> SOVIETS MOBILIZE SUPPORT FOR ANTI-MADIST REVOLUTIONARIES IN CHINA

SEPT. 13 (IPS)—THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT NEWSPAPER, IZVESTIA, YES—TERDAY APPEALED TO THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNIST MOVEMENT TO SUP—PORT ANTI-MADIST REVOLUTIONARIES IN CHINA. "THE PRINCIPLED FIGHT OF REVOLUTIONARIES ALL OVER THE WORLD AGAINST THE HEGEMONIST POLICY OF PEKING HAS FIRST-RANK SIGNIFICANCE," SAID AUTHOR VLADIMI—ROV, "AND IT IS AT THE SAME TIME AN EXPRESSION OF THE FRATERNAL SOLIDARITY OF COMMUNISTS WITH THE TRUE SUPPORTERS OF SCIENTIFIC SOCIALISM WITHIN CHINA."

THE NATIONALISTIC TENDENCIES OF PEASANT CHINA WERE USED BY THE MAD REGIME TO CREATE AN IDEOLOGY OF GREAT POWER CHAUVINSIM, VLADI-MIROV WROTE. THUS MANY OFFICIALS "REGARDED MARXISM NOT AS INTERNATIONALIST BY ITS VERY NATURE AS A SCIENTIFIC THEORY, BUT AS A RADICAL MEANS FOR THE 'RENAISSANCE OF THE GREATNESS OF CHINA'."

DESPITE THIS NATIONALISM, VLADIMORIV NOTED "BASIC ELEMENTS OF A SOCIALIST CHARACTER" REMAIN IN CHINA. "UNDER FAVORABLE CIRCUM-STANCES, THESE ELEMENTS COULD REINFORCE THEMSELVES AND TURN IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION, WHICH IN TURN COULD POSITIVELY INFLUENCE THE SUPERSTRUCTURE OF CHINESE SOCIETY. THE MADIST LEADERS UNDERSTAND THIS AND ARE DOING EVERYTHING TO ENSURE THAT SUCH A TURNING POINT IS NOT REACHED."

IN PARTICULAR, VLADIMIROV WARNED CHINA'S NEIGHBORS OF THE MAO-ISTS' ADMITTED EXPANSIONIST AIMS. "ANTI-SOVIETISM IS NO GUARANTEE AGAINST PROVOCATIONS BY MAOIST CHINA...THE MUNICH POLICY OF APPEASEMENT OF A POTENTIAL AGGRESSOR IN THE PRESENT NUCLEAR MISSILE AGE CAN TURN FIRST OF ALL AGAINST THOSE WHO TRY TO PURSUE IT...THE WHOLE BOURGEOIS PROPAGANDA MACHINE IS NOW MOBILIZED," VLADIMIROV ADDED, "TO ROMANTICIZE MAOISM AND ITS CREATOR, DISGUISING THE GREAT POWER, NATIONALIST POLICY OF MAOIST CHINA."

THE ARTICLE CONCLUDED WITH A CALL TO ACTION BY ALL COMMUNISTS:
"THE FIGHT OF THE FRATERNAL PARTIES AGAINST THE THEORY AND PRACTICE OF MADISM IS ESSENTIALLY THE INTERNATIONAL FORM OF HELP FOR THE REVOLUTIONARY CAUSE OF THE CHINESE PEOPLE. THIS IS THE WAY TO SUPPORT THE CHINESE REVOLUTION IN THIS TRAGIC PERIOD, THE FIGHT FOR THE SOCIALIST PERSPECTIVE OF THE CHINESE PEOPLE'S RE-

PUBLIC, FOR RETURNING THE COUNTRY TO THE FIGHT AGAINST IMPERIALISM." QUOTING SOVIET COMMUNIST PARTY GENERAL SECRETARY BREZHNEY,
VLADIMIROV WROTE, "WE ARE CONVINCED THAT THIS UNNATURAL SITUATION
CANNOT LAST. THIS GLOOMY PAGE IN THE HISTORY OF THE CHINESE PEOPLE, OF THEIR RELATIONS WITH THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES, WILL INEVITABLY BE OVERTURNED BY THE CHINESE PEOPLE THEMSELVES."

