SEPT. 5 (IPS)—YESTERDAY'S AVANTE, THE WEEKLY NEWSPAPER OF THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP), WARNS THE U.S. MAFIOSO AMBASSADOR TO PORTUGAL, "FRANKIE" CARLUCCI, NOT TO DELUDE HIMSELF THAT IMPASSES CAUSED BY A NUMBER OF OLD-REGIME COMNECTED OFFICERS IN PORTUGAL'S ARMED FORCES MOVEMENT (MFA) WILL SUFFICE TO LIQUIDATE THE ALLIANCE BETWEEN THE WORKING CLASS AND ITS MFA MILITARY ALLIES. "THE FATE OF THE REVOLUTION IS MOT DECIDED IN THE HEAVENLY SPHERES. IT IS DECIDED BY THE STRUGGLE IN THE FACTORIES, IN THE FIRMS, IN THE FARMLANDS, AND IN ALL PLACES OF LABOR AND EDUCATION. IT WILL BE DECIDED IN THE ACTIVITIES OF THE TRADE UNIONS, THE ASSOCIATION OF FARMERS AND OTHER MASS ORGANIZATIONS."

SPINOLA INVASION FROM SPAIN THREATENED

SEPT. 5 (IPS)—PARAMILITARY GROUPS OF SUPPORTEPS OF THE EXILED PORTUGUESE GENERAL, ANTONIO DE SPINOLA, ARE PREPARING TO INVADE PORTUGAL VIA A ROUTE PASSING THROUGH SANTIAGO DE CAMPOSTELA AND VIGO, SPAIN, THE BRAZILIAN WEEKLY OPINIAO OF AUG. 29 REPORTS. SPINOLA'S INVADING BANDS WOULD BE COMPRISED OF "RECENTLY ARRIVED ELEMENTS FROM THE EX-COLONIES," SUCH AS ANGOLA, MEMBERS OF THE FORMER PORTUGUESE SECRET POLICE (PIDE), AND MILITARY OFFICERS WHO FLED PORTUGAL AFTER APRIL 25, 1974 AND MARCH 11, 1975. ACCORDING TO OPINIAO, SPINOLA'S BANDS COULD INCLUDE AS MANY AS 16,000 TROOPS.

STATE DEPT ON PORTUGAL: THINGS ARE LOOKING UP... LIKE CHILE

SEPT. 5 (IPS)—IN A SECRET BRIEFING TO MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE ON POLITICAL AND MILITARY AFFAIRS YESTERDAY, DEPUTY ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR EUROPEAN AFFAIRS BRUCE LAINGEN REPORTED THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT WAS MORE HOPEFUL ABOUT THE POLITICAL OUTLOOK IN PORTUGAL AS A RESULT OF THE RECENT CABINET DESTABILIZATIONS THERE.

STATE DEPARTMENT SOURCES TOLD THE NEW YORK TIMES, IN AN ARTICLE IN TODAY'S EDITION, THAT THE U.S. WAS RELYING ON AN ALLIANCE BETWEEN MAJOR ERNESTO MELO ANTUNES AND FASCIST PSP-LEADER MARIO SOARES TO DISRUPT THE PRO-COMMUNIST CONSOLIDATION OF THE GOVERNMENT. THE SAME SOURCES THEN WARHED THE PCP TO BACK DOWN IN ORDER TO "AVOID A CONFRONTATION SUCH AS DEVELOPED IN CHILE...WHEN A PIGHT-WING MILITARY JUNTA OVERTHREW...ALLENDE."

BRITISH TUC CALLS FOR DEFENSE OF PORTUGUESE DEMOCRACY

SEPT. 5 (IPS)—THE ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE BRITISH TRADES UNION CONGRESS YESTERDAY CALLED FOR "SOLIDARITY AND SUPPORT FOR ALL THOSE IN SPAIN AND PORTUGAL FIGHTING TO END FASCISM AND ESTABLISH DEMOCRACY," ADN. THE EAST GERMAN NEWS AGENCY REPORTS.

