LE MONDE SAYS KISSINGER MAY BE SABOTAGING NORTH-SOUTH CONFERENCE

NOV. 22 (IPS)—THE SPECIAL ENERGY CORRESPONDENT FOR LE MONDE RE-PORTED YESTERDAY THAT THERE ARE INDICATIONS THAT U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINER IS DELIBERATELY ATTEMPTING TO STALL THE NORTH-SOUTH INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON RAW MATERIALS WHICH IS SCHEDULED TO TAKE PLACE IN PARIS IN MID-DECEMBER. A PROPOSAL FOR DEBT MORATORIA AND A NEW INTERNATIONAL LENDING AGENCY IS EXPECTED TO BE ON THE AGENDA OF THAT CONFERENCE.

REPORTING THAT BOTH THE THIRD WORLD "GROUP OF 77" AND THE INDUSTRIALIZED NATIONS ARE HAVING DIFFICULTIES DECIDING ON THEIR
REPRESENTATIVES FOR THE CONFERENCE, PHILIPPE SIMMONOT CONCLUDES:
"ONE CAN ALSO ASK ONESELF WHETHER, THROUGH THIS DIPLOMATIC IMBROGLIO, THE AMERICANS ARE NOT TRYING TO STALL, DIRECTLY OR
THROUGH THE BRITISH, IT IS NOT EXACTLY A COINCIDENCE IF MR. WILSON, THE BRITISH PRIME MINISTER, AND MR. ENDERS, MR. KISSINGER'S
ASSISTANT, WERE THE FIRST TO REVEAL THE DIFFICULTIES ENCOUNTERED
BY THE GROUP OF 77. IN WASHINGTON, THE FUNDAMENTAL QUESTION CONTINUES TO BE POSED: DOES THE UNITED STATES REALLY WANT TO OPEN
UP A *DIALOGUE*?"

STATE DEPARTMENT INTERVENES TO TOPPLE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

NOV. 22 (IPS)—WEST GERMANY'S SUEDDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG, A RECOGNIZED MOUTHPIECE FOR THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT, HAS CALLED FOR THE DUMPING OF PRO-DEVELOPMENT JAPANESE PRIME MINISTER MIKI AND HIS REPLACEMENT BY AMERICAN AGENT DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER FUKUDA. IN A LENGTHY ARTICLE ON JAPANESE POLITICS TODAY, THE ZEITUNG CLAIMED THAT MIKI IS ONLY A PLACE-HOLDER AND STATES THAT THE MAIN QUESTION IN JAPANESE POLITICS IS WHETHER HE WILL RESIGN "BEFORE OR AFTER THE ELECTIONS." THE ZEITUNG QUOTES FUKUDA AS SAYING THAT HE IS THINKING OF REPLACING MIKI "VERY SOON."

NOT MENTIONED IN THE COMMENTARY IS MIKI'S CALL FOR VASTLY EXPANDED INTERNATIONAL NORTH-SOUTH AID AND DEVELOPMENT ISSUED AT
THE RAMBOUILLET ECONOMIC SUMMIT LAST WEEK. ALSO NOT REPORTED IS
THE FIGHT RAGING IN JAPAN BETWEEN MIKI AND HIS SUPPORTERS IN JAPANESE INDUSTRY WHO FAVOR EXPANDED WORLD TRADE, AND FUKUDA AND FINANCE MINISTRY BOSS OHIRA, WHO ADVOCATE AUSTERITY, TRIAGE AND
CONTINUING DEPRESSED PRODUCTION LEVELS. MIKI'S RAMBOUILLET
SPEECH HAS BEEN BLACKED OUT BY MOST OF THE WESTERN PRESS ON ORDERS FROM SECRETARY OF STATE KISSINGER AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT.

THE SUEDDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG ALSO SINGLES OUT THE JAPANESE SOCIAL-IST PARTY, WHICH HAS BEEN GROOMED FOR SEVERAL YEARS TO BECOME A RESPECTABLE AND "LIBERAL" PRO-AMERICAN OPPOSITION PARTY, WARNING THAT THE JSP MUST DISCIPLINE OR EXPEL ITS MILITANT LEFT WING IF IT EVER EXPECTS TO BECOME THE GOVERNMENT.