SOVIETS FINGER MADISTIRIGHT-WING CONNECTIONS IN BRD

SEPT. 13 (IPS)—THE SOVIET YOUTH PAPER, KOMSOMOLSKAYA PRAVDA, EX-POSED THE TIES BETWEEN WEST GERMANY'S MADISTS AND "BROWN" (RIGHT-WING) POLITICIANS IN AN ARTICLE YESTERDAY: "IT EXISTS, THAT BROWN ICEBERG, AND ITS TIP, VISIBLE ON THE SURFACE OF POLITICAL LIFE, WARNS OF THE NECESSITY FOR VIGILENCE," WROTE AUTHOR G. GUR-KOV.

GURKOV QUOTED A BOOK BY GUENTHER BARTSCH, RECENTLY PUBLISHED IN WEST GERMANY, WHICH STATES THAT MANY RIGHT-WING NEO-FASCISTS IN THE BRD POSE AS "LEFT RADICALS" AND "ANARCHISTS" AND THAT "AMONG THE HEROES OF THE NEW RIGHT ARE SUCH PEOPLE AS FRIEDRICH THE GREAT, BISMARCK, AND MAO TSE-TUNG."

RIGHT-WINGER FRANZ JOSEF STRAUSS, REPORTED GURKOV, WHEN ASKED HIS OPINION OF THE ACTIVITY OF THE BRD MADISTS, REPLIED: "VARIOUS GROUPS EXIST HERE. WE HAVE ALREADY SEEN THAT THERE IS SOMETIMES A BASIS FOR RELATIONS WITH SOME OF THESE MADISTS, WHO HAVE LEARNED THE DOCTRINE OF THE GREAT CHAIRMAN AND WHO DO NOT WANT TO WEAKEN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC, AND WHO RECOGNIZE THAT WESTERN EUROPE HAS TO BECOME STRONG."

AN ARTICLE IN PRAVDA YESTERDAY SCORED MADIST SABOTAGE OF THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY, CHARGING THAT "THE SPARSE BUT MALI-CIOUS AND AGGRESSIVE MADIST GROUPINGS IN PORTUGAL, CLOSELY LINKED TO PEKING...ARE TAKING PART IN THE BANDIT ATTACK ON PCP OFFICES AND THOSE OF OTHER DEMOCRATIC ORGANIZATIONS."

CUNHAL REJECTS PARTICPATION IN RIGHT-WING GOVERNMENT

SEPT. 13 (IPS)—PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) HEAD ALVARO CUNHAL AFFIRMED THAT THE PCP "WILL NOT PARTICIPATE IN A GOVERNMENT WHICH IS BASED ON THE PRINCIPLES OF A CLASSICAL COALITION OF PARTIES," SPEAKING YESTERDAY AT A METALLURGICAL FACTORY IN THE LISBON SUBURB OF AMADORA. "THE PCP IS ALSO AGAINST THE FORMATION OF A GOVERNMENT WHICH IS INCAPABLE OF GUARANTEEING THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE WORKING CLASS, ESPECIALLY NATIONALIZATION AND AGRARIAN REFORM," CUNHAL SAID.

"WE ARE PREPARED TO UNDERGO ALL EFFORTS IN ORDER TO ARRIVE AT WHAT ONE WOULD CALL A COMPROMISE, IF THE FASCIST THRUST WILL ALSO BE HALTED BY THIS, AND IF THIS WILL ALSO PREVENT A SPINOLA OR A PINOCHET FROM BEING ABLE TO REALIZE A FASCIST PUTSCH IN OUR COUNTRY," CUNHAL CONTINUED. IN THIS RESPECT, HOWEVER, HE STRESSED "WE WILL ADVOCATE NO POLICIES THAT PLACE IN QUESTION THE DEMOCRATIC FREEDOMS ATTAINED BY OUR PEOPLE, OR WHICH WOULD ENDANGER THE SUCCESSES IN THE LIQUIDATION OF THE POWER OF THE MONOPOLIES OR THE REALIZATION OF AGRICULTURAL REFORM."

