WEST GERMAN NATO EXPERT CONFIRMS THAT HILEX 175 IS NO EXERCISE

BONN, W. GERMANY, DEC. 6 (IPS) -- WERNER MARX, THE DEFENSE POLICY SPOKESMAN FOR THE WEST GERMAN CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION (CDU), CONFIRMED THAT THE ONGOING NATO EXERCISE "HILEX 15" IS AN OPERATIONAL STEP-BY-STEP "LIMITED" NUCLEAR CONFRONTATION WITH THE SOVIET UNION IN AN INTERVIEW TODAY.

MARX ALSO JUSTIFIED THE HILEX CONFRONTATION BY SAYING THAT THE SOVIETS HAD USED DETENTE TO MASK 2AGRESSION" AND INDICATED THAT HE WAS NOT WORRIED ABOUT THE FACT THAT HILEX COULD PROVOKE AN ALL-OUT SOVIET NUCLEAR COUNTERATTACK.

"YES, SURE, THESE MANEUVERS ARE AN IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHLESINGER'S (TACTICAL NUCLEAR WAR) CONCEPT." MARX ELABORATED.
"THEY ARE VERY POLITICAL AND NOT SO MILITARY...THERE IS A VERY COMPLEX CONNECTION OF POLITICAL, PSYCHOLOGICAL, ECONOMIC, AND MILITARY FACTORS. A MANEUVER OF THIS KIND IS NOT USUAL. EARLIER MANEUVERS WERE TO RESPOND TO A CONVENTIONAL ATTACK, NOW, IT'S TO A GLOBAL DEPLOYMENT. THERE'S ALSO THE PROBLEM OF AN OIL CUT-OFF...THE SOVIET'S 'OCEAN' MANEUVERS TAUGHT US THAT THEY HAVE SENT THEIR NAVY EVERYNHERE, CAPE VERDE, SOMALIA (THERE THEY ARE THREATENING IRAN NITH THEIR MISSILES), THE MOUTH OF THE PERSIAN GULF, THE GULF OF BENGAL, THE CHINA SEA..."

MARX ALSO SAID THAT "NO EUROPEAN, WHETHER GISCARD, SCHMIDT OR FORD (SIC) COULD SAY AFTER DISCUSSING WITH THE CHINESE THAT THEY TOOK THEM SERIOUSLY. THE WEST BELIEVES IN DETENTE." HE WAS NOT ALARMED AT THE SOVIET WAR POLICY OF MUTUALLY ASSURED DESTRUCTION (MAD). "NATURALLY, NATURALLY...THAT IS THEIR POLICY... AS ALWAYS, THE SOVIET SIDE HAS ITS *HARD NUCLEAR STRATEGY. MAD."

MARX CONCLUDED THE INTERVIEW BY CHARGING THAT THE SOVIETS HAD VIOLATED DETENTE: "THE SOVIETS WILL INCREASE THEIR PRESSURE ON EUROPE...THERE ARE 3000 CUBAN SOLDIERS AND SOVIET INSTRUCTORS IN ANGOLA...THE SOVIETS HAVE MILITARILY STRENGTHENED EVERYWHERE...EVERYWHERE, THE SOVIETS ARE ON THE MARCH PHYSICALLY. THE WEST BELIEVED IN DETENTE, BUT FOR THE EAST, THIS WAS JUST A TACTICAL VARIATION OF THEIR AGGRESSIVE POLICY."

KTSSINGER: U.S. AND CHINESE DISCUSSED WAR NITH SOVIETS IN PEKING

DEC. 6 (IPS) -- IN A LAST-MINUTE BRIEFING TO REPORTERS FOLLOWING THE FINAL TALKS BETWEEN U.S. AND SOVIET LEADERS IN PAKING YESTER-

DAY, SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER CONFIRMED THAT PRESIDENT FORD'S PEKING TRIP HAD FOCUSED ON PLANS FOR WAR AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION. "WE ARE NOT CONVINCED OF THE INEVITABILITY OF WAR." KISSINGER SAID, ACCORDING TO THE BALTIMORE SUN, "BUT, SHOULD THE CHINESE INTERPRETATION (I.E., THAT WAR IS INEVITABLE) BE CORRECT, I BELIEVE THAT THE UNITED STATES WOULD SEE THE PROBLEM QUITE SERTOUSLY."

A STATEMENT BY AN UNNAMED AIDE TO PRESIDENT FORD REPORTED IN TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES SAID THAT THE CHINESE HAD URGED THE U.S. TO "GIVE UP DETENTE AND ATTACK THE RUSSIANS FRONTALLY, TO TAKE THE HEAT OFF THEM—THAT'S WHAT THEY WANT."

FBI CHIEF DEMANDS ABROGATION OF CONSTITUTION

ST. LOUIS, DEC. 6 (IPS)—FBI CHIEF CLARENCE KELLEY, SPEAKING BEFORE THE "CONFERENCE ON HUMAN DIGNITY AND AMERICAN DEMOCRACY" HERE TODAY, TOLD THE CONFERENCE: "WE MIGHT AS WELL ACKNOWLEDGE, IT, AN OCCASIONAL AND TIGHTLY CONTROLLED ABROGATION OF RIGHTS IS UNAVOIDABLE IF THE NATIONAL SECURITY IS 10 BE PROTECTED."

