NSC. CHINA. PAKISTAN ATTEMPT NUCLEAR PROVOCATION IN BANGLADESH

NOV. 27 (IPS)—INDIA'S HIGH COMMISSIONER TO BANGLADESH, SAMAR SEN, WAS CRITICALLY HOUNDED YESTERDAY MORNING WHEN GUNMEN ATTACKED AND ATTEMPTED TO KIDNAP HIM AS HE ENTERED THE OFFICES OF THE HIGH COMMISSION IN DACCA. IN THE ENSUING SHOOT-OUT BETWEEN INDIAN SECURITY POLICE AT THE HIGH COMMISSION, BENGALI POLICE, AND THE GUNMEN, FOUR GUNMEN WERE KILLED AND TWO WERE INJURED AND ARRESTED. RELIABLE REPORTS INDICATE THAT THE ATTEMPTED KIDNAP-PING WAS A RETALIATORY ACTION BY THE CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY-LINKED JATIYO SAMAJTRANTRIC DAL (JSD), WHOSE TOP LEADERSHIP WAS ARRESTED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF BANGLADESH NOV. 25 IN A MOVE AIMED AT HELPING TO RESTORE STABILITY TO THAT COUNTRY.

THE SHOOT-OUT AND ATTEMPTED KIDNAPPING OF SEN-AN ATTEMPT TO PROVOKE THE INDIAN GOVERNMENT INTO MILITARY CONFRONTATION IN BANGLADESH-IS THE LATEST IN A SERIES OF EFFORTS BY U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER'S NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL (NSC) TO USE THE INDIAN SUBCONTINENT AS THE TRIPWIRE FOR A THERMONUCLEAR CONFRONTATION WITH THE SOVIET UNION. KISSINGER'S EFFORTS HAVE THE ACTIVE POLITICAL AND MILITARY SUPPORT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND FORMER PAKISTANI MILITARY OFFICERS NOW IN BANGLADESH WHO HAVE MAINTAINED CLOSE TIES WITH THE CIA-ORGANIZED PAKISTANI ARMED FORCES.

THE NSC HAS ACTIVELY ADOPTED A POLICY OF GENOCIDE TOWARD BAN-GLADESH, AND THERE IS EXTENSIVE DOCUMENTATION SHOWING THAT THE NSC'S GENOCIDE SCENARIO INCLUDES FAMINE, COMMUNAL HINDU-MUSLIM WARFARE, AND MAOIST TERROR. IF THE NSC SCENARIO IS SUCCESSFULLY IMPLEMENTED IN BANGLADESH, THE CHAOS WILL INEVITABLY SPREAD INTO INDIA, AS PANICKY REFUGEES SWARM INTO INDIA'S TROUBLED NORTHEAST-ERN REGION.

INDIAN GOVERNMENT REPORTS ISSUED EARLIER THIS WEEK HAVE WARNED THAT CHINA AND THE PAKISTANI GOVERNMENT HAVE BEEN COOPERATING TO KEEP PRESSURES ON THE NORTHERN AND WESTERN BORDER OF INDIA AT THE SAME TIME AS PROVOCATIONS AGAINST BANGLADESH'S 10 MILLION HINDUS AND INDIAN NATIONALS IN BANGLADESH WERE BEING SYSTEMATICALLY ESCALATED TO FORCE INDIAN MILITARY RESPONSE. THE PROVOCATIONS INCLUDE:

* ON NOV. 8. THE JATIYO SAMAJTRANTRIC DAL (JSD). ALSO KNOWN AS THE NATIONAL SOCIALIST GROUP, DISTRIBUTED THOUSANDS OF LEAFLETS FILLED WITH ANTI-INDIAN PROPAGANDA. THE JSD TOOK PUBLIC RESPON-

SIBILITY FOR THE ASSASSINATION OF ALL BANGLADESH'S LEADING INTEL-LECTUALS AND FORMER FOLLOWERS OF PRO-SOVIET PRESIDENT MUJIBUR RAHMAN. RAHMAN WAS HIMSELF ASSASSINATED ON AUG. 15 BY YOUNG MIL-ITARY OFFICERS, LINKED TO THE PAKISTANI ARMY AND TO THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL REGIONAL HEADQUARTERS IN BANGKOK.

- * ON NOV. 16. A LIVE GRENADE WAS FOUND IN THE HOME OF HIGH COMMISSIONER SEN.
- * IN THE PAST TWO WEEKS, THE JSD HAS MURDERED OVER 100 PRO-SOVIET INTELLECTUALS IN THEIR REIGN OF TERROR.
- * NEW AGE, WEEKLY OF THE INDIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (CPI). HAS CHARGED THAT THE CIA AND MAOISTS IN BANGLADESH ARE INVOLVED IN EFFORTS TO "DESTABILIZE THE ENTIRE INDIAN SUBCONTINENT." U.S. AMBASSADOR TO BANGLADESH DAVIS BOOSTER WAS A STATE DEPARTMENT LIAISON TO THE U.S. EMBASSY IN CHILE AT THE TIME OF THE ASSASSINATION OF CHILEAN PRESIDENT ALLENDE. ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-THO MEMBERS OF THE U.S. MISSION IN BANGLADESH HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AS FORMER MEMBERS OF THE U.S. EMBASSY IN SAIGON DURING THE VIETNAM WAR.

THE BANGLADESH GOVERNMENT HAS ARRESTED 19 JSD LEADERS, INCLUDING MAJ. JALIL, WHO "PREDICTED THAT PAKISTAN WOULD GO TO WAR
AGAINST INDIA TO REVENGE PAST DEFEATS," MAJ. ABDUR RUQ, WHO WAS
INVOLVED IN THE ASSASSINATION OF PRO-SOVIET MAJ. GEN. KHALID MUSSARAF, AND LT. COL. ABU TAHER, THE JSD'S PRIME ORGANIZER INSIDE
THE BENGALI ARMED FORCES. ALL ARE CHARGED WITH SUBVERSIVE ANTIGOVERNMENT ACTIVITY."

THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA HAS OFFICIALLY RELEASED A STATEMENT EXPRESSING SHOCK AT THE ATTEMPT ON SEN'S LIFE AND DEMANDING THAT "THE GOVERNMENT INSTITUTE AN IMMEDIATE INQUIRY INTO THIS INCI-DENT, EXPOSE THE CONSPIRACY BEHIND IT AND PUNISH THE OFFENDERS."

THE INDIAN GOVERNMENT FURTHER STATED THAT "FOR THE LAST FEW WEEKS, INSIDIOUS AND MISCHIEVOUS PROPAGANDA HAS BEEN CARRIED ON IN BANGLADESH, AGAINST INDIA. SEN HAS DRAWN THE ATTENTION OF THE BANGLADESH GOVERNMENT TO THE SERIOUS CONSEQUENCES OF THIS CAMPAIGN BUT IT HAS CONTINUED.

**THE INDIAN GOVERNMENT HAS REMINDED THE BANGLADESH GOVERNMENT OF ITS RESPONSIBILITY TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE PROTECTION TO THE HIGH COMMISSION STAFF AND ALL INDIAN NATIONALS IN BANGLADESH, TO AVOID FURTHER INCIDENTS OF GRAVE CONSEQUENCES FOR THE REGION.
