INTERNATIONAL PRESS REPORT

GONCALVES RECEIVES VOTE OF CONFIDENCE FROM KEY MILITARY OFFICERS

AUGUST 6 (IPS) — AT A MEETING IN THE LISBON MILITARY COMMAND MONDAY, "GONCALVES RECEIVED A VOTE OF CONFIDENCE (FROM) 50 KEY MILITARY OFFICERS, MANY OF THEM FROM COPCON," REPORTS THE WASHINGTON POST TODAY. THE VOTE WAS BROADCAST OVER STATE TELEVISION AND THE COMMERCIAL RADIO STATION RADIO CLUBE PORTUGUES, NOTED THE POST.

PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY TARGETS CIA OPERATIONS

AUGUST 6 (IPS) — THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) CRITICIZED THE PLUNDERING AND DESTRUCTION OF ITS HEADQUARTERS IN FAMILICAO, AND DENOUNCED THE PARTICIPATION OF SOME ARMED FORCE MOVEMENT (MFA) OFFICERS IN THE ATTACK WHICH OCCURRED YESTERDAY. ACCORDING TO TODAY'S UNITA, PAPER OF THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY, THE PCP ASSERTED THAT SUCH INSTANCES OF ANTI-COMMUNIST VIOLENCE ARE "ACTS OF FASCIST GOONERY FROM AGENTS TRAINED IN SPAIN AND COMMANDED BY MERCENARY GROUPS (REFUGEES FROM ANGOLA) PAID BY THE CAPITALISTS AND THE CIA AND COVERED BY THE PROPAGANDA OF THE PORTUGUESE DEMOCRATIC PARTY (PPD) AND THE CENTER DEMOCRATIC SOCIAL PARTY (CDS)."

CIA ADMITS ACTIVITY IN PORTUGAL

AUG. 6 (IPS) — FORMER CIA AGENT PHILIP AGEE, YESTERDAY STRONGLY CONTRADICTED PRESIDENT FORD'S RECENT STATEMENTS THAT THE CIA WAS NOT ACTIVE IN PORTUGAL.

AGEE SAID THAT HE HAD BEEN IN PORTUGAL RECENTLY AND THE CIA AGENTS THAT WERE ATTACHED TO THE AMERICAN EMBASSY THERE WERE THE SAME AGENTS HE HAD PERSONALLY WORKED WITH IN LATIN AMERICA. THESE AGENTS, ACCORDING TO AGEE, WERE CURRENTLY INVOLVED IN THE SAME KINDS OF ACTIVITIES IN PORTUGAL THAT THEY UNDERTOOK IN LATIN AMERICA, INCLUDING THE FUNDING OF RIGHT-WING GROUPS. THE REPORT WAS CARRIED YESTERDAY OVER THE LOCAL CBS TELEVISION AFFILIATE IN DETROIT.

ALGERIA DEFENDS PORTUGUESE REVOLUTION

AUG. 6 (IPS) — ALGERIA HAS STRONGLY CRITICIZED ATTEMPTS BY EEC COUNTRIES TO ISOLATE PORTUGAL FROM ITS ALLIES IN THE DEVELOPING WORLD.

(APS), PUBLISHED IN THE JULY 25 ISSUE OF THE ALGERIAN DAILY EL MOUDJAHID, IDENTIFIES THE PORTUGUESE ECONOMY AS THAT OF A STRUGGLING DEVELOPING COUNTRY AND STATES THAT "A P R I O R I, NOTHING PERMITS CHEYSSON (AN EEC SPOKESMAN -- ED.) TO INTRODUCE A GEOGRAPHICAL DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PORTUGAL AND THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES."

APS NOTES THAT THE PRESENT EEC POSITION AGAINST THE PORTUGUESE GOVERNMENT, WHICH IS DEMOCRATICALLY SUPPORTED BY A MAJORITY OF THE PORTUGUESE PEOPLE RESEMBLES THE BLACKMAIL POLITICAL CONDITIONS OF U.S. AID TO EUROPE DURING THE MARSHALL PLAN AFTER WORLD WAR II.

