## I. INTERNATIONAL PRESS

### FORMER EGYPTIAN MINISTER PROPOSES "WORLD CENTRAL BANK"

OCT. 14 (IPS) — FORMER EGYPTIAN FINANCE MINISTER ISMAIL SABRI ABDULLAH HAS PROPOSED THE CREATION OF AN "INTERNATIONAL CENTRAL BANK" AND A NEW WORLD CURRENCY THAT WOULD REPLACE THE DOLLAR. THE PROPOSAL CAME IN AN INTERVIEW WITH THE LEFT-WING EGYPTIAN WEEKLY ROSE AL-YOUSEF.

SPLASHED ACROSS THE COVER OF ROSE AL-YOUSEF WAS THE TITLE OF THE ARTICLE: "DUMP THE DOLLAR!"

ABDULLAH STATED THAT THE PROPOSED NEW INSTITUTION, WHOSE DESCRIPTION CLOSELY PARALLELS THE INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT BANK PROPOSAL ORIGINALLY CIRCULATED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITTEES, WOULD FUNCTION TO GUARANTEE WORLD TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT. CREDIT FROM THE INSTITUTION, HE SAYS, WOULD BE GUARANTEED BY THE "NATURAL RESOURCES AND LABOR FORCE" OF THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES.

"I PROPOSE THE CONVENING OF A CONFERENCE BETWEEN THE CREDITORS AND THE INDEBTED COUNTRIES," ABDULLAH ADDED, "WHERE THE PROBLEM OF DEBT CAN BE SOLVED BY RENOUNCING SOME DEBT AND REVIEWING THE INTEREST RATES OF THE REST."

### ITALIAN MINISTER CALLS FOR MILITARIZATION OF THE ECONOMY

OCT. 14 (IPS) — THE ITALIAN MINISTER FOR SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH, MARIO PEDINI, STATED YESTERDAY THAT "SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH AT THE MILITARY LEVEL" AND PRODUCTION OF ARMAMENTS IS THE WAY OUT OF THE COUNTRY'S ECONOMIC CRISIS. "IT IS NECESSARY TO GET RID OF FALSE MODESTY: ITALY MUST DEVELOP A POLICY OF WEAPONS EXPORT," HE STATED IN AN INTERVIEW PUBLISHED IN THE DAILY CORRIERE DELLA SERA. TO ACCOMPLISH THESE AIMS, PEDINI PROPOSED THE FORMATION OF A SUPER-MINISTRY FOR TECHNOLOGICAL AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH WHICH WOULD NOT ONLY RECEIVE CARTE BLANCHE STATUS FROM THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS, BUT WOULD ALSO HAVE UNLIMITED FUNDS FOR THIS ACTIVITY."

PCI MOVES TO SUPPORT NATO MILITARIZATION POLICY

OCT. 14 (IPS) — ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY SPOKESMAN GIOVANNI BERLINGUER, THE BROTHER OF PCI GENERAL SECRETARY ENRICO BERLINGUER, TODAY CALLED FOR "DISCUSSION" OF THE "RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN TECHNICAL-SCIENTIFIC DEVELOPMENT AND THE ARMAMENTS RACE, ON THE PREMISE THAT FASCISM WAS BORN FROM THE MILITARIZATION OF THE ECONOMY." BERLINGUER WAS RESPONDING TO A DEMAND BY MARIO PEDINI, MINISTER OF SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH, FOR A SUPER-GOVERNMENTAL ARMAMENTS MINISTRY WITH UNLIMITED SPENDING POWERS TO END ITALY'S ECONOMIC CRISIS.

"IT IS TRUE," BERLINGUER WRITES IN A STATEMENT PRINTED IN TODAY'S UNITA, ORGAN OF THE PCI, "THAT MILITARY RESEARCH HAS BEEN, UNFORTUNATELY, A STIMULATING FACTOR FOR THE ECONOMY, PARTICULARLY FOR THE UNITED STATES." HE ALSO NOTES THAT ADOPTION OF AN ARMS SPENDING POLICY WOULD UNFORTUNATELY MEAN THE END OF DETENTE.

THE ITALIAN SOCIALIST PARTY (PSI) AND THE NATO ALLIANCE HAVE ALSO CALLED FOR INCREASED ARMS SPENDING IN RECENT WEEKS. THE PCI IS SEEKING TO JOIN A GOVERNMENT WITH THE PSI ON A PROGRAM WHICH INCLUDES SUPPORT FOR THE NATO ALLIANCE. FORMAL ADOPTION OF A MILITARIZATION POLICY BY THE PCI WOULD COMPLEMENT A LIST OF EXPLICITLY FASCIST PROGRAMS ALREADY SUPPORTED BY THE PCI, INCLUDING AUSTERITY AND WORKER "CO-PARTICIPATION" IN FACTORY MANAGEMENT.

