHAR HAVE BEEN ENLISTED FOR THIS CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE STRUGGLE.

## II. CONTINENTAL PRESS ROUND-UP

### KISSINGER BLAMED FOR FOREIGN POLICY DEFEATS

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- IN ONE OF THE STRONGEST ANTI-KISSINGER ARTICLES TO DATE, SYNDICATED COLUMNISTS EVANS AND NOVAK TODAY IDENTIFIED SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER AS "A CAPITOL PROBLEM."

THE ADMINISTRATION'S TRAGIC FAILURE ON THE TURKISH AID QUESTION "QUITE LIKELY WOULD NOT HAVE OCCURRED IF DR. HENRY A. KISSINGER WERE NOT SECRETARY OF STATE." WHAT DO YOU DO WITH SOMEONE, THEY ASKED PRESIDENT FORD, WHOSE PRESENCE ON CAPITOL HILL HURTS MORE THAN HELPS?

### KISSINGER SCORED FOR ALLOWING SOVIET INITIATIVES

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- ALL OF SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER'S FORMER POLITICAL PRONOUNCEMENTS, MADE WHEN HE WAS AN OUTSPOKEN CRITIC OF PERSONAL DIPLOMACY AND SUMMIT MEETINGS IN THE 1950S, PROVIDE THE BEST COMMENT ON HIS PRESENT INEPTITUDE, ACCORDING TO GARRY WILLS IN TODAY'S BALTIMORE SUN. WILLS EXCORIATES KISSINGER FOR HIS POLICY REVERSALS BECAUSE THEY'VE LED TO A SITUATION WHERE THE UNITED STATES HAS HAD TO GIVE LEGITIMACY TO SOVIET INITIATIVES AT THE JUST CONCLUDED HELSINKI SUMMIT.

### SUN SAYS OUTLOOK FOR ECONOMIC REFORMS "BLEAK"

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- A BALTIMORE SUN EDITORIAL TODAY DECLARED THAT PRESENT ECONOMIC CONDITIONS HAVE PRODUCED A HOPELESS IMPASSE FOR TRADE AND MONETARY REFORM. AMONG WIDENING DIFFERENCES ON ANY REFORM THE SUN CITES THE WIDENING DISPUTE BETWEEN DEVELOPED AND UNDERDEVELOPED COUNTRIES, ONE THAT "SURFACES IN MORE SPECTACULAR FORM IN THE ENVIRONS OF THE UNITED NATIONS," AND UNBREACHABLE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE U.S. AND FRANCE ON MONETARY REFORM.

U.S. PRESS WARNS SOVIET GRAIN PURCHASE THREATENS JAPANESE  
FOOD SUPPLY

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- PROMINENT STORIES IN TODAY'S JOURNAL OF COMMERCE AND WINS RADIO ALLEGE THAT CURRENT LARGE SOVIET PURCHASES ON THE OVERFLOWING U.S. GRAIN MARKETS WILL CAUSE "PUBLIC PRESSURE" IN THE U.S. MAKING IT IMPOSSIBLE FOR JAPAN TO PURCHASE U.S. GRAIN. OVER 90% OF JAPANESE FOOD IMPORTS ORIGINATE IN THE U.S.

JAPANESE PRIME MINISTER MIKI IN WASHINGTON THIS WEEK IS SAID TO BE PLANNING TO ASK PRESIDENT FORD TO "REASSURE HIM THAT NO RESTRICTIONS ON FOOD EXPORTS TO JAPAN WILL BE IMPOSED," AND JAPANESE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FORESTRY SHINTARO ABE IS REPORTED TRAVELING TO MOSCOW LATER THIS MONTH "TO SEEK SOVIET REASSURANCES THAT THEY WILL EXERCISE RESTRAINT IN THEIR GRAIN IMPORT PROGRAM."

