'An Impeachable High Crime and Misdemeanor'

Here is the key portion of House Concurrent Resolution 107, introduced by Rep. Walter Jones, in Congress, on March 7.

Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate concurring), That it is the sense of Congress that, except in response to an

actual or imminent attack against the territory of the United States, the use of offensive military force by a President without prior and clear authorization of an Act of Congress violates Congress's exclusive power to declare war under article I, section 8, clause 11 of the Constitution and therefore constitutes an impeachable high crime and misdemeanor under article II, section 4 of the Constitution.