CUNHAL'S SPEECH WAS REPORTED IN TODAY'S NEUES DEUTSCHLAND, NEWSPAPER OF THE EAST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY.

FORMATION OF NEW PORTUGUESE CABINET STALLED

SEPT. 13 (IPS)—DESPITE A SERIES OF ALL-NIGHT MEETINGS BETWEEN REPRESENTATIVES OF PORTUGAL'S LEADING POLITICAL PARTIES WITH PRESIDENT COSTA GOMES AND THE PRIME MINISTER DESIGNATE AZEVEDO, A NEW CABINET IS NOT EXPECTED UNTIL NEXT WEEK. UNITED PRESS INTERNATIONAL ATTRIBUTED THIS NEWS TO A "SOCIALIST PARTY SPOKESMAN" IN A DISPATCH TODAY.

UPI ALSO REPORTS "RUMORS" THAT AZEVEDO'S INABILITY TO FORM A NEW CABINET MAY LEAD TO HIS REPLACEMENT BY THE "MODERATE" MILITARY OFFICER, MAJOR MELO ANTUNES. ANTUNES IS A KNOWN U.S. OPERATIVE.

THE LONDON ECONOMIST QUESTIONS ITT PULL-OUT OF PORTUGAL

SEPT. 13 (IPS) -- THE LONDON WEEKLY THE ECONOMIST IN TODAY'S ISSUE QUESTIONS WHY INTERNATIONAL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH (ITT) LEFT PORTUGAL LAST WEEK. ITT'S REASONS FOR CLOSING, THE ECONOMIST SPECULATES, COULD NOT HAVE BEEN PREMIER GONCALVES' LAST LAW, WHICH "ADMONISHES THE WORKERS TO INCREASE PRODUCTIVITY."

AT THE BASE OF THE PORTUGUESE WORKERS' COMMITTEES, THE ECONO-MIST WRITES, "IS A NORMAL DEGREE OF CONCERN THAT WORKERS GET A FAIR WAGE, EARNED UNDER ACCEPTABLE WORKING CONDITIONS, AND BENEFITS FROM SOCIAL SECURITY." BEFORE THE REVOLUTION, ITT HAD PAID "SHAMEFULLY LOW WAGES AND VIRTUALLY NON-EXISTENT SOCIAL SECURITY," THE ECONOMIST ADDS.

WEST GERMAN CHANCELLOR LIES TO PARLIAMENTARIANS

SEPT. 13 (IPS)--WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC CHANCELLOR HELMUT SCHMIDT CLAIMED THAT THERE WILL BE "NO REAL INCOME GROWTH IN 1976" IN AN INTERVIEW WITH THE RIGHT-WING RHEINISCHE POST YESTER-DAY. SCHMIDT PROPOSED THAT "FACTORY COUNCILS AND CORPORATE LEADERS SHOULD ASK THEMSELVES WHETHER THEY ARE CONSIDERING THE GOOD OF SOCIETY WHEN THEY CONCERN THEMSELVES WITH OVERTIME PAY AND HOLIDAYS INSTEAD OF HIRING UNEMPLOYED WORKERS." HIS PROPOSAL IS A FASCIST MODEL FOR DIVIDING THE INTERESTS OF EMPLOYED AND UNEMPLOYED IN THE BATTLE FOR SO-CALLED LIMITED RESOURCES.

SPEAKING IN BONN THE SAME DAY BEFORE THE SPD PARLIAMENTARY FRACTION LED BY HERBERT WEHNER, SCHMIDT CLAIMED, "I NEVER SAID THAT WAGES WOULD BE A MAJOR BATTLEGROUND IN THE NEXT ECONOMIC PERIOD."

