



At 38, Jules doesn't look like someone who would be diagnosed with lung cancer and she believe this, coupled with her non-respiratory symptoms, meant she wasn't diagnosed as quickly as she could have been. She is sharing her experience to help others avoid similar delays.

"I think people would look at me and never believe I have stage 4 lung cancer which has spread to three points in my spine and pelvis but this is my reality.

"I was diagnosed on 5th November after a series of what I now know to be lung cancer symptoms. I had been suffering from back ache, shoulder pain and then developed a lump in my neck. I was totally unaware that any of these were signs of lung cancer and my doctors didn't piece it together either.

"My backache was put down to sciatica. My shoulder pain was diagnosed as tennis elbow – over the phone – whilst the lump in my neck was dismissed as a cyst or swollen gland that people get when they are run down. I wasn't happy with this so pushed back and was referred to an ear, nose and throat specialist and this was how I finally started on the path to diagnosis.

"The ENT doctor sent me for an ultrasound and they told me they were taking biopsies. That was when alarm bells started to ring.

"My worst fears were soon confirmed and I was diagnosed with lung cancer. At that point,

we didn't really know what was going on. The person who delivered the news was not a lung cancer specialist and so couldn't answer any of our questions. I was left fearing the worst.

As a mother, you just think of all the worst scenarios. I thought I was going to die and how was I going to tell my son. It just doesn't feel real. You just keep asking yourself 'Is this actually happening to me?'

"Three days later, I had a phone call to tell me the scans showed it had spread to my spine and pelvis. We were completely devastated and so scared. We were still waiting on the results of the biopsies so I still didn't have a treatment plan. All those worst case scenarios were feeling like they were coming true. All we knew for sure was that it was stage 4 and it felt like the end of the road.

"But then my treatment plan came in. I met my consultant and asked 'Can anything be done?' and he said yes! He told me about a targeted therapy that was showing great success, especially in the younger generation, by basically putting my cancer to sleep. And that is what is happening.

"Each day, I take this one little pill – I call it my magic medicine – and every scan since has shown my cancer is stable.

"It doesn't come without side effects. I think that's the price you pay for having a drug working so invasively in your system. I have mouthwashes constantly. My skin is cracked and dry because all the oil has been extracted from my body. I have diarrhea, sickness, loss of appetite and fatigue. The list goes on but that's where your lung nurse comes in. She will make everything more manageable.

I'm now approaching a year since my diagnosis and I have come to peace with it. I do not live with cancer; my cancer lives with me. I am the one in control.

"However, I do still feel angry. I'm not a medical professional so I couldn't have known that my body was sending out a message. I believe those little jigsaw pieces should have been picked up by a medical professional. I should have been scanned sooner and then my lung cancer could have been found out at a lower stage instead of stage four.

"I think lung cancer is very much associated to men. It has been largely thought of a manly illness, maybe someone who was a heavy smoker, or a man that worked in the asbestos industry.

"I want to break that stigma. And I will do everything in my power to do just that."



"We thought it was just flu but when we realised it was getting worse we took him to hospital in Durban, but they couldn't figure out what was wrong. We decided to take him to another hospital in Pietermaritzburg because this 'flu' was not getting any better. There they discovered he had lung cancer."

"They drew around one litre of water and blood from his lungs which showed it was at an advanced stage. So he died of lung cancer."

He said Bonginkosi's death was a big blow to the family as they had lost a responsible man who would attend to every need as soon as possible.

"We were very dependent on him. I would tell him 'you're the head of this home' because I was looking at his good deeds at home."

'Strong and passionate' Norfolk mum dies six weeks after cancer diagnosis

A young Norfolk mum has sadly lost her battle with cancer, after originally being told by dentists and GPs that she just had wisdom tooth pain. 31-year-old Jessica Robinson from Titchwell died on October 15 leaving behind her five-year-old daughter, Lilith as well has her loving mother and sister.

Jessica worked at her local primary school, and was about to begin her first year working as a teaching assistant before she became ill. She began to experience what she thought was wisdom tooth pain and attended many dentist and GP appointments with no real diagnosis. At the end of the school summer holidays, Jess was bed bound, in too much pain to move or eat.

