I. WORLD PRESS SUMMARY: INTERNATIONAL NEWS

CIA PLANNING NEW "ARAB TERRORISM"?

OCT. 5 (IPS)—ONE RESULT OF REDUCED ARAB FUNDS FOR PALESTINIAN ORGANIZATIONS COULD BE AN UPSURGE IN COMMANDO AND TERRORIST ACTIVITY, INCLUDING ATTACKS ON OTHER ARABS, TO FORCE MORE ATTENTION TO BE PAID TO THE PALESTINIAN CAUSE, REPORTS MICHAEL PARKS IN TODAY'S BALTIMORE SUN.

"SOME GROUPS ARE GETTING VERY CLOSE TO THE DESPERATION THRESH-OLD BECAUSE OF THE REDUCTION IN AID," SAYS PARKS, ADDING THAT THEY SEE THIS AS AN ABANDONMENT OF THE PALESTINIAN CAUSE.

HE ALSO NOTES THAT SOME OF THE MORE RADICAL GROUPS WOULD LIKE A NEW ARAB-ISRAELI WAR TO REVERSE THIS TREND AND MAY TRY TO PROVOKE ONE IF THEY CAN.

"PERU AND THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC DRAW CLOSER"

OCT. 5 (IPS)--AFTER MEETING WITH PERUVIAN PRESIDENT MORALES BER-MUDEZ ON SEPT. 30, EAST GERMAN FOREIGN MINISTER FISCHER TOLD RE-PORTERS, "PERU AND THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC ARE UNITED IN A COMMON FRONT AGAINST THE MONOPOLIES AND IMPERIALISM AND FOR THE PROGRESS AND PEACE OF THEIR PEOPLES." FISCHER NOTED THAT EAST GERMANY (DDR) HAS BECOME THE LEADING BUYER OF PERUVIAN FISHMEAL AND ANNOUNCED THAT THE DDR WAS PURCHASING \$28 MILLION IN PERUVIAN MINERALS.

FISCHER ALSO SIGNED A CULTURAL AGREEMENT WITH THE PERUVIANS CALLING FOR EXCHANGE OF SOCIAL COMMUNICATION AND EDUCATION TECHNIQUES AND OF TEACHERS AND STUDENTS. THE PERUVIAN GOVERNMENT-OWNED NEWSPAPER, CRONICA, WELCOMED FISCHER'S PRAISE OF PERU IN AN EDITORIAL ENTITLED "PERU AND THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC DRAW CLOSER."

NUCLEAR WAR WILL MEAN "BACKLASH," ECOLOGICAL CATASTROPHE, REPORT SAYS

OCT. 5 (IPS) -- NUCLEAR WAR WOULD CAUSE A SERIOUS DEPLETION OF THE OZONE LAYER THAT SHIELDS THE EARTH FROM THE LETHAL EFFECTS OF THE SUN'S ULTRAVIOLET RADIATION CAUSING AN ECOLOGICAL HOLOCAUST EFFECT OF DEVASTATION OF CROPS AND CLIMATIC CHANGES. ACCORDING TO THE CONCLUSIONS DRAWN FROM A REPORT WRITTEN FOR THE ARMS CONTROL

(MORE)

AND DISARMAMENT AGENCY. THE REPORT, MADE PUBLIC YESTERDAY AND REPORTED IN TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES, CONCLUDES THAT AN ATTACKING NATION, EVEN IF IT RECEIVED NO RETALIATION, WOULD SUFFER A BACKLASH EFFECT AGAINST ITS ENVIRONMENT. THE CONCLUSIONS, ACCORDING TO ACDA DIRECTOR FRED IKLE, SHOULD PROVIDE A FURTHER DETERRENT TO THE USE OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS.

GUSANO CALLS FOR RELIANCE ON MADISTS TO TOPPLE CASTRO

OCT. 5 (IPS) -- RIGHT-WING CUBAN EXILE COLUMNIST ANTONIO LLANO MONTES, WRITING IN THE SEPT. 23 EDITION OF THE VENEZUELAN DAILY EL MUNDO, HAS CALLED ON "ALL ANTI-CASTRO CUBANS" TO "FIX THEIR ATTENTION" ON MADIST CHINA FOR HELP IN OVERTHROWING THE CASTRO GOVERNMENT. DEMANDING A NEW CUBAN REGIME "TIED COMMERCIALLY AND MILITARILY TO RED CHINA," THE "GUSANO" COLUMNIST PROCLAIMED: "WE MUST CHOOSE THE ROAD OF CHINA...THE ROAD OF MAO, TO ATTAIN LIBERTY."

LLANO POINTED OUT THAT "THE RECENT COUP IN BANGLADESH, FI-NANCED, SUPPORTED AND CARRIED OUT BY RED CHINA, IS SOMETHING FROM WHICH ANTI-CASTRO CUBANS SHOULD TAKE GOOD AND POSTIVE EXPERIENCE."

"CUBAN EXILE LEADERS," HE CONCLUDES, "SHOULD APPROACH THE RED CHINESE DELEGATIONS AT THE UN OR THE CHINESE DIPLOMATIC MISSION IN WHATEVER EUROPEAN COUNTRY TO INITIATE DISCUSSIONS."

