LEONE ISSUES CALL FOR ITALIAN FASCISM

OCT. 18 (1PS)--ITALIAN PRESIDENT GIOVANNI LEONE, TRADIONALLY A FIGURE-HEAD IN ITALIAN POLITICS, DELIVERED A FAR-REACHING ADDRESS TO PARLIAMENT OCT. 15. WHICH CALLED FOR AN END TO CORRUPTION IN GOVERNMENT, A REVISION OF PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURES, THE RE-ENACTMENT OF THE NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR THE ECONOMY AND LABOR (CNEL -A FASCIST NATIONAL PLANNING BODY) AND FOR RESTRICTIONS ON WORKERS RIGHT TO STRIKE.

LEONE'S CALL FOR FASCISM, SEEN AS A DESPERATE ATTEMPT TO INTERVENE IN ITALY'S CHAOTIC POLITICAL AND ECONIMIC SITUATION, WAS MET WITH WELL-ORCHESTRATED PRAISE FROM SUCH RESPECTED ITALIAN NEWS-PAPERS AS IL FIORINO, THE FINANCIAL DAILY, WHICH TERMED THE CALL "HOMAGE TO THE ENTIRE ITALIAN PRESS."

THE CALL ALSO MET WITH QUALIFIED PRAISE FROM ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY PARLIAMENTARY GROUP LEADER NATTA, WHO QUASHED AN EARLIER ATTACK ON THE CALL BY THE PCI PARLIAMENTARIAN, TROMBADORI, TERMING THE SPEECH A PROVOCATION FOR A GOVERNMENT CRISIS.

PCI-LED TRADE UNIONS CRITICIZED THE PROPOSED REGULATION OF STRIKES. STATING THAT THEY PREFERRED TO RESTRICT STRIKE THEMSELVES.

GISCARD/BREZHNEV TALKS CANCELLED OVER "IDEOLOGICAL DETENTE" DISAGREE OVER "IDEOLOGICAL DETENTE" DISAGREEMENT

OCT. 18 (IPS)—YESTERDAY'S LE MONDE REPORTS THAT THE SUDDEN POST-PONEMENT TWO DAYS AGO OF FRENCH PRESIDENT GISCARD D'ESTAING'S PRIVATE MEETING WITH SOVIET COMMUNIST PARTY GENERAL SECRETARY LEONID BREZHNEY, WAS A POLITICAL DECISION STEMMING FROM DISAGREEMENT OVER GISCARD'S CALL THE "NEED TO PROMOTE DETENTE IN IDEOLOGICAL COMPETITION."

LE MONDE SAYS THAT THE SOVIETS GREETED GISCARD'S CALL BY CALLING IT "SACRELIGIOUS." THE SOVIET PRESS HAS ALREADY REPRINTED FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF) WARNINGS AGAINST ANY ATTEMPT BY GISCARD TO PRESSURE THE SOVIETS INTO POLICING THE COMMUNIST MOVEMENT, ESPECIALLY THE PCF.

GISCARD RESPONDED TO THE SOVIETS' REBUKE BY "CORRECTING" HIS STATEMENTS TO SAY THAT HE REALLY MEANT INTERNATIONAL IDEOLOGICAL DETENTE. NOT NATIONAL DETENTE.

HEALEY REFUSES TO CUT PUBLIC SPENDING

OCT. 18 (1PS)—REFLECTING GROWING BRITISH CONCERN OVER THE COLLAPSE OF THE BRITISH INDUSTRIAL INVESTMENT, CHANCELLOR OF THE EXCHEQUER DENIS HEALEY ANNOUNCED YESTERDAY THAT THE GOVERNMENT WOULD NOT PROPOSE CUTS IN GOVERNMENT SPENDING, ACCORDING TO THE FINANCIAL TIMES TODAY. HEALEY, SPEAKING AT A DINNER ATTENDED BY REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CITY OF LONDON, DIRECTLY OPPOSED EARLIER DEMANDS BY BANK OF ENGLAND HEAD GORDON RICHARDSON THAT THE GOVERNMENT IMPLEMENT MASSIVE CUTS IN PUBLIC SPENDING. "I DO NOT THINK IT WOULD BE DESIRABLE, AT A TIME WHEN THE ECONOMY IS WORKING BELOW CAPACITY AND UNEMPLOYEMNT IS STILL RISING, TO MAKE IMMEDIATE REDUCTIONS IN PUBLIC EXPENDITURE THIS YEAR." HE SAID.

