I. WORLD PRESS SUMMARY: INTERNATIONAL NEWS ROUND-UP

PCF WARNS AGAINST IIT SABOTAGE IN PORTUGAL

SEPT. 9 (IPS)--CITING THE ROLE OF THE U.S. MULTINATIONAL FIRM IIT IN UNDERMINING THE POPULAR UNITY GOVERNMENT OF SALVADOR ALLENDE IN CHILE, THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF) TODAY WARNED OF THE COMPANY'S PRESENT ACTIVITY AGAINST THE PORTUGUESE GOVERNMENT. L'HUMANITE, NEWSPAPER OF THE PCF, NOTES THAT IIT OWNS THE SHERATON HOTEL CHAIN WHOSE PARIS FACILITIES ARE PRESENTLY HOUSING EX-POR- TUGUESE GENERAL SPINOLA AND CITES A THREAT THAT IIT SUBSIDIARIES, OLIVA, RABOR AND STANDARD ELECTRIC WILL CUT OFF PORTUGAL'S COMMUNICATIONS WITH THE OUTSIDE WORLD.

PCF BLASTS LONDON SECOND INTERNATIONAL MEETING

SEPT. 9 (IPS)--TODAY'S L'HUMANITE, NEWSPAPER OF THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF), ATTACKS LAST WEEK'S LONDON MEETING OF SECOND INTERNATIONAL LEADERS, DECLARING THAT THE MEETING ON PORTUGAL HAD ONLY TWO AIMS: TO PRESERVE THE INTERESTS OF NATO AND TO ATTACK THE COMMUNISTS. ENTITLING THEIR REPORT "BRUTAL INTERFERENCE BY THE SOCIALIST LEADERS," L'HUMANITE QUESTIONS THE "CONCEPTION OF DEMOCRACY OF THIS COMMITTEE," ESPECIALLY SINCE WILLY BRANDT WAS CHOSEN AS PRESIDENT.

THE ARTICLE ALSO REPORTS THAT BRANDT WILL MEET WITH PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST LEADER MARIO SOARES IN FRANKFURT, WEST GERMANY NEXT MONDAY.

FIGHTING INTENSIFIES IN LEBANON

SEPT. 9 (IPS)--AN ESTIMATED 200 PEOPLE HAVE DIED IN THE NORTHERN LEBANESE CITY OF TRIPOLI AS THE FIGHTING BETWEEN CHRISTIANS AND MUSLIMS CONTINUES. TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST HINTS AT THE TRUTH OF THIS LATEST ROUND OF FIGHTING, STATING THAT THERE ARE FEARS "THAT THE GOVERNMENT WAS SEEKING A PRETEXT TO CRACK DOWN ON THE LEFT AND THE PALESTINIANS." THE TRIPOLI AREA IS A STRONGHOLD OF THE IRAQI-BACKED BAATHISTS.

IRISH POLICE CHARGE BRITISH SPY NETWORK IN REPUBLIC

SEPT. 9 (IPS)--OFFICIALS OF THE IRISH REPUBLIC ARE CHARGING THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT WITH HAVING "COMMITTED A DIPLOMATIC BLUNDER," IN THE WORDS OF THE LONDON DAILY TELEGRAPH IN THEIR EXPOSURE OF "THE BLONDE BOMBSHELL" WANTED FOR SEVERAL BOMBINGS IN BRITAIN.

THE BRITISH PRESS HAS PUBLISHED PICTURES OF THE WANTED WOMAN, TAKEN ALLEGEDLY BY PHOTOGRAPHERS FROM SCOTLAND YARD'S C11 DIVISION, WHICH IRISH OFFICIALS SAY RAISE THE IMPLICATION "THAT UNDERCOVER PEOPLE WERE AT WORK IN THIS TERRITORY. WE HAVE SAID BEFORE THAT THIS IS NOT ACCEPTABLE." OFFICIALS ALSO CHARGE THAT SCOTLAND YARD'S USE OF THE MATERIAL IS AIMED SOLELY AT EMBARRASSING THE IRISH GOVERNMENT, WHOSE FILES SHOW THAT THE SUSPECT WAS NOT EVEN IN BRITAIN AT THE TIME SHE ALLEGEDLY COMMITTED SOME OF THE EXPLOSIONS.

FORD ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT MEANS KENNEDY WON'T RUN

SEPT. 9 (IPS)--NEW YORK TIMES COLUMNIST TOM WICKER TODAY SHEDS LIGHT ON LAST WEEK'S ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT AGAINST PRESIDENT FORD BY A BRAINWASHED ZOMBIE ASSOCIATED WITH THE MANSON CULT. "IT IS NOW LESS LIKELY THAN EVER THAT EDWARD KENNEDY WILL BECOME A CANDIDATE" BECAUSE IT "IS MORE LIKELY THAT THIS LAST OF THE KENNEDY BROTHERS WILL BECOME AN ASSASSIN'S TARGET," DECLARES WICKER.