HAIG CONTINUES NATO DEPLOYMENT FOR NUCLEAR CONFRONTATION

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- GENERAL ALEXANDER HAIG, SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER OF NATO, IS CONTINUING TO IMPLEMENT THE SCHLESINGER DOCTRINE FOR NUCLEAR CONFRONTATION WITH THE SOVIET UNION REDEPLOYING U.S. FORCES TO THE NORTH GERMAN PLAIN, PUSHING NATO DEFENSIVE LINES AS FAR FORWARD AS POSSIBLE, AND INCREASING THE INTERNATIONAL CONTENT OF MAJOR TRAINING EXERCISES ACCORDING TO DREW MIDDLETON IN TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES. THE TIMES NOTES THAT THE HAIG REDEPLOYMENT TAKES PLACE IN AN ATMOSPHERE OF WIDESPREAD OPPOSITION AND IS RISKY FOR NATO.

ISRAELI RAIDS, AIR STRIKES INTO LEBANON

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- A BLOODY ISRAELI COMMANDO RAID INTO LEBANON FOLLOWED BY AN AIR ATTACK BY SIX FIGHTER-BOMBERS NETTED 10 DEAD, INCLUDING FOUR LEBANESE ARMY LIEUTENANTS EARLY YESTERDAY. ACCORDING TO THE WASHINGTON POST, 200-300 COMMANDOS WERE INVOLVED IN THE FIRST BEACH LANDING BY ISRAELI FORCES IN LEBANON.

COMMENTING ON THE RAIDS, ISRAELI DEFENSE MINISTER SHIMON PERES DECLARED THAT THEY WERE "PREVENTIVE AND NOT PUNITIVE."

THE ISRAELI ATTACKS WERE INTERSECTED BY A PALESTINIAN ROCKET ATTACK ON THE ISRAELI VILLAGE OF QIRYAT SHIMONA. THE NEW YORK TIMES DESCRIBED THE EVENTS AS "A DAY OF VIOLENT CROSS-EXCHANGES, WHICH HAVE BECOME ALMOST COMMONPLACE."

KISSINGER, SADAT BOTH SET TO FALL

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER "HAS TO WORRY ABOUT (EGYPTIAN PRESIDENT) SADAT'S FALL -- EVEN IF HE HAS NOTHING ELSE ON HIS MIND, FOR INSTANCE HIS OWN FALL," WEST GERMAN EDITORIALIST DIETER CYCON WRITES TODAY IN THE RIGHT-WING DIE WELT NEWSPAPER.

ACCORDING TO CYCON, BITTER AND GROWING DOMESTIC OPPOSITION IN THE U.S. TO KISSINGER IS COMBINING WITH SOVIET DIPLOMATIC EFFORTS TO PARALYZE AMERICAN MIDDLE EAST POLICY. BUT, CYCON WARNS, THE CURRENT PERIOD "COULD WELL BE THE CALM BEFORE THE STORM."

SYRIA-JORDAN JOINT MILITARY COMMAND ALREADY FORMED

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- DURING RECENTLY CONCLUDED TALKS BETWEEN SYRIA AND JORDAN, AGREEMENTS WERE MADE TO FORM A JOINT MILITARY COMMAND WITH HEADQUARTERS IN AMMAN, JORDAN, ACCORDING TO REVELATIONS BY THE BEIRUT LEFTIST PAPER AS-SAFIR PUBLISHED IN YESTERDAY'S LONDON DAILY TELEGRAPH.

THE RIGHT-WING TELEGRAPH ADDS THAT, AS PART OF THE AGREEMENTS, SYRIA WILL SET UP CONTACTS BETWEEN JORDAN AND THE PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION AND WILL RELAY SOVIET SAM MISSILES TO JORDAN.

SYRIA AND JORDAN PLAN MERGER

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- "WE AND OUR BROTHERS IN JORDAN HOPE THAT, IN DUE COURSE, WE WILL NOT ONLY HAVE MILITARY UNITY, BUT AN OVERALL MERGER," SYRIA'S PRESIDENT HAFEZ ASSAD TOLD A GROUP OF LEBANESE NEWSMEN THIS WEEKEND, THE AUGUST 4 JERUSALEM POST REPORTS. THE POST INSISTS THAT ASSAD'S AIM IS TO MERGE JORDAN AND SYRIA IN ONE POLITICAL ENTITY AND THAT KING HUSSEIN OF JORDAN IS COOPERATING TOWARD THIS END.

