NATO HEAD LUNS SEES EUROPE THROUGH U.S. FIELD BINOCULARS

OCT. 4 (IPS) — NATO SECRETARY GENERAL LUNS "LOOKS AT OUR CONTINENT ONLY THROUGH HIS FIELD BINOCULARS AND ONLY AS A POTENTIAL THEATRE OF MILITARY OPERATIONS," IZVESTIA, THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT DAILY, CHARGED ON OCTOBER 2. THE RECENT ATTACKS BY LUNS ON A REDUCTION IN THE DUTCH DEFENSE BUDGET, ACCORDING TO IZVESTIA, ARE NO COINCIDENCE: "THE U.S. DEFENSE MINISTER (JAMES R.) SCHLESINGER, IS TOURING EUROPE FOR INSPECTION PURPOSES. IT IS THEREFORE NECESSARY FOR LUNS TO SHOW HIS ZEAL."

PCF RIGHT-WINGER DEFENDS HISTORICAL COMPROMISE

OCT. 4 (IPS) — FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF) RIGHT-WINGER JEAN RONY HAS CALLED FOR AN ALLIANCE BETWEEN ITALY'S AGENT-LED COMMUNIST PARTY (PCI) AND THE RULING CHRISTIAN DEMOCRACY, IN AN ARTICLE IN THE LATEST ISSUE OF THE PCF WEEKLY FRANCE NOUVELLE. RONY SAYS THAT THE PLAN — WHICH HAS GAINED NOTORIETY AMONG THE COMMUNIST MOVEMENT UNDER THE NAME "HISTORICAL COMPROMISE" — IS FEASIBLE IF BASED ON "SOCIAL CHRISTIANISM" AND CHANNELED THROUGH THE CISL, THE ITALIAN CATHOLIC TRADE UNION FEDERATION.

MANY COMMUNISTS, INCLUDING THE LEADERSHIP OF THE PCF, HAVE CHARGED THAT THE "HISTORICAL COMPROMISE" IS A COVER UNDER WHICH CIA AGENTS LEADING THE PCI HOPE TO IMPOSE ROCKEFELLER-DICTATED LEVELS OF AUSTERITY ON ITALY.

SEVERAL WEEKS AGO, RONY ATTACKED A LEADING SOVIET COMMENTATOR, KONSTANTIN ZARADOV, FOR DEFENDING THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY'S REFUSAL TO GIVE UNQUALIFIED SUPPORT TO A CIA-BACKED PORTUGUESE CABINET FORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH RIGGED ELECTIONS LAST APRIL. RONY CLAIMED THAT THE CONCEPTION OF "LENINIST DEMOCRACY" ADVANCED BY ZARADOV IN DEFENSE OF THE PCP WAS ANALOGOUS TO THE BELIEFS OF CHARLES MAURRAS, LEADER OF FRANCE'S FASCIST ACTION FRANCAISE.

SOVIET AND PCF YOUTH LEADERS ISSUE JOINT CALL

OCT. 4 (IPS) — JEAN MICHEL CATALA, HEAD OF THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF) YOUTH ORGANIZATION AND SOVIET KOMSOMOL (YOUTH ORGANIZATION) LEADER GUENADI YANAUD YESTERDAY ISSUED A JOINT CALL TO ALL "REVOLUTIONARY YOUTH" TO ATTEND A MASS MEETING IN THE PARIS PALAIS DES SPORTS NEXT WEEK. THE CALL FOLLOWS A SERIES OF MEETINGS BETWEEN CATALA AND KOMSOMOL LEADERS IN THE USSE LAST WEEK AND IS REGARDED AS A MOVE TO COUNTER THE MOBILIZATION OF FRANCE'S CIA-DOMINATED ULTRA-LEFT GROUPS THIS WEEK IN PROTESTS AGAINST THE EXECUTION OF TERRORISTS BY THE GOVERNMENT OF SPAIN.

THE PALAIS DES SPORTS MEETING WILL BE PRECEDED THIS SATUR-DAY BY A HUGE PCF YOUTH RALLY IN PARIS AGAINST AUSTERITY WHICH WILL CALL FOR JOBS AND EDUCATION. OVER 70,000 YOUTH ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND THE RALLY, ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S HUMANITE, THE NEWSPAPER OF THE PCF.

