NATO PRAISES GONCALVES RESIGNATION: WILL HOLD MEETING ON PORTUGAL

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—NATO HEADQUARTERS IN BRUSSELS EXPRESSED ITS JOY OVER RECENT EVENTS IN PORTUGAL, ESPECIALLY THE RESIGNATION OF EX-PREMIER VASCO GONCALVES AS ARMED FORCES CHIEF OF STAFF. NATO WILL HOLD A TWO-DAY MEETING THIS WEEK TO DISCUSS PORTUGAL, REPORTS EAST GER-MAN RADIO.

PRO-CP LISBON PRESS DENOUNCE RIGHTWING MANUEVERS

SEPT. 7 (1PS)-LISBON'S EVENING NEWSPAPERS YESTERDAY COMMENTED THAT RIGHTWING MILITARY MANUEVERING AT FRIDAY'S TANCOS MEETING. WHICH LED TO THE PURGING OF GEN. VASCO GONCALVES AND SEVERAL OTHER PRO-COMMUNIST OFFICERS FROM THE REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL. CONSTITUTES "EVEN GREATER DANGERS FOR THE REVOLUTION. AND IT CAN ONLY BE A VICTORY FOR THE INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL REACTION." ACCORDING TO EAST GERMAN TELEVISION YESTERDAY.

### PCP YOUTH DEMONSTRATE IN LISPON

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—THOUSANDS OF PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY YOUTH DE-MONSTRATED IN LISBON YESTERDAY TO CALL FOR THE UNIFICATION OF ALL DEMOCRATIC PARTIES. THEY ALSO CALLED FOR THE "DEFENSE OF THE ACH-IEVEMENTS OF THE REVOLUTION AGAINST THE FASCIST ATTACKS." REPORTS EAST GERMAN RADIO.

# SOVIETS BLAST IMPERIALIST INTERVENTIONS IN PORTUGAL. ANGOLA

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—TODAY'S PRAVDA, ORGAN OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF THE SOVIET UNION, SHARPLY ATTACKS "THE APPARATUS OF IMPERIALIST PROPAGANDA" WHICH "IS MOBILIZED TO DISCREDIT THE ATTITUDE OF THE COMMUNISTS IN THEIR DEFENSE OF THE REVOLUTION" IN PORTUGAL. "THEY ALSO PROVOKE SOME MILITARY UNITS TO COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY ACTIONS," STATES PRAVDA. "THE ENEMIES OF THE PORTUGUESE REVOLUTION AND THEIR SUPPORTERS IN THE IMPERIALIST PRESS ARE THE ACCOMPLICES OF THE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES NOW THREATENING ANGOLA." REPORTS ON THE ARTICLE WERE CARRED THROUGHOUT THE NIGHT ON "VOICE OF EAST GERMANY" RADIO.

### EAST GERMAN TRADE MINISTER STRESSES 3PD WORLD TIES -

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—SPEAKING AT THE HEAVILY ATTENDED INTERNATIONAL TRADE FAIR IN LEIPZIG, EAST GERMANY YESTERDAY, EAST GERMAN FOREIGN TRADE MINISTER HORST SOELLE SAID THAT HIS COUNTRY HAS MADE GREAT PROGRESS IN TRADE AND ECONOMIC COOPERATION WITH THE DEVELOPING SECTOR. THE BERLIN DAILY, NEUES DEUTSCHLAND, REPORTING SOELLE'S STATEMENT, NOTED THAT EAST GERMAN TRADE WITH IRAQ HAS INCREASED SIX-FOLD AND WITH ALGERIA THREE-FOLD IN THE PAST THREE YEARS.

### INDIA FEARS MALARIA, CHOLERA SPREADING

SPET. 7 (IPS)—THE INDIAN GOVERNMENT AND THE NORLD HEALTH OR-GANIZATION (WHO) ARE WORRIED ABOUT A SHARP RISE OFMALARIACASES RE-PORTED FROM INDIA, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST. THERE ARE SOME 30,000 CASES OF THE DISEASE IN NEW DELHI ALONE — DOUBLE THAT OF THREE YEARS AGO — AND THE TIMES OF INDIA TODAY REPORTS A SHORT-AGE OF MEDICINE IN THE CAPITAL CITY.

THE INDIAN GOVERNMENT ALSO REPORTS THAT OVER 50 PEOPLE HAVE DIED OF CHOLERA IN FLOOD-STRICKEN PATNA -- CAPITAL OF THE INDIAN STATE OF BIHAR. ACCORDING TO A REPORT APPEARING IN TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES.