PORTUGAL'S PRIME MINISTER CALLS FOR AUSTERITY

OCT. 14 (IPS) — IN A SPEECH ON PORTUGAL'S NATIONWIDE TELEVISION LAST NIGHT, PRIME MINISTER PINHEIRO DE AZEVEDO CALLED FOR AUSTERITY AND SACRIFICE BY THE PORTUGUESE POPULATION, TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES REPORTS. CALLING ON THE PORTUGUESE PEOPLE TO "PRODUCE MORE AND CONSUME LESS," AZEVEDO BLAMED THE IMPACT OF REVOLUTIONARY DEMANDS FOR THE DETERIORATION OF THE ECONOMY AND CALLED FOR MORE EMPHASIS ON PRIVATE INITIATIVE AND SMALL BUSINESS.

SUV DISAVOWS LINKS TO MFA;  
CALLS FOR FORMATION OF MASS REVOLUTIONARY ARMY

OCT. 14 (IPS) — A SPOKESMAN FOR THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY-BACKED "UNITED SOLDIERS WILL WIN" (SUV) MOVEMENT DISAVOWED ANY LINKS BETWEEN HIS ORGANIZATION AND THE RULING ARMED FORCES MOVEMENT (MFA) AT A MEETING IN THE SOUTHERN CITY OF BEJA YESTERDAY.

"THE SUV DOES NOT INTEND TO OPERATE AS A LEFTWING CURRENT OF THE MFA, NOR TO PLACE REVOLUTIONARY MILITARY MEN ON THE (RULING) REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL," THE SPOKESMAN SAID, ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S LISBON O SEculo. "WHAT THE SUV IS DOING IS FIGHTING ALONGSIDE ALL OF THE WORKERS FOR THE PREPARATION OF THE CONDITIONS THAT WILL PERMIT THE DESTRUCTION OF THE BOURGEOIS STATE AND THE CREATION OF THE ARMED BRANCH OF THE POWER OF THE WORKERS: THE POPULAR REVOLUTIONARY ARMY."

WALL STREET JOURNAL CHARGES CALLAGHAN  
WITH "WASHINGTON-INSPIRED PLOY"  
TO WRECK PARIS CONFERENCE

OCT. 14 (IPS) — "THE CALLAGHAN 'BOMBSHELL'" — THE DEMAND BY BRITISH FOREIGN SECRETARY JAMES CALLAGHAN FOR BRITAIN TO RECEIVE ITS OWN REPRESENTATIVE AT THE PARIS ENERGY, DEVELOPMENT AND FINANCE TALKS — "MIGHT BE A WASHINGTON-INSPIRED PLOY TO KEEP THE WHOLE EFFORT FROM GETTING OFF THE GROUND, ACCORDING TO SOME EUROPEAN DIPLOMATS," TODAY'S WALL STREET JOURNAL CHARGES.

ONE UNNAMED "FRENCH SOURCE" TOLD THE JOURNAL, "I WOULDN'T RULE OUT THE POSSIBILITY THAT MR. CALLAGHAN IS WRECKING IT ON BEHALF OF THE U.S."

THE JOURNAL REPORTS THAT U.S. HYSTERIA ABOUT THE PARIS TALKS CENTERS AROUND THE PROPOSED DISCUSSIONS OF MONETARY MATTERS, WHICH U.S. OFFICIALS WOULD PREFER TO HAVE TAKE PLACE THROUGH MORE CONTROLLABLE CHANNELS LIKE THE INTERNATIONAL MONETARY FUND.