OPUS DEI - SPANISH FASCISTS PUSH CO-PARTICIPATION

OCT. 4 (IPS) — NAVARRO RUBIO, A LEADING BANKER WITHIN THE SPANISH CATHOLIC FASCIST ORGANIZATION, OPUS DEI, HAS CALLED FOR SPREADING "WORKER-MANAGEMENT CO-PARTICIPATION" THROUGHOUT SPANISH FACTORIES.

RUBIO, LIKE THE UNITED AUTOWORKERS PRESIDENT, LEONARD WOODCOCK, A SUPPORTER OF CORPORATIST POLICIES, STRESSED THE IMPORTANCE OF "TURNING THE PRESENT TRADE UNIONS INTO UNIONS OF PARTICIPATION." "IN THE PRESENT CIRCUMSTANCES," HE ADDED, "IT IS MORE IMPORTANT TO INVENT FORMULAS FOR SOCIAL PARTICIPATION THAN FOR INVENTING MACHINES." RUBIO'S STATEMENTS WERE FEATURED IN A LEAD COMMENTARY IN THE MADRID WEEKLY, ABC.

OPUS DEI CAN COUNT ON HELP FROM ITS PARTMER IN THE SO-CALLED DEMOCRATIC JUNTA OF THE SPANISH OPPOSITION. NATO AGENT SANTIAGO CARRILLO AND HIS ANTI-SOVIET SPANISH COMMUNIST PARTY. CARRILLO. ALSO A WELL-KNOWN SUPPORTER OF CORPORATISM. RECENTLY BOASTED OF HUGE GAINS MADE BY HIS PARTY IN SPANISH TRADE UNION ELECTIONS.

SPANISH GOVERNMENT ARRESTS CIA MAOISTS IN JESUIT CENTER

OCT. 4 (IPS) — SPANISH POLICE ARRESTED 35 MEMBERS OF A MADIST LABOR ORGANIZATION CALLED THE SPANISH LABOR PARTY LAST WEEK IN A JESUIT CENTER CALLED PIGNATELLI, ACCORDING TO THE OCT. 2 ISSUE OF THE SPANISH PAPER ABC. THE JESUITS IN SPAIN LONG HAVE BEEN COUNTERINSURGENT LABOR AGITATORS.

STANDING OVATION FOR SOARES AT BRITISH LABOUR PARTY CONFERENCE

OCT. 4 (IPS) -- MARIO SOARES, GENERAL SECRETARY OF THE PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST PARTY AND RECIPIENT OF CIA FUNDS, RECEIVED A WARM WELCOME FROM THE LEADERSHIP OF THE RULING BRITISH LABOUR PARTY AND A STANDING OVATION FROM DELEGATES TO THE LABOUR PARTY'S ANNUAL CONVENTION AT BLACKPOOL, ENGLAND, TWO DAYS AGO, THE BRITISH PRESS REPORTS.

"I AM HONORED TO BE HERE REPRESENTING THE SOCIALIST SECOND INTERNATIONAL," SOARES SAID. "OTHERS WHO HAVE HELD THIS HONOR HAVE BEEN WILLY BRANDT AND LEON BLOM."

BRANDT IS THE ATLANTICIST CHAIRMAN OF THE WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY. THE LATE LEON BLUM LED THE STRIKE-BREAKING POPULAR FRONT GOVERNMENT OF FRANCE IN 1936.

SOVIET SUPPORT FOR THE INTEGRITY OF ISRAEL

OCT. 4 (IPS) — THE LONDON TIMES REPORTS YESTERDAY THAT, SOVIET PREMIER ALEXEI KOSYGIN DURING THEIR RECENT MEETING IN MOSCOW, TOLD DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL HOPEFUL SARGENT SHRIVER THAT THE SOVIET UNION UNEQUIVOCABLY SUPPORTS THE INVIOLABILITY OF ISRAEL'S FRONTIERS, AND IS PREPARED TO GUARANTEE HER INTEGRITY, PROVIDED ISRAEL WITH-DRAWS TO HER 1967 BORDERS, AND ACCEPTS UNITED NATIONS RESOLUTIONS ON THE MIDDLE EAST. THE MEETING REPORTEDLY REVIEWED THE WHOLE SPECTRUM OF SOVIET-AMERICAN RELATIONS, WITH EMPHASIS ON DISARMAMENT AND TRADE. THE WEST GERMAN DAILY, FRANKFURTER ALLGEMEINE ZEITUNG, REPORTS TODAY THAT A SOVIET DELEGATION IS SCHEDULED TO VISIT ISRAEL IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

THE MOVES REPRESENT A CONTINUATION OF SOVIET DIPLOMATIC MOVES TO DEFUSE THE TENSION IN THE MIDDLE EAST CREATED BY THE U.S.-AUTHORED SINAI ACCORD.