MICK MCGAHEY, COMMUNIST VICE PRESIDENT OF THE MATIONAL UNION OF MINE WORKERS WHO INTRODUCED THE MOTION, SAID, "TO DEFEAT THE RIGHT IT IS NECESSARY TO HAVE THE UNITY OF THE DEMOCRATIC FORCES, THE COMMUNISTS, SOCIALISTS, AMD THE ARMED FORCES MOVEMENT."

PASSAGE OF THE COMMUNIST-BACKED RESOLUTION BY THE T.J.C. COMES AS BRITAIN'S PRIME MINISTER HAROLD WILSON IS HOSTING AN INTERNATIONAL MEETING OF SECOND INTERNATIONAL AGENTS IN LONDON TO PLAN A FASCIST COUP IN PORTUGAL.

WEST GERMAN OP LEADER BLASTS WILLY BRANDT

SEPT. 5 (IPS)—WEST GERMAN CP-HEAD MERBERT WIES HAS ISSUED AN UNPRECEDENTED DENUNCIATION OF GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRACY HEAD WILLI BRANDT, WHO IS NOW IN LONDON MEETING WITH OTHER SECOND INTERNATIONAL LEADERS DISCUSSING INTERVENTION AGAINST THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) LED PORTUGUESE WORKING CLASS. WIES, IN AN OPEN LETTER TO BRANDT, TELLS BRANDT TO STOP HIS CONTINUAL MEDDLING IN PORTUGUESE INTERNAL AFFAIRS, TO STOP SUPPORTING PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST PARTY LEADER MARIO SOARES, A CIA AGENT, AND IN GENERAL TO DESIST FROM SABOTAGING THE WEEKS-OLD HELSINKI AGREEMENT WHICH COMMITS SIGNATORY NATIONS SUCH AS WEST GERMANY TO NON-INTERFERENCE IN OTHER COUNTRY'S AFFAIRS.

PORTUGUESE MILITARY IN ANGOLA DEMOUNCES ARMY ASSEMBLY RESOLUTIONS

SEPT. 5 (IPS)—OFFICERS, NOM-COMMISSIONED OFFICERS, AND SOLDIERS OF THE MFA UNITS STATIONED IN ANGOLA ARE PUBLICLY CONTESTING THE LEGITIMACY OF THE 3D DELEGATES WHO SUPPOSEDLY REPRESENTED THEM AT THE ARMY ASSEMBLY MEETING HELD AT TANCOS AIR BASE, PORTUGAL, LAST TUESDAY, ACCORDING TO AN EAST GERMAN PRESS AGENCY (ADN) DISPATCH ISSUED YESTERDAY. THE DENUNCIATION CAME FOLLOWING A MEETING OF PORTUGUESE MILITARY HELD IN ANGOLA'S CAPITAL CITY OF LUANDA, THE DAY FOLLOWING THE TANCOS MEETING. THE TANCOS MEETING WAS PACKED WITH SUPPORTERS OF THE ARMY HEAD, GAM. CARLOS FARIAO, A NATO AGENT.

GISCARD PLAN LAUNCHED

SEPT. 5 (IPS)—IN A TELEVISED ADDRESS TO THE FRENCH NATION LAST NIGHT, FRENCH PRESIDENT GISCARD D'ESTAING PUBLICLY CEDED FRENCH ECONOMIC POLICY TO FRANCE'S INDUSTRIAL MONOPOLIES. THE ADDRESS WAS A PRESENTATION IN FINAL FORM OF CISCARD'S \$7 BILLION REFLATIONARY ECONOMIC PROGRAM FOR THE NEW BUSINESS YEAR WHICH WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE FRENCH PARLIAMENT NEXT WEEK FOR DEBATE. THE PLAN HAS BEEN REVISED THREE TIMES IN THE PAST 10 DAYS.

EARLY REPORTS INDICATED THAT THE PRIMARY FOCUS OF THE PLAN WAS TO HAVE BEEN INCREASED CONSUMPTION AND REDUCED UNEMPLOYMENT: THE FINAL REVISED PLAN CALLS FOR ONLY \$1.1 BILLION GOING TO SUBSIDIES FOR THE AGED AND FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN, \$2.84 BILLION IN CORPORATE TAX REBATES AND TAX POSTPONEMENTS FOR INDUSTRY, AND \$3.01 BILLION IN PUBLIC WORKS—OF WHICH OVER \$900 MILLION WILL GO FOR SOFT LOANS TO INDUSTRY.