LEBANESE AND EGYPTIAN COMMUNISTS PLAST SINAI ACCORDS LEBANESE PROTOCOLS

OCT. 18 (1PS)—THE LEBANESE AND EGYPTIAN COMMUNIST PARTIES HAVE USUED A JOINT COMMUNIQUE BLASTING THE PARTITION OF LEBANON AS A PAIN TO "CYPRIOTIZE" THE COUNTRY AND CALLING FOR A GENEVA CONFERENCE ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S BERLINER ZEITUNG. THE CALL REFLECTS THE GROWING ARAB COMMUNIST OFFENSIVE IN THE MIDDLE EAST THAT BEGAN WITH THE REACTIVATION OF THE EGYPTIAN COMMUNIST PARTY IN EARLY AUGUST 1975.

THE PARTITIONING OF LEBANON WAS AGREED UPON BY THE U.S. AND EGYPT IN A SECRET PROVISION OF THE SINAI PACT.

PORTUGAL'S NORTHERN MILITARY COMMANDER TAKING REPRISALS VS. MUTINOUS UNIT

OCT. 18 (IPS)—THE ANTI-COMMUNIST COMMANDER OF PORTUGAL'S NORTHERN MILITARY REGION, GEN. ANTONIO PIRES BELOSO, IS REPORTED TO HAVE TAKEN PROVOCATIVE REPRISALS AGAINST MUTINOUS SOLDIERS WHO SUCCESSFULLY OCCUPIED AN ARTILERY BASE OVERLOOKING OPORTO LAST WEEK.

RENEGING ON AN AGREEMENT HAMMERED OUT BY ARMY CHIEF OF STAFF GEN. FABIAO TO THE COMMUNIST-SUPPORTED SOLDIERS THAT ENDED THE OCCUPATION, VELOSO HAS "ORDERED FURLOUGHS FOR THE RINGLEADERS PENDING DISCHARGE FROM THE SERVICE," TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST REPORTS.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE SOLDIERS COMMENTING ON VELOSO'S ACTION IS QUOTED AS SAYING, "WE CANNOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANYTHING THAT MIGHT HAPPEN (FROM HERE ON OUT)."

WEST GERMANY DEFIES WORLD BANK: GRANTS DEVELOPMENT AID TO TURKEY

OCT. 18 (IPS)—A MAJOR BREAK IN ROCKEFELLER EFFORTS TO BLOCK DEVELOPMENT AID TO BRANKRUPT UNDERDEVELOPED COUNTRIES OCCURRED YESTERDAY WHEN WEST GERMANY AGREED TO GIVE TURKEY APPROXIMATELY \$50 MILLION IN AID TO BUILD THE AFSIN-ALBSTAN POWER STATION IN TURKEY. THE POWER STATION, WHICH IS AN ABSOLUTE NECESSITY FOR FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF TURKISH INDUSTRY, HAS BEEN REFUSED FUNDING BY THE WORLD BANK, AND ITS PRESIDENT, ROCKEFELLER FLUNKEY ROBERT MCNAMARA, THE SUEDDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG REPORTS TODAY.

