#### I. WORLD PRESS ROUND-UP: INTERNATIONAL NEWS

#### EUROPEAN CP LEADERS TO MEET AGAIN NEXT MONTH

OCT. 12 (IPS) — TWENTY-SEVEN EUROPEAN COMMUNIST PARTY LEADERS MEETING IN EAST BERLIN HAVE ADOPTED THE OUTLINE OF A COMMON DOCUMENT TO
BE SUBMITTED TO THE EUROPEAN CP CONFERENCE SCHEDULED FOR LATER THIS
YEAR. THE DOCUMENT WILL BE FILLED OUT AT A MEETING NEXT MONTH,
REPORTED YESTERDAY'S NEUES DEUTSCHLAND, THE EAST GERMAN DAILY. HERMAN
AXEN, HEAD OF THE RULING EAST GERMAN SOCIALIST UNITY PARTY (SED)
HAS BEEN PLACED IN CHARGE OF THE PREPARATIONS FOR THE MEETING.

THE LEADERSHIP OF THE CIA-CONTROLLED ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (PCI) IS REPORTED TO BE UPSET BY THESE DEVELOPMENTS. YESTERDAY'S L'UNITA, THE PCI DAILY, INDICATES THAT "CHANGES MUST BE MADE (IN THE DOCUMENT) BEFORE ANYTHING CAN BE ACCEPTED."

#### DIE WELT AIRS SPD DIRTY LAUNDRY

WIESBADEN, BRD, OCT. 12 (IPS) -- THE RIGHT-WING WEST GERMAN DAILY DIE WELT REPORTED OCT. 10 THAT SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY (SPD) CHAIRMAN WILLY BRANDT ADMITTED THAT THE SPD GAVE "INDIRECT" AID TO PARTIES IN ITALY THE SAME WAY THAT IT AIDS SOCIAL DEMOCRATS IN PORTUGAL AND FINLAND.

DIE WELT WAS THE ONLY BOURGEOIS WEST GERMAN PAPER TO ACCURATELY COVER THE OCT. 10 PRESS CONFERENCE IN FRANKFURT OF BRANDT AND HIS FELLOW SECOND INTERNATIONAL AGENTS BRUNO KREISKY OF AUSTRIA AND OLAF PALME OF SWEDEN. A CORRESPONDENT FROM THIS PRESS SERVICE HAD QUES—TIONED BRANDT AT THE PRESS CONFERENCE ABOUT HIS CONDUITING OF FUNDS TO SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTIES IN PORTUGAL AND FINLAND TO FIGHT COMMUNISM. ALL THREE AGENTS DISCLAIMED KNOWLEDGE OF THE FUNDS.

AFTER REPRINTING KREISKY'S COMMENT THAT SUCH LAUNDERING OF FUNDS "FUNDAMENTALLY WAS A NOBLE VIRTUE AND OBLIGATION," DIE WELT QUIPPED, "THUS A NOBLE MATTER WHICH NO ONE WANTS ANYTHING TO DO WITH."

#### COLOMBIAN EX-PRESIDENT HEATS UP CONFLICT WITH VENEZUFLA

OCT. 12 (IPS) -- COLOMBIAN EX-PRESIDENT MISAEL PASTRANA BLAMED THE VENEZUELAN "POLITICAL INTERESTS" FOR SABOTAGING NEGOTIATIONS OVER THE GULF OF VENEZUELA, A DISPUTED BORDER AREA BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES. PASTRANA FURTHER STATED THAT THE AREA WAS KNOWN TO BE RICH

IN OIL, CITING THE PRESIDENT OF STANDARD OIL AS HIS SOURCE. PRIOR TO THIS, NO LEADING STATESMAN FROM EITHER COUNTRY HAS PUBLICLY STATED THAT THEY BELIEVED THE AREA RICH IN OIL.

PASTRANA'S PROVOCATIVE COMMENTS WERE GIVEN MAJOR PRESS COVERAGE TWO DAYS AGO IN THE COLOMBIAN PRESS. THEY HAVE REVIVED THE RECENTLY QUIETED BUT STILL POTENTIALLY EXPLOSIVE CONFLICT BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES.

THE RAND CORPORATION HAS IDENTIFIED THE COLOMBIAN-VENEZUELAN BORDER DISPUTE AS ONE OF THE POTENTIAL "HOT-SPOTS" ON THE SOUTH AMERICAN CONTINENT WHICH MAY REQUIRE THE INTERVENTION OF THE UNITED STATES AS A "FRIENDLY MEDIATOR" IF CONFLICT BREAKS OUT.