COLOMBIAN TEXTILE WORKERS UNION EXPELS MAOIST PROVOCATEURS FROM THEIR RANKS

BOGOTA, OCT. 5 (IPS)--AT ITS LAST MEETING, THE COLOMBIAN TEXTILE WORKERS UNION EXPELLED TWO KNOWN MADIST LEADERS FOR ANTI-WORKING-CLASS ORGANIZING AGAINST THE COLOMBIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (PCC)-LED TRADE UNION FEDERATION. THE MEETING WAS REPORTED ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THE LATEST EDITION OF THE PCC'S WEEKLY, VOZ PROLETARIA. THE TWO EXPELLED PROVOCATEURS ARE MEMBERS OF THE CIA-CONTROLLED COLOMBIAN MADIST GROUP, MOIR. MOIR HAS PARTICIPATED IN RECENT ATTACKS AGAINST THE COLOMBIAN LOCAL OF THE LATIN AMERICAN LABOR COMMITTEES.

RIGHT-WING FORCES STEP UP ARMED ATTACKS AGAINST COLOMBIAN COMMUNISTS

BOGOTA, OCT. 5 (IPS) -- VARIOUS "UNIDENTIFIED" INDIVIDUALS UNSUCCESSFULLY ATTEMPTED AN ARMED ASSAULT LAST WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON ON THE MAIN OFFICE OF THE COLOMBIAN COMMUNIST PARTY'S (PCC) NEWSPAPER, VOZ PROLETARIA. THE INCIDENT WAS DENOUNCED BY PCC CONGRESSMAN HERNANDO HURTADO, WHO ATTRIBUTED THE ACTION TO THE SAME RIGHT-WING GROUPS WHO LAST SATURDAY PLANTED BOMBS AT BOTH THE SOVIET EMBASSY AND THE DISTRICT PLANETARIUM IN BOGOTA. ANOTHER POC PARLIAMENTARIAN, JOSE CARDONA HOYOS, BLAMED THE COLOMBIAN ARMY FOR THE ARMED ASSAULT, ACCORDING TO THE COLOMBIAN LIBERAL DAILY, EL PUEBLO.

TWO BRAZILIAN ARMY OFFICIALS LINKED TO COMMUNISTS "DIED IN THEIR CELLS"

OCT. 5 (IPS)--ONE COLONEL AND ONE ARMY LIEUTENANT ARRESTED WITH 63 OTHER HIGH-RANKING OFFICERS OF THE BRAZILIAN ARMY AND CHARGED WITH BEING MEMBERS OF THE OUTLAWED PRO-SOVIET COMMUNIST PARTY (PCB) WERE FOUND DEAD IN THEIR CELLS YESTERDAY, ACCORDING TO A UPI DISPATCH APPEARING IN THE MEXICAN DAILY EL SOL. THE INFORMATION WAS RELEASED IN AN OFFICIAL COMMUNIQUE FROM THE HEAD OF THE MILITARY REGION OF SAO PAULO AND WAS SAID TO BE THE FIRST "OFFICIAL ADMISSION OF SUPPOSED INFILTRATION OF THE PCB IN THE RANKS OF THE ARMY."

THE UPI DISPATCH ADDED THAT ARMY OFFICIALS ATTRIBUTED THE COL-ONEL'S DEATH TO "HEART ATTACK" AND THE LIEUTENANT'S TO "SUICIDE." IT WAS REPORTED, HOWEVER, THAT THE LIEUTENANT WAS FOUND DEAD IN HIS CELL "JUST AFTER" COMPLETION OF A LONG INTERROGATION. THE ARRESTS AND MURDERS OF MILITARY LEADERS HAVE OCCURRED AMID MAJOR FACTIONAL STRIFE AMONG RULING CLASS LAYERS, SOME OF IT ANTI-ROCKEFELLER.

II. WORLD PRESS SUMMARY: CONTINENTAL NEWS

FORD TO PROPOSE FEDERAL BANKRUPTCY REFEREES FOR CITIES

OCT. 5 (IPS)--THE FORD ADMINISTRATION WILL SOON PROPOSE NEW LEG-ISLATION THAT WOULD ENABLE NEW YORK AND OTHER LARGE CITIES TO PETITION FOR BANKRUPTCY AND SURRENDER FISCAL CONTROL TO A COURTAPPOINTED FEDERAL REFEREE, ACCORDING TO THE NEW YORK TIMES. UNDER THIS PROPOSED LAW, THE CITY WOULD SUBMIT A PLAN FOR PAYMENT OF CREDITORS TO THE REFEREE, WHO WOULD BE EMPOWERED TO COLLECT CITY FUNDS AND MAKE DISBURSEMENTS. ONE HIGH ADMINISTRATION OFFICIAL, HOWEVER, SAID THAT "PAYROLL TAKES PRECEDENCE OVER THE BONDHOLDERS."