EGYPTIAN COMMUNIST PARTY RECONSTITUTED

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- THE EGYPTIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (ECP) HAS PUBLISHED A LENGTHY MANIFESTO IN THE BEIRUT AS-SAFIR NEWSPAPER ANNOUNCING ITS RECONSTITUTION AS AN INDEPENDENT PARTY ORGANIZATION, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST. THE ECP WAS DISSOLVED IN 1964.

"SOCIALIZED MEDICINE" MAINTAINS ZOMBIE POPULATION

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- ACCORDING TO REPORTS IN YESTERDAY'S LONDON DAILY EXPRESS, ONE OUT OF EVERY 10 BRITISH ADULTS GO THROUGH LIFE IN A PERMANENTLY DRUGGED STATE. OVER-WORKED AND UNDER-PAID DOCTORS ON THE NATIONAL HEALTH SYSTEM ARE INCREASINGLY AUTOMATICALLY PRESCRIBING LITHIUM, VALIUM AND OTHER TRANQUILIZERS TO CHRONICALLY DEPRESSED PATIENTS UNABLE TO DEAL WITH BRITAIN'S COLLAPSING LIVING STANDARDS. ACCORDING TO THE EXPRESS, SCHOOL OFFICIALS ARE BECOMING ALARMED AT INCREASING ADDICTION IN 14-AND 15-YEAR-OLD STUDENTS, AND IN SOME CASES, CHILDREN AS YOUNG AS FIVE OR SIX.

PRENTICE REJECTS CALL TO END AID TO INDIA

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- A CALL TO END ECONOMIC AID TO INDIA BECAUSE OF RECENT POLITICAL DEVELOPMENTS THERE, WAS REJECTED IN THE BRITISH PARLIAMENT YESTERDAY BY MINISTER FOR OVERSEAS DEVELOPMENT, REG PRENTICE.

PRENTICE, A NOTORIOUS RIGHT-WINGER RECENTLY UNDER PRESSURE FROM HIS LEFT-WING LABOUR PARTY CONSTITUENCY, CITED AID PROGRAMS AS A CONTRIBUTION WHICH THE AFFLUENT COUNTRIES "CAN AND SHOULD MAKE TO THE DEVELOPMENT PLANS OF THE THIRD WORLD" AND REPLIED: "I HOPE YOU DO NOT SUGGEST WE CUT OFF AID TO INDIA BECAUSE IT MAY BE PURSUING A POLICY (MORE)

OF WHICH WE DO NOT APPROVE."

HEALTH EMERGENCY IN PALERMO

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- A "PRE-ALARM" STATE OF HEALTH HAS BEEN DECLARED BY THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL IN PALERMO AS A RESULT OF GARBAGE PILE-UP AND LACK OF WATER, REPORTS THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY DAILY, UNITA TODAY. THROUGHOUT THE CITY, HUNDREDS OF FIRES HAVE BEEN STARTED ON PILES OF UNCOLLECTED GARBAGE, AND OFFICIALS ARE CONCERNED OVER THE POSSIBILITY OF A TYPHUS EPIDEMIC. "TENS OF INFECTIONS OF TYPHUS FEVER AND VIRAL HEPATITIS ARE ALREADY KNOWN PARTICULARLY AMONG THE CHILDREN OF THE GHETTOS," SAYS UNITA.

CONTINENTAL PRESS REPORT

MEXICAN PRESIDENT ECHEVERRIA PROPOSES FUND FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THIRD WORLD

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- PRESIDENT OF MEXICO LOIS ECHEVERRIA YESTERDAY PROPOSED THE FORMATION OF A "FINANCIAL FUND SPECIFICALLY ORIENTED TO THE...PERMANENT DEFENSE OF PRICES AND MERCHANDISING OF EXPORT PRODUCTS...AND TO GUARANTEE OPTIMAL LEVELS OF IMPORTATION OF GOODS, CAPITAL AND TECHNOLOGIES," BY THIRD WORLD COUNTRIES. ECHEVERRIA PROPOSED THE FORMATION OF THE FUND, DERIVED FROM THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES, AS A "FUNDAMENTAL INSTRUMENT" OF THE SYSTEM FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE THIRD WORLD WHICH HE HAS BEEN CAMPAIGNING FOR DURING HIS PRESENT TOUR OF 14 THIRD WORLD COUNTRIES.

