INTERNATIONAL PRESS WRAP-UP

GONCALVES WARNS PARTIES TO UNITE WITH PORTUGUESE REVOLUTION

AUG. 18 (IPS)--PORTUGAL'S COMMUNIST-BACKED PRIME MINISTER, GEN. VASCO GONCALVES, IN A RECENT SPEECH STATED THAT "THE PORTUGUESE PEOPLE MUST NOW RAISE THE DEMAND THAT THE POLITICAL SPLITS WITHIN THE ARMED FORCES MOVEMENT (MFA), WHICH ARE PUTTING THE UNITY OF THE MFA IN JEOPARDY, MUST BE SWIFTLY OVERCOME AND THAT THOSE (POLITICAL) PARTIES WHICH ARE DETRACTING FROM (THE RESOLUTION OF) NATIONAL PROBLEMS MUST BE SUPPRESSED."

GONCALVES STATED THAT THE MFA AND POLITICAL OPPOSITION FACT-IONS HE WAS REFERRING TO WERE DELIBERATELY DELAYING "THE SOLUTION OF DECISIVE TASKS" AND WERE "SERVING AS THE COVER FOR THOSE IN-TERNAL AND FOREIGN FORCES WHICH WISH TO ANNUL THE PORTUGUESE REV-OLUTION."

GONCALVES' SPEECH IS REPORTED IN TODAY'S EAST GERMAN NEWS-PAPER. NEUES DEUTSCHLAND.

MAOIST MRPP SUPPRESSED

AUG. 18 (IPS)—AN OFFICE OF THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY IN THE AZORES HAS BEEN DESTROYED BY A MOB COMPRISED OF FASCISTS AND MEMBERS OF THE MAOIST MRPP PARTY. ACCORDING TO ITALIAN RADIO TODAY. IN RETALIATION, PORTUGAL'S REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL HAS JUST ORDERED THE SUPPRESSION OF THE MRPP.

PREVIOUSLY. THE MRPP HAD VERBALLY APPLAUDED THE DESTRUCTION OF PCP OFFICES BY BANDS OF FASCISTS.

EXPECT ANTI-KISSINGER DEMONSTRATIONS IN ISRAEL

AUG. 18 (IPS)—VENEZUELA'S LEADING WEEKLY NEWS MAGAZINE, RESUMEN, UNTIL RECENTLY A CONSISTENT MOUTHPIECE OF INTERNATIONAL ROCKE-FELLER INTERESTS, IN ITS LATEST ISSUE CITES AS AUTHORITATIVE THE ANALYSIS OF THE LATIN AMERICAN LABOR COMMITTEES (LALC) ON THE HELSINKI CONFERENCE AS A "REAL ECONOMIC OFFENSIVE OF COMECON."

RESUMEN QUOTES NUEVA SOLIDARIDAD TO THE EFFECT THAT HELSINKI REPRESENTS AN INIATIVE BY THE SOVIETS TO ESTABLISH THE CONVERTIBLE RUBLE "TO FINANCE TRIANGULAR AGREEMENTS AHONG COMECON, THE THIRD WORLD, AND EUROPE," SUBSTITUTING THE DOLLAR, WHICH IS "BEING ROUTED."

RESUMEN ALSO CITES THE LALC ON TRIANGULAR TRADE ARRANGEMENTS THAT HAVE BEEN IMPLEMENTED BETWEEN COMECON AND IRAQ. AND A SIMILAR ACCORD. BEING INITIATED WITH MEXICO.

PCF PREPARES OFFENSIVE ON ITS ECONOMIC PROGRAM

AUG. 18 (IPS)—IN AN EDITORIAL STATEMENT IN TODAY'S L'HUMANITE, THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF) ASSERTS THAT ITS SUMMER FACTORY ORGANIZING CAMPAIGN HAS SUCCESSFULLY LAID THE BASIS FOR A FALL OFFENSIVE AROUND THE ECONOMIC PROGRAM LAID OUT BY ITS SECRETARY-GENERAL GEORGE MARCHAIS.