#### II. CONTINENTAL

#### U.S. BACKS DOWN ON EAST-WEST TRADE SABOTAGE

OCT. 12 (IPS) -- PRESIDENT FORD ANNOUNCED YESTERDAY THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT BAN ON GRAIN SALES TO POLAND HAD BEEN RESCINDED, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES.

THE POLISH EMBARGO WAS INSTITUTED FOLLOWING A SIMILAR MORATORIUM ON GRAIN SALES TO THE SOVIET UNION IN AN ATTEMPT TO SABOTAGE THE PROFILIPERATION OF EAST-WEST TRADE AGREEMENTS.

FORD TOLD REPORTERS THAT THE MORATORIUM ON SOVIET SALES WOULD BE RETAINED, HOWEVER, BECAUSE, "THE U.S. SHOULD NEGOTIATE FROM STRENGTH WITH MOSCOW IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THIS COUNTRY." MOMENTS LATER, FORD ADMITTED THAT THE ADMINISTRATION WOULD PROBABLY FAIL TO MEET ITS OWN DEADLINE OF OCT. 15 FOR SECURING A COMMITMENT FOR LONG-TERM GRAIN PURCHASES FROM THE SOVIET UNION -- THE OSTENSIBLE PURPOSE OF THE EMBARGO.

GRAIN TRADERS AND FARMERS — OUTRAGED AT THE EMBARGO — FEAR THAT THE SOVIETS, RATHER THAN TOLERATE SUCH BULLYING, WILL SIMPLY BUY THEIR GRAIN ELSEWHERE.

## KISSINGER REFUSES TO SEND PIKE COMMITTEE CYPRUS DOCUMENT

OCT. 12 (IPS) -- SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER IS SENDING A FORMAL LETTER TO HOUSE INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN OTIS PIKE REFUSING TO COMPLY WITH A SUBPOEMA FOR STATE DEPARTMENT DOCUMENTS CONCERNING THE 1974 CYPRUS COUP, ACCORDING TO JEREMIAH O'LEARY WRITING IN TODAY'S WASHINGTON STAR. PIKE HAD INDICATED PRIOR TO THIS REFUSAL THAT HE WOULD ASK THE HOUSE FOR A CONTEMPT CITATION AGAINST "SOMEONE" IF THE DOCUMENTS WERE NOT FORTHCOMING.

#### TIMES BLASTS SIMON FOR MYC STAND

OCT. 12 (IPS) -- THE LEAD EDITORIAL IN TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES BLASTS TREASURY SECRETARY WILLIAM SIMON FOR ACTIONS WHICH WOULD "WRECK THE FISCAL FOUNDATIONS OF MOST AMERICAN CITIES AND STATES AND JEOPARDIZE

THE NATIONAL AND EVEN THE WORLD ECONOMY."

THE TIMES ATTACKS SIMON FOR HIS REPORTED WILLINGNESS TO ALLOW NEW YORK CITY TO SINK INTO BANKRUPTCY AND DEFAULT RATHER THAN SUPPORT FEDERAL AID.

ONLY LAST WEEK IN AN INTERVIEW PUBLISHED ON THE FRONT PAGE OF THE TIMES, SIMON HAD PROPOSED THAT MAJOR BANKS ALLOW NEW YORK TO DECLARE A MORATORIUM ON ITS DEBT SERVICE. THE TIMES EDITORIAL MADE NO MENTION OF SIMON'S DEBT MORATORIUM PROPOSAL.

THE BANKERS' CHOICE: PAYLESS PAYDAYS OR NO CITY HOSPITAL SERVICES

OCT. 12 (IPS) -- PAYLESS PAYDAYS FOR NEW YORK CITY HOSPITAL WORKERS WILL OCCUR WITHIN A MONTH UMLESS AN UNDISCLOSED NUMBER OF HOSPITALS UNDER THE CITY'S HEALTH AND HOSPITAL CORPORATION ARE SHUT DOWN, WARNED NEW YORK CITY BUDGET DIRECTOR MELVIN N. LECHNER IN TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES.

LECHNER POSED ONE ALTERNATIVE TO THIS DEPRESSION DICTUM: "A DEG-RADATION OF ALL MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL SERVICES."