SPEAKING AT A DINNER IN HIS HONOR HOSTED BY EGYPTIAN PRESIDENT ANWAR SADAT IN CAIRO, ECHEVERRIA EXPLAINED THAT THE FUND WOULD BE MANAGED UNDER "A GLOBAL AND LONG TERM STRATEGY, THAT WOULD OVERCOME ADVERSE CONJUNCTURES, MULTINATIONAL CORPORATIONS AND SPECIFIC TRANSNATIONALS."

ECHEVERRIA'S STATEMENTS WERE REPORTED BY TWO MEXICAN NEWSPAPERS, EXCELSIOR AND EL DIA.

DROUGHT IN HONDURAS THREATENS FAMINE

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- UP TO 80 PER CENT OF THE HONDURAN CORN CROP HAS BEEN DESTROYED BY A DROUGHT WHICH IS RAVAGING CENTRAL AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN. THE DROUGHT, WHICH FOLLOWS THE DESTRUCTION LEFT BY HURRICANE FIFI, LEAVES 700,000 PEOPLE FACING STARVATION. CHILDREN ARE ALREADY DYING OF HUNGER WHILE WAITING IN FOOD LINES, ACCORDING TO REPORTS IN THE MIAMI HERALD.

PATTY HEARST REPORTED IN BRAZIL

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- URUGUAYAN PRESS SOURCES REPORTED TODAY THAT PATRICIA

HEARST IS BELIEVED TO BE SOMEWHERE IN THE BORDER AREA OF SOUTHERN BRAZIL. PRESS DISPATCHES EMANATING FROM MONTEVIDEO, URUGUAY, REPORT THAT "ALL BRAZIL IS LOOKING FOR HER" AND THE BRAZILIAN FEDERAL POLICE UNITS ARE ON ALERT.

HEARST IS REPORTED TO BE IN THE SAME AREA WHERE DEVASTATING FROSTS OCCURRED LESS THAN TWO WEEKS AGO, CAUSING THE UNEMPLOYMENT OF HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF RURAL LABORERS AND PRICE HIKES RESULTING FROM FOOD SHORTAGES.

HOUSE CIA COMMITTEE SUBPOENAS NSA DOCUMENT

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- BY A VOTE OF 11 TO 0, THE HOUSE INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEE YESTERDAY BACKED CHAIRMAN OTIS PIKE'S (D-NY) MOTION TO SUBPOENA DEFENSE DEPARTMENT NATIONAL SECURITY DOCUMENT NO. 0 -- THE 1952 WHITE HOUSE DIRECTIVE WHICH ESTABLISHED THE NATIONAL SECURITY AGENCY.

PIKE UPBRAIDED ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF DEFENSE ALBERT HALL DURING YESTERDAY'S COMMITTEE HEARING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION'S REFUSAL TO COOPERATE WITH THE COMMITTEE IN ITS INVESTIGATION OF THE ENTIRE FEDERAL INTELLIGENCE APPARATUS. THE NEW YORK TIMES REPORTS TODAY THAT AN UNIDENTIFIED "KEY INTELLIGENCE SOURCE" COMMENTED, "IF THAT COMMITTEE WAS ALL OTIS PIKE, I'D MOVE TO AUSTRALIA. THEY'D DISMANTLE THE INTELLIGENCE SYSTEM."

NSC SEEKS TO WITHHOLD DATA

AUG. 6 (IPS) -- IN RESPONSE TO A SUIT FILED AGAINST IT BY FORMER STAFFER-MEMBER MORTON HALPERIN, THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL (NSC) HAS FILED AN AFFIDAVIT WITH THE WASHINGTON U.S. DISTRICT COURT WHICH STATES THAT THE NSC'S WORK IS SO SENSITIVE THAT EVEN THE RELEASE OF THE TITLES OF ITS DOCUMENTS WOULD ENDANGER NATIONAL SECURITY.