GEORGES SEGUY, HEAD OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY-ALLIED TRADE UNION, THE CGT, IMMEDIATELY RESPONDED TO THE PLAM, BLASTING IT AS AN ANTI-WORKING-CLASS PROGRAM. TODAY'S U.S. PRESS UNANIMOUSLY AGREE THAT THE PLAN WILL HAVE MINIMAL IMMEDIATE IMPACT ON UNEMPLOYMENT.

PCF'S MARCHAIS: "GISCARD BLUFFS"

SEPT. 5 (IPS)--FRENCH PRESIDENT GISCARD D'ESTAING'S LONG-AMAITED ECONOMIC RELAUNCHING PLAN IS A "BLUFF," SAID FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY GENERAL SECRETARY GEORGES MARCHAIS AT A PRESS CONFERENCE YESTERDAY, REPORTS TODAY'S L'HUMANITE. "HIS PLAN DOES NOT RELAUNCH POPULAR CONSUMPTION, DOES NOT DEVELOP ECONOMIC ACTIVITY AND EMPLOYMENT, DOES NOT PERMIT INFLATION TO BE BRAKED, DOES NOT GO AFTER INEQUALITIES. SOCIAL IMJUSTICE AND WASTE."

GISCARD'S PLAN "ANNOUNCES HARD DAYS FOR WORKERS AND THEIR FAM-ILIES," MARCHAIS SAID, AND DEMANDED THAT FRANCE BREAK ANAY FROM THE DOMINATION OF U.S. AND WEST GERMAN MULTINATIONAL CONTROL.

RABIN CALLS FOR U.S.-SOVIET COOPERATION

SEPT. 5 (IPS)—ISRAELI PRIME MINISTER YITZAK RABIN YESTERDAY CALLED FOR "SOME MEASURE" OF UNITED STATES-SOVIET COOPERATION "IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE AN OVER-ALL SETTLEMENT OF THE ARAB-ISRAELI CONFLICT." THE STATEMENT WAS MADE IN AN INTERVIEW WITH THE ISRAELI LABOR PARTY NEWSPAPER, DAVOR.

SOVIETS BOYCOTT SIGNING OF SINAI PACT

SEPT. 5 (IPS)--THE SOVIET UNION YESTERDAY BOYCOTTED THE SIGNING OF THE SINAI PACT IN GENEVA AS A DEMONSTRATION OF ITS DISAPPROVAL OF THE KISSINGER-ORCHESTRATED SINAI AGREEMENT, ACCORDING TO TO-DAY'S WASHINGTON POST.

THE BOYCOTT WAS FOLLOWED BY AN ANTI-SOVIET TIRADE BY EGYPTIAN PRESIDENT ANWAR SADAT.

ABORTED COUP IN SUDAN

SEPT. 5 (IPS)—A COUP ATTEMPT BY A GROUP OF UNKNOWN OFFICERS WAS QUICKLY ABORTED LAST NIGHT IN SUDAN, ACCORDING TO CBS PADIO. PRE-LIMINARY INDICATIONS ARE THAT THE ATTEMPTED OVERTHROW OF THE NU-MEIRY GOVERNMENT WAS A REFLECTION OF REACTIONS IN THE ARAB SECTOR AGAINST THE SIGNING-OF THE SIMAL INTERIM SETTLEMENT BY EGYPTIAN PRESIDENT ANWAR SADAT.

EGYPT AND SUDAN HAVE CLOSE POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC RELATIONS.

WHITE HOUSE TO TUPN OVER "CHILE PAPERS"

SEPT. 5 (IPS)—MINUTES OF THE MATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL'S SECRET "40 COMMITTEE" CONCERNING NIXON ADMINISTRATION ATTEMPTS TO DE-STABILIZE OR OVERTHROW THE ALLENDE GOVERNMENT WILL BE FURNIED OVER TO THE SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES.

THE COMMITTEE HAD SUBPORMARD THE WHITE HOUSE FOR THE DOCUMENTS CONCERNING CHILE AND FOR DOCUMENTS ON THE SO-CALLED HUSTON PLAN TO EXPAND DOMESTIC INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES.