One more appointment with a doctor saw her heading to hospital for a chest X-ray where a shadow was found in her lungs. After biopsies and MRI scans, the family were told that she had cancer in her left lung, fluid around her heart and swelling in her brain.

The fluid around her heart continued to grow and caused both chambers on the right side of her heart to collapse. She was sent to Royal Papworth Hospital in Cambridge where 2.5 litres of fluid was drained from her chest. Usually people have around 10-15 millilitres.


The family then received the devastating news that Jessica had stage four inoperable lung cancer. They were told that treatment could give her another 18 months but without it, she would only live for a maximum of six months. Sadly, Jessica never got well enough for treatment and the cancer spread, engulfing her whole left lung as well as her aorta and infusing into her spine. It was 45 days after her diagnosis that she sadly died.

Jessica's sister, Harriet Letzer said; "One of the things that Jessica wanted to do but never got the time to do was raise awareness for the symptoms that she got. It showed up as wisdom tooth pain because it turns out that nerves connect your face and your lungs together. One of the things she wanted to do was raise awareness for it because she spent weeks being bounced from the dentist to the GP with neither of them pressing any further than just her tooth pain."

The family was told that doctors had not been looking for lung cancer as the symptoms presented by Jessica were symptoms that usually present in people much older than her Harriet said: "Cancer is well known to get anybody at any age whether you're healthy or unhealthy.

"We all carry cancer cells, it's just whether or not they mutate. So being told that she was too young to be looking for it is very frustrating and it makes you angry because you just think 'why aren't we looking for it?" What could have been done if we had been looking for it?"



I am starting this fund on behalf of my incredible sister, Lindsey Porter.


Lindsey had bad daily headaches for about a month and explained them away as we are prone to do. Finally, she saw the doctor and he ordered an MRI. On Friday, August 4th she received a call from the doctor's office telling her to go to the ER because they see masses in her brain and she needed to get a full body CT Scan. The results came back positive for stage 4 adenocarcinoma in her lung, with metastasis to her brain. The world as we know it came to a halt for her family, and of course, Lindsey can only think of how much her baby needs her and she needs to be here for her.

We have listened to the medical plan which includes brain surgery later this week to remove the large tumor, radiation and chemotherapy. The best drugs available for her type of cancer are relatively new and can be outrageously expensive, even with some insurance coverage. There are large deductibles, and copays, and like most couples, Lindsey and Nigel both need to work. Lindsey was an emergency room nurse for 16 yrs and has since been working as a Trauma Specialist. Since my last update, Lindsey has been referred to Moffitt Cancer Center in Tampa. She has been seen by a thoracic surgeon who plans to remove half of her left lung-the entire left upper lobe after 3-4 rounds of chemo. Surgery will likely be just before Christmas. Due to her age she will be treated very aggressively, which we are all grateful for but it will be a long, difficult road for her. Chemo will begin as soon as she finishes her first cyberknife treatment on her brain, so in about 1-2 weeks. The real fight begins now. She continues to find strength from her miracle baby, Kami as well as family, friends and the many prayers and comforting words.

Hi my name is Michelle and I am fundraising for one of my co-workers, Ezti, who works with me at the veterinary clinic that I work at.

Ezti is a beautiful 29-year-old single mom to a sweet little 3-year-old girl that has worked with me for the past five years. Ezti started feeling poorly about year ago and was advocating for herself as best as she could with her doctor, who told her she had asthma with no diagnostics confirming this or any other issues that may be going on at the beginning of this year. Throughout this year, she has progressively gotten worse with her respiratory symptoms and she had been seen countless times trying to get her symptoms under control. Sadly she has had crucial diagnostic tests rescheduled several times due to varying reasons given by the medical facility that she had to have the testing done at.

Last Friday, August 18th, Ezti ended up in the ER with difficulty breathing. It was found that she had a collapsed lung and fluid in her chest. She had 2 1/2 liters of fluid drained from her chest and was sent home where her lung collapsed again. She returned to the ER Monday and they drained another 3 liters from her chest, placed a chest tube and set her up to get the CT that she has literally waited months to have done. Long story short, with finally having the diagnostics done, as well as the fluid that was in her chest sent out for cytology, Ezti has been diagnosed with stage 4 lung cancer.