HALPERIN IS SUING FOR ALL NSC DOCUMENTS WHICH HAVE BEEN USED TO ANALYZE FOREIGN POLICY SINCE 1969, INCLUDING MEMOS WHICH WOULD "IDENTIFY VARIOUS NUCLEAR POLICIES OR ACTIVITIES." THE REPORT COMES FROM TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST.

HYPERINFLATION URGED FOR EUROPE

AUG. 6 (IPS)--STATING THAT THE EUROPEAN RECOVERY WAS "MERELY A MIRAGE" AND "EUROPE COULD BE HEADED FOR STILL MORE HARD TIMES," VARIOUS EUROPEAN ECONOMIC THINK TANKS AND THE COMMON MARKET HAVE COME OUT IN SUPPORT OF HYPERINFLATIONARY POLICIES AS THE

"ONLY WAY OUT OF THE RECESSION."

ACCORDING TO A NEWSWEEK INTERNATIONAL EDITORIAL SERVICE ARTICLE, APPEARING IN TODAY'S CHICAGO TRIBUNE, THE COMMON MARKET'S EXECUTIVE COMMISSION RECOMMENDED LAST WEEK THAT SEVEN OF THE NINE MEMBERS (BRITAIN AND IRELAND EXEMPTED) EMBARK ON AN IMMEDIATE SPENDING SPREE. SIMILARLY, THE BRITISH NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC RESEARCH SAID THAT "COUNTRIES LIKE GERMANY, WHICH HAVE TO REFLATE...WERE PREPARED TO ACCEPT A HIGH UNEMPLOYMENT RATE" AS A CONSEQUENCE. EARLIER THE ARTICLE CITED "GLOOMY FORECASTS" FROM THE GERMAN ECONOMIC INSTITUTE WHICH ANTICIPATES AN 8 PERCENT DROPOFF IN GERMAN EXPORTS AND A 7 PER CENT REDUCTION IN INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION.

MAJOR BORROWINGS IN STORE FOR IRAN

AUG. 6 (IPS)—A RECENT IRANIAN LOAN FROM THE BERLINER HANDELS-GESELLSCHAFT FRANKFURTER BANK FOR 80 MILLION DOLLARS AND OTHER COMPARATIVELY SMALL LOANS TO IRANIAN VENTURES ARE ONLY "A PRELUDE TO MAJOR BORROWINGS BY OTHER IRANIAN ENTITIES," YESTERDAY'S FINANCIAL TIMES OF LONDON REPORTS. ONE-HALF OF THE FINANCING FOR PROPOSED \$1 BILLION JOINT IRAN-JAPAN VENTURES MAY BE SOUGHT ON THE EUROMARKETS, THE TIMES NOTES.

RESERVES HOAX RAISES FALSE CONFIDENCE

AUG. 6 (IPS)—CONTRARY TO ELATED REPORTS IN THE BRITISH PRESS OF A \$61 MILLION RISE IN THE UNITED KINGDOM'S OFFICIAL RESERVES, THERE WAS ALMOST NO NET CHANGE IN THE SIZE OF THE RESERVES OVER THE PAST MONTH.

ACCORDING TO THE LONDON DAILY EXPRESS, THE INCREASE IN THE RESERVES INCLUDED \$69 MILLION BORROWED ABROAD BY BRITAIN'S FAST-SINKING NATIONALIZED INDUSTRIES AND ITS DEBT-STRAPPED LOCAL AUTHORITIES (MUNICIPALITIES.) IF THESE LOANS ARE DISCOUNTED, RESERVES ACTUALLY FELL BY \$8.8 MILLION.

ORGANIZING AND INTELLIGENCE REPORT

AXIOS STATEMENT AT MOUNTAIN LAKES SENTENCING

MT. LAKES, N.J., AUG. 6 (IPS)—NATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITTEES (NCLC) MEMBER DANIEL WASSERMAN AND NCLC NATIONAL EXECUTIVE MEMBER COSTAS AXIOS WERE SENTENCED BY JUDGE BERTRAM POLOW TO ONE YEAR SUSPENDED SENTENCE TWO YEARS PROBATION AND \$1500 EACH IN FINES. BOTH NCLC LEADERS WERE CONVICTED OF POSSESSION OF A DEADLY WEAPON ON JUNE 27.