HONECKER STRESSES MILITARY DETENTE, PERSPECTIVES FOR WORLD SOCIALISM

SEPT. 13 (IPS)--IN AN ADDRESS BEFORE THE EAST GERMAN ARMY SEPT.
11, SOCIALIST UNITY PARTY HEAD ERICH HONECKER GAVE A BROAD OVERVIEW OF THE INTERNATIONAL STRATEGIC SITUATION AND THE TASKS OF IMPLEMENTING THE EUROPEAN SECURITY CONFERENCE RESOLUTIONS.

MILITARY DETENTE IS CRUCIAL, SAID HONECKER, CITING THE PERI-LOUS "LIMITED NUCLEAR MARFARE" DOCTRINE OF U.S. SECRETARY OF DE-FENSE SCHLESINGER. SOCIALISM, HE SAID, HAS THE INITIATIVE IN FORCING IT ON THE BOURGEOISIE.

HONECKER DEALT WITH CAPITALIST FACTIONALIZATION AS AN INTERNAL CRISIS INSIDE CAPITALIST GROUPINGS AND INDIVIDUALS. HE DISCUSSED THE PORTUGUESE SITUATION AS PART OF THE INTERNATIONAL STRUGGLE AGAINST IMPERIALISM, STRESSING THAT "AS INTERNATIONAL—ISTS, WE STAND BEHIND OUR COMPADES IN THE POP." DESCRIBING HIS PARTY'S OUTLOOK OF "OPTIMISM AND FIGHTING SPIRIT," HONECKER SAID THAT THE PARTY'S UPCOMING NINTH CONGRESS WILL MAP THE COUNTRY'S DEVELOPMENT FOR THE NEXT OUAPTED CEMTURY—A BOLD, LONG-TERM PERSPECTIVE UNPRECEDENTED FOR EAST GERMANY OR ANY OTHER SOVIET ALLY.

STRAUSS COLLIDES WITH PRO-DEVELOPMENT CHRISTIAN DEMS

MUNICH, BRD, SEPT. 13 (IPS)—AT A PARTY MEETING HERE YESTERDAY, FRANZ JOSEF STRAUSS, THE NEO-FASCIST CHAIRMAN OF THE PAVARIAN CHRISTIAN SOCIAL UNION, CLAIMED THAT HE WOULD LEAD THE "GREAT CHANGE" IN ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL POLICY FOR THE MEST GERMAN FEDERAL ELECTIONS IN 1976. "THE ECOMOMIC CRISIS IS HOME-MADE AND NOT IMPORTED," STRAUSS STATED, EMBARKING ON A DIRECT COLLISION COURSE WITH THE PRO-DEVELOPMENT WEST GERMAN CURISTIAN DEMOCRATS LED BY CDU DEPUTY CHAIRMAN GERHARD STOLTENBERG.

THE MEETING WAS HELD UNDER THE FASCIST SLOGAN OF "LABOR FOR GERMANY."

NEW YORK TIMES CONCEDES THIRD MODELD FIGHT AGAINST U.S. AT UN SESSION

SEPT. 13 (IPS)--"POLITICAL AND DOCTRINAIRE ELEMENTS HAD BEEN INTRODUCED INTO DISCUSSIONS ON TECHNICAL MATTERS LATELY, AND HAD LED TO A HARDENING OF THIRD WORLD POSITIONS," THE NEW YORK TIMES ADMITTED TODAY ABOUT THE UNITED NATIONS SPECIAL SESSION. THE TIMES CORRECTLY CITES THE ALGERIAN AUD IRAQI DEMANDS FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AS "INSTRUMENTAL IN STIEMENING THE ATTITUDE OF THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES." PREVIOUS TIMES REPORTS ATTEMPTED TO HIDE THE RIFT BETWEEN THE U.S. AND THIRD MORLD NATIONS, ESPECIALLY OVER THE QUESTION OF DEBT MORATORIA.