PORTUGUESE LEFT. MILITARY COUNCIL SCRAPPING REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL RESOLUTION

NOV. 22 (IPS)—THE MAJORITY OF MILITARY UNITS IN THE LISBON REGION TODAY REJECTED A RESOLUTION FOR SOLVING THE NATION'S POLITICAL CRISIS SUBMITTED BY PORTUGAL'S REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL. FOLLOWING THE REJECTION, PORTUGUESE PRESIDENT COSTA GOMES REVOKED THE RESOLUTION AND CALLED ANOTHER MEETING OF THE REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL FOR THIS EVENING. THE CRISIS WAS PROVOKED WHEN THE NATOLED SIXTH GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCED THAT IT HAD SUSPENDED ITS FUNCTIONING UNTIL THE ARMED FORCES GUARANTEES IT PROTECTION FROM THE POPULATION, WHICH IS PROTESTING ITS AUSTERITY PROGRAM.

THE REJECTED RESOLUTION, WHICH WAS MADE PUBLIC ONLY YESTERDAY, HAD CALLED FOR TALKS WITH POLITICAL LEADERS TO DISCUSS THE RESTRUCTURING OF THE GOVERNMENT AND HAD "ORDERED" THE REPLACEMENT OF LISBON'S PRO-MADIST REGIONAL COMMANDER, GEN. OTELO SARAWADE CARVALHO, WITH A RIGHT-WING REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL MEMBER, CAPT. VASCO LOURENCO. UNDER THE RESOLUTION, CARVALHO WAS DESIGNATED TO SUPERVISE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A PLAN TO CREATE LINKS BETWEEN CIVILIAN POPULAR ORGANIZATIONS AND THE ARMED FORCES MOVEMENT THAT MOULD BYPASS THE POLITICAL PARTIES, MOST SIGNIFICANTLY THE COMMUNIST PARTY, WHICH HAS GREATER PENETRATION INTO POPULAR ORGANIZATIONS THAN THE OTHER POLITICAL PARTIES.

ALTHOUGH CARVALHO, WHO IS REPORTEDLY A "PERSONAL FRIEND" OF LOURENCO, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES, AGREED WITH THE REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL'S DECISION, PROGRESSIVE MILITARY UNITS WENT ON ALERT AND FORCED ITS CANCELLATION.

FRENCH EXPAND MIDEAST DIPLOMACY TO EGYPT AND SAUDI ARABIA

NOV. 22 (IPS)—THE PRO-ROCKEFELLER FRENCH GOVERNMENT HAS BACKED UP THE INTERVENTION OF FORMER FRENCH PRIME MINISTER MAURICE COUVE DE MURVILLE INTO THE CIA-INSTIGATED LEBANESE CIVIL WAR WITH INTERVENTIONS INTO EGYPT AND SAUDI ARABIA. THE FRENCH INTERVENTION IS WIDELY CONCEDED TO BE AIMED AT PROPPING UP THE SAGGING MIDEAST DIPLOMATIC MANIPULATIONS OF U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER, WHICH ARE NOW THREATENED BY A CONSOLIDATION OF COMMUNIST AND OTHER LEFTIST FORCES THROUGHOUT THE MIDEAST.

A FRENCH DELEGATION LEFT CAIRO TODAY AFTER HAVING ESTABLISHED TIES BETWEEN PRESIDENT ANWAR SADAT'S EGYPTIAN ARAB SOCIALIST UNION AND THE FRENCH GAULLIST PARTY, THE UDR. THE DELEGATION ALSO PREPARED THE WAY FOR A DEC. 10 VISIT TO EGYPT BY FRENCH PRESIDENT GISCARD HIMSELF, ACCORDING TO COMBINED FRENCH PRESS REPORTS.

IN ADDITION. THE FRENCH HAVE CONTRACTED TO ARM AND TRAIN THE SAUDI ARABIAN ARMY AND NATIONAL GUARD. THE CHIEF PROTECTORS OF ROCKEFELLER OIL INTERESTS IN SAUDI ARADIA.