DURING A STATEMENT BEFORE THE SENTENCING AXIOS REITERATED HIS INNOCENCE AND LABELLED THE DECEMBER 1973 FRAMEUP ARREST OF

HIMSELF, DANIEL WASSERMAN AND THEN USLP CANDIDATE FOR U.S. SENATE, ELIJAH BOYD (WHO WAS ACQUITTED OF CHARGES) AS A PLATANT EXAMPLE OF CIA/FBI DOMESTIC POLITICAL DESTABILIZATIONS MADE IT MORE OBVIOUS THAN EVER THAT THE ARREST AND PROSECUTION WAS PART OF A CAREFULLY PLANNED SET UP.

JUDGE POLOW SAID IN RESPONSE THAT HE WOULD NOT JAIL AXIOS FOR CONTEMPT OF COURT FOR FEAR HE WOULD CREATE A MARTYR.

THIS MORNING NCLC EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBER EDWARD SPANNAUS ANNOUNCED THAT APPEALS NOTICES WILL BE FILED BEFORE AUGUST 13 BY DEFENSE ATTORNEY THOMAS ASHLEY. THE FOCUS OF THE APPEAL WILL BE POLOW'S PREJUDICE THROUGHOUT THE TRIAL. THE NCLC WILL ALLEGE THAT THE JURY SELECTION PROCESS IN PARTICULAR WAS PREJUDICED AND DENIED THE ORGANIZERS A JURY OF THEIR PEERS. POLOW'S FAILURE TO SUPPRESS ILLEGALLY OBTAINED EVIDENCE AND OTHER PREJUDICIAL RULINGS WILL ALSO BE CONTESTED IN THE APPEAL.

FBI-LEAA COVER ASSASSINATION CONSPIRACY AND DRUG-RUNNING

RICHMOND, VA., AUG. 6 (IPS)--POLICE AUTHORITIES HERE, THE FBI AND THE LEAA ARE NOW ATTEMPTING TO SQUASH A LABOR PARTY INVESTIGATION INTO DRUG-RUNNING IN VIRGINIA STATE PRISON (VSP) AND THE ATTEMPTED ASSASSINATION OF A LABOR PARTY MEMBER AND VSP INMATE WILLIAM POOLE.

POOLE WAS SURROUNDED TWO WEEKS AGO BY HALF A DOZEN DRUGGED INMATES WHO THREATENED TO KILL HIM IF HE TALKED.

AT A PRESS CONFERENCE HERE YESTERDAY ON THE POOLE ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT A LABOR PARTY REPRESENTATIVE FOUND A PIECE OF METAL JAMMED INTO ONE OF HER CAR'S TIRES. DURING THE DAY, SHE WAS SURVEILLED AND HARASSED IN THREE INCIDENTS. ONE OF THE HARASSERS BOASTED OF BEING A "FEDERAL AGENT."

THE LAWYER ORIGINALLY WISHING TO DEFEND POOLE'S RIGHTS AND SAFETY ALSO COMPLAINED OF HARASSMENT.

SECURITY COUNCIL APPROVES VIETNAMESE APPLICATIONS

UNITED NATIONS, AUG. 6 (IPS)--THE U.N. SECURITY COUNCIL TODAY REJECTED A MOVE BY THE UNITED STATES TO LINK THE ADMISSION OF THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM AND THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH VIETNAM TO THE ADMISSION OF THE REPUBLIC OF (SOUTH) KOREA. THE AGENDA PRESENTED THE THREE COUNTRIES TOGETHER BUT BY A VOTE THE SOUTH KOREANS WERE REMOVED AND THE APPLICATIONS OF BOTH NORTH AND SOUTH VIETNAM APPROVED. THE VIETNAMESE APPLICATIONS WILL GO TO THE ADMISSIONS COMMISSION OF THE UN TOMORROW FOR A FINAL VOTE.