ROCKY TO TESTIFY AT HEARINGS ON NEW YORK UDC COLLAPSE;
HEARINGS TO FOCUS ON STATE DEBT

OCT. 12 (IPS) -- VICE PRESIDENT NELSON ROCKEFELLER IS SCHEDULED TO TESTIFY AT MORELAND ACT COMMISSION HEARINGS ON THE BANKRUPTCY OF THE URBAN DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, THE FINANCING APPARATUS FOR MEW YORK STATE HOUSING, WHICH BEGINS IN NEW YORK CITY ON TUESDAY. THE HEARINGS WILL FOCUS ON THE STATE'S OVER-ALL DEBT AS WELL AS THE GROWTH OF SO-CALLED MORAL OBLIGATION FINANCING WHICH ROCKEFELLER DEVELOPED WHILE GOVERNOR, TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES REPORTS.

DELLUMS, NCLC SPOKESMAN ADDRESS SPOOK CONFERENCE

SAN FRANCISCO, OCT. 12 (IPS) -- RON DELLUMS (D-CAL.), HEAD OF THE CONGRESSIONAL BLACK CAUCUS, TOLD A "COUNTERSPY" CONFERENCE HERE LAST NIGHT THAT THE PIKE COMMITTEE'S INVESTIGATION OF THE CIA LEFT LITTLE DOUBT THAT AMERICANS HAVE ABSOLUTELY NO CONTROL OVER THE CIA AND ITS FAR-FLUNG ACTIVITIES.

DELLUMS POINTED TO THE INTERNATIONAL FLASHPOINTS OF CYPRUS AND PORTUGAL AS CRITICAL EXAMPLES OF WHERE THE CIA'S ACTIVITIES ARE WIDELY KNOWN BUT NOT OFFICIALLY DISCLOSED. "WE HAVE TO KNOW WHAT'S GOING ON THERE," DELLUMS SAID. DELLUMS CONTINUED HIS CRITICISM, ASSERTING THAT THE CIA'S BUDGET HAS BEEN UNWISELY KEPT A SECRET FROM THE PEOPLE WHO ARE ELECTED TO RUN THE GOVERNMENT.

GLANCING AT THE SPOOK CONFERENCE PANEL, WHICH CONSISTED OF NOTABLES LIKE "EX" CIA AGENTS MORTON HALPERIN, PHILLIP AGEE, AND DANIEL ELLSBERG, DELLUMS CHARGED, "THERE IS NO SUCH THING AS AN 'EX'-CIA AGENT."

PAT DOLBEARE, NATIONAL COMMITTEE MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITTEES, GAVE AN UNSCHEDULED TEN-MINUTE BRIEFING TO THE CONFERENCE ON THE REAL CIA AND ITS DRUG TRAFFICKING. "YOU WANT TO CONTROL THE CIA, YOU HAVE TO STOP ROCKEFELLER, KISSINGER, AND THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL," DOLBEARE SAID.

THE THREE-DAY CONFERENCE, WHICH DREW 350 PERSONS, WAS SPON-SORED BY THE COUNTERCULTURE RADIO STATION KPFA.

### PSYCHOTIC VIETNAM VET ATTACKS KRESGE PICKET LINES

INDIANAPOLIS, OCT. 12 (IPS) -- A CRAZED VIETNAM VETERAN ATTACKED U.S. LABOR PARTY ORGANIZERS AT TWO K-MART PICKET LINES HERE YES-TERDAY. THE VET, KNOWN AS FREENEY, ASSAULTED AN ORGANIZER AT THE EAST WASHINGTON K-MART AND THEN WENT TO THE NORTHEAST K-MART WHERE HE MADE A SECOND ATTACK.

POLICE CALLED TO THE SCENE REFUSED TO FILE CHARGES. INSTEAD, POLICE THREATENED TO BREAK UP THE USLP PICKET LINES.

THE LABOR PARTY IS INVESTIGATING FREENEY'S CONNECTIONS TO THE VETERAN'S ADMINISTRATION HOSPITAL PROGRAMS, WHICH ARE HEAVILY IN-VOLVED IN METHADONE MAINTENANCE AND OTHER ZOMBIE CONTROL PROGRAMS.