JAPAN-EAST GERMANY HOLD POLITICAL-ECONOMIC DISCUSSIONS

SEPT. 13 (IPS)—TWENTY LEADING JAPANESE INDUSTRIALISTS COMPOSING A DELEGATION OF THE JAPAN-DDR FRIENDSHIP ASSOCIATION ARE CURRENT-LY IN EAST GERMANY COMPUCTING DISCUSSIONS DESCRIBED AS BEING OF "EXTREME POLITICAL IMPORTANCE."

THE DELEGATION, WHICH RECEIVED FRONT-PAGE COVERAGE IN THE EAST GERMAN PRESS, IS LED BY NIPPON STEEL HEAD INDYAMA AND MET WITH THE HEAD OF EAST GERMANY'S RULING SOCIALIST UNITY PARTY.

THE EAST BERLIN DAILY DER MORGEN SEPT. 4 COMMENTED ON THE TRIP THAT THE "TALKS DO NOT COME ABOUT BY CHANCE BUT RATHER MIRROR THE INTEREST OF BOTH SIDES TO DEEPEN ECONOMIC RELATIONS ON A FAIR AND EQUITABLE BASIS."

TRENTON OFFICIAL ATTEMPTS TO KEEP USLP OUT OF WATER INVESTIGATION

TRENTON, N.J., SEPT. 13 (IPS) -- TRENTON PUBLIC MORRS DIRECTOR JO-SEPH TURCELLO YESTERDAY DEMANDED THAT A CORDON SAMITAIRE BE PLACED AROUND TRENTON WATERWORKS, RECAUSE OF "TERRORIST THREATS" AND "UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL WALKING AROUND THE PLANT PUSHING DUT-TONS AND PULLING LEVERS."

TURCELLO'S MOVE APPEARS TO BE A DIRECT RESPONSE TO THE INTER-VENTION OF U.S. LABOR PARTY CANDIDATE FOR NEW JERSEY ASSEMBLY ELLIOTT GREENSPAN IN A PRESS CONFFRENCE SEPT. 8 HELD INSIDE THE WATER FILTRATION PLANT. WHEN GREENSPAN CALLED FOR AN IMMEDIATE FULL INVESTIGATION OF THE WATER DISASTER, CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT CARCELLO ATTEMPTED TO HAVE GREENSPAN REMOVED. CARCELLO SCREAMED "HE'S NOT AUTHORIZED-HE'S THE U.S. LABOR PARTY CANDIDATE."

TRENTON MAYOR HOLLAND AUTHORIZED AM INDEPENDENT INVESTIGATION AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE.

BALTIMORE SUN DEMANDS METHADONE MAINTENANCE

BALTIMORE, SEPT. 13 (IPS) -- THE BALTIMORE SUN CALLS FOR METHADONE MAINTENANCE IN AN EDITORIAL TODAY: "IN THE REAL MORLD, ATTENUATION OF ADDICTION OFTEN IS THE BEST THAT CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED."

THE EDITORIAL ATTACKS MARYLAND STATE HOSPITAL SUPERINTENDENTS FOR DENYING METHADONE TO PATIENTS WHO HAD BEEN ON METHADONE PROGRAMS PREVIOUSLY.

THE SUN'S CANDIDATE FOR CITY COUNCIL, GRENVILLE WHITMAN, WHO INITIATED BALTIMORE'S METHADONE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM, WAS SOUNDLY DEFEATED IN THE PRIMARY ELECTION LAST WEEK. THE U.S. LABOR PARTY HAD SINGLED WHITMAN OUT AS AN AGENT AND DRUG PUSHER IN A WELL-RECEIVED CAMPAIGN HERE.

SHADOW COMMITTEE WARNS OF HYPERINFLATION

SEPT. 13 (IPS)—THE SHADOW OPEN MARKET COMMITTEE, A GROUP OF ACADEMIC AND BUSINESS ECONOMISTS, SAID THAT THE "EXPLOSION" OF THE FEDERAL DEFICIT THREATENS TO BLOW APART THE FEDERAL RESERVE'S POLICY OF MODERATE MONETARY GROWTH, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES. THE COMMITTEE HAS BEEN MEETING EVERY SIX MONTHS SINCE SEPTEMBER 1973 TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON FEDERAL RESERVE MONETARY POLICY.