IRAN LOANS TURKEY ONE BILLION DOLLARS

OCT. 18 (IPS)—IRAN HAS LENT TURKEY AN UNPRECEDENTED \$1.2 BILLION TO IMPROVE RAILROADS, ROADS, AND INDUSTRY, ACCORDING TO REUTERS NEWS SERVICE. THE LOAN, OBSERVERS INDICATE, IS AN ATTEMPT TO OFFSET TURKEY'S GROWING TRADE RELATIONS WITH COUNTRIES OUTSIDE THE U.S. DOLLAR ORBIT, MOST NOTABLY PRO-SOVIET IRAQ.

GERMAN BANKS WARN OF "RISKS" IN EURODOLLAR MARKET

OCT. 18 (IPS)—AT A SYMPOSIUM ON THE SAFETY OF COVERING THE WEST GERMAN BUDGET DEFICIT THROUGH FOREIGN BORROWING, DR. OTMAR EMMINGER, VICE PRESIDENT OF THE DEUTSCHE BUNDESBANK, KARL OTTO POEHL, STATE SECRETARY IN THE BONN FINANCE MINISTRY, AND HERMANN ABS. CHAIRMAN OF THE SUPERVISORY BOARD OF THE DEUTSCHE BANK, GERMANY'S LARGEST BANK, ALL EXPRESSED GRAVE DOUBTS ABOUT THE STABILITY OF THE EURODOLLAR MARKET.

ARGUING THAT NEW FINANCING SHOULD BYPASS THE MARKET AND WORK THROUGH OTHER FINANCIAL INSTITIONS, ABS CITED THE INSECURITY AND ILLIQUIDITY RISKS WHICH EURODOLLAR INVESTMENTS IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF OIL TANKERS AND IN REAL ESTATE POSED FOR THE STABILITY OF THE \$200 BILLION EURODOLLAR MARKET, EXPRESSING HORROR AT THE LACK OF INFORMATION ON THE MARKET, AND ITS ENORMOUS GROWTH OVER THE PAST 12 YEARS, ABS BLURTED OUT "DO YOU THINK THE BANK OF AMERICA IS GOOD FOR A BILLION DOLLARS!"

THE SYMPOSIUM WAS REPORTED IN YESTERDAY'S FINANCIAL TIMES.

ROCKY AGAIN CALLS FOR AID TO NYC TO BAIL-OUT BANKS

OCT. 18 (IPS)—IN THE PANICKY ATMOSPHERE CREATED BY YESTERDAY'S NEAR DEFAULT OF NEW YORK CITY THE WASHINGTON POST TODAY PUBLISHED AN EXCLUSIVE INTERVIEW WITH VICE PRESIDENT NELSON ROCKEFELLER IN WHICH HE DEMANDED THAT THE DEMOCRATIC CONGRESS TAKE ACTION TO PREVENT A "CATASTROPHIC" DEFAULT IN THE FUTURE IN OPPOSITION TO ADMINISTRATION POLICY.

"I DON'T CARE IF ITS A LOAN OF GUARANTEE, ROCKEFELLER TOLD POST COLUMNIST HOBART ROWAN, "BUT IF CONGRESS WANTS TO SHOW LEADERSHIP, IT HAS A GRAND OPPORTUNITY TO SHOW ITS MUSCLE AND MOBILIZE THE DEMOCRATIC STRENGTH TO SUPPORT A DEMOCRATIC MAYOR AND A DEMOCRATIC GOVERNOR."

"CONGRESS IS-ALWAYS SAYING THAT THE PRESIDENT IS USURPING THE CONGRESS' POWER. " ROCKEFELLER STATED. " WELL HE HASN'T ... HERE'S THEIR CHANCE TO DO SOMETHING."

ROCKEFELLER SPECIFICALLY DISTANCED HIMSELF FROM TREASURY SECRETARY WILLIAM SIMON'S ANALYSIS THAT THE EFFECTS OF A DEFAULT WOULD BE TOLERABLE AND TEMPORARY. ROCKEFELLER SAID, "NOBODY CAN TELL HOW FAR THE CRISIS CAN GO OR WHAT FORM IT WILL TAKE."