TERMING PRESIDENT GISCARD'S OWN NON-ECONOMIC POLICY A "CHLOROFORM OPERATION" AGAINST THE FRENCH WORKING CLASS, THE EDITORIAL CONTINUES: "THE RESPONSE (TO GISCARD) MUST PE IMMEDIATE; THE STRUGGLE OBJECTIVES RECENTLY PROPOSED BY THE PCF GO PRECISELY IN THIS DIRECTION. AUG. 18 (IPS)—CHARLES PASOUA, VICE PRESIDENT OF FRANCE'S GUALLIST PARTY (UDR), SAID TO A JOURNALIST AUGUST 16: "I AM A FIERCE DEFENDER OF FREE ENTERPRISE, BUT OF THE BOSSES WHO DRAG THEIR FEET, WE MUST ENVISAGE RESTRUCTURINGS, HASTEN THE EVOLUTION OF THINGS, AND, IF NECESSARY, GO AS FAR AS NATIONALIZATIONS. THUS, WE WOULD NOT LEAVE CERTAIN ECONOMIC CONTROL WEAPONS IN THE HANDS OF OUR OPPONENTS. AFTER ALL, SO FAR AS NATIONALIZATIONS ARE CONCERNED, WE GAULLISTS HAVE SHOWED THE WAY IN THE PAST."

THIS STATEMENT APPEARS IN TODAYS LE FICARO.

EL MOUDJAHID ACCUSES PONIATOWSKI OF DISTORTING HISTORY

AUGUST 18 (IPS)—COMMENTING ON A RECENT SPEECH MADE BY FRENCH INTERIOR MINISTER PONIATOWSKI AT THE PRESENTATION OF A MEMORIAL TO THE FRENCH AFRICAN ARMY, THE ALGERIAN NEWSPAPER EL MOUDJAHID STATED. "AS FOR PONIA, THE BEST DEMONSTRATION OF RECOGNITION THAT HE COULD GIVE OUR PEOPLE, WOULD BE TO TRANSLATE THE NOSTALGIA FOR THE OAS (FRENCH FASCISTS IN ALGERIA) AND OTHER FASCISTS, OF FLAGRANT AGGRESSIONS AGAINST THE ALGERIAN IMMIGRANT COMMUNITY IN FRANCE, BEFORE THE COURTS OF HIS COUNTRY AND MAKE THEM RECALL, IF NEEDED, CERTAIN HISTORICAL TRUTHS WHICH THERE IS A TENDENCY TO FORGET."

TO DATE PONIATOWSKI HAS LARGELY IGNORED ALGERIAN GOVERNMENT COMPLAINTS ABOUT TERROR ATTACKS ON ALGERIAN IMMIGRANT WORKERS IN FRANCE.

GANDHI COMMENTS ON BANGLADESH

AUG. 17 (IPS)—INDIAN PRIME MINISTER INDIRA GANDHI. IN HER FIRST STATEMENT ON THE COUP IN BANGLADESH INDICATED THAT "INDIA WOULD NOT KNOW HOW TO REMAIN INSENSIBLE TO THE EVENTS IN BANGLADESH."

CURRENTLY, THE FOREIGN MINISTER OF THE DEPOSED MUJIB GOVERN-MENT, KAMAL HOSSEIN, IS IN NEW DELHI IN DISCUSSIONS WITH INDIAN FOREIGN MINISTER CHAVAN. HOSSEIN WAS IN EUROPE AT THE TIME OF THE COUP, ON HIS WAY TO LIMA.

YUGOSLAVIA: BENGALI COUP BLOW TO NON-ALIGNED

AUG. 18 (IPS)—THE GOVERNMENT OF YUGOSLAVIA EXPRESSED TODAY
DEEP REGRET OVER THE DEATH OF BANGLADESH LEADER MUJIBUR REHMAN
AND INDICATED THAT THE PRO-U.S. COUP IN BANGLADESH IS A "HEAVY BLOW
AGAINST THE NON-ALIGNED NATIONS OF THE WORLD."

IN AN ARTICLE TITLED "LOSS FOR THE NON-ALIGNED" TODAY'S FRANKFURTER ALLGEMEINE ZEITUNG, INDICATES THAT PRESIDENT TITO EXPECTS "DEEP ROOTED CHANGES IN THE BANGLADESH GOVERNMENT" AS A RESULT OF THE MUJIBUR'S DEATH.

AT THE TIME OF THE COUP, BENGALI FOREIGN MINISTER KAMAL HOSSEIN WAS IN BELGRADE DISCUSSING WITH TITO PREPARATIONS FOR THE COMING LIMA NON-ALIGNED CONFERENCE.

