BA'ATH PARTY: LEBANESE CIVIL WAR SET UP BY U.S. TO EXPAND CONTROL OVER MIDEAST OIL

DEC. 12 (IPS) -- THE IRAQI BA'ATH SOCIALIST PARTY ORGAN, ATH-THAWRA, IN ITS ISSUE OF NOV. 25, IDENTIFIES THE FIGHTING IN LEB-ANON AS PART OF A U.S. DICTATED SCENARIO TO EXPAND ITS DIRECT CONTROL OVER THE MIDDLE WEAST OIL FIELD AND IN SO DOING SUBJECT BOTH THE EAST AND THE WEST TO ITS MILITARY AND ECONOMIC DECTATORSHIP.

"SOON AFTER THE SECOND SINAL AGREEMENT" ATH-THAWRA WRITES
"THE LEBANESE RIGHT-WING ENCOURAGED BY U.S. IMPERIALISM AND ARAB
RIGHT-WING CIRCLES, LAUNCHED A BLOODY TERRORIST OPERATION TO LIQUIDATE BOTH PALESTINIANS AND ARAB PROGRESSIVE FORCES AND TO
TRANSFORM LEBANON INTO A SECTARIAN REACTIONARY ARM OF THE U.S.
FOR MOVING THROUGH SYRIA, TO IRAQ AND TO THE GULF. IN THIS FASHION, THE U.S. WILL GAIN TOTAL CONTROL OF ALL OIL RESOURCES."

INTENTIONS TO PUSH AHEAD WITH THIS SCENARIO, THE PAPER REPORTS, WERE UNDERSCORED BY THE RECENT DEPLOYMENT OF THE MIDDLE EAST
FLEET TROUGHOUT THE PERSIAN GULF, AROUND THE SAUDI ARABIAN PENINSULA AND THROUGH THE RED SEA. "THESE NAVY EXERCISES," ATHTHAWRA CONTINUES, "HAVE NO OTHER MEANING THAN TO DECLARE
THAT ALL WATERS SURROUNDING THE OIL FIELDS ARE IN AN AREA OF
U.S. STRATEGIC HEGEMONY." THE U.S. INTENDS TO SURROUND THE FIELDS
"WITH A MILITARY BELT CONTROLLING AT THE SAME TIME THE ROADS
AND GAINING CONTROL OF ALL TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES AS WELL AS
TERMINALS AND PIPELINES."

ATH-THAWRA WARNS THAT THIS IS THE MAJOR ASPECT OF SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER'S MIDDLE EAST SETTLEMENT, LEADING TO "FULL U.S. MILITARY DICTATORSHIP OF THE AREA...(THIS WILL) PROVOKE NOT ONLY UNLIMITED DANGERS FOR THE MIDDLE EAST BUT FOR THE ENTIRE WORLD...THE MIDDLE EAST WILL THEN BECOME A LAUNCHING PAD FOR ALL KINDS OF PROVOCATIVE MILITARY DEPLOYMENTS AND MASSIVE LOOTING..."

"THERE IS STILL TIME TO STOP THE EVIL CONSEQUENCES OF KISSINGER'S PLAN," ATH-THAWRA CONCLUDES. "RESPONSIBLE FORCES MUSTHWAKEGIONAL, NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY MUST TAKE "A FIRM STAND IN OPENLY DEMANDING DISUCSSION OF THESE ITENTIONS OF SUCH A U.S. IMPERIALIST SCHEME."

DIE WELT CALLS FOR END TO DEMOCRACY

DEC. 12 (IPS) -- RIGHT-WING EDITORIALIST GUSTAVE STROEHM OF THE WEST GERMAN NATO-ALLIED NEWSPAPER DIE WELT YESTERDAY CALLED FOR AN END TO DEMOCRATIC PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURES EECAUSE THEY AMOUNT TO "MORE SUBTLE FORMS OF TERROR...WITH WHOSE HELP POWERFUL INTEREST GROUPS AND INFLUENTIAL INDIVIDUALS IN THE WESTERN DEMOCRACIES CREATE A CLIMATE IN WHICH IT IS SUICIDAL FOR A POLITICIAN AND HIS CAREER TO REFLECT ON THE SURVIVIAL F THE STATE..."

STROEHM'S ATTACK ON WESTERN DEMOCRATIC INSTITUTIONS WAS ISSUED SPECIFICALLY IN DEFENSE OF WEST GERMAN DEFENSE MINISTER AND NUCLEAR WAR PROPONENT GEORG LEBER. "FOLLOWING THE TOPPLING OF (U.S. SECRETARY OF DEFENSE) SCHLESINGER, GEORG LEBER IS THE LAST DEFENSE MINISTER OF NATO WHO HAS A POLITICAL CONCEPT," STROEHM WRITES. ANGOLA A NEW CUBAN MISSILE CRISIS?

TO IMPROVE THE MILITARY FORTUNES OF THE TWO ANTI-COMMUNIST LIB-ERATION MOVEMENTS OF ANGOLA." THE PAPER REPORTS.