MEXICAN AGRICULTURAL FEDERATION CALLS FOR  
DEBT MORATORIA, INT'L DEVELOPMENT BANK

MEXICO CITY, OCT. 14 (IPS) — THE PRESIDENT OF THE MEXICAN FEDERATION OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCERS (FEDEMOA), ALBERTO SALINAS RAMOS, YESTERDAY ENDORSED EVERY KEY FEATURE OF THE INTERNATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITTEES' INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT BANK PROPOSAL. IN AN INTERVIEW PRINTED IN THE MEXICAN DAILY EL NACIONAL, SALINAS CALLED FOR "MORATORIUM ON THE DEBT, TRIANGULAR TRADE, A NEW MONETARY SYSTEM BASED ON GOLD AND THE CREATION OF AN ADEQUATE INTERNATIONAL BANK TO FINANCE DEVELOPMENT." THESE MEASURES, SAID SALINAS, ARE THE "ONLY CONCEPTS THAT CAN MAKE IT POSSIBLE FOR THE COUNTRIES OF THE THIRD WORLD TO GET OUT OF THE PRESENT CRISIS." SALINAS ADDED THAT FEDEMOA, WHICH GROUPS SEVERAL THOUSANDS OF GOVERNMENT LAND-HOLDERS FROM THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY, "SUPPORTS THE RESOLUTIONS OF THE FORUM OF THE THIRD WORLD PRESENTED BY MEXICO AT THE MEETING OF THE NON-ALIGNED IN LIMA, PERU, WHICH EMPHASIZED MORATORIA ON NATIONAL DEBTS, THE CREATION OF AN INTERNATIONAL CENTRAL BANK AND THE NEED FOR EXPANDED TRADE WITH ALL THE COUNTRIES OF THE WORLD." HE NOTED THAT TO ACHIEVE A "MASSIVE EXPANSION OF THE MEANS OF AGRICULTURAL AND INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION... IT IS NECESSARY TO OBTAIN BENEFITS FROM THE ADVANCED SECTOR, SINCE THE THIRD WORLD NATIONS DON'T HAVE THE ECONOMIC INFRASTRUCTURE AND THE SKILLED LABOR TO IMPLEMENT DEVELOPMENT ON THEIR OWN."

BRANDT MOVES TO CENSOR IPS

BONN, WEST GERMANY, OCT. 14 (IPS) — THE INTERNATIONAL PRESS SERVICE WAS EXPELLED FROM THE BONN FOREIGN PRESS ASSOCIATION (VAP) TODAY.

IPS HAS LEARNED FROM HIGHLY INFORMED PRESS SOURCES HERE THAT

THE EXPULSION COMES AT THE PERSONAL INSTIGATION OF WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY CHAIRMAN WILLY BRANDT.

OFFICIALS OF THE VAP YESTERDAY REFUSED TO SPECIFY THE CHARGES AGAINST IPS OR REVEAL THE SOURCE OF THE COMPLAINT.

THE VAP ACTION FOLLOWS AN OCT. 9 PRESS CONFERENCE AT THE FRANKFURT BOOKFAIR HALD BY BRANDT AND HIS FELLOW SECOND INTERNATIONAL AGENTS BRUNO KREISKY OF AUSTRIA, AND OLOF PALME OF SWEDEN IN WHICH THE FOREIGN PRESS USED IPS REPORTERS' QUESTIONS TO RIDICULE BRANDT. THE QUESTIONS CONCERNED BRANDT'S ROLE AS A LAUNDERER OF CIA FUNDS. DURING THE COURSE OF THE QUESTIONING, PALME HAD SCREAMED, "IPS IS AN AGENCY FOR WHICH YOU DON'T HAVE TO ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS; YOU SIMPLY HAVE TO ORGANIZE OTHER JOURNALISTS TO KICK THEM OUT."

BRANDT IS SCHEDULED TO DELIVER A MAJOR ADDRESS THIS WEEK AT THE VAP. IPS HAS BEEN INFORMED THAT ITS REPORTERS WILL BE ARRESTED FOR TRESPASSING IF THEY TRY TO ATTEND.

LAWYERS FOR IPS HERE ARE NOW PREPARING LEGAL ACTION AGAINST THE VAP.

IPS ANALYSIS:  
PARIS PRODUCERS-CONSUMERS MEETING IN BREAKUP

OCT. 14 (IPS) — ALL SIGNS POINT TO A BREAKUP OF THIS WEEK'S PARIS CONFERENCE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF OIL-PRODUCING AND CONSUMING COUNTRIES, FOLLOWING A SPLIT TODAY BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND ALGERIA ON PROCEDURAL QUESTIONS. AS WORRIED U.S. POLICY-MAKERS HAD PREDICTED LAST WEEK, THE THIRD WORLD COUNTRIES AND EIGHT OPEC (ORGANIZATION OF PETROLEUM-EXPORTING COUNTRIES) NATIONS LINED UP UNANIMOUSLY BEHIND THE ALGERIANS WHO ALSO GATHERED SIGNIFICANT EUROPEAN SUPPORT.