US PRESS GOES SCHIZOID ON PORTUGAL

AUGUST 18 (IPS)—MAJOR BOURGEOIS U.S. DAILY NEWSPAPERS REACTED TODAY IN BLATANT SCHIZOID FASHION TO THE LATEST DEVELOPMENTS IN PORTUGAL. MOST NEWSPAPERS CONTAINED HIGHLY CONTRADICTORY NEWS REPORTS AND COMMENTARIES ON THE SITUATION:

\*STRAIGHT COVERAGE WAS PROVIDED TODAY BY THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE

(MORE)

WHICH, IN A FRONT PAGE ARTICLE REPORTED THAT "THE SIEGE OF ALCOBACA BEGAN WITH 100 HARD-FACED MEN WHO CALL THEMSELVES SOC-IALISTS AND CHRISTIANS, BUT WHO TURNED INTO COMMON THUGS DETERMINED TO DRAW COMMUNIST BLOOD...THE ANTI-COMMUNIST PREMEDITATED ATTACK PROBABLY CREATED A TACTICAL VICTORY FOR PORTUGAL'S COMMUNIST LEADER ALVARO CUNHAL." AN ACCOMPANYING PICTURE, CAPTIONED, PORTRAYS THE COMMUNISTS AS THE "THUGS".

\*THE NEW YORK TIMES REPORTS THE EVENTS AS A "HUMILIATING DEFEAT FOR THE PCP AND CUNHAL, CHARGING CUNHAL WITH "PROVOCATIONS" WHICH LED TO VIOLENCE IN ALCOBACA.

\*THE BALTIMORE SUN RUNS A FRONT PAGE PICURE OF CUNHAL, SAYING HE "STANDS UNRUFFLED" AT THE PCP RALLY IN THE NORTH. AN ACCOMPANYING "NEWS" ACCOUNT, HOWEVER, UNDER A HEADLINE "COMMUNIST RALLY CRUMBLES IN PORTUGAL" CHARACTERIZED CUNHAL AS "LOOKING TIRED, HIS EYES BLOODSHOT" AND AS HAVING SUFFERED A "HUMILIATING" DEFEAT AT ALCOBACA.

GAULLIST COLUMNIST SUPPORTS PCP

AUG. 18 (IPS)—LE MONDE'S GAULLIST COLUMNIST BERTRAND FESSARD DE FOUCAULT WRITES TODAY THAT "IN PORTUGAL AS WELL AS FRANCE, IT IS NOT THE COMMUNISTS WHOM ONE SHOULD QUESTION ABOUT DEMOCRACY. BUT THE "SOCIAL-DEMOCRATIC" AND "CHRISTIAN" DEMONSTRATORS THERE, AND THE GOVERNMENT HERE. KISSINGER TO HOLD BRAINWASHING SESSION FOR BLACK CONGRESSMEN

AUG. 18 (IPS)—SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER WILL MEET TOMORROW WITH MEMBERS OF THE BLACK CONGRESSIONAL CAUCUS IN WASH-INGTON TO DISCUSS "DIPLOMATIC MATTERS IN AFRICA," TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES REPORTS. INDICATIONS ARE THAT MR. KISSINGER WILL ATTEMPT TO BRAINWASH THE CAUCUS MEMBERS INTO SUPPORTING THE CIA'S BLOODY DESTABLIZATION OF ANGOLA.

KISSINGER CONFIRMS RIFTS, BREAKDOWN OF STATE DEPT. BUREAUCRACY

VAIL, COLO., AUG. 18 (IPS)—SPEAKING TO A NEWS CONFERENCE HERE YESTERDAY, SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER INADVERTENTLY REVEALED THE SEVERE RIFTS INSIDE THE STATE DEPARTMENT BETWEEN HIMSELF AND A GROWING NUMBER OF CAREER DIPLOMATS AND FOREIGN SERVICE OFFICERS. ASKED BY NEWSMEN TO COMMENT ON REPORTS THAT HE HAD TRANSFERRED FORMER U.S. AMBASSADOR TO TANZANIA, W. BEVERLY CARTER, TO THE U.S. INFORMATION AGENCY, KISSINGER REPLIED, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S BALTIMORE SUN, "TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE — AND I AM NOT ALWAYS TOLD EVERYTHING IN THE STATE DEPARTMENT — AMBASSADOR CARTER HAS NOT BEEN TRANSFERRED OUT OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT." KISSINGER IS REPORTEDLY UPSET THAT CARTER NEGOTIATED DIRECTLY WITH TERRORISTS IN A TERRORIST INCIDENT IN TANZANIA LAST MAY. AT HIS NEWS CONFERENCE, KISSINGER ACCUSED CARTER OF ENGAGING IN "AN INDEPENDENT PUBLICITY CAMPAIGN OF HIS OWN."