CHICAGO TRIBUNE ENDORSES SOVIET-US GRAIN DEALS

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE, A LEADING PRESS REPRESENTATIVE OF MIDWEST INDUSTRIAL AND AGRICULTURAL INTERESTS, EMPHATICALLY ENDORSES SOVIET-U.S. GRAIN DEALS IN AN EDITORIAL TODAY. THE EDITORIAL NOTES, "GEORGE MEANY AND OTHERS WHO BLAME THE SALES TO RUSSIA FOR RISING FOOD PRICES FORGET THAT THE BASIC CAUSE IS INFLATION...THEY ALSO FORGET THE AMERICAN FARMERS' NEED FOR A DECENT INCOME, AND THE IMPORTANCE OF A FAVORABLE BALANCE OF TRADE TO ENABLE THE U.S. TO PAY FOR THE OIL AND OTHER GOODS IT IMPORTS."

TIMES FEARFUL OF KENNEDY DRAFT

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES EDITORIAL CONVEYED FEARS THAT PUBLIC PRESSURE COULD COMPEL THE NOMINATION OF SENATOR EDWARD M. KENNEDY. "WHAT MORE DOES SENATOR KENNEDY HAVE TO DO FOR THE POLLSTERS TO TAKE HIM AT HIS WORD?" WRITES THE TIMES.

WILL GIVES SUPPORT FOR SHRIVER

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- RIGHT WING ANTI-ROCKEFELLER COLUMNIST, GEORGE F. WILL, WRITING IN BOTH THE WASHINGTON POST AND THE BALTIMORE SUN, GAVE FAVORABLE SUPPORT TO SARGENT SHRIVER--A WELL KNOWN STALKING HORSE FOR KENNEDY, SHRIVER IS CHARACTERIZED AS A "NEW FRONTIER"-TYPE WHO "EMBODIES THE POLITICAL SENSIBILITY OF 1961."

CANADA HALTS NEW GRAIN EXPORTS

AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- THE CANADIAN WHEAT BOARD HAS HALTED ALL NEW GRAIN EXPORT SALES AT LEAST UNTIL THE SIZE AND QUALITY OF THIS YEAR'S

HARVEST ARE KNOWN ACCORDING TO CANADIAN PRESS SOURCES. THE BOARD CLAIMS THAT UNUSUALLY HOT AND DRY WEATHER IN THE PRAIRIES HAS SEVERELY LOWERED CROP ESTIMATES. THE BAN ON NEW SALES WILL NOT AFFECT PREVIOUS EXPORT COMMITMENTS, INCLUDING RECORD SHIPMENTS TO THE SOVIET UNION.

#### DREGGER SPOKESMAN COMMENTS ON THE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC DIVISION OF LABOR BETWEEN POLITICS AND ECONOMICS

WIESBADEN, BRD, AUGUST 4 (IPS) -- D. REICHELT, SPOKESMAN FOR ALFRED DREGGER, CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION CHAIRMAN IN THE STATE OF HESSEN, IN AN INTERVIEW TODAY STATED THAT DREGGER DISTINGUISHES BETWEEN "POLITICAL" AND "ECONOMIC" ASPECTS IN HIS EVALUATION OF THE RESULTS OF THE RECENT HELSINKI SUMMIT CONFERENCE ON SECURITY AND COOPERATION IN EUROPE (CSCE). "HE IS VERY POSITIVE ABOUT THE ECONOMIC POSSIBILITIES, BUT SKEPTICAL ABOUT WHETHER THE POLITICAL ASPECTS WILL BE REALIZED," REICHELT TOLD IPS.

DREGGER WILL JOIN WITH GERHARD STOLTENBERG, INDUSTRIALIST-BACKED AND PRO-EAST/WEST TRADE CDU CHAIRMAN IN SCHLESWIG-HOLSTEIN, TO KICK OFF THE CDU'S 1976 PARLIAMENTARY ELECTION CAMPAIGN IN FRANKFURT ON AUGUST 14. AT THAT POINT THEY PLAN TO REVEAL THE PARTY'S ECONOMIC PROGRAM.

SEASONED POLITICAL OBSERVERS IN WEST GERMANY INTERPRET THESE DEVELOPMENTS TO MEAN THAT THE STOLTENBERG-INDUSTRIALIST FACTION HAS NOW FORCED THE RIGHT WING OF THE CDU, REPRESENTED BY DREGGER, TO GIVE UP ANY PRETENSIONS TO COMPETENCE IN ECONOMIC AFFAIRS. ON THE OTHER SIDE, THE RIGHT WING IS EXPECTED TO REMAIN SKEPTICAL POLITICALLY.
