

The Princess of Wales, Kate Middleton, Has Been Diagnosed with Cancer

There is a high probability she has turbo cancer caused by COVID-19 mRNA vaccines she took in 2021.

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What type of mRNA-Induced Turbo Cancer would require urgent abdominal surgery, followed by "preventative chemotherapy"?

1. Turbo Colon Cancer – one of the most common Turbo Cancers today
2. Turbo Ovarian Cancer – on the rise with a devastating prognosis
3. Turbo Uterine Cancer – showing up in younger women
4. Rare Turbo Cancers: appendix, gallbladder, pancreas, gastric, liver

I will go through each possibility in detail and then give my hypothesis, on what I believe is the most plausible cancer.

Turbo Colon Cancer

- Turbo Cancer is a cancer that arises following the administration of one or more COVID-19 mRNA Vaccines
- Turbo Colon Cancer would be very plausible as Colon cancer is one of the most common Turbo Cancers (there is evidence suggesting it is in the top 5)
- It may have presented with abdominal pain, blood in the stool or a bowel obstruction
- It is believed on Dec. 28, 2023, Kate was taken in an ambulance to the hospital, possibly due to one of these symptoms.
- She would have likely have had imaging done that would have shown a mass

that required surgery, which took place two weeks later on Jan. 16, 2024.

- We are told the Jan. 16, 2024 surgery was not for cancer:

[Feb. 9, 2024 Daily Mail](#): "The spokesman did not provide details about the nature of her surgery, but sources briefed that it was not for cancer."

- Princess Kate: "In January, I underwent major abdominal surgery...and at the time, it was thought my condition was non-cancerous. The surgery was successful, however tests after the operation, found that cancer had been present"
- Princess Kate: "My medical team therefore advised that I should undergo a course of "preventative chemotherapy" and I am now in the early stages of that treatment"

Examples:

April 23, 2023 - Missouri, MO - On March 16, 2023, 29 year old Elise Scott was supposed to have surgery to remove a pair of masses on her ovaries. She was diagnosed with Stage 4 Colon Cancer with spots on her liver, ovaries and along her abdomen wall. She will have chemo for up to 6 months.

On March 16th, 2023, our world changed, Elise was supposed to have surgery to remove a pair of identified masses on her ovaries. The doctor brought me and her mother into a consultation room to inform us that Elise does have stage 4 colon cancer and they have identified spots on her liver, ovaries and along her abdomen wall. Coming to grips with what the future holds is uncertain at best, besides a long road of chemotherapy treatments for up to 6 months to hopefully shrink the cancer enough for a lengthy surgery. After which, Elise will have another round of 4+ months of chemotherapy. Her ability to work will be impacted by this and she will need support to assist with the uncertain bills ahead.

[May 26, 2023](#) - Orange, CA - 24 year old Ciara Meza is a college graduate working on master's degree in Psychology. She had cramping and bloating and ended up in emergency and was diagnosed with Stage 4 Colon Cancer that has metastasized to her lungs.

Hi my name is Ciara Meza, I'm a 24 year old college graduate with a degree in Human Services and currently working on my master's degree in Psychology. I hope to become a Licensed Clinical Psychologist to help those struggling with mental illness. When I am not in school, I work as a waitress at Outback Steakhouse as well as a day counselor at an Intensive Outpatient Substance Abuse Treatment Center. My life was just getting started, until it paused...

It started off with typical cramping pain and bloating until it became unbearable I ended up in the emergency room. After many tests and a colonoscopy later, it was on March 8, 2023, I was diagnosed with stage 4 colon cancer that has metastasized into a nodule on my lung. With the amazing help from my doctors at St. Joseph's, I have begun receiving chemotherapy treatments and attend every other week. I am expected to have surgery

[Aug. 5, 2023](#) - Modesto, CA - 44 year old Gemma Nelson woke up with pain in her groin area that became very severe over the course of 3 days. She was diagnosed with Stage 4 Colon cancer with a 14 inch tumor wrapped around her left ovary and back and a 6 inch tumor in her colon. She is currently doing chemotherapy for 10 months now.