MEANWHILE, COUVE TODAY BEGAN A ROUND OF MEETINGS WITH LEBANESE OFFICIALS AND POLITICAL LEADERS. IN AN INDICATION THAT HE WILL TRY TO ARRANGE A SERIES OF "CONCESSIONS" TO THE LEBANESE LEFT AS A PACIFICATION MEASURE, YESTERDAY'S LONDON TIMES REPORTS THAT THE FANATIC RIGHT-WING CHRISTIAN FALANGISTS IN LEBANON HAD OPPOSED'HIS VISIT.

ANGOLA FACTION FIGHT IN STATE DEPARTMENT?

NOV. 22 (IPS)—"A FAIR-SIZED DEBATE" IS TAKING PLACE IN THE DE-PARTMENT OF STATE OVER WHAT TO DO IN ANGOLA NOW THAT THE CIA/ SOUTH AFRICAN-SUPPORTED INVASION OF THAT COUNTRY IS LOSING STEAM, ACCORDING TO THE NOV. 22 ISSUE OF THE BRITISH FINANCIAL WEEKLY. THE ECONOMIST.

"THE AMERICANS' OWN MOVES SO FAR HAVE BEEN LIMITED TO COVERT SUPPLIES OF MILITARY AID, SHIPPED VIA ZAIRE (TO THE NATIONAL FRONT AND NATIONAL UNION)," SAYS THE ARTICLE. "THE STATE DE-PARTMENT'S AFRICAN SPECIALISTS ARE GENERALLY AGAINST GIVING MORE AID IN THIS WAY, BUT MR. KISSINGER...THINKS THE UNITED STATES CANNOT SIT IDLY BY WHILE THE RUSSIANS MOVE IN."

THE ECONOMIST ADDS THAT KISSINGER, NOT THE STATE DEPARTMENT AFRICA BUREAU, WAS LARGELY RESPONSIBLE FOR AID TO THE "ANTI-MARX-IST FORCES" IN THE FIRST PLACE. IN THE CONTEXT OF THE FIRM SOVIET COMMITMENT TO THE POPULAR MOVEMENT GOVERNMENT IN ANGOLA, THE ECONOMIST SAYS THE ODDS ARE AGAINST AMERICAN ESCALATION, DUE TO THE FACT THAT KISSINGER'S POSITION WAS "WEAKENED BY THE GOVERNMENT RESHUFFLE IN WASHINGTON THREE WEEKS AGO."

"IF THE RUSSIANS REALLY WANT THEIR SIDE TO WIN IN ANGOLA," THE ARTICLE CONCLUDES, "THERE ARE LIMITS TO WHAT THE AMERICANS WILL DO TO PREVENT THEM."

HARD-LINE FACTION CLEANS OUT SOUTH AFRICAN COMMUNIST PARTY

NOV. 22 (IPS)—THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF SOUTH AFRICA (SACP) HAS PRAISED THE HELSINKI CONFERENCE ON EUROPEAN SECURITY AS ALLOWING "THE FREEDOM STRUGGLE TO BE PURSUED WITH UTMOST VIGOUR, WITHOUT LEADING TO ATOMIC WORLD WAR," IN THE LATEST ISSUE OF ITS QUARTER-LY THEORETICAL JOURNAL, THE AFRICAN COMMUNIST. THE SACP STATEMENT ATTACKS MADISM FOR CRITICIZING THE HELSINKI CONFERENCE AS A CARVING UP OF THE GLOBE INTO COMMUNIST AND "DEMOCRATIC" SPHERES OF INFLUENCE.

IN A SECTION DEVOTED TO ANTI-WORKING-CLASS IDEOLOGIES, THE SACP HITS SOCIAL DEMOCRATS WHO "BREAK UP THE UNITY OF THE WORKING CLASS IN THEIR HATRED OF COMMUNISM, PAVING THE WAY FOR THE BOURGEOIS AND FASCIST ELEMENTS, WHO, AS EVER, FIND THEM A CONVENIENT STALKING HORSE." WEST GERMAN OFFICIAL REFUSES TO INVESTIGATE ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT

NOV. 22 (IPS)—FURTHER INVESTIGATION OF THE ATTEMPTED MURDER OF HEINZ MUELLER, PARLIAMENTARY PRESIDENT OF THE WEST GERMAN STATE OF LOWER SAXONY, HAS BEEN SUSPENDED BY STATE'S ATTORNEY KLAUS KUTZER, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S FRANKFURTER RUNDSCHAU. IN EFFECT, KUTZER ANNOUNCED YESTERDAY THAT NO SUCH ATTEMPT HAD TAKEN PLACE, CLAIMING THAT THE POLICE HAD BEEN UNABLE TO FIND BULLET HOLES OR CASINGS AT THE WOODED SITE OF THE MURDER ATTEMPT. THE POLICE, ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S RUNDSCHAU, ALSO CONCLUDED THAT "THERE IS NO CONCRETE PROOF OF AN ATTEMPTED CRIME BY ANARCHISTS."

KUTZER'S MOVE FOLLOWS CLOSELY HIS RECENT REFUSAL TO PROSECUTE MAOISTS WHO HAD ASSAULTED EUROPEAN LABOR COMMITTEE MEMBERS IN THE LOWER SAXONY CITY OF HANNOVER, ALTHOUGH BYSTANDERS COMPARED THE INCIDENT TO NAZI STORM-TROOPER ATTACKS. KUTZER JUSTIFIED THAT MOVE ON THE GROUNDS THAT ELC NEWSPAPER ARTICLES ON MAOISM CONSTITUTED AN EXTENUATING "PROVOCATION."

THESE TWO EVIDENT ABROGATIONS OF DUTY PROVIDE PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE THAT KUTZER IS ACTING IN CONCERT WITH BRITISH AND U.S. AGENT COUNT PETER VON CERTZEN, THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC LEADER IN THE HANNOVER AREA WHO HELPED SET UP THE MACIST NETWORKS IN WEST GERMANY.

ROME CONFERENCE ON THE FUTURE OF CAPITALISM REPORTED PESSIMISTIC ON CAPITALISM'S PROSPECTS

NOV. 22 (IPS)—TOP ROCKEFELLER CABAL OPERATIVES FROM THROUGHOUT EUROPE GATHERED YESTERDAY IN ROME FOR AN "INTERNATIONAL DEBATE" ON "THE FUTURE OF CAPITALISM." AMONG THOSE PRESENT WERE FORMER CONSERVATIVE PRIME MINISTER EDWARD HEATH OF BRITAIN, FRANCOIS MITTERRAND, LEADER OF THE FRENCH SOCIALIST PARTY, GIORGIO AMENDOLA FROM THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY'S NATO—CONTROLLED LEADER—SHIP, GUIDO CARLI, FORMERLY GOVERNOR OF THE BANK OF ITALY, AND ROCKEFELLER'S TOP ITALIAN ENFORCER, GIANNI AGNELLI OF FIAT. ACCORDING TO REPORTS IN THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY NEWSPAPER, UNITA, CARLI WAS "VERY PESSIMISTIC" ON THE STATE OF THE WORLD ECONOMY, WHILE AMENDOLA CONCENTRATED ON ASSURING THOSE PRESENT THAT HIS PARTY CONTINUES TO HAVE THE "COURAGE" TO DEMAND "SACRIFICES" FROM THE WORKING CLASS.

II. CONTINENTAL

CHURCH AND KISSINGER ENDORSE MURPHY PROPOSALS ON CIA AND FBI

NOV. 22 (IPS)—SEN. FRANK CHURCH YESTERDAY ANNOUNCED THAT HIS SE-LECT COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE WILL INTRODUCE LEGISLATIVE PROPO-SALS FOR A JOINT CONGRESSIONAL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE FOR THE NA-TION'S INTELLIGENCE AGENCIES. ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES.

YESTERDAY SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER APPEARED BEFORE THE CHURCH COMMITTEE TO REVIEW IN EXECUTIVE SESSION "THE GENERAL PROBLEM OF CONTROL OF INTELLIGENCE FUNCTIONS." ACCORDING TO THE WASHINGTON POST, KISSINGER TOLD REPORTERS LATER THAT HE FAVORED TIGHTER CONTROL OF THE CIA AND FBI BY THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CONGRESSIONAL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE TO WORK CLOSELY WITH THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH "AS IT DEVELOPS COVERT OPERATIONS."