MICHIGAN HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES VOTES TO INVESTIGATE COMMON CAUSE

AUG. 18 (IPS)—THE MICHIGAN STATE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES VOTED LAST WEEK TO INVESTIGATE COMMON CAUSE'S "LEGITIMACY" AND "SERIOUSNESS" AS A LOBBYING ORGANIZATION FOLLOWING ITS FAILURE TO REPORT MONEY IT SPENT ON LOBBYING EXPENSES.

THE RESOLUTION, INITIATED BY CONSERVATIVE REP. QUINCY HOFFMAN, FOLLOWS COMMON CAUSE'S SUCCESSFULLY RAMMING A POLITICAL REFORM BILL PAST THE STATE LEGISLATURE.

BEFORE PASSING THE BILL TO INVESTIGATE COMMON CAUSE, THE HOUSE STRUCK A PROVISION WHICH WOULD HAVE ALLOWED A HOUSE COMMITTEE TO EXAMINE THE RECORDS OF CORPORTATIONS WHICH MAY HAVE DONATED MONEY TO COMMON CAUSE. IN A PARANOID PROJECTION, COMMON CAUSE CHAIR-PERSON SUSAN RENNELS STATED THAT SHE FEARS THE INVESTIGATION WILL BECOME "A WITCH HUNT."

SAN FRANCISCO MAYOR ALIOTO SAYS MUNI WORKERS WILL BE FIRED IF THEY STRIKE

SAN FRANCISCO, AUG. 18 (IPS)—MAYOR ALIOTO ANNOUNCED YESTERDAY THAT ANY CITY WORKER WHO WALKS OFF THE JOB WILL BE FIRED, AFTER POLICE, FIREMEN, AND CITY TRANSPORT WORKERS THREATENED TO STRIKE! OVER NEW CONTRACT DEMANDS. ACCORDING TO THE SAN FRANCISCO EXAMINER, THE POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION HAS ANNOUNCED THAT A POLICE STRIKE WILL OCCUR TOMORROW IF THEIR DEMANDS FOR A 13% WAGE INCREASE ARE

NOT MET. BUS DRIVERS WILL VOTE TODAY AND FIREMEN TOMORROW ON STRIKE ACTION AGAINST THE CITY.

THE SAN FRANCISCO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HAS OFFERED ONLY A 6 PERCENT INCREASE, AND HAS ALREADY LAID OFF MANY TEMPORARY CITY WORKERS AND IMPLEMENTED OTHER CUTS IN CITY SERVICES.

ROCKEFELLER FLUNKEY TO ORGANIZE FOR NYC CHARTER REFORM

AUG. 18 (IPS) — ARCHIBALD GILLIES, A FORMER AID TO NELSON ROCKEFELLER WHEN HE WAS GOVERNOR OF NEW YORK STATE, WILL HEAD UP A NEW GROUP WHICH WILL ORGANIZE SUPPORT FOR THE FASCIST NEW YORK CITY CHARTER REFORM REFERENDUM TO BE VOTED ON THIS NOVEMBER. ACCORDING TO THE NEW YORK TIMES, MR. GILLIES WILL STEP DOWN FROM HIS POSITION AS HEAD OF THE WHITNEY FOUNDATION IN ORDER TO PUSH THE CHARTER, BUT HIS SALARY WILL STILL BE PAID BY JOHN HAY WHITNEY, WHO THE TIMES IDENTIFIES AS ONE OF THE WEALTHIEST SUPPORTERS OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY.

ALMOST ALL OF THE ANNUAL \$1 MILLION BUDGET OF THE WHITNEY FOUNDATION HAS BEEN SPENT SO "THAT GOVERNMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY CAN BE BROUGHT DOWN TO THE NEIGHBORHOOD LEVEL", ACCORDING TO THE TIMES.