Hello my name is Gemma. I am 44 years old with two wonderful children. Unfortunately one morning in October 2022 I woke up to aching in my groin area & within 3 days I was hunched over walking with a cane. A 14 inch tumor & a 6 inch tumor was found discovered. The 14 inch tumor was wrapped around my back and destroyed my left ovary. The 6 inch tumor was found in my colon. I had no reaction I just felt numb & my kids & the treatment options. I mean what particular emotion am I supposed to feel when a Dr tell you I'm sorry but you are stage 4 Colon cancer? You are handing your life in professionals hands to beat this nightmare. My first surgery was in November 2022 the 14 inch mass via cesarean section due to being the size of a newborn and my second surgery was in January 2023 that was for a bowel resection & After 6 hours the 6 inch mass was removed. Turbo Ovarian Cancer

- Ovarian tumors can be benign or malignant and the ovaries are not accessible for biopsy, which means you usually need to have a surgery first before a diagnosis can be made.
- They can also be very difficult to distinguish on imaging, so a cancer might not be initially suspected.
- If Kate ended up in emergency on Dec.28 due to pain, and imaging showed an ovarian cyst or mass, it is plausible she would have been scheduled for a major abdominal surgery (such as a total hysterectomy) and the hope was that it was a non-cancerous process like an ovarian cyst.
- Only after pathology examination, could a determination be made if the ovarian cyst was a cancer.

Examples:

[Nov. 8, 2023](#) – 21 year old Destinee had a large cyst that was believed to be benign. After surgery she was diagnosed with a 32 by 15cm ovarian cancer in Jan. 2022.

She was diagnosed with ovarian cancer at the age of 21 – this is Destinee's story



"It was just after New Year's, and I went to a CrossFit session – at this point, I looked about nine months pregnant. I ended up presenting to the emergency room after and that's when they told me that they thought I had a benign tumour. Surgery was booked for six weeks," she says.

"Two days later, I presented back. My tumour had ruptured which caused my lungs to collapse, amongst a lot of other things. They ended up flying me to Brisbane for emergency surgery."

Then, her entire world was turned upside down during a single phone call three weeks later when the biopsy results came back – the 32 cm by 15 cm tumour was cancerous.

"I was diagnosed [with ovarian cancer] over a five-minute phone call. And in that same phone call, I was told that I had to do chemo and that it was really recommended that I freeze my eggs," says Destinee.

Going through the motions – incredibly frustrated with her sudden lack of independence – she spent her 22nd birthday in hospital receiving chemo. Now, after finishing her treatment in 2022, she's living her life the way she wants to, right here in Canberra.

[Dec. 8, 2023](#) – Avondale, AZ – 31 year old Ashlie Edwards had a surgery (laparotomy) to remove two large cysts. She was diagnosed with Stage 3C Ovarian Cancer on Aug. 17, 2023. One mass was the size of a basketball on her left ovary, another mass was on her kidney.

Hey Everyone,

My Name is Ashlie Edwards and I have recently been diagnosed August 17, 2023 with Stage 3C Ovarian cancer. At the age of 31, I am learning of this news and coming to terms that my life has changed forever. I was placed on an unpaid LOA (leave of absence) from work to heal from my laparotomy (open surgery) to remove the two large cysts. **One the size of a Basketball was on my left ovary going into my lower and mid abdomen and the second mass was on my kidney.** Returning back to work was a hassle after surgery due to my employer not having light duty accommodations. I could not return to work until my doctor approved of my incision being completely healed.

My name is Porschea. I am a 32 year mother of a sweet and sometimes wild 6 year old little boy. **I was diagnosed with Ovarian cancer- Mucinous Adenocarcinoma in August 2023.** This is my journey and struggles thus far.

For those who do not know. I had an ovarian cyst that started at 11cm. My specialist refused to operate stating it will go away or burst and be absorbed. Fast forward it shrunk to 8cm and I was put on lupron depot to help with symptoms from the endometriosis. After starting lupron the cyst began to grow rapidly and the **specialist kept turning surgery down until the cyst was 30 cm and taking up my entire abdomen.** He then stated he recommends a full hysterectomy and he did not do those and told the hospital to refer me to an Obgyn. I'll skip quite a few details but I ended up finally having surgery on August 3, 2023. I was cut from sternum to pubic bone and spent 4 days in the hospital at sycamore shoals.

Turbo Uterine Cancer:

- If Kate presented to emergency on Dec. 28, 2023 with abdominal pain or vaginal bleeding, and imaging showed a uterine mass, it is possible that doctors suspected a benign mass such as fibroids (uterine leiomyoma).
- Only after pathological examination could a determination be made whether there was cancer present, such as endometrial cancer or uterine sarcoma - this would certainly come as a shock.

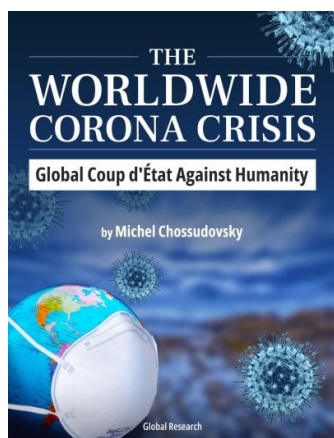
- Uterine sarcomas are more aggressive and have a worse prognosis than endometrial cancer.