CORE'S CHAIRMAN, ROY INNIS ADMITTED THAT HE WAS RECRUITING BLACK AMERICANS FOR SERVICE AS MERCENARIES IN A "POLICE FORCE" TO BE OFFERED TO THE ORGANIZATION OF AFRICAN UNITY (OAU) FOR USE IN ANGOLA. INNIS TERMED THE ANGOLAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC AS "SOVIET DOMINATED" AND THAT HE "DID NOT LOOK FORWARD AT ALL TO A SOVIET TAKEOVER IN ANGOLA," ACCORDING TO NEWSDAY. THE NEWSDAY STORY WAS WIDELY COVERED ON WINS AND WHWS-FM RADIO TODAY.

IN A PRESS CONFERENCE THIS AFTERNOON, ROY INNIS ADMITTED THAT HE WAS RECRUITING THE MERCENARIES, BUT DENIED CIA INVOLVEMENT.

PCP ENDORSES AGENT ANTUNES! POP FRONT STRATEGY AGAINST PCP

DEC. 12 (IPS)--YESTERDAY'S L'HUMANITE, THE NEWSPAPER OF THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF), FULLY ENDORSES THE ATTEMPTS OF THE PORTU-GUESE FOREIGN MINISTER AND NATO AGENT MAJOR MELO ANTUNES, TO LURE THE PORTUGUESE COMUNIST PARTY (PCP) INTO A POPULAR FRONT AUSTERITY GOVERNMENT.

THE PAPER GIVES EXTENSIVE COVERAGE TO RECENT STATEMENTS MADE BY ANTUNES THAT "THE PARTICIPATION OF THE COMMUNISTS IS INDISPEN-SIBLE FOR THE EDIFICATION OF DEMOCRACY."

THE ARTICLE CONCLUDES WITH AN OUT-OF-CONTEXT QUOTE OF A STATEMENT BY PCP LEADER ALVARO CUNHAL IN WHICH HE CALLED FOR "NEW FORMS OF STRUGGLE" -- WRONGLY IMPLYING THTAT A COALITION GOVERNMENT MAY BE ACCEPTABLE TO THE PCP.

L'HUMANITE DOES NOT MENTION THAT ANTUNES IS THE HEAD OF THE RIGHTWING "GROUP OF NINE" OFFICERS NOR HIS BEING A STAUNCH SUP-PORTER OF THE CREATION OF A "NON-ALIGNED SOUTHERN EUROPEAN BLOC" INTENT ON SHATTERING THE WARSAW PACT.

MOVE TO SET UP JAPAN-U.S. BODY TO COORDINATE MILITARY ROLES IN ASIA

DEC. 12 (IPS)--THE U.S. AND JAPAN WILL HOLD TALKS IN MID-JANUARY TO SET UP A JOINT FORUM FOR CONSULTATION ON COORDINATION OF MIL-ITARY ROLES IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, ACCORDING TO THE DEC. 8 JAPANESE DAILY YOMIURI TO RESPONSE TO A U.S. REQUEST.

THE FORUM WILL NOT ONLY CONSIDER JOINT ACTION IN CASE OF MILITARY ATTACKS ON JAPAN, BUT WILL ALSO — MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR U.S. FORCES TO EFFECTIVELY USE ITS JAPAN BASES "TO MAINTAIN SECURITY AND PEACE IN THE FAR EAST." THE USE OF JAPANESE BASES FOR SUCH PURPOSES HAD PREVIOUSLY BEEN OPPOSED BY THE JAPANESE GOV'T.

THE JOINT FORUM IS BEING SET UP IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN AUGUST 1975 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THEN U.S. DEFENSE SECRETARY JAMES R. SCHLESINGER (MORE)

AND JAPAN DEFENSE AGENCY HEAD AND SCHLESINGER ADMIRER, MACHITA SAKATA.

LEFT SP LEADER CALLS FOR LIQUIDATION OF PCF

DEC 12 (IPS)—JEAN PIERRE CHEVENEMENT, MEMBER OF THE FRENCH SOCIALIST PARTY (PSF) EXECUTIVE BUREAU AND LEADER OF THE "LEFT-WING" CERES FACTION, HAS CALLED FOR THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF) TO LIQUIDATE ITSELF INTO THE SOCIALIST PARTY.

IN A MAJOR ARTICLE IN THE DEC. 10 PARIS DAILY, LE MONDE CHEVENEMENT ARGUES THAT THE PCF'S SPLIT FROM THE PSF IN 1920 ON ORDERS FROM THE COMINTERN HAS DONE IRREPARABLE DAMAGE TO THE UNITY OF THE WORKING CLASS MOVEMENT AND CALLED FOR THE REESTABLISHMENT OF "ORGANIC UNITY" BETWEEN THE TWO PARTIES. CHEVENMENT ALSO CALLS ON THE PCF TO RECOGNIZE THAT THE SOVIET UNION IS NOT THE SOLE "POLE" OF THE WORKING CLASS MOVEMENT, CITING THE EXAMPLE OF THE "INDEPENDENT" CIA-AGENT LED ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY.