ONTARIO COMMUNIST PARTY TURNS NEW ELECTION LAW AGAINST MEDIA

SEPT. 5 (IPS)—THE ONTARIO COMMITTEE OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CANADA (CPC) HAS NON A MAJOR VICTORY AGAINST THE NEW PROVINCIAL ELECTION FINANCING LAW WHICH WAS ORIGINALLY DESIGNED TO BAR SMALL PARTIES LIKE THE CPC AND THE MORTH AMERICAN LABOR PARTY (NALP) FROM ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN ELECTIONS. HAVING SUBMITTED THE REQUIRED 10,000 PETITION SIGNATURES TO REGISTER AS A PARTY WITHIN THE RIDICULOUSLY SHORI PERIOD MANDATED BY THE NEW LAW, THE CP HAS FILED COMPLAINTS AGAINST THE MAJOR NEWS MEDIA IN ONTARIO WHICH HAVE FAILED TO GIVE EQUAL COVERAGE TO THE CPC'S 33 CANDIDATES IN THE UPCOMING ELECTION. IN ADDITION TO THE TORONTO STAR, THE TORONTO TELEVISION STATION CFTO AND THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION OF ONTARIO HAVE BEEN OFFICIALLY NARMED BY THE NEW COMMISSION ON ELECTION CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENSES THAT THEIR DISCRIMINATION AGAINST THE CPC IS NOW BEING MONITORED BY THE COMMISSION FOR VIOLATIONS UNDER THE NEW LAW.

KISSINGER SAYS "NO" TO DEBT MORATORIUM

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y., SEPT. 5 (IPS)—SECPETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER TOLD A GROUP OF MORE THAN 100 DEPORTERS AT A PRESS CONFERENCE HERE TODAY THAT "I WOULD NOT FAVO OUTRIGHT CANCELLATION" OF THIRD WORLD DEBT. KISSINGER MADE THIS ADMISSION IN RESPONSE TO AN IPS CORRESPONDENT WHO ASKED HIM IF, GIVEN THE UNIFORMLY UNFAVORABLE RECEPTION TO HIS SPEECH MONDAY TO THE UN SPECIAL SESSION ON DEVELOPMENT, HE WOULD CONSIDER MAKING A PRO-DEBT MORATOR—IUM STAND ALONG THE LINES OF THAT PROPOSED YESTERDAY BY SWEDISH MINISTER OF STATE LINDBLOM. KISSINGER AT FIRST TRIED TO PUNT ON THE QUESTION, CLAIMING THAT HIS SPEECH WAS "NOT A FINAL PROPOSAL" BUT MERELY "A NEGOTIATING DOCUMENT," AND THAT, FURTHERMORE, HE HAD NOT YET "STUDIED" THE LINDBLOM PROPOSAL. HOWEVER, WHEN IPS INSISTED THAT HE DIRECTLY ADDRESS THE QUESTION OF DEBT MORATORIUM,

A CLEARLY UNNERVED KISSINGER BLURTED OUT HIS CITED RESPONSE, ADD-ING THAT HE DID FAVOR "DEBT REMEGOTATION" IN CERTAIN CASES, IF IT WAS TIED TO "SPECIFIC DEVELOPMENT (I.E., SLAVE LABOR--ED.) PROJECTS." KISSINGER THEN ENDED THE PRESS CONFERENCE.

ILLUSTRATING HIS CONTEMPT FOR THIRD WORLD CONCERNS, KISSINGER TIMED HIS PRESS CONFERENCE TO COINCIDE WITH THAT OF THE PRO-DE-VELOPMENT IRADIS, FORCING THEM TO POSTPONE THEIR OWN.

BANKERS TO MONOPOLIZE MYC DEBT HEARINGS

SEPT. 5 (IPS)--NEW YORK CITY CONGRESSMAN BENJAMIN ROSENTHAL HAS SCHEDULED HOUSE BANKING COMMITTEE HEARINGS ON THE IMPLICATIONS OF A DEFAULT BY NEW YORK CITY. "ONLY BANKS AND BROKERAGE FIRMS WILL TESTIFY," A ROSENTHAL AIDE SAID. "THERE IS NO ROOM FOR THE U.S. LABOR PARTY AT THESE HEARINGS."