CRITICIZING CONGRESSIONAL INVESTIGATIONS INTO FBI COVERT OPERATIONS, KELLEY DEFENDED ONGOING ILLEGAL FBI COINTELPRO OPERATIONS AND INDICATED THAT COVERT FBI TERRORISM THROUGH SUCH GROUPS AS THE KU KLUX KLAN, THE WEATHERMEN, THE REVOLUTIONARY UNION, AND OTHERS, WOULD CONTINUE. "GATHERING INTELLIGENCE ABOUT EXTREMIST GROUPS THAT THREATEN TERRORIST ACTS IS ESSENTIAL, AND OUR ABILITY TO DISCHARGE THIS FUNCTION SIMPLY MUST NOT BE CRIPPLED."

KELLEY'S REMARKS CLOSELY PARALLEL REMARKS BY ATTORNEY GENERAL EDWARD LEVI AT THE COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY LAW SCHOOL EARLIER THIS WEEK. LEVI INDICATED THAT ROCKEFELLER FORCES WOULD MOVE TO IMPOSE AN OVERT FASCIST DICTATOR SHIP IN THE UNITED STATES IF CONGRESS ATTEMPTED TO INTERFERE WITH ROCKEFELLER'S "INVISIBLE GOVERNMENT" APPARATUS.

CALLS FOR FOOD BOYCOTT OF SOVIETS MOUNT

DEC. 6 (IPS)—AMID CALLS BY ROCKEFELLER SPOKESMEN FOR THE UNITED STATES TO USE FOOD AS A "POLITICAL WEAPON." THE U.S. GOVERNMENT FOR THE SECOND TIME THIS YEAR IS COLLABORATING WITH THE INTERNATIONAL LONGSHOREMAN'S ASSOCIATION TO EMBARGO THE SALE OF GRAIN TO THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT. ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF COMMERCE ROBERT BLACKWELL ANNOUNCED IN MOSCOW TODAY THAT THE SOVIETS ARE REFUSING TO RENEW A GRAIN TRADE AGREEMENT WHICH CALLS FOR THE SOVIETS TO PAY AMERICAN SHIPPING COMPANIES \$6 PER TON MORE THAN THE WORLD PRICE OF \$10 PER TON FOR TRANSPORTING U.S. GRAIN TO THE USSR, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES.

AT THE SAME TIME, THOMAS GLEASON, THE ILA HEAD WHO LAUNCHED AN EAST COAST WIDE BOYCOTT OF SOVIET GRAIN SHIPMENTS LAST FALL, WARNED THAT HIS UNION WOULD RENEW ITS BOYCOTT UNLESS THE SOVIETS AGREED TO RENEW THE SHIPPING AGREEMENT BEFORE THE DECEMBER 31 EXPIRATION DATE.

GLEASON'S LAST BOYCOTT IS KNOWN TO HAVE BEEN ORCHESTRATED BY JOSEPH SISCO, A TOP STATE DEPARTMENT AIDE TO SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER.

ALSO TODAY, THE DAILY EXPRESS OF LONDON URGED THE WORLD'S GRAIN EXPORTING COUNTRIES TO "BRING IT HOME (TO THE SOVIET PEOPLE) THROUGH A 'FOOD SHORTAGE' HOW INCOMPETENT THEIR LEADERS ARE AND FURTHER WARNED THAT BRITISH BREAD PRICES WOULD RISE AS A CONSEQUENCE OF SOVIET FOOD IMPORTS.

THE LONDON DAILY TELEGRAPH URGED THE WEST TO RETHINK THE WHOLE QUESTION OF EXPORTING GRAIN TO THE SOVIETS.

THE CALLS FOR A FOOD BOYCOTT OF THE USSR FOLLOW PRESS REPORTS OF A RECORD FAILURE OF THE SOVIET GRAIN HARVEST, WHICH, WESTERN PRESS SOURCES SAY, WILL REQUIRE THE SOVIETS TO INCREASE THEIR FOOD AND GRAIN IMPORTS FROM THE UNITED STATES.

KISSINGER DEPLOYS ROGERS TO MEXICO AS PART OF U.S. OFFENSIVE TO IMPLEMENT RAND SCENARIOS IN LATIN AMERICA

DEC. 6 (IPS)—U.S. UNDERSECRETARY OF STATE WILLIAM D. ROGERS ARRIVED IN MEXICO YESTERDAY TO DISCUSS QUESTIONS OF RESTRUCTURING THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES (OAS) WITH HIGH MEXICAN OFFICIALS. HE IS SCHEDULED TO HAVE MEETINGS WITH MEXICAN PRESIDENT LUIS ECHEVERRIA AND UNDERSECRETARY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS GONZALEZ SOSA, ACCORDING TO REPORTS BY THE FRENCH NEWS AGENCY AGENCE FRANCE PRESSE AND THE MEXICO CITY EVENING PAPER, ULTIMAS NOTICIAS, DEC. 5.