NEGOTIATIONS BROKE DOWN TODAY WHEN THE U.S. REFUSED TO CONCEDE TO ALGERIAN DEMANDS FOR THE CONSTITUTION OF A COMMISSION ON MONETARY AFFAIRS, IN ADDITION TO EXISTING COMMISSIONS ON ENERGY, RAW MATERIALS, AND DEVELOPMENT. SAUDI ARABIA HAD INITIALLY DEMANDED THE OORMATION OF SUCH A COMMITTEE IN SEPTEMBER AS A PRE-CONDITION FOR A SUCCESSFUL MINISTERIAL-LEVEL MEETING LATER IN THE YEAR. IN ADDITION, A SPLIT AROSE OVER THE MINISTERIAL MEETING'S AGENDA, TENTATIVELY SLATED FOR DEC. 6. ALGERIA AND OTHER THIRD WORLD NATIONS WANTED AN AGENDA PINPOINTING SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES, WHILE THE U.S. REFUSED TO ADOPT ANYTHING BUT A VERY GENERAL AGENDA.

ACCORDING TO RELIABLE REPORTS, BOTH WEST GERMANY AND JAPAN BROKE RANKS AND BACKED THE ALGERIANS ON THE MONETARY ISSUE. UNCONFIRMED REPORTS SAY THAT BRITAIN BROKE RANKS AS WELL. ONE

WASHINGTON FOREIGN POLICY OBSERVER SAID, "IF THE SAUDIS INSIST ON THIS, IT WILL BE THE END," SINCE THE U.S. HAS NOTHING CONCRETE TO OFFER IN THE WAY OF INTERNATIONAL MONETARY REFORM.

U.S. GOV'T OFFICIALS DON'T KNOW  
WHO SENT SCHULTZ TO PARIS?

WASHINGTON, D.C. OCT. 14 (IKPS) -- CONFUSION ABOUNDED IN OFFICIAL WASHINGTON TODAY OVER THE NATURE OF THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC MISSION OF FORMER TREASURY SECRETARY GEORGE SCHULTZ. REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF STATE FOR ECONOMIC AFFAIRS THOMAS ENDERS DENIED KNOWING ANYTHING ABOUT THE MISSION, AND REFERRED REPORTERS TO THE OFFICE OF WHITE HOUSE ASSISTANT TO THE PRESIDENT FOR ECONOMIC AFFAIRS, WILLIAM SEIDMAN. REPORTERS WHO CONTACTED THE OFFICE OF SEIDMAN, WHO HAS HAD NOTHING TO SAY ABOUT ANY ASPECT OF ECONOMIC MATTERS FOR THE PAST SIX MONTHS, FOUND IT STAFFED BY A LONE SECRETARY WHO SAID SHE DID NOT KNOW ANYTHING.

MEANWHILE, OTHER INFORMED SOURCES SAID THAT TREASURY UNDERSECRETARY EDWIN YEO III, WHO ARRIVED IN PARIS TODAY TO JOIN THE SCHULTZ TEAM, WAS DISPATCHED TO "WATCH SCHULTZ" AND REPORT BACK TO TREASURY SECRETARY WILLIAM SIMON.

OBSERVERS SAW THE CONFUSION AS A CONTINUATION OF WHAT COLUMNIST JOSEPH KRAFT HAS DESCRIBED AS "GUERRILLA WARFARE" BETWEEN ADMINISTRATION OFFICIALS ALIGNED WITH SIMON, PRESIDENTIAL CHIEF OF STAFF DONALD RUMSFELD, AND MIDWESTERN INDUSTRIALISTS, AND THOSE WHO REPORT DIRECTLY TO VICE PRESIDENT ROCKEFELLER. TODAY'S DEVELOPMENTS, IT IS FELT, PROVE CONCLUSIVELY THAT SCHULTZ WAS DIRECTLY DISPATCHED BY ROCKEFELLER AND SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER, AND THAT SCHULTZ IN FACT HAS NO OFFICIAL AUTHORITY TO NEGOTIATE ANYTHING. THE QUESTION FACING WESTERN EUROPEANS AND OTHERS WHO ARE ATTEMPTING TO NEGOTIATE TERMS OF A NEW ECONOMIC ORDER WITH THE U.S., THE OBSERVERS FEEL, IS WHO DOES SPEAK FOR U.S. GOVERNMENT ECONOMIC POLICY.