WEST GERMAN DEVELOPMENT FORCES BLAST VETTER CO-DETERMINATION PLAN

OCT. 4 (IPS) — LEADING PRO-DEVELOPMENT SPOKESMEN IN WEST GERMANY HAVE ATTACKED A PLAN BY HEINZ OSCAR VETTER, CHAIRMAN OF THE WEST GERMAN TRADE UNION CONFEDERATION AND A MEMBER OF DAVID ROCKEFELLER'S TRILATERAL COMMISSION, TO PERMIT THE NATION'S TRADE UNIONS AND EMPLOYERS TO INDEPENDENTLY COME TO AGREEMENT ON THE DEGREE OF "CO-DETERMINATION" WHICH UNIONS WILL BE GIVEN IN THE MANAGEMENT OF INDUSTRY, VETTER'S PLAN WOULD SCUTTLE A PARLIAMENTARY COMPROMISE WORKED OUT BETWEEN THE RULING SOCIAL DEMOCRATS (SPD) AND THE FREE DEMOCRATS (FDP). THEIR PARTNERS IN THE GOVERNMENT, UNDER WHICH THE QUESTION WOULD BE SETTLED BY THE FEDERAL PARLIAMENT IN BONN. THE FREE DEMOCRATS HAVE INSISTED THAT THE CO-DETERMINATION QUESTION BE SETTLED BY THE PARLIAMENT AS A CONDITION FOR THEIR CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN THE GOVERNMENT.

THE FDP PARLIAMENTARY LEADER, WOLFGANG MISCHNIK, BLASTED THE PLAN, STATING, ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S DIE WELT, THAT "WE NEED SOLIDARITY, BECAUSE IN ITS PLACE THERE IS NOW HATE." AND PHILIP VON BISMARCK, AN ECONOMICS EXPERT AND EAST-WEST TRADE SPECIALIST FOR THE OPPOSITION CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION (CDU) STATED THAT "IT IS PARLIAMENT'S AFFAIR TO ESTABLISH HOW THE DECISION PROCESS SHOULD COME ABOUT. NEITHER THE UNIONS NOR THE EMPLOYERS ARE ENTITLED TO MAKE DECISIONS ON THE FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS OF CITIZENS."

THE ROCKEFELLER FORCES' RACE THAT THE PARLIAMENTARY COMMISSION WHICH IS WORKING ON THE PROBLEM IS HEADED BY TWO OF PARLIAMENT'S LEADING DEVELOPMENT SPOKESMEN, MISCHNIK AND SPD PARLIAMENTARY LEADER HERBERT WEHNER. UNDER THEIR LEADERSHIP, THE OBSERVERS SAY, THE COMMISSION HAS SHOWN MORE INTEREST IN PROBLEMS OF DEVELOPMENT THAN IN THE NARROW CO-DETERMINATION QUESTION. THE OBSERVERS ALSO NOTE THAT VETTER'S ATTEMPT TO SCUTTLE THE COMMISSION WOULD BRING DOWN THE GOVERNMENT, AND CITE THIS AS A MEASURE OF THE ROCKEFELLER FORCES' DESPERATION.

II. CONTINENTAL

TIMES ACCUSES ECHEVERRIA OF "MONUMENTAL HYPOCRISY"

OCT. 4 (IPS) — THE NEW YORK TIMES ACCUSED MEXICAN PRESIDENT LUIS ECHEVERRIA — AN AVOWED SUPPORTER OF THE DEBT MORATORIUM — OF "MONUMENTAL HYPOCRISY" FOR ASKING THAT SPAIN BE SUSPENDED FROM THE UNITED NATIONS FOR EXECUTING FIVE CONVICTED TERRORISTS, IN AN EDITORIAL YESTERDAY.