SENATOR CHURCH MOVES AGAINST
REOPENING WARREN COMMISSION FINDINGS

SEPT. 9 (IPS)--SENATOR FRANK CHURCH, HEAD OF THE SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE NOW INVESTIGATING THE CIA, INDICATED LAST NIGHT ON CBS RADIO THAT MATERIALS SUBMITTED TO HIM BY SENATOR RICHARD SCHWEIKER ON CIA AND FBI INVOLVEMENT IN PRESIDENT JOHN KENNEDY'S ASSASSINATION WERE "EXTREMELY FRAGMENTARY" AND THEREFORE DID NOT WARRANT A REOPENING OF THE WARREN COMMISSION'S INVESTIGATION. TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST CONFIRMS CHURCH'S POSITION, SAYING THAT HE HAS "SHOWN NO INCLINATION TO EMBARK ON A RE-NEWED INVESTIGATION OF THE JFK ASSASSINATION ITSELF."

BANKS WARN CONGRESSMEN OF HORRORS OF DEFAULT

SEPT. 9 (IPS)--ATTEMPTING TO HEAD OFF ANY TALK OF DEBT MORATORIA AND TO ENSURE PASSAGE OF VARIOUS BIG MAC BAIL-OUT SCHEMES FOR NEW YORK CITY, REPRESENTATIVES FROM TEN LEADING BANKS AND BROKERAGE FIRMS HELD A BRAINWASHING SESSION YESTERDAY IN WASHINGTON FOR 28 CONGRESSMEN AND ONE SENATOR, LED BY THE NEW YORK CITY DELEGATION. THE BANKERS WARNED OF INNUMERABLE HORRORS IF THE CITY DID NOT PAY ITS DEBTS, REPORTS THE NEW YORK TIMES.

BOSTON POLICE CALL SICK-OUT AGAINST MAYOR, GUARD

SEPT. 9 (IPS)--THE POLICE PATROLMEN'S ASSOCIATION OF BOSTON HAS CALLED AN UNOFFICIAL SICK-OUT TO PROTEST THE PRESENCE OF 1,200 NATIONAL GUARDSMEN THERE ON THE PRETEXT PROVIDED BY FBI-PROVOCATEUR "RACIAL VIOLENCE" OVER FORCED SCHOOL BUSING. PPA HEAD BRODERICK HAS ACCUSED MAYOR KEVIN WHITE OF USING "NAZI-LIKE" TACTICS AND HAS DECLARED THAT THE POLICE "WILL NOT PERMIT MAYOR WHITE TO TURN THIS CITY INTO ANOTHER KENT STATE."

QUEBEC FEDERATION OF LABOR:
PRODUCTIVITY IS "ASSASSINATING WORKERS"

SEPT. 9 (IPS)--"WE CANNOT AND SHALL NOT TOLERATE THE HEAVY PRICE IN LIVES PAID FOR PRODUCTIVITY, THIS ASSASSINATION OF OUR WORKERS," ANNOUNCED FERNAND DAoust, SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE QUEBEC FEDERATION OF LABOR (QFL), AT A PRESS CONFERENCE LAST WEEK. IN IMPASSIONED CHARGES, DAoust CALLED FOR A HALT IN THE SLAUGHTER OF CONSTRUCTION WORKERS RESULTING FROM THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE SO-CALLED CLICHE COMMISSION. THE DEATH LAST WEEK OF A SURVEYOR AT THE OLYMPIC STADIUM SITE IN MONTREAL BROUGHT TO SEVEN THE NUMBER OF FATAL CONSTRUCTION ACCIDENTS IN QUEBEC IN THE PAST MONTH ALONE.

III. ICLC INTELLIGENCE AND ORGANIZING REPORT

MALAYSIAN FINANCE MINISTER
DEMANDS EUROPE MOVE ON DEVELOPMENT

SEPT. 9 (IPS)--TAN SRI CHONG HON NYAN, DEPUTY FINANCE MINISTER OF MALAYSIA, INTERVIEWED YESTERDAY AT THE FAR EAST-AMERICA COUNCIL OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY, DECLARED THAT THE LACK OF A PUBLIC COMMITMENT BY EUROPEAN GOVERNMENTS TO THIRD WORLD PROPOSALS FOR DEBT MORATORIUM, TRIANGULAR TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT IS NOW THE ONLY ROADBLOCK TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW INTERNATIONAL ORDER BASED ON SUCH AGREEMENTS.

"WE HAVE TALKED TO THEM (IRAQ, ALGERIA AND INDIA) AND ARE IN FULL AGREEMENT WITH THEIR PROPOSALS," HE SAID. "WE WORK VERY CLOSELY WITH UNCTAD." UNCTAD YESTERDAY MADE COMECON-THIRD WORLD RELATIONS THE CENTERPIECE OF ITS DEVELOPMENT POLICY.

MR. CHONG ALSO EMPHASIZED THAT ONLY THROUGH MASSIVE EXPORTS OF INDUSTRIAL GOODS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE THIRD WORLD WOULD THE UNITED STATES AND THE REST OF THE WEST BE PULLED OUT OF THE DEPRESSION.

"BUT WE HAVE TOLD THE GERMANS," HE WARNED FORCEFULLY, "WE HAVE TOLD THE FRENCH AND EVEN THE AMERICANS OF THESE NECESSITIES. DID YOU HEAR THE GERMANS' SPEECH AT THE IMF? THERE IS NO EUROPEAN GOVERNMENT READY FOR COMMITMENT" TO DEVELOPMENT. CHONG STRESSED THAT THE PRO-DEVELOPMENT FACTIONS IN EUROPE MUST SEE TO IT THAT THEIR POLICIES BECOME GOVERNMENT POLICY.