THE PRINCIPAL BENEFICIARY OF SUCH "AID" WOULD BE THE NEW YORK BANKING SYSTEM, CONTROLLED BY NELSON'S BROTHER DAVID.

ROWAN NOTED THAT ROCKEFELLER HAD NOT BEEN INVITED TO AN EMERGENCY WHITE HOUSE MEETING OF SENIOR FINANCIAL ADVISORS DURING YES-TERDAY'S POTENTIAL DEFAULT CRISIS.

DALEY CALLS FOR MAINTENANCE OF NYC SERVICES

OCT. 18 (IPS)--CHICAGO MAYOR DALEY TODAY CALLED FOR FEDERAL AID TO NEW YORK CITY SO THAT THE CITY CAN MAINTAIN ITS ESSENTIAL CITY SERVICES. ACCORDING TO THE CHICAGO SUN TIMES. DALEY'S CALL FOR AID TO THE CITY CONTRASTS SIGNIFICANTLY WITH DEMANDS BY ROCKEFELLER FORCES THAT FEDERAL AID BE MADE CONTINGENT ON MASSIVE NEW BUDGET CUST BY THE CITY.

DALEY HAS ALSO REVEALED THAT HE HAS A "SECRET PLAN" FOR NEW YORK CITY WHICH HE HAS COMMUNICATED TO NEW YORK MAYOR BEAME. DALEY WOULD NOT ELABORATE.

EVANS AND NOVAK SEE "IMMENSE" POLITICAL DANGER IN STORE FOR ROCKY

OCT. 18 (IPS) -- "THAT A VICE PRESIDENT SHOULD MUSTER THE POLITICAL BRAVADO TO CHALLENGE HIS PRESIDENT SO FRONTALLY REVEALS MUCH ABOUT THE PRESENT STATE OF FORD'S ADMINISTRATION, AND PARTICULARLY THE RANCID IN-FIGHTING BETWEEN ROCKEFELLER AND RUMSFELD," EVANS AND NOVAK DECLARE IN THEIR OCT. 16 SYNDICATED COLUMN ENTITLED "ROCKY'S DANGEROUS GAME."

ACCORDING TO THESE SAME PUNDITS, ROCKEFELLER IS PLAYING WITH DYNAMITE IN HIS CALCULATED BREAK WITH FORD OVER FEDERAL AID TO HIS BROTHER'S NEW YORK BANKS "IF THE PRESIDENT CONTINUES IN ALLIANCE WITH SIMON AND RUMSFELD." EVANS AND NOVAK CONCLUDE THAT FOR ROCKEFELLER "THE POLITICAL DNAGER IS IMMENSE" THAT FORD WILL CONTINUE TO WANT HIM AS A RUNNING-MATE SINCE HE IS NOW OVERDRAWN ON "HIS POLITICAL CREDIT IN THE BANK OF JERRY FORD" DESPITE THE FACT THAT ROCKEFELLER INTIMATES SCOFF AT ANY PROSPECT OF FORD DUMPING HIM.

ORGANIZING AND ITELLIGENCE

PSI LEADER BLASTS TRILATERAL COMMISSION ITALIAN REARMAMENT POLICY

ROME, ITALY, OCT. 18 (IPS)—GIACOMO MANCINI, FORMER SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE ITALIAN SOCIALIST PARTY (PSI), DENOUNCED THE REARMAMENT POLICY PROPOSED BY THE ITALIAN MINISTER FOR RESEARCH AND TECHNOLOGY, PEDINI, AND BY AN UNDERSECRETARY OF THE SAME MINISTRY, GUADALUPI'S SU, A MEMBER OF THE HIS SOCIALIST PARTY. IN AN INTERVIEW YESTERDAY, MANCINI SAID. "I HAVE LISTENED TO PEDINI'S AND GUADALUPI'S SUGGESTIONS, BUT THEY WILL NOT RESOLVE THE ECONOMIC CRISIS. I AM COMPLETELY OPPOSED TO IT."