"DIPLOMATS SAW MEXICO'S DEMAND AS PART OF PRESIDENT LUIS ECHEVERRIA'S CAMPAIGN FOR SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS ON THE EXPIRATION OF KURT WALDHEIM'S TERM NEXT YEAR," THE TIMES SAID, "RECALLING MR. ECHEVERRIA'S ALLEGED ROLE, AS INTERIOR MINISTER, IN THE KILLING OF AT LEAST FIFTY STUDENTS AND THE WOUNDING OF HUNDREDS MORE DURING A PROTEST PRIOR TO THE OLYMPIC GAMES IN MEXICO CITY IN 1968."

OBSERVERS SAW THE TIMES VIOLENT BLAST AS PART OF ITS CAMPAIGN TO DISCREDIT THE THIRD WORLD "GROUP OF 77" WHICH, UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF ECHEVERRIA AND OTHERS, DEMANDED FAR-REACHING CHANGES IN THE WORLD ECONOMIC ORDER AT THE RECENT UN SPECIAL SESSION, DESPITE THE OPPOSITION OF U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER. GROUP OF 77 MEMBERS HAD ISSUED A STATEMENT AT THE END OF THE SESSION EXPRESSING DISPLEASURE WITH THE TIMES COVERAGE OF THE SESSION.

SENATE FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE DECLASSIFIES SINAI PACT AGREEMENTS

OCT. 4 (IPS) — THE SENATE FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE, AFTER HOURS OF NEGOTIATIONS WITH SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER, YESTERDAY RELEASED FOUR DOCUMENTS CONTAINING THE TEXTS OF AMERICAN GUARANTEES TO ISRAEL AND SYRIA CONTAINED IN THE SINAI ACCORDS. KISSINGER FILED A FORMAL OBJECTION TO THE RELEASE BUT, THE NEW YORK TIMES NOTES TODAY, "MR. KISSINGER'S OBJECTIONS WERE MADE MORE FOR THE RECORD THAN ANYTHING ELSE."

KISSINGER'S OBJECTIONS TO PUBLICLY RELEASING THE DOCUMENTS ARE AIMED AT FOCUSSING ATTENTION AWAY FROM PROVISIONS IN THE SINAI ACCORD WHICH CALL FOR STAGING THE CIVIL WAR IN LEBANON IN ORDER TO WIPE OUT THE INFLUENTIAL LEFT-WING POLITICAL FORCES IN THAT COUNTRY.

CIA ASSASSINATION UNIT REVEALED

OCT. 4 (IPS) — SEN. FRANK CHURCH (D-IDAHO), HEAD OF THE SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE, CONFIRMED YESTERDAY THE EXISTENCE IN THE EARLY 1960S OF A SPECIAL CIA "EXECUTIVE ACTION" GROUP WHOSE JOE WAS TO DEVELOP METHODS FOR THE REMOVAL OF "UNFRIENDLY" FOREIGN LEADERS. ACCORDING TO TWO CIA OFFICIALS, CHURCH STATED, THESE METHODS INCLUDED ASSASSINATIONS AND COUPS.

CHURCH INDICATED, AS REPORTED IN THE U.S. PRESS TODAY, THAT THE GROUP WAS SO SELECT AND SECRETIVE THAT EVEN THEN-PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY DID NOT KNOW OF ITS EXISTENCE. THE GROUP WAS DISBANDED IN LATE 1963, SHORTLY AFTER THE NOVEMBER ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

PIKE ATTRIBUTES INTELLIGENCE FAILURES TO KISSINGER

OCT. 4 (IPS) — "YOU CAN HAVE THE BEST INTELLIGENCE IN THE WORLD AND IF THE INTELLIGENCE DOES NOT GET THROUGH TO THE PEOPLE RESPONSIBLE IT DOESN'T DO YOU MUCH GOOD," OTIS PIKE, CHAIRMAN OF THE HOUSE SELECT COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE, CHARGED YESTERDAY IN AN INTERVIEW ON WITG-TV IN WASHINGTON, D.C. PIKE INDICATED HIS DISPUTE WITH SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER REVOLVES AROUND THIS ISSUE, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S BALTIMORE SUN.

MR. KISSINGER HAS ISSUED AN ORDER PROHIBITING LOWER-LEVEL STATE DEPARTMENT OFFICIALS FROM TESTIFYING ON RECOMMENDA-TIONS THEY PROVIDE FOR U.S. POLICY DECISIONS. PIKE TERMED THE DIRECTIVE "RIDICULOUS," AND REITERATED HIS INTENTION TO HAUL KISSINGER BEFORE THE COMMITTEE. IF HE FAILS TO RETRACT IT.
