

During a U15 encounter in Sens in Yonne, the young man complained of chest pain. He couldn't be revived. At this stage, no investigation is opened.

Following the discomfort, Clement is taken urgently to the hospital of Sens where his death will be pronounced in the middle of afternoon. He had a heart attack, reports <u>France Bleu Auxerre</u>.

No investigation is open to date, says the parquet of Auxerre. Medical investigations are currently underway.



But tragedy struck on Tuesday when Mondou was found unresponsive by emergency services at his flat in Hamar, 60 miles north of Norway's capital Oslo.

In a statement, HamKam said: 'It is with great sadness that HamKam Football has received the news that Achilles has passed away at the age of



March 7 (Reuters) - Sweden midfielder Kristoffer Olsson is suffering from multiple small blood clots on both sides of his brain as a result of an extremely rare inflammatory condition in his brain vessels, the player's club Midtjylland said on Thursday.

Olsson has been in hospital and <u>put on a ventilator</u> after the 28-year-old fell unconscious at home last month. He was admitted to Aarhus University Hospital where the club said he had undergone several scans and tests in recent weeks.

"The diagnosis matches the thesis on which the medical specialists have so far worked and treated Kristoffer," the Danish club said in a statement.

(CNN) — Swedish soccer star Kristoffer Olsson has been hospitalized and placed on a ventilator, seemingly due to an "acute disease related to the brain," according to a statement from his team FC Midtjylland on Tuesday.

The Danish side said the 28-year-old lost consciousness at his home on February 20 and was taken to a local hospital in Aarhus, Denmark, where he continues to receive treatment.

Olsson, who has played 47 times for his country and once represented English Premier League club <u>Arsenal</u>, has been surrounded by immediate family and club staff since being admitted to hospital, the team added.

"Everyone at FC Midtjylland is of course deeply affected by Kristoffer's sudden illness and our thoughts and full support go out to Kristoffer and his family," the club said in the statement.

The club said it released the statement after rumors started spreading online about Olsson's continued absence from the team. FC Midtjylland also asked for privacy to allow the midfielder and his family to focus on recovery.

FC Midtjylland <u>said on Wednesday</u> that training had been closed to media and fans as the club had been so affected by what had happened to Olsson.

A former Norway player has passed away at the age of 39 following a cardiac arrest.

Mounir Hamoud retired in 2019 after a 15-year career as a professional in his homeland, starring for the likes of Lyn, Bodo/Glimt and Stromsgodset.

He was also capped 15 times by his country at youth level, playing seven times for the under 21 side, though never for the Norway senior team.

Keen to stay in football post-retirement, Hamoud had picked up a job as an 'elite player developer' with former side Stromsgodset having worked as a circuit manager for player development in NFF Buskerud for the last four years.

Hamoud, who was 39, died Monday on the morning of the first day of his new job in player development with Strømsgodset, the team said Monday.

Hamoud, a Moroccan-born forward, spent the final eight seasons of his 15-year playing career at Strømsgodset before retiring in 2019. He played for Norway's Under-18, Under-19 and Under-21 teams and was selected once for the country's senior team but didn't get off the bench in a 1-0 win over Germany in Dusseldorf in 2009, the Norwegian news agency NTB said.



He woke up, but doctors then told the family he had an incurable form of cancer that was spreading rapidly. He was transferred to St Vincent's Hospice for palliative care on January 30. Within hours of arriving, he tragically died. His devastated family is now urging other young people not to ignore serious changes to their bodies.

Gerald's cousin Ailley Colquhoun told the **Record**: "When my auntie Paula found out Gerald had been hiding the fact he had blood in his sick, she immediately took him to hospital. He was obviously scared when he hid it so we're urging anyone who has any symptoms like his to get checked out immediately, before it's too late There was nothing they could do for Gerald, the cancer was just everywhere. It was in his bones and in his blood. Our whole family were with him when he died. He told us he loved us and he said goodbye. Those were his last words. He passed away a few hours later."

Ailley added: "It was so quick, it's hard to take in that he's actually gone. We're all in shock." As the family come to terms with the loss of Gerald, who was a carer for his dad Gerry following a stroke, a **fundraiser** has been set up to help them pay for his funeral and give him the "send off he deserves".

Ailley continued: "Gerald was the youngest in the family and he was Paula and Gerry's only son. He was a funny, cheeky lad. He loved his **dogs** and St Mirren FC. He was always up for a laugh and very easy going. He never took life too seriously. Everyone always says how polite and kind he was. So many people have been paying tribute to him have said he was a great footballer too. He played all through school but had given it up in recent years when he became a carer. He had his whole life ahead of him but he was unaware of what was going on until last week. It's just unbelievably sad."

(CNN) — Former Panama striker Luis 'Matador' Tejada, who helped the national team qualify for its first ever World Cup in 2018, has died at the age of 41, the Panamanian Football Federation (FEPAFUT) announced on Sunday.

Local media reported that Tejada, whose 43 international goals makes him Panama's all-time leading goal scorer, collapsed while playing in a local recreational league.

CNN Sport has reached out to the Panamanian national police for comment.

FEPAFUT said in a statement that Tejada, who played 108 times for Panama, was "synonymous with the development and evolution of football in our country."

"We express our sincerest condolences to his relatives, friends and the whole football family and Panamanian sport in general," the statement read.

"We will never forget you Matador!"

Former Panama striker Blas Pérez, who played alongside Tejada in attack for Panama and is second behind the 'Matador' on the national team's scoring charts, wrote on X

Gray, the son of former Leeds United and Scotland winger Eddie Gray, died at a hospice in Yorkshire after being diagnosed with cancer last year.

The U's said in a statement: "Everyone at **Oxford United** was saddened to learn of the death of our former winger Stuart Gray.

"The former Celtic player joined Oxford from Rushden & Diamonds in August 2005, to link up again with manager Brian Talbot.

"He made 11 appearances for the U's, with his final game coming in February 2006, before injury ended his professional career.

"Stuart had been bravely fighting Cholangiocarcinoma, a very rare and highly aggressive form of cancer. Our thoughts are with his family and friends."

Gray played 32 times for Celtic after coming through the club's youth ranks. He also played for Greenock Morton on loan, before going on to play for Reading, Rushden & Diamonds, and United.

Celtic said in a statement: "Everyone at Celtic is deeply saddened by the news that former Celt, Stuart Gray, has passed away after illness at the age of 50.

"The thoughts and prayers of everyone at Celtic Park are with Stuart's family and friends at this very sad time."

"The past months I've had some tests done," wrote Sevecke in a social media post. 🗗