ASKED TO COMMENT ON THE SIGNIFICANCE OF LAST SATURDAY'S MEETING OF THE TRILATERAL COMMISSION AT THE AGNELLI FOUNDATION IN TURIN, MANCINI SAID THAT THE MEETING WAS RELATED TO THE TURIN MEETING OF THE PIEDMONT ECONOMIC REGIONAL CONFERENCE LAST WEEKEND, "WHOSE RESULT WAS CLEAR! IT IS A DECISION FOR THE COMPLETE DESTRUCTION OF PRODUCTION, PARTICULARLY IN THE SOUTH, "SAID MANCINI.

THE PROPSED ITALIAN REARMAMENT POLICY HAS BEEN DEVELOPED PRIO-O-MARILY BY ROCKEFELLER-AGENT GIANNI AGNELLI. CHAIRMAN OF FIAT WITH THE IMPLICIT SUPPORT OF THE AGENT-LED ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY.

MORATORIUM "THE ONLY SOLUTION" SAYS MILAN MAYOR

ROME, ITALY, OCT. 18 (IPS)—ALDO ANIASI, THE SOCIALIST MAYOR OF MILAN, TOLD IPS TODAY THAT THE ONLY SOLUTION TO THE CITY'S BUDGET CRISIS IS A DEBT MORATORIUM. "IT IS THE ONLY SOLUTION," HE STATED. ANIASI WENT ON TO SPECIFY THAT "IT IS THE ONLY WAY, NOT ONLY FOR MILAN BUT FOR ALL CITIES."

ANIASI INVITED IPS TO "COME TO THE NEXT MILAN (CITY COUNCIL) MEETING AND LOOK..."

THE MAYOR'S UNFINISHED STATEMENT MAY INDICATE THAT HE SOON INTENDS TO FORMALLY CALL FOR A DEBT MORATORIUM FOR THE NEAR-BANKRUPT MILAN. ANIASI RECENTLY TOLD THE CITY COUNCIL THAT MILAN IS IN A "STATE OF EMERGENCY."

WAYNE EVANS BRIEFS MICHIGAN LEGISLATURE ON LABOR HOLOCAUST

DETROIT. OCT. 18 (IPS)—WAYNE EVANS. U.S. LABOR PARTY CANDIDATE FOR VICE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES TESTIFIED ON BESTIAL WORKING CONDITIONS AND DRUG TRAFFICKING IN MIDWESTERN FACTORIES BEFORE A JOINT SESSION OF THE MICHIGAN HOUSE AND SENATE LABOR OCMMITTEES YESTERDAY. THE HEARINGS WERE HELD TO CONSIDER PROPOSED LEGISLATION TO EXPAND WORKINGMAN'S COMPENSATION BENEFITS.

TESTIFYING FOR 25 MINUTES, EVANS COUNTERPOSED THE LABOR BILL OF RIGHTS, A PLANK IN THE USLP PRESIDENTIAL PLATFORM CALLING FOR DECENT LIVING CONDITIONS, AND TO PREVENT THE DESTRUCTION OF THE WORKING CLASS CURRENTLY GOING ON AT SUCH MAJOR INDUSTRIAL PLANTS AS FORD ROUGE, WIXOM, DODGE MAIN, AND DOZENS OF OTHER NAZIFIED AUTO PLANTS. HE CALLED UPON THE JOINT COMMITTEE TO INITIATE A MAJOR INVESTIGATION OF PRESENT PLANT CONDITIONS.

AUTO COMPANY AND BUSINESS WITNESSES DENOUNCED WORKINGMAN'S COMPENSATION AND THREATENED TO NEVER BUILD NEW FACILITIES IN THE STATE IF BENEFITS FOR WERE INCREASED.

