## I. PRIORITY ITEMS

PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST LEADER, ALVARO CUNHAL, SAYS THAT NOW IS THE TIME FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF COMMUNISM

DEC. 8 (IPS)—ALVARO CUNHAL, THE LEADER OF THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) HAS DECLARED THAT IT IS NECESSARY TO LAUNCH A CAMPAIGN TO REINFORCE THE POWER OF THE PCP, ACCORDING TO A UPI DISPATCH YESTERDAY.

ADDRESSING A CROWD OF MORE THAN 20,000 IN THE LISBON BULL-RING YESTERDAY, CUNHAL SAID: "WE MUST REORGANIZE AND CONSOLIDATE OUR POSITION FOR A NEW ATTACK. (IT IS OUR) AIM THAT THE PORTUGUESE REVOLUTION ADVANCE TOWARDS THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SOCIALISM. NOW, THE SLOGAN MUST BE TO IMPLANT COMMUNISM IN EVERY FACTORY AND FOR EVERYONE IN THE COUNTRY."

CUNHAL BELITTLED THE THREAT ALLEGEDLY POSED BY THE NOV. 25
MILITARY UPRISINGS WHICH HAVE BEEN USED AS AN EXCUSE FOR A MASSIVE MILITARY CRACKDOWN ON THE LEFT, SAYING THAT THE REVOLT HAD BEEN
CAUSED BY SOLDIERS WHO WERE PROVOKED BY REACTIONARY OFFICERS. HE
DENIED THAT THE PCP LEADERSHIP HAD BEEN INVOLVED IN THE REVOLT.

DE MARTINO SUMMONED TO THE U.S. TO GET ORDERS FROM KISSINGER

DEC. 8 (IPS)—FRANCESCO DE MARTINO, GENERAL SECRETARY OF THE ITALIAN SOCIALIST PARTY (PSI), HAS BEEN INVITED TO VISIT THE USA WHERE HE WILL MEET WITH SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER JAN.

12. THE DEC. 5 FINANCIAL TIMES, WHICH REPORTS THE NEWS, ALSO INDICATES THAT THE MAJOR TOPIC OF THE DISCUSSIONS WILL BE TO TRY TO CONVINCE DE MARTINO TO ENTER A "CENTER-LEFT" GOVERNMENT AND PREVENT THE CONSUMATION OF THE "HISTORICAL COMPROMISE" BETWEEN THE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCI) AND THE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRACY (DC).

THE INVITATION COMES AT A TIME WHEN THE PSI IS ENGAGED IN AN INTERNAL FACTION FIGHT SPEARHEADED BY DE MARTINO'S MAJOR FACTIONAL OPPONENT, FORMER PSI GENERAL SECRETARY GIACOMO MANCINI, SPOKESMAN FOR THE PRO-DEVELOPMENT FACTION OF THE PARTY.

DE MARTINO HAS BEEN NOTED IN THE PAST FOR HIS DEMAND TO EXTEND "GOVERNMENTAL RESPONSIBILITIES" TO THE CIA-CONTROLLED LEADERSHIP OF THE PCI.

## MEXICAN PAPER BLASTS SIMON AND ROCKEFELLER FOR ATTACKS ON NEW WORLD ECONOMIC ORDER

DEC. 8 (IPS)—THE DEC. 5 MEXICAN PROGRESSIVE DAILY EL SOL, WHICH IS LINKED TO CIRCLES CLOSE TO MEXICAN PRESIDENT LUIS ECHEVERRIA. BLASTED RECENT STATEMENTS OF U.S. SECRETARY OF THE TREASURY WILLIAM SIMON AND DAVID ROCKEFELLER. THE PAPER HAD REPORTED THE STATEMENTS THE DAY BEFORE UNDER THE JOINT HEADLINE. "SIMON AND D(AVID) ROCKEFELLER ASSERT THAT THE NEW WORLD ECONOMIC ORDER PROVOKES DIFFICULTIES."

EL SOL HAD QUOTED A DAVID ROCKEFELLER SPEECH BEFORE THE U.S. CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IN MILAN, ITALY IN WHICH ROCKEFELLER "STRONG-LY ATTACKED 'POLITICAL ACTS AIMED AT RESTRICTING THE LEGITIMATE AND BENEFICIENT ACTIVITIES OF TRANSNATIONAL CORPORATIONS.'" SIMON WAS QUOTED AS SAYING THAT THE "SO-CALLED NEW WORLD ECONOMIC OR-CENTER OF SHOULD BE OPPOSED IF IT AFFECTS THE PRINCIPLES OF FREE ENTER-PRISE" AT THE RECENTLY CONCLUDED "PACEM IN TERRIS" THINK-TANK/GATHERING IN PARIS.

THE SOL EDITORIAL REJOINDER STRESSED THAT "THE COINCIDENCE OF VIEWS (BETWEEN SIMON AND ROCKEFELLER) RESPONDS SIGNIFICANTLY TO THE SAME ATTITUDE: THE OPPOSITION TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MORE JUST WORLD ECONOMIC ORDER, AND THE REFUSAL TO ACCEPT THAT THE ECONOMIC INTERRELATION OF THE WORLD HAS CHANGED. IN APPEARANCE (THEY) DEFEND FREE ENTERPRISE. BUT IT SHOULD BE ASKED: IS IT FREE ENTERPRISE THAT IS WANTED OR FREE MANIPULATION BY THE MULTINATIONALS?"

THE EDITORIAL CONCLUDES STRONGLY THAT IT IS EXACTLY THE MAN-IPULATION BY MULTINATIONALS DEFENDED BY ROCKEFELLER WHICH "MAKE THE NEW ECONOMIC ORDER MORE URGENT EVERY DAY."

## LAROUCHE REPRESENTATIVE LAYS OUT HILEX '75 TO MASS DEMS

WORCHESTER, MASS., DEC. 8 (IPS)—A SPOKESMAN FOR THE U.S. LABOR PARTY PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE LYNDON H. LAROUCHE, JR. TOLD AN AUDIENCE OF DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES AND OVER 1,000 LIBERAL DEMOCRATS AT THE PRESIDENTIAL CAUCUS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS CITIZENS FOR PARTICIPATION IN POLITICAL ACTION (CPPAX) HERE YESTERDAY THAT THE NATO MANEUVERS CODE NAMED HILEX 15 WOULD LEAD TO A THERMONUCLEAR WAR WITHIN THE NEXT TWO MONTHS.

THE AUDIENCE, WHICH INCLUDED REP. PHILIP DRINAN (D-MASS). PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES EX-SENATOR FRED HARRIS, REP. MORRIS UDALL (D-ARIZ) AND OTHERS, RECEIVED USLP REPRESENTATIVE GRAHM LOWRY'S PRESENTATION WITH SERIOUSNESS AND GREAT DISCOMFORT. SEN. FRANK CHURCH'S (D-IDAHO) SON, SPOKESMAN FOR HIS FATHER, APPLAUDED LOWRY'S CALL FOR AN IMMEDIATE INVESTIGATION OF HILEX '75. DURING A PRESS CONFERENCE LATER IN THE AFTERNOON, REP. UDALL COMMITTED HIMSELF TO INVESTIGATE HILEX '75.