### CHINESE LEADER ATTACKS SOVIET INFLUENCE IN CHINA

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—CHINESE VICE-PREMIER TENG HSIO-PING IN AN INTER-VIEW WITH NEW ZEALAND JOURNALISTS "MADE CLEAR THAT A MAJOR CON-CERN OF THE PRESENT AND PREVIOUS POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS (WITHIN CHINA) WAS TO PREVENT CHINA FROM SLIPPING INTO WHAT PEKING SEES AS MOS-COM'S IDEOLOGICAL AND MORAL QUAGMIRE, " ACCORDING TO TODAY'S WASH-INGTON POST.

TENG ALSO TOLD THE JOURNALISTS THAT THE CURRENT CHINESE CAMPAIGN AROUND THE NOVEL "ALL MEN ARE BROTHERS" WAS "MERELY PART OF PEKING'S EFFORTS TO PREVENT A RESTORATION OF CAPITALISM."

### GROMYKO INVITED TO THAILAND

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—THAILAND HAS INVITED SOVIET FOREIGN MINISTER ANDREI GROMYKO TO VISIT BANGKOK TO CONCLUDE A CULTURAL AGREEMENT AND DISCUSS A SOVIET REQUEST TO OPEN A MILITARY MISSION THERE. THAI FOREIGN MINISTER CHATICHAI CHOONHAVEN HAS STATED IN AN INTERVIEW REPORTED ON IN TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST.

#### RASKIN: DEBT MORATORIUM LIKELY IN NYC

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—THERE IS A "LIKELIHOOD" OF A MORATORIUM FOR A YEAR OR LONGER ON ANY PAYMENTS OF INTEREST OR PRINCIPAL" TO NEW YORK CITY'S BONDHOLDERS, INCLUDING "SOME OF THE COUNTRY'S LARGEST BANKS, BROKERAGE HOUSES AND INSURANCE COMPANIES," ACKNOWLEDGES A.H. RASKIN, WRITING ON NEW YORK CITY'S ECONOMIC CRISIS IN TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES.

RASKIN'S PIECE ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THE EDITORIAL SECTION ANTI-CIPATES THE ROCKEFELLER BANKING COMMUNITY'S WORST FEARS: A DEBT MORATORIUM PASSED INTO LAW AND INCLUDING PROVISION FOR BRINGING SERVICES BACK UP TO 1972 LEVELS.

### FORD FOUNDATION ACHIEVING DESTRUCTION OF LITERACY

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS TAKING THE COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION BOARD EXAMS THIS YEAR HAVE SCORED LOWER THAN EVER. CAPPING A 12-YEAR DECLINE IN THE TEST SCORES, WHICH MEASURES BASIC SKILLS IN LANGUAGE AND MATH, ACCORDING TO A FRONT-PAGE ARTICLE IN THE WASHINGTON POST TODAY.

MANY EDUCATORS LINK THE DISASTROUS DECLINE TO RELIANCE ON SO-CALLED "INNOVATIVE" PROGRAMS BASED ON BEHAVIORIST PSYCHOLOGY — PROGRAMS DEVELOPED ALMOST EXCLUSIVELY BY THE FORD FOUNDATION.

IN A COMPANION PIECE, THE POST OUTLINES MOVES MADE BY MANY COM-MUNITIES TO RUTURN TO BASIC EDUCATION, INDICATING WORKING-CLASS DISGUST WITH PROGRAMS DESIGNED TO UNDERMINE CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT.

### SECURITY CLASS UPSETS NSA. ACDA

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—THE CENTER FOR DEFENSE INFORMATION (CDI) HEADED BY FORMER REAR ADMIRAL GENE LAROCQUE IS CONDUCTING A CLASS ON "U.S. NATONAL SECURITY" FOR CONGRESSIONAL AIDES, ACCORDING TO EVANS AND NOVAK MRITING IN TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST. THE COURSE, CONDUCTED BY DR. BARRY SCHNEIDER, A COLLEAGUE OF LAROCQUE WHO LIKE HIM IS HIGHLY CRITICAL OF ADMINISTRATION FOREIGN POLICY, HAS THE NATIONAL SECURITY AGENCY AND THE ARMS CONTROL AND DISARMAMENT AGENCY UPSET. A HIGH-RANKING OFFICIAL TOLD THE COLUMNISTS "THIS (THE CDI) IS SIMPLY NOT A RESPECTABLE OUTFIT." THE TWO AGENCIES HAVE REFUSED TO SEND SPEAKERS, A USUAL PRACTICE FOR SUCH COURSES.