THUS FAR LENINIST ELEMENTS IN THE PCF LEADERSHIP HAS NOT RE-SPONDED TO THIS OUT-RIGHT PROVOCATION.

WEST GERMANY ANNOUNCES "MEDITERRANEAN FOREIGN POLICY"

DEC. 12 (IPS) -- DOM MINTOFF, PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF MALTA -- SITE OF A MAJOR MEDITERRANEAN NATO INSTALLATION -- ARRIVED IN BONN WEST GERMANY YESTERDAY FOR CONFIDENTIAL TALKS WITH NATO AGENT AND WEST GERMAN FOREIGN MINISTER AND NATO AGENT HANS DIETRICH GENSCHER, ACCORDING TO WEST GERMAN RADIO, GENSCHER ANNOUNCED THE ACTIVE PARTICIPATION BY HIS COUNTRY IN MINTOFF'S "MEDITERRANEAN" SECURITY AND POLITICAL COLLABORATION STRATEGY.

THE MINTOFF VISIT TO WEST GERMANY FOLLOWS EARLIER VISITS THIS WEEK TO ITALY AND GREAT BRITAIN. WHILE IN LONDON, MINTOFF CONSULTED WITH BRITISH PRIME MINISTER AND LABOUR PARTY LEADER HAROLD WILSON AND DUTCH PRESIDENT JOOP DEN UYL. THERE IS SPECULATION IN INFORMED POLITICAL CIRCLES IN EUROPE THAT MINTOFF IS ALSO FUNCTIONING FOR NATO AS A MESSENGER ON THE SUBJECT OF RECENT OUTBREAKS OF TERRORIST VIOLENCE IN PARTICULARLY, HOLLAND.

POLICE MOBILIZATION IN MUNICH

MUNICH, BRD, DEC. 12 (IPS) -- A MASSIVE POLICE "SEARCH" FOR AN ALLEGED MURDERER BEGAN HERE YESTERDAY, WHICH INCLUDED THE USE OF HELICOPTERS AND INDISCRIMINATE INDENTITY CHECKS. AT ONE UNEMPLOY-MENT OFFICE, POLICE CHECKED THE IDENTITITES OF EUROPEAN LABOR PARTY ORGANIZERS AS WELL AS THOSE OF A NUMBER OF FOREIGN AND WEST GERMAN WORKERS.

AFRICAN LEADERS ARE DRAWING THE SAME CONCLUSION ABOUT ANGOLA'S INDEPENDENCE. THE UNITED NATIONS AMBASSADOR FROM ONE OF INDEPENDENCE. THE UNITED NATIONS AMBASSADOR FROM ONE OF THE MORE CONSERVATIVE AFRICAN GOVERNMENTS REPORTEDLY TOLD A CLOSED MEETING OF THE AFRICAN REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNITED NATIONS DEC. 9. "THE U.S. COULD HAVE SECURED THE INDPENDENCE OF ANGOLA IN THE 1960'S WITH A MERE NOD TO PORTUGAL -- IF IT HAD WISHED. NOW THA ANGOLA IS INDEPENDENT, WHAT IS THE MEANING OF THIS SUDDEN U.S. 'CONCERN' FOR ANGOLA? THIS IS LAUGHABLE!" THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AFRICAN TRADE UNION UNITY (OATUU), DENNIS AKUMU, EXPRESSED SIMILAR SENTIMENTS AT A PRESS CONFERENCE AT THE UN.

IV. ORGANIZING AND INTELLIGENCE

KISSINGER PUSHES PSYWAR ARMS POROPOSAL TO NATO MINISTERS

DEC. 12 (IPS) -- SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY A. KISSINGER INSTRUCTED REPORTERS HERE AND IN WASHINGTON THIS WEEK TO REPORT THAT HE WOULD ISSUE A "MAJOR PROPOSAL" TO NATO FOREIGN MINISTERS MEETING HERE FOR A REDUCTION IN THE U.S. TACTICAL NUCLEAR WEAPON ARSENAL IN WESTERN EUROPE IN EXCHANGE FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF A FULL SOVIET TANK ARMY FROM EASTERN EUROPE. MOST REPORTERS OBEDIENTLY FILED THE STORY WHICH WAS PLAYED UP TODAY BY THE NEW YORK TIMES? DREW MIDDLETON.

ACCORDING TO INFORMED SOURCES, KISSINGER IS SEEKING TO FOSTER THIS "PROPOSAL" -- WHICH HAS ALREADY BEEN REJECTED AS RIDICULOUS BY THE SOVIET UNION OVER SIX MONTHS AGO -- AS A MEANS TO CREATING THE APPEARANCE OF A SOVIET UNWILLINGNESS TO NEGOTIATE MUTUAL AND BALANCED FORCE REDUCTIONS. ALSO, SOURCES SSAID, THE SO-CALLED KISSINGER "PROPOSAL" IS INTENDED TO LEAD TO STATEMENTS OF OPPOSITION TO THE PROPOSAL FROM ROCKEFLLER-LINKED LEADERS IN WESTERN EUROPE WHO WOULD THEN DECLARE SUPPORT FOR U.S. OCCUPATION FORCES IN EUROPE.