THE PROPOSALS ARE BORROWED DIRECTLY FROM THE REPORT OF THE ROCKEFELLER-RUN MURPHY COMMISSION.

CIA'S 23RD OF SEPTEMBER LEAGUE ACTIVATED IN WAXACA, MEXICO

NOV. 22 (IPS)—A GROUP OF YOUTHS ALLEGED TO BE MEMBERS OF THE CIA-CONTROLLED 23RD OF SEPTEMBER LEAGUE IN MEXICO SHOT AND KILLED FOUR PEOPLE IN A DEMONSTRATION CALLED TO OUST THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF JUCHITAN, OAXACA TWO DAYS AGO. THE CROWD CAUGHT AND LYNCHED TWO OF THE GUNMEN, ACCORDING TO ACCOUNTS IN THE MEXICAN DAILIES EXCELSIOR, LA PRENSA AND OVACIONES.

THE MOTIVES OF THE SLAYINGS ARE NOT CLEAR.

TUNNEY TO INCLUDE CHURCH/MURPHY INTELLIGENCE PROPOSALS IN S. 1

WASHINGTON, D.C., NOV. 22 (1PS)—A CONGRESSIONAL SOURCE TOLD IPS YESTERDAY THAT SEN. JOHN TUNNEY (D-CALIF) IS PLANNING TO INCORPORATE THE SOON-TO-BE-RELEASED RECOMMENDATIONS OF SEN. FRANK CHURCH'S (D-ID) SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE ON INTELLIGENCE TO CURB ILLEGAL ACTIVITIES BY THE FBI AND CIA INTO THE PROPOSED S. I REVISION OF THE UNITED STATES CRIMINAL CODE.

S. 1. WHICH HAS BEEN VIGOROUSLY SOUGHT BY THE ROCKEFELLER FORCES, WOULD RE-ENACT SUBSTANTIAL PORTIONS OF THE ANTI-COMMUNIST SMITH ACT WHICH HAVE BEEN DECLARED UNCONSTITUTIONAL BY THE COURTS. AS WELL AS GRANTING OTHER BROAD POLICE POWERS WHICH VIOLATE THE CONSTITUTION. ACCORDING TO SENATE INSIDERS, THE ROCKEFELLER FORCES PLAN TO SNEAK S. I THROUGH THE SENATE WITHIN THE NEXT TWO TO THREE WEEKS.

THE SENATE INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEE'S RECOMMENDATIONS ON ILLEGAL INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES ARE EXPECTED TO RESEMBLE CLOSELY THOSE OF THE ROCKEFELLER-LED MURPHY COMMISSION. THE MURPHY COMMISSION HAS CALLED FOR THE CREATION OF A NEW NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE BODY WITH THE POWER TO UNDERTAKE INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES WHICH ARE NOW ILLEGAL

N.J. ATTORNEY GENERAL RAILRAODS USLP IN ELIZABETH CASE

ELIZABETH, N.J., NOV. 22 (IPS)—A DEPUTY TO NEW JERSEY ATTORNEY GENERAL WILLIAM HYLAND ACTED COLLUSIVELY WITH A UNION COUNTY JUDGE IN ELIZABETH THIS MORNING TO PREVENT POLICE CHIEF RAY FROM TESTIFYING ON BEHALF OF SIX LABOR PARTY DEFENDANTS CHARGED WITH "SOLICITING IN A ROADWAY." THE ORGANIZERS WERE ARRESTED AUG. 26 FOR SELLING NEWSPAPERS AT AN ELIZABETH INTERSECTION.

POLICE CHIEF RAY WAS PREPARED TO TESTIFY THAT HE HAD ONCE ATTEMPTED TO REMOVE A BOURGEOIS NEWSPAPER STAND FROM A SIMILAR INTERSECTION BUT HAD BEEN ENJOINED FROM DOING SO BY THE UNION COUNTY COURT ITSELF—DEMONSTRATING EXTREME PREJUDICE IN THE LABOR PARTY CASES AND OPENING UP ATTORNEY GENERAL HYLAND TO A SUIT CHARGING CONSPIRACY TO VIOLATE THE USLP'S FIRST AMENDMENT RIGHTS.