ISRAELI "NUCLEAR OPTION" RESURFACES

AUG. 6 (IPS)--TALK OF AN ISRAELI NUCLEAR ATTACK AGAINST THE ARABS IN A NEW MIDDLE EAST WAR SURFACED AGAIN THIS WEEK FROM

A NUMBER OF ISRAELIS, ZIONIST SOURCES, AND U.S. MILITARY ANALYSTS. THE SPATE OF ARTICLES AND SPEECHES ON ISRAEL'S "NUCLEAR OPTION" WAS MOST LIKELY PROVOKED BY THE SHARP ARAB TURN TOWARD SUPPORT PROPOSALS SIMILAR TO THAT OF THE ICLC'S INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT BANK. STRIPPED OF ALL REAL INFLUENCE IN THE MIDDLE EAST, ROCKEFELLER AND KISSINGER ARE RESORTING TO EMPTY NUCLEAR BLACKMAIL THREATS AGAINST PRO-DEVELOPMENT ARAB MOTION LED BY THE IRAQIS.

LEADING THE PACK OF ISRAELI NUCLEAR-WARRIORS WAS FRED IKLE, HEAD OF THE ARMS CONTROL AND DISARMAMENT AGENCY. RAND MAN IKLE, IN A STATEMENT ON NBC'S "MEET THE PRESS," SOUNDED THE ALARM THAT THE NEXT MIDEAST WAR "OR THE ONE THEREAFTER" COULD BE A NUCLEAR ONE, ACCORDING TO THE AUGUST 4 JERUSALEM POST.

MORE OMINOUSLY, THE AUG. 8 JEWISH PRESS, PUBLISHED IN BROOKLYN, N.Y. OVERTLY WARNED THAT ISRAEL MAY BE "FORCED" TO USE ITS "TEN NUCLEAR BOMBS" IF U.S. DELIVERIES OF CONVENTIONAL WEAPONS ARE DELAYED. "ISRAEL COULD BE FORCED TO USE HER NUCLEAR WEAPONRY IF CHALLENGED," STATED A HIGH ISRAELI OFFICIAL QUOTED IN THE JEWISH PRESS. A SIMILAR ARTICLE APPEARED IN THE AGNELLI-CONTROLLED ITALIAN DAILY LA STAMPA YESTERDAY.

DR. AMNON SELA, A "WELL-KNOWN ISRAELI AUTHORITY ON SOVIET AFFAIRS," ACCORDING TO THE U.S. JOURNAL, FURTHER WARNS THAT A FIFTH ARAB-ISRAELI WAR "WILL EMPLOY THE MOST SOPHISTICATED AND DESTRUCTIVE WEAPONRY"—S H O R T OF ATOMIC WEAPONS. THE PRESENT "PRECARIOUS" MIDDLE EAST BALANCE "CREATES A FERTILE GROUND FOR A VARIETY OF PREEMPTIVE STRIKES," CLAIMS DR. SELA.

SUCH ACADEMIC DEBATE OVER THE LIKELIHOOD OF ISRAELI USE OF ITS PROVEN NUCLEAR CAPABILITY IN THE PAGES OF THE PRO-ISRAELI PRESS SURFACES ON OCCASION AS A WARNING TO THE ARABS. AS IPS HAS CONSISTENTLY DOCUMENTED, ANY ISRAELI USE OF ATOMIC BOMBS IS DIRECTLY THE RESULT OF THE RAND-CIA DOCTRINE OF LIMITED NUCLEAR WAR—THE SCHLESINGER DOCTRINE. SINCE LAST FALL, THE ROCKEFELLER FORCES HAVE THREATENED TO TEST THIS DOCTRINE IN THE MIDDLE EAST.

THE ARTICLE REPORTED IMMINENT CHINESE TESTING OF ICBM'S FROM THEIR TIBET MISSILE RANGE.

--WRITING IN PRAVDA AUG. 4, ALEXANDER FILIPPOV CHARGED THAT PEKING HAS INTERVENED AGAINST INDIAN AND PAKISTANI ATTEMPTS TO NEGOTIATE A PEACEFUL SETTLEMENT OF THEIR STANDING DISPUTES. FURTHERMORE, WROTE FILIPPOV, CHINA CONTINUES TO ARM AND INSTIGATE SEPARATIST REBELS INTO THE NORTH OF INDIA.