FROM HOOVER TO ROCKEFELLER

OCT. 5 (IPS)--PRESIDENT FORD'S SUPPORT FOR NELSON ROCKEFELLER'S \$100 BILLION ENERGY BOONDOGGLE, THE "ENERGY INDEPENDENCE AUTHOR-ITY," INDICATES HE IS DUMPING HIS PREVIOUS "HOOVER-LIKE APPROACH TO ECONOMIC PROBLEMS," SUBSTITUTING AN "ACTIVIST APPROACH TO GOVERNMENT," WHICH TODAY'S BALTIMORE SUN EDITORIAL CALLS "PURE ROCKEFELLER." THE SUN ARGUES THAT IF THE ADMINISTRATION IS WILLING TO FINANCE "HIGH-RISK ENERGY VENTURES" FOR PRIVATE INDUSTRY, THEN IT "OUGHT TO BE WILLING TO USE ITS GOOD NAME TO PREVENT NEW YORK CITY FROM GOING DOWN THE FISCAL DRAIN."

SENATE COMMITTEE REPORTED "DISCOVERING" RFK LINKS TO ASSASSINATION PLOTS

OCT. 5 (IPS)--SEVERAL NEW "LEADS" FROM "RECENTLY DISCOVERED" DOCU-MENTS IN THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT AND THE WHITE HOUSE HAVE REPORT-EDLY LINKED ROBERT F. KENNEDY TO THE CIA PLOT TO KILL CUBAN PRE-MIER FIDEL CASTRO. THE LEADS ARE BEING INVESTIGATED BY THE SEN- ATE SELECT COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE AND ARE REPORTEDLY A FACTOR IN THE DELAY IN ADOPTING AND PUBLISHING THE COMMITTEE'S REPORT ON ASSASSINATIONS, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES.

BRESLIN SCORES TIMES' STRIKE-BREAKING EFFORTS FOR WASHINGTON POST

OCT. 5 (IPS)—WASHINGTON STAR WRITER JIMMY BRESLIN YESTERDAY DETAILED HOW NEW YORK TIMES PUBLISHERS INTERVENED AGAINST THE PUBLISHER OF THE WASHINGTON STAR IN AN ATTEMPT TO FORCE THE STAR TO EITHER SUSPEND PUBLICATION OR PRINT THE POST NEWS COPY DURING A STRIKE ACTION TAKEN BY POST PRESSMEN. BRESLIN REPORTED THAT TIMES PUBLISHER ARTHUR OCHS SULZBERGER AND CLIFTON DANIEL, CHIEF OF THE TIMES WASHINGTON BUREAU, TOOK STAR PUBLISHER JOE ALLBRITTON TO LUNCH THURSDAY AND "URGED" HIM TO SUSPEND PUBLICATION OF THE STAR FOR THE DURATION OF THE STRIKE IF HE WOULD NOT PRINT THE POST'S NEWS COPY AT THE STAR FACILITIES.

WHEN ALLBRITTON REFUSED TO GO ALONG WITH THE SCHEME, TIMES COLUMNIST JAMES RESTON FEATURED IN HIS COLUMN OCT. 3 AN ATTACK ON THE POST PRESSMEN COUPLED WITH A DENUNCIATION OF THE STAR FOR PLAYING "THE ROLE OF FEARFUL BYSTANDER IN THE CRISIS" AND NOT "MAKING A COMMON FRONT AGAINST ALL THIS ANARCHY." BRESLIN COM-PARED RESTON TO "ANY TOUGH OLD COMPANY HEADBREAKER WHO EVER DEFENDED THE PLANT GATES" AND THE TIMES INTERCESSION AS EFFECTIVELY SAYING TO ALLBRITTON, "COME ALONG WITH US, YOU ALLBRITTON, OR WE'LL BURY YOU."

III. LABOR PARTY INTELLIGENCE AND ORGANIZING REPORT

RCMP TO ATTEMPT FRAME-UP OF NALP MEMBER

OCT. 5 (IPS)--ROYAL CANADIAN MOUNTED POLICE (RCMP) OFFICER "DUNCAN" YESTERDAY PICKED UP AND INTERROGATED NORTH AMERICAN LABOR PARTY (NALP) LEADER ANDRE DOUCET IN CONNECTION WITH A "ROBBERY" WHICH ALLEGEDLY OCCURRED SEVERAL WEEKS AGO IN VANCOUVER, B.C. THE RCMP OFFICER ATTEMPTED TO QUESTION DOUCET AT A SHOPPING CENTER WHERE NALP MEMBERS WERE ORGANIZING, BUT DOUCET REFUSED TO ANSWER THE WILD QUESTIONS. LATER RCMP OFFICER DUNCAN STOPPED THE CAR THAT DOUCET WAS RIDING IN WITH ANOTHER NALP MEMBER AND RESTATED HIS QUESTIONS. DOUCET REFUSED TO BE INTIMIDATED BY DUNCAN, WHO INDICATED THAT A FRAME-UP WAS IN THE WORKS, SAYING, "I'M GOING TO HAVE TO PUT THIS IN MY REPORT (DOUCET'S "UNCOOPERATIVENESS") AND IT MAKES YOU SUSPECT." DUNCAN HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS THE SAME OFFICER WHO STOPPED ANOTHER NALP ORGANIZER TWO NIGHTS EARLIER WITHOUT CAUSE.