SHRIVER REPORTED AGAINST EIA,  
BACKS TRIANGULAR TRADE

OCT. 14 (IPS) -- AN AIDE TO DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL HOPEFUL R. SARGENT SHRIVER TOLD IPS TODAY THAT SHRIVER IS "100 PER CENT OPPOSED TO VICE PRESIDENT NELSON ROCKEFELLER'S CREATING THE \$100-BILLION ENERGY BOONDOGGLE, THE SO-CALLED ENERGY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY." THE AIDE SAID SHRIVER FAVORS INSTEAD, MASSIVE TECHNOLOGY TRANSFERS FROM THE UNITED STATES AND WESTERN EUROPE IN EXCHANGE FOR OIL AND OTHER RAW MATERIALS FROM THE EAST BLOC AND THIRD WORLD COUNTRIES.

IN DISCUSSING THE U.S. LABOR PARTY'S PROGRAM FOR ECONOMIC RECONSTRUCTION, SHRIVER'S AIDE SAID HE FOUND THE PROPOSAL FOR A DEBT MORATORIUM "VERY ENTICING." THE AIDE SAID THAT ALTHOUGH HE DIDN'T THINK "WE'D (SHRIVER) GO WITH IT RIGHT AWAY," HE WOULD PROBABLY KEEP IT IN THE FIRE AS A "FUTURE OPTION."

GOV'T GAINS FRAME-UP OF NCLC MEMBER SAWICKY

NEWARK, N.J. OCT. 14 (IPS) — A JURY IN ESSEX COUNTY COURT HERE FOUND LABOR COMMITTEE MEMBER MAX SAWICKY GUILTY ON ALL COUNTS OF A SERIES OF CHARGES STEMMING FROM THE SEPT. 1973 FBI-DIRECTED RIOT IN THE NEWARK CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS. SAWICKY, WHO FACES A POSSIBLE FOURTEEN YEARS IN JAIL, WILL BE SENTENCED NOV. 5. HIS ATTORNEYS ARE ALREADY MAPPING PLANS FOR AN APPEAL. FOLLOWING A THREE-DAY RECESS, THE JURY RETURNED TO DELIBERATIONS THIS MORNING AND READ ITS GUILTY VERDICT TO THE COURT AT 4:00 P.M. THE RECESS WAS ORDERED BY JUDGE STANLEY BEDFORD AFTER THE JURY REPORTED ON FRIDAY THAT IT WAS HOPELESSLY DEADLOCKED.

SAWICKY HAD BEEN CHARGED WITH ASSAULT AND BATTERY OF A POLICE OFFICER, POSSESSION OF NUNCHAKAS (A COMMON KARATE WEAPON) WITH INTENT TO USE, AND POSSESSION OF NUNCHAKAS.

PROCEEDINGS BEGAN THIS MORNING WITH A REQUEST FROM THE JURORS TO REHEAR TESTIMONY FROM OFFICERS ROBESON AND SCARPONE OF THE NEWARK TACTICAL SQUAD. ROBESON IS THE OFFICER SAWICKY IS ACCUSED OF ASSAULTING.

TESTIMONY FROM BOTH OFFICERS HAD BEEN EXTREMELY CONTRADICTORY DURING THE COURT PROCEEDINGS. NEITHER WAS ABLE TO PLACE SAWICKY ON THE SIDE OF THE ROOM WHERE POLICE PHOTOS OF THE MELEE SHOW HIM TO BE. THEY COULD NOT RECOUNT THEIR OWN APPEARANCE OR EXPLAIN HOW SAWICKY MOVED SO QUICKLY FROM ONE SIDE OF THE ROOM TO THE OTHER.

SAWICKY'S LAWYER, MYRON SMERODSKY, MOVED FOR A "JUDGMENT NOTWITHSTANDING THE VERDICT" AFTER HEARING THE JURY'S DECISION. THIS MOTION IS MADE IN CASES WHERE IT IS ASSUMED THAT ANY REASONABLE JURY WOULD HAVE REACHED THE OPPOSITE VERDICT AND PROVIDES THE JUDGE WITH THE OPTION OF OVERRIDING THE JURY'S DECISION. JUDGE BEDFORD DENIED THE MOTION.