# PHILADELPHIA TRANSIT WORKERS OFFICIAL ENDORSES DEBT MORATORIUM

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—VINCE CAMERETTA, SECRETARY-TREASURER OF TRANSIT WORKERS UNION (TWU) LOCAL 234 IN PHILADELPHIA TOLD IPS FRIDAY THAT HE COMPLETELY SUPPORTS A DEBT MORATORIUM AND WISHES TO HAVE HIS NAME USED AS A PUBLIC BACKER OF THE MEASURE. THE TWU NEGOTIATES FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE SOUTH EASTERN PENNSYLVANIA TRANSIT AUTHORITY (SEPTA). AN INSTRUMENT FOR ONE OF THE LARGEST BOND-LOOTING SWINDLES IN U.S. MUNICIPAL HISTORY.

#### USLP TARGETS CONGRESSMEN ON PORTUGAL

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—YESTERDAY'S "OPERATIONS BULLETIN," A REPORT ON OR-GANIZING ACTIVITIES CIRCULATED DAILY BY THE U.S. LABOR PARTY TO ALL ITS ORGANIZERS, HAS DIRECTED THE U.S. LABOR PARTY REGIONAL POL-ITICAL MACHINES TO MOBILIZE LARGE-SCALE PRESSURE AGAINST TEN KEY MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE TO LAUNCH AN INVES- TIGATION INTO OPEN AND ILLEGAL CIA ACTIVITY IN PORTUGAL, AIMED AT PREPARING A "CHILE-STYLE" BLOODBATH THERE. "DESPITE ALL THE EMBARASSMENT TO CONGRESSIONAL SENSIBILITIES STEMMING FROM CHILE." THE DIRECTIVE STATES, "CONGRESS WILL NOT MOBILIZE AGAINST ANOTHER CIA-ENGINEERED 'CHILE' IN PORTUGAL UNLESS THE WORKING CLASS LETS THEM KNOW THEY MUST."

### VANCOUVER IWA MADISTS DENOUNCE DEVELOPMENT TO SABOTAGE STRIKE WAVE

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—THE LATEST ISSUE OF THE BARKER, NEWSPAPER OF LOCAL 217 OF THE INTERNATIONAL MOODWORKERS OF AMERICA (IWA) IN THE VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA AREA CARRIED TWO ARTICLES ATTESTING TO THE MAOIST IWA LEADERSHIP'S DESIRE TO SABOTAGE THE CURRENT STRIKEWAVE IN BRITISH COLUMBIA. THE FIRST WAS A REPRINT OF AN ARTICLE FROM THE BRITISH NEW STATESMAN, QUOTING HAROLD WILSON'S ATTACK ON THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY. THE SECOND WAS A DENOUNCIATION OF INDIRA GANDHI'S PRO-DEVELOPMENT REGIME IN INDIA.

THE BARKER'S STAND ON THESE TWO KEY ISSUES REPRESENTS AN IMPLICIT ATTACK ON THE GROWING ORIENTATION OF THE B.C. STRIKENAVE TOWARD THE PORTUGUESE REVOLUTION AND THE PRO-DEVELOPMENT LABOR BILL OF RIGHTS. WHICH WOULD ALLY NORTH AMERICAN WORKERS PROGRAMMATICALLY WITH GANDHI AND THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNISTS.

### CIA TERRORIST ACTIVITY INCREASING

SEPT. 7 (IPS)—COMBINED REPORTS SHOW AN UPSWING IN CIA-DEPLOYED TERRORIST BOMBING ACTIVITY THROUGHOUT THE WORLD. THE CIA'S "WEATHER UNDERGROUND", IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE RELEASE OF THE SECOND EDITION OF THE "NEWSPAPER" "PRAIRIE FIRE," HAS BOMBED THE OFFICES OF KENNECOTT COPPER IN SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH. IN ADDITION, TWO LARGE BOMBINGS, ONE IN A LONDON HOTEL AND ONE IN A BELFAST PUB BY THE "IRA", HAVE CAUSED SERIOUS INJURY TO DOZENS OF PEOPLE. ALL OF THE BOMBINGS HAPPENED ON THE SAME DAY AT THE "MANSON" ZOMBIE ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT ON PRESIDENT FORD.