THE COMMITTEE REPORTED THAT IN 1973-74, THE FED ACQUIRED 23.5
PER CENT OF THE GOVERNMENT'S DEBT, COMPARED WITH ABOUT 11 PER
CENT IN THE 1950S. IF THE FED CONTINUES ITS RECENT PRACTICE OF
BUYING NEARLY A QUARIER OF THE TREASURY SECURITIES ISSUED IN FISCAL 1976 AND 1977, THE COMMITTEE WARNED, THE EFFECT WOULD BE AN
EXPLOSIVE EXPANSION IN THE MONEY SUPPLY-THREATENING LONG-TERM
PRICE STABILITY AND REAL OUTPUT. "THE EXPERIENCE OF GOST COUNTRIES SUGGESTS THAT LONG-RUN BUDGETARY CONTROL IS A NECESSARY
CONDITION FOR EFFECTIVE MONETARY CONTROL," THE COMMITTEE SAID.

LEAA ELEPHANT TANNIAN CALLS USLP "MOSQUITO"

DETROIT, SEPT. 13 (IPS)—ACCOMPANIED BY TWO POLICE COMMANDERS, DETROIT POLICE CHIEF PHILIP TANNIAN APPEARED AT A POLICE COMMISSION MEETING SEPT. 9 TO DENY U.S. LABOR PARTY CHARGES THAT HE ORDERED POLICE TO HARASS USLP PICKETERS AT K-MART SITES.

LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE ADMINISTRATION (LEAA) OPERATIVE TANNIAN SAID: "I AM OFFENDED BY THE VEILED INNUENDOS THAT I AM RESPONSIBLE FOR THE HARASSMENT OF THE LABOR PARTY. I CONSIDER THE LABOR PARTY TO BE A MERE MOSQUITO."

THE POLICE COMMISSION DECIDED TO INVESTIGATE FURTHER THE DENI-AL TO THE USLP OF THE RIGHT TO CAMPAIGN IN A K-MART PARKING LOT. POLICE COMMISSIONER LITTLEJOHN COMMENTED AT THE MEETING THAT THE MEMO OF WAYNE COUNTY PROSECUTOR KAHALAN ON THE MATTER WAS "UNSAT-ISFACTORY."

TO EXERCISE ITS FIRST AMENDMENT RIGHTS AT SHOPPING CENTERS, LITTLEJOHN SAID, THE LABOR PARTY WOULD HAVE TO REACH PEOPLE INSIDE THE PARKING LOTS.

TANNIAN REFUSED TO ANSWER THE COMMISSION'S QUESTIONS ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE DETROIT RED SQUAD, SAYING THAT HE IS PRESENTLY A LITIGANT IN ANOTHER SUIT CONCERNING THE RED SQUAD.

THE COMMISSON MEETS AGAIN SEPT. 15.

ROCKY: JUDEO-CHRISTIAN ETHIC MUST GO

SEPT. 13 (IPS)—VICE PRESIDENT NELSON ROCKEFELLER, SPEAKING IN ARKANSAS LAST NIGHT, SAID THAT THE "NATION'S ECONOMIC WOES" ARE RELATED "TO OUR ADHERENCE TO THE OUTMODED JUDEO-CHRISTIAN TRADI-TION." DEFINING THAT TRADITION AS "GIVING CHARITY TO THE NEEDY," ROCKEFELLER WENT ON TO PROPOSE A FUNDAMENTAL REVISION: "WE JUST CAN'T AFFORD TO GIVE TO PEOPLE JUST BECAUSE THEY ARE IN NEED."

THE LAST WELL-KNOWN POLITICAL FIGURE TO ATTACK THE JUDEO-CHRISTIAN TRADITION WITH SIMILAR VEHEMENCE DIED IN A BERLIN BUNKER IN APRIL 1945.