ROGERS ARRIVED JUST ONE DAY AFTER THE COLLAPSE OF THE CIA-CO-ORDINATED "TRACTOR STRIKE" OF LATIFUNDISTS IN THE STATES OF SONORA AND SINALOA, AND IMMEDIATELY MET JITH THE CIA'S TOP OPERATIVE IN MEXICO, U.S. AMBASSADOR JOHN JOSEPH JOVA.

THE ROGERS VISIT IS PART OF MAJOR KISSINGER DEPLOYMENTS THROUGH-OUT LATIN AMERICA TO IMPLEMENT RAND CORPORATION SCENARIOS OF STARTING "LOCAL WARS" IN LATIN AMERICA WHICH WOULD THEN REQUIRE U.S. CONTROLLED "PEACEKEEPING FORCES." ROGERS WENT TO MEXICO DIRECT FROM MIAMI WHERE HE ECHOED THE RAND LINE THAT THE INTERAMERICAN TREATY OF RECIPROCAL ASSISTANCE, THE PARENT MILITARY TREATY BEHIND THE OAS, SHOULD BE ADAPTED FOR INTERVENTION IN MEMBER STATES RATHER THAN ORGANIZED FOR COMMON PROTECTION AGAINST AN OUI-SIDE ENEMY.

SCHEEL TRIGGERS STEP IN HILEX ESCALATION SCENARIO

DEC. 6 (IPS)—IN AN INTERVIEW WITH THE RIGHT-WING DAILY DIE WELT YESTERDAY, WEST GERMAN PRESIDENT WALTER SCHEEL ANNOUNCED THAT "THE TROOPS OF OUR PARTNERS IN THE ALLIANCE (NATO) THAT ARE IN WEST GERMANY ARE PROOF OF THE ALLIANCE'S READINESS....IN CASE WE HAVE TO AVERT AN ATTACK OUT OF SELF-DEFENSE, THEN THE BUNDESWEHR (WEST GERMAN ARMY) CAN MOBILIZE A SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF MEN WHO ARE TRAINED FOR DEFENSE."

ACCORDING TO THE JULY 14 ISSUE OF THE WEST GERMAN WEEKLY DER SPIEGEL, ONE OF THE ESCALATION STEPS IN A NATO THERMONUCLEAR CON-FRONTATION WITH THE SOVIET UNION PROGRAMMED INTO THE CURRENT. FOUR-WEEK-LONG NATO "EXERCISE" CALLED HILEX '75 IS AN ANNOUNCE-MENT BY A WESTERN HEAD OF STATE CONFIRMING "THE READINESS FOR WAR OF ALL THE TROOPS IN THE ALLIANCE." SCHEEL'S STATEMENT, INEXPLICABLE EXCEPT AS AN ACTUAL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE HILEX SCENARIO, IS SEEN AS ONE MORE SIGN THAT HILEX IS A REAL CONFRONTATION, NOT AN EXERCISE.

VORWAERTS HITS NUCLEAR WAR DEPLOYMENT

DEC. 6 (IPS)—THE LATEST ISSUE OF VORWAERTS, THE WEEKLY PAPER OF THE WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY (SPD), FEATURES A SERIES OF MAJOR BLASTS AGAINST THE ROCKEFELLER DEPLOYMENT FOR A NUCLEAR CONFRONTATION WITH THE SOVIET UNION. THE LEAD ARTICLE IN VORWAERTS CRITICIZES ANY ATTEMPT TO SEND WEST GERMAN ARMS EXPORTS TO HOT SPOT COUNTRIES, WHICH IS OUTLAWED BY THE WEST GERMAN CONSTITUTION. VORWAERTS IDENTIFIES NATO-ALIGNED PAKISTAN BY NAME AS ONE EXAMPLE OF A COUNTRY THAT TRIES TO GET WEST GERMAN ARMS BY SAYING THAT IT NEEDS PROTECTION AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION.

FOLLOW-UP ARTICLES CRITICIZE CHINA FOR TRYING TO PUSH PRESI-DENT FORD AWAY FROM A "FRAGILE DETENTE" AND BLAST AN ARTICLE BY ONE THOMAS SCHELLING IN HARVARD MAGAZINE WHICH SAYS THE WORLD MUST CHOOSE BETWEEN NUCLEAR MAR OR WORLDWIDE TERRORISM. "THE U.S. SHOULD ONCE AND FOR ALL GIVE UP THE IDEA OF NUCLEAR CONFRON-TATION WITH THE SOVIET UNION AND SHOULD STRIVE FOR MILITARY DE-TENTE AT THE INTERNATIONAL LEVEL." VORWAERTS SAYS.

FINALLY, IN AN ARTICLE ON THE LONG-DELAYED GUN-RUNNING TRIAL OF KARL CARSTENS, A LEADING WEST GERMAN ROCKEFELLER AGENT, VOR-WAERTS DEMANDS: "NHEN WILL HE COME TO TRIAL?"