BENTON ADDRESSES SF DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE

SAN FRANCISCO, OCT. 18 (IPS) -- U.S. LABOR PARTY MAYORAL CANDIDATE NICK BENTON ADDRESSED THE SAN FRANCISCO COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE FOR 15 MINUTES LAST NIGHT. AND DOMINATED THE MEETING, HELD TO ENDORSE A CANDIDATE FOR THE NOVEMBER MAYORAL PRIMARY ELECTION, WITH A PRESENTATION BLASTING EFFORTS TO IMPOSE AUSTERITY ON THE WORKING CLASS. BENTON CALLED ON THE COMMITTEE TO ENDORSE THE DEBT MORATORIUM, FUSION POWER, AND THE 10-DAY DRUG DETOXIFICATION PROGRAM PROPOSED BY THE USLP.

FOLLOWING THE PRESENTATION, BENTON ANSWERED EXTENDED QUESTIONS FROM COMMITTEE MEMBERS, AND SOLD SEVERAL USLP PRESIDENTIAL PLATFORMS THAT HE HAD BROUGHT WITH HIM.

OTHER CANDIDATES WERE ALLOWED ONLY FIVE MINUTES TO ADDRESS THE COMMITTEE NONETHELESS, COMMITTEE MEMBERS SAID THAT THEY COULD NOT ENDORSE BENTON BECAUSE THE COMMITTEE "COULD ONLY ENDORSE A DEMOCRAT."

MEANWHILE, BENTON ANNOUNCED IN A SPECIAL BROADCAST ON THE SANFRANCISCO CBS AFFILIATE, THAT HIS CAMPAIGN HAS TARGETTED THE 28 PER CENT OF THE VOTERS WHO ARE SHOWN AS "UNDECIDED" IN POLLS TO GIVE HIM A VICTORY MARGIN. THE OTHER VOTES ARE DIVIDED AMONG EIGHT CANDIDATES. THE CBS BROADCAST BREAKS A PRESS BLACKOUT ON THE BENTON CAMPAIGN. BENTON ALSO HAS A SCHEDULED TEVEVISION DEBATE WITH ANOTHER CANDIDATE, JUDGE ERTOLA, ON OCTOBER 28.

GAULLIST VOTERS TURN BACKS ON PRO-ROCKEFELLER MINISTER

OCT. 18 (IPS)—INCUMBENT DEPUTY PIERRE ABELIN. THE PRO-ROCKEFELLER MINISTER OF COOPERATION IN THE GOVERNMENT OF PRESIDENT GISCARD FACES A RUN-OFF ELECTION TO RETAIN HIS SEAT IN FRANCE'S PARLIAMENT TOMMORROW. AFTER HE FAILED TO RECEIVE AN ABSOLUTE MAJORITY IN THE FIRST ROUND ELECTION OCT. 12. ABELIN RECEIVED ONLY 49.5 PER CENT OF OF THE VOTE THIS YEAR. AFTER HE WON 60 PER CENT IN THE 1973 ELECTION.

ABELIN'S STARTLING LOSS OF SUPPORT IS ATTRIBUTED TO GAULLIST VOTERS' REFUSAL TO SUPPORT HIM, DESPITE HIS BACKING FROM GAULLIST PRIME MINISTER CHIRAC. ACCORDING TO IPS ANALYSIS, THE GAULLIST VOTE SPLIT FOUR WAYS. OVER 50 PER CENT ABSTAINED, 20 PER CENT VOTED FOR ABELIN, 15 PER CENT VOTED FOR THE SOCIALIST CANDIDATE EDITH CRESSON, AND 13 PER CENT VOTED FOR DISSIDENT GAULLIST CANDIDATE ROUSSEL.

UNLESS LARGE NUMBERS OF GAULLISTS WHO ABSTAINED IN THE OCT. 12 ELECTION DECIDE TO TURN OUT FOR ABELIN TOMORROW, OBSERVERS GIVE HIS NON-OPPONENT CRESSON WHO HAS THE SUPPORT OF THE COMMUNISTS, A GOOD CHANCE TO UNSEAT ABELIN TOMORROW.