# DENVER LEAA OPERATIVE ADMITS HE RUNS A MAZI PROGRAM

DENBVER, OCT. 12 (IPS)—RICHARD PEREZ, DIRECTOR OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE ADMINISTRATION (LEAA) NEIGHBORHOOD ACTION PROGRAM HERE TOLD LABOR PARTY ORGANIZERS THAT HIS BLOCKWATCHING PROGRAM IS "BASICALLY NO DIFFERENT" FROM SIMILAR PROGRAMS IN HITLER'S GERMANY. LEAA BLOCKWATCHING OPERATIONS NOW, LIKE THOSE IN NAZI GERMANY, USE A NETWORK OF NEIGHBORHOOD INFORMANTS TO SPY ON OTHER RESIDENTS, ESPECIALLY THOSE WHO PROTEST SUCH POLICE STATE MEASURES.

THE LABOR PARTY LAUNCHED A DRIVE TO SHUT DOWN PREEZ' NAZI OPERATION. ALREADY DOZENS OF WORKERS APPRISED OF PEREZ' SELF-INCRIMINATION, CALLED PEREZ TO INDICT HIM AS A NUREMBERG CRIMINAL GUILTY OF CRIMES AGAINST HUMANITY.

#### III. IPS ANALYSIS

## ROCKEFELLER FLIES TO TURIN FOR SECRET TRILATERAL COMMISSION MEETING

OCT. 12 (IPS)—DAVID ROCKEFELLER, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF CHASE MANHATTAN BANK, SUDDENLY FLEW INTO TURIN YESTERDAY FOR A MEETING WITH ITALIAN INDUSTRIALIST GIANNI AGNELLI AND TEN OF THE WORLD'S TOP BANKERS AT THE AGNELLI FOUNDATION HEADQUARTERS, ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S GAZETTA DE POPULO, AN ITALIAN DAILY. YESTERDAY'S IL MESSAGERO REPORTED THAT THE MEETING WAS AN INFORMAL GATHERING OF THE TRILATERAL COMMISSION, THE ROCKEFELLERS' SUPRANATIONAL PLANING APPARAT. CHARACTERIZED AS AN "ECONOMIC YALTA" BY THE MESSAGERO

CORRESPONDENT, THE "SUPER-SECRET" MEETING WAS PUT TOGETHER IN LESS THAN SIX HOURS, FOLLOWING AGNELLI'S RETURN FROM CHINA.

THE AGNELLI FOUNDATION IS SIMULTANEOUSLY REPORTED TO BE THE SCENE OF ANOTHER MAJOR MEETING WHICH BRINGS TOGETHER THE AGNELLI BROTHERS UMBERTO AND GIANNI, INDUSTRIALISTS FROM THE PIEDMONT REGION OF ITALY, AND REPRESENTATIVES OF TRADE UNIONS AND POLITICAL PARTIES THE PIEDMONT. ACCORDING TO ITALIAN PRESS REPORTS, THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO DISCUSS EMPLOYMENT, INVESTMENT POLICY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE PIEDMONT.

INFORMED POLITICAL OBSERVERS HOWEVER INDICATE THAT THE ACTUAL CONTENT OF THE PIEDMONT MEETING IS TO DISCUSS FURTHER DECENTRAL-IZATION PLANS FOR THE REGION, AND BROADER EFFORTS TO BAIL OUT AGNELLI'S OPERATIONS, AS WELL AS ORGANIZING TO DESTROY THE MONT-EDISON CORPORATION, CONTROLLED BY THE AGNELLI'S INDUSTRIAL OPPONENTS. THE CEFIS.

THE PIEDMONT HAS BECOME A PILOT PROJECT FOR DECENTRALIZED GOVERNMENT THAT AGNELLI AND OTHER ROCKEFELLER-LINKED POLITICAL AND INDUSTRIAL FIGURES WOULD LIKE TO IMPOSE ON ALL OF ITALY. IT IS THE FIRST REGION TO HAVE AN "OPEN GIUNTA"-TYPE GOVERNMENT IN WHICH THE AGENTS OF THE CIA-CONTROLLED COMMUNIST AND SOCIALIST PARTIES ARE LUMPED TOGETHER WITH NATO-CONTROLLED FASCIST AGENTS ON THE RIGHT WING OF THE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRACY.

THE OBVIOUSLY PLANNED COINCIDENCE OF THE TWO MEETINGS IN THE SAME BUILDING HAS LED TO SPECULATION THAT DAVID ROCKEFELLER MAY BE ASSISTING THE AGNELLI BROTHERS IN THEIR POLITICAL EFFORTS TO BRING THE PCI INTO THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT.