SAWICKY'S CONVICTION IS ONLY THE SECOND IN TWELVE ATTEMPTED FRAME-UP CASES STEMMING FROM THE NEWARK CITY COUNCIL MELEE ON SEPT. 5, 1973. TESTIMONY IN PREVIOUS TRIALS REVEALED THAT THE LEAA-DIRECTED NEWARK POLICE TACTICAL SQUAD STAGED A RIOT IN ORDER TO DISRUPT THE SCHEDULED TESTIMONY OF LABOR COMMITTEE SPOKESMAN DENNIS SPEED ON LEAA-CIA CONTROL OF NEWARK. FOUR LABOR COMMITTEE MEMBERS HAVE BEEN ACQUITTED OF MISDEMEANOR CHARGES STEMMING FROM THE RIOT, WHILE SIX OTHERS WERE ACQUITTED OF ALL FELONY CHARGES.

DOMESTIC COUNCIL PANICKED OVER CHICAGO PRESS ATTACKS  
ON GOVERNMENT DRUG PUSHING

WASHINGTON, D.C. OCT. 14 (IPS) — RICHARD PARSONS, STAFF MEMBER FOR DRUG CONTROL ON VICE PRESIDENT NELSON ROCKEFELLER'S DOMESTIC COUNCIL AND AUTHOR OF THE COUNCIL'S JUST-RELEASED REPORT LAUDING THE DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION (DEA), TERMED RECENT EXPOSES OF DEA PROTECTION OF DRUG PUSHERS BY THE CHICAGO PRESS THE WORK OF "WILD MEN."

THEY HAVE GIVEN THIS WHOLE QUESTION MORE COVERAGE THAN ANYONE ELSE AND IT IS NOT COHERENT NOR FAVORABLE. IT AMELES ALONG TELLING WHAT'S WRONG, BUT IT'S INACCURATE IN PINPOINTING WHAT TO DO."

PARSONS DISMISSED AS "TOTALLY MADE UP" A REPORT BY THE NEW YORK POST THAT WHITE HOUSE CHIEF OF STAFF DONALD RUMSFELD HAD ASSAILED HIS DOMESTIC COUNCIL REPORT AS A WHITEWASH AND HAD HELD UP PRESIDENTIAL APPROVAL OF THE REPORT.

PARSONS REFUSED TO COMMENT ON CHARGES RAISED BY FORMER TREASURY AGENT ROY FRANKHAUSER THAT THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT WERE OVERSEEING DRUG RUNNING. "I HAVE HEARD TOF THOSE CHARGES THOUGH THERE HAS BEEN NOTHING IN PRINT," HE MUMBLED BEFORE HE HASTILY HUNG UP THE PHONE.

W. GERMAN UNIONISTS COLD-SHOULDER  
TAVISTOCK'S "MITBESTIMMUNG"

WIESBADEN, WEST GERMANY OCT. 14 (IPS) — A WEST GERMAN TRADE UNION CONFEDERATION (DGB) SPOKESMAN TOLD WORKERS AT A DGB CONFERENCE THIS WEEKEND THAT "MITBESTIMMUNG," THE POLICY OF WORKERS' MANAGEMENT CO-PARTICIPATION, WAS "VERIFIED" BY THE NOTORIOUS TAVISTOCK INSTITUTE, THE ROCKEFELLER-FUNDED, BRITISH-BASED PSYCHOLOGICAL THINK-TANK. THE DGB LEADERSHIP STRONGLY SUPPORTS MITBESTIMMUNG.

THE EXPERT, A DR. FLEISCHMANN, MADE HIS REMARKS IN THE KEY-NOTE ADDRESS AT THE SPECIAL CONFERENCE CALLED BY THE DGB TO SELL WORKERS ON THE CONTINUED "MERITS" OF CO-PARTICIPATION. FLEISCHMANN TOLD HIS AUDIENCE THAT THE TAVISTOCK PROGRAM WAS WARMLY RECEIVED BY WORKERS IN SWEDEN, GREAT BRITAIN, AND HERE IN WEST GERMANY.

AFTER WORKERS FAILED TO "WARMLY RECIEVE" HIS REMARKS, FLEISCHMANN DECIDED TO CHANGE HIS TACTICS. HE DROPPED HIS SOFT-SALES PITCH AND WARNED HIS AUDIENCE, "EVEN IF YOU ARE NOT A FOLLOWER OF ZERO GROWTH, YOU STILL HAVE TO ADMIT THAT WE CAN'T HAVE THE HIGH LEVEL OF SATISFACTION IN THE FUTURE THAT WE HAD IN THE PAST." AS A SILENT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF REAL WEST GERMAN WORKING-CLASS FEELING ABOUT CO-PARTICIPATION AND SIMILAR SCHEMES TO ENFORCE AUSTERITY, NOT ONE WEST GERMAN PAPER DARED TO COVER THE CONFERENCE IN YESTERDAY'S EDITIONS.
